GOOSE EGGS: Posted a career-high 20.0-inning scoreless streak from the third inning on April 15 at Boston to the third inning on May 3 at Baltimore...streak is the longest by a Twins pitcher this season...per Elias, Ryan's 20.0-inning scoreless streak matched Jim Hughes (20.0 IP; May 14-24, 1975) for the second-longest run by a rookie starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), trailing only Joe Mays (20.1 IP; July 17-29, 1999).

MONEY MOVES: Ryan drew attention when chasing after a foul ball and calling off catcher Ryan Jeffers earlier this season...upon catching the ball, Ryan signaled "5-0-0" to the dugout...after the game, Ryan told reporters that each foul ball caught is good for $\$ 100$ from each fellow starter.
