THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their current six-game homestand, going 1-2 against Cleveland, followed by a loss to Colorado last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three against the Rockies...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Cleveland to play a five-game series at Progressive Field, which includes a scheduled double header on Tuesday...Twins are 21-17 at home and 18-16 on the road.

BATS TURN BLUE AGAINST ROCKIES: The Twins lost to the Rockies last night at Target Field by a score of 1-0...Dylan Bundy (4-4, 4.80) was the starter and loser, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched...the offense was shutout for the 10th time this season, tied with Seattle, Kansas City and Detroit for the most in baseball...Ryan Jeffers, Carlos Correa and Max Kepler had all three of the Twins hits as Jeffers recorded his ninth double of the season. Last night marked the second time in Twins history (1961-present) with a 1-0/0-1 score in back-to-back games; the other was September 13-15, 1971, the 13th being the second game of a doubleheader at California and the 15th at Milwaukee.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed outfielder Trevor Larnach on the 10-day Injured List with a core muscle strain...Larnach has played in 51 games for the Twins this season, hitting .231 (37-for-160) with 13 doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, 22 runs scored, 18 walks and a .712 OPS. This marks his second stint on the Injured List this season, after missing 13 games from May 7-22 with a right adductor strain...to replace Larnach on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Mark Contreras from Triple-A St Paul...Contreras, 27, has played in 52 games for the Saints this season, hitting .245 (46-for-188) with 11 doubles, seven home runs, 30 RBI, a .346 on-base percentage and a .772 OPS...he played in three games over his two previous stints with the Twins this season.

WHEN IT RAINS, IT POURS: The Twins have gone 9-12 this month...below are their offensive numbers in wins compared to losses in June:

ADDITIONALLY: Twins have scored eight-plus runs 17 times this season, the most in baseball, going 16-1 in those games...however, they have been shut out 10 times this season, tied with Seattle, Kansas City and Detroit for the most in baseball.

JEFF YEA: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with four doubles, two home runs, six RBI, five walks, a .441 on-base percentage, a .690 slugging percentage and a 1.031 OPS in his last nine games...has hit safely in a career-high five straight games...in fact, in each of those games, he also has an extra-base hit...below are the longest extra-base hit streaks in Twins history among catchers (since 1961):

\* - Mauer's streak spanned six seasons, starting in 2013 when he was a regular catcher...he suffered concussions and moved from catcher to first base...on September 30, 2018, in his final career game, he doubled against the Chicago White Sox and finished his career catching one pitch behind the plate.

IL PLAY: The Twins are 1-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field last weekend and 0-1 against the Rockies...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is: Milwaukee at Target Field from July 12-13 and at American Family Field from July 26-27, San Diego at Petco Park from July 29-31, Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10, and San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28...Twins all-time IL wins ranks to the right.

Max Kepler is hitting .385 (15-for-39) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, six walks, a .467 OBP, a .641 SLG and a 1.108 OPS in his last 11 IL games.

TWINS-ROX: The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 17th time in their history...the Twins have gone 8-8 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 3-3 at Coors Field (2008, '14) and 3-4 at Target Field (2010, '17 & '22). Carlos Correa is hitting .385 (25-for-65) with seven doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, a .444 on-base percentage, a .631 slugging percentage and a 1.075 OPS in 17 career games against the Rockies.

C4: Carlos Correa has hit safely in four straight and 12 of his last 14 games this month...in 14 June games, he has hit .356 (21-for-59) with three doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, a .397 on-base percentage, a .610 slugging percentage and a 1.007 OPS. Correa has hit safely in 15 of his last 16 home games...on the season, he is hitting .320 (33-for-103) in 25 games at Target Field.

AN ARRAEZ WE DON'T RECOGNIZE: Luis Arraez enters tonight riding a season-long 0-for-his-last-11...his last hit was a seventh inning home run on Tuesday vs. the Guardians, going 0-for-4, 0-for-4 and 0-for-2 in three games since...the last time he went three straight starts without a hit was September 9-12, 2021, going 0-for-11...the last time he went four straight hitless starts was August 25-30, 2021...regardless of the slide, he is still leading baseball in batting average (.345), nine points ahead of Paul Goldschmidt (.336) and on-base percentage (.427), six points ahead of Goldschmidt (.421). Also, he has struck out just 20 times in 253 plate appearances and posted a 8.5 swing and miss %, trailing only Steven Kwan (8.4%) for best in baseball...he has swung at 435 pitches this season and missed just 37 times.

- Making his team-leading 14th start of the season and 229th of his career...marks his 232nd career appearance.
Is 1-1, 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER) in four June starts and has a 2.70 ERA (30.0 IP, 9 ER) in his last seven trips to the mound (Twins are 4-3).
Today marks his fourth career start and appearance against Colorado; is 2-1, 3.94 ERA (16.0 IP, 7 ER) with six walks and 17 strikeouts in his three prior starts.
Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Was saddled with his third loss of the season last Sunday in the roadtrip finale at Arizona...worked 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits, with no walks and three strikeouts; both Diamondbacks runs came via solo home runs off the bat of Christian Walker (leading off the second inning and with one out in the fourth)...Pavin Smith added a solo shot of his own off Griffin Jax in the fifth and Buddy Kennedy touched Caleb Thielbar for a grand slam in the sixth, while the Twins were handcuffed by D-Backs starter Merrill Kelly.

- Walker's first solo blast snapped a stretch of 120 consecutive batters Archer had faced without allowing a home run...the streak began with the final seven batters he faced in a May 11 start vs. Houston, spanned six consecutive starts from May 16 - June 13, and finished with a 1-2-3 first inning at Chase Field.
All eight home runs Archer has allowed this season have been solo...the last longball he allowed with runners on base was a two-run shot by the Twins' Jorge Polanco on September 4, 2021 at Tropicana Field (with Tampa Bay).

TWO STARTS AGO: Delivered his third-straight strong start in the June 13 roadtrip opener at Seattle...did not factor in the decision, allowing one unearned run on four hits in 4.0 innings of a 3-2 Twins win (2 BB, 3 K)...was staked to a 2-0 lead on Byron Buxton's first-inning, two-run home run, and made that stand...yielded an unearned run in the third inning when Dylan Moore reached on a one-out catcher's interference and eventually scored...six Twins relievers combined for the final 5.0 innings, allowing just two hits and one run, to close out the victory.

- Induced his third groundball double play in his last two starts (in the first inning, off the bat of Ty France), after posting just one GIDP in his first 10 efforts.

JUNE BOON CONTINUES STRONG STRETCH: In four June starts, Archer is 1-1, 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER) with seven walks, 11 strikeouts and a .197/.286/.328 opponent slash line (12-for-61 with 2 2B, 2 HR and a HBP)...he has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in all four efforts, while the Twins are 2-2.

- Among American League starters with at least 18.0 innings pitched in June, he ranks sixth in ERA and eighth in opponent batting average.
Going back even further, Archer has a 2.70 ERA (30.0 IP, 9 ER) with 11 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .218/.298/.345 opponent slash line (24-for-110 with 8 2B, 2 HR and 2 HBP) in his last seven starts (he is 1-2, while the Twins are 4-3)...he has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in six of those seven trips to the mound (since May 16).

VS. THE ROCKIES: Archer is set to make his fourth career start and appearance against Colorado, but first since May 21, 2019 (with Pittsburgh)...is 2-1, 3.94 ERA (16.0 IP, 7 ER) lifetime against the Rockies, having also faced them in 2016 (with Tampa Bay) and 2018 (with the Pirates).

- Shouldered a 5-0 loss to last night's Colorado starter, Germán Márquez, in that 2019 contest at PNC Park (5.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R / 3 ER, 2 BB, 3 K).
Won both his starts at Coors Field (July 20, 2016 and August 8, 2018), while posting a 3.27 ERA (11.0, 4 ER).

JUNIOR CIRCUIT LEADS TO SENIOR CIRCUIT SUCCESS: While pitching for either the Rays or Twins, Archer has posted a 3.38 ERA (136.0 IP, 51 ER) in 24 career Interleague games (23 starts)...however, in a Pirates uniform, he logged a 4.99 ERA (155.0 IP, 86 ER) in 30 starts against National League teams.

- Tonight will be Archer's third Interleague start of 2022, having posted a 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER) over his first two efforts...blanked the Dodgers on two hits over 4.0 innings of a no-decision on April 12, before yielding a pair of solo home runs in 4.0 frames of last Sunday's loss in Arizona.
All told (both AL and NL), is 7-12, 3.47 ERA (153.0 IP, 59 ER) in 27 career Interleague games (26 starts)...his last Interleague win was September 19, 2018 for Pittsburgh vs. Kansas City (7.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 8 K; Pirates won, 2-1); his last Interleague victory against a National League team was July 4, 2017 at Chicago, for Tampa Bay (6.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 8 K; Rays won, 6-5).

ARCHER ON TARGET: Archer earned his lone win of the season in his last Target Field outing, allowing just one run on two hits over 5.0 innings of an 8-1 victory over New York-AL on June 8...that effort snapped a four-start stretch at home in which he had been touched for 13 runs (10 earned) on 18 hits over 14.0 innings.

- In six home starts overall this season, he is 1-2, 4.30 ERA (23.0 IP, 11 ER) with a .247/.337/.404 opponent slash line (22-for-89 with 8 2B and 2 HR).
Owns a 2.76 ERA (29.1 IP, 9 ER) in his seven road starts, with 11 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .213/.292/.426 opponent slash line (23-for-108 with 5 2B and 6 HR).
In 12 career starts at Target Field (6 with Minnesota, 5 with Tampa Bay and 1 with Pittsburgh), Archer is 5-2, 3.09 ERA (58.1 IP, 20 ER).

SOFT CONTACT: Archer has allowed an average exit velocity of 89.1 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (besting the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .245 opponent batting average on balls in play would also be the lowest of his career, besting the .254 of his first full season in 2013; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

THE ARSENAL: In his first three starts of the season, just 3.5 percent of Archer's pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed, per Baseball Savant...in 10 starts since, he has thrown his changeup and curveball 22.4 percent of the time (156 of 697 pitches)...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

- His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.6 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.
Opponents are a combined 26-for-138 (.188) with 10 doubles, three homers and 33 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball; they are hitting .322 (19-for-59) with three doubles, five home runs and seven strikeouts against his fastball...however, opponents are 4-for-22 (.182) with one homer off Archer's fastball in June.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2022 SEASON: 5-3, 3.00 ERA // CAREER: 7-4, 3.35 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow's series and homestand finale vs. Colorado...will mark his third start since being reinstated from the COVID IL on June 14; is 0-1, 5.91 ERA (10.2 IP, 7 ER) in those efforts, after going 5-2, 2.28 ERA (43.1 IP, 11 ER) in eight starts prior...threw 101 pitches during a quality start in Tuesday's homestand opener vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER/ER, 1 BB, 7 K), but did not factor in the decision of the Twins' 6-5, 11-inning loss...has made two career Interleague starts, both against Chicago-NL last year (including his September 1, 2021 MLB debut)...went 1-1, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER) in those two outings.

CAREER NOTES

- Twins are his fifth organization, following time with Cleveland (2006-08), Chicago-NL (2009-10), Tampa Bay (2011-18 and 2021) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).
Has recorded double-digit strikeout totals 30 times in career...also boasts three seasons with at least 200.0 innings pitched and 200-plus strikeouts (212.0 IP and 252 K in 2015, 201.1 and 233 in 2016, and 201.0 and 249 in 2017).
Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks tied for fifth in the American League with 1171 strikeouts since 2013 (his first full season)...is also fifth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 9.53 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched (1105.1 IP).
Missed the 2020 season recovering from thoracic outlet surgery...procedure was performed on June 2, 2020 by Dr. Robert Thompson at Washington University in St. Louis.
Twice named to the American League All-Star Team (2015 and 2017).
Pitched for Team USA in 2017 World Baseball Classic, starting and tossing 4.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts in an eventual 3-2, 10-inning walk-off win over Columbia to open Pool Play...Team USA would go on to win the 2017 WBC.
Led Major League Baseball and tied the Tampa Bay record with 34 starts in 2017.
Posted a Rays-record 252 strikeouts in 2015, second in the AL behind the White Sox' Chris Sale (274) and fourth in the majors...finished the season 12-13, becoming the seventh pitcher in the modern era (since 1900) to record 250 strikeouts without posting a winning record...four of the previous six are Hall of Famers: Nolan Ryan (three times), Steve Carlton, Phil Niekro and Ed Walsh.
Finished fifth in 2015 AL Cy Young Award voting after leading the big leagues and tying Tampa's club mark with 34 starts...also ranked sixth in the AL with a 3.23 ERA.
Finished third in 2013 AL Rookie of the Year balloting...named AL Pitcher of the Month and AL Rookie of the Month for July 2013.
Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 2 prospect in the Rays' system following the 2012 season...was tabbed by the same organization as the top prospect in the Chicago-NL organization following the 2010 campaign.
Originally selected by Cleveland in the fifth round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...part of multi-player trades to Chicago-NL in December of 2008, to Tampa Bay in January of 2011 and to Pittsburgh at the 2018 Trade Deadline.
