**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-3 through five games on their current six-game homestand, going 1-2 against Cleveland, followed by splitting the last two nights with Colorado...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale against the Rockies...after the game, the Twins will travel to Cleveland to play a five-game series at Progressive Field from Monday-Thursday, which includes a scheduled double header on Tuesday...Twins are 22-17 at home and 18-16 on the road.  
 ☞ Twins are looking to win consecutive games in June for just the second time, the other being June 10 and 11 vs. Tampa Bay.  
 ☞ Twins are 5-2 in rubber games, both losses coming this month: June 9 vs. New York-AL and June 19 at Arizona.

**ROCKIE MOUNTAIN HIGH:** The Twins shut out the Rockies last night at Target Field by a score of 6-0...Chris Archer (2-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one walk and five strikeouts...Jharel Cotton (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Tyler Thornburg (2.0) combined for 4.0 innings of no-hit relief...Alex Kirilloff drove in a season-high three runs and went 1-for-3 with a double...Twins pitchers combined to allow just one hit for the 21st time in club history (since 1961), first since September 8, 2021 at Cleveland...Rocco Baldelli earned his 250th career managerial win, the eighth Twins manager to reach that mark.

**WHEN IT RAINS, IT POURS:** The Twins have gone 10-12 this month...below are their offensive numbers in wins compared to losses in June:

**IL PLAY:** The Twins are 2-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field last weekend and 1-1 against the Rockies...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is: Milwaukee at Target Field from July 12-13 and at American Family Field from July 26-27, San Diego at Petco Park from July 29-31, Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10, and San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28...Twins all-time IL wins ranks to the right.  
 ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .375 (19-for-40) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, nine walks, a .490 OBP, a .625 SLG and a 1.115 OPS in his last 12 IL games.

**TWINS-ROX:** The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 18th time in their history...the Twins have gone 9-8 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 3-3 at Coors Field (2008, '14) and 4-4 at Target Field (2010, '17 & '22).

☞ The Twins have hit just 10 home runs against the Rockies in their history, the second-fewest against any opponent, trailing just the six they have hit against the Dodgers...the eight Twins that have homered against Colorado are Brian Dozier (2), A.J. Pierzynski (2), Byron Buxton (1), Eduardo Escobar (1), Jason Kubel (1), Matthew LeCroy (1), Justin Morneau (1) and Matt Tolbert (1)...Buxton's home run came in his first career game against the Rockies on May 16, 2017, a solo shot off Kyle Freeland at Target Field — also their last home against Colorado pitching, a span of 1,868 days.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .377 (26-for-69) with seven doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, a .434 on-base percentage, a .609 slugging percentage and a 1.043 OPS in 18 career games against the Rockies.

**JEFF YEA:** Ryan Jeffers is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with four doubles, two home runs, six RBI, five walks, a .441 on-base percentage, a .690 slugging percentage and a 1.031 OPS in his last nine games...has hit safely in a career-high five-straight games...in fact, in each of those games, he also has an extra-base hit...below are the longest extra-base hit streaks in Twins history among catchers (since 1961):

\* Mauer's streak spanned six seasons, starting in 2013 when he was a regular catcher...he suffered concussions and moved from catcher to first base...on September 30, 2018, in his final career game, he doubled against the Chicago White Sox and finished his career catching one pitch behind the plate.

**SERIES FINALE:** The Twins have gone 11-7-4 in series play this season...they went 7-2-1 in series play from May 13-June 15, but have gone 0-2 since, dropping consecutive three-game series to Arizona last weekend and Cleveland at the start of this homestand (2022 series results to the right)...the Twins are seeking their first series win over the Rockies since taking two of three at Coors Field from July 11-13, 2014...the Twins' last series win in IL Play came September 21-22, 2021, sweeping the Cubs in two games at Wrigley Field.

**NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS:** Carlos Correa has hit safely in five straight and 13 of his last 15 games this month...in 15 June games, he has hit .349 (22-for-63) with three doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, a .388 on-base percentage, a .587 slugging percentage and a .975 OPS.  
 ☞ Correa has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 home games...on the season, he is hitting .318 (34-for-107) in 26 games at Target Field.

**MULTIP-LU HITS:** After going 2-for-5 last night, Luis Arraez is now tied with Rafael Devers and Ty France for first in baseball with 25 multi-hit games...nine of his 25 multi-hit games have come this month...on the season, he is leading baseball in batting average (.347), nine points ahead of Paul Goldschmidt (.338) and on-base percentage (.426), four points ahead of Goldschmidt (.422).

**YOU GOT IT:** Alex Kirilloff is hitting .353 (48-for-136) with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, 39 RBI, a .430 on-base percentage, a .654 slugging percentage and a 1.084 OPS in his last 36 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota.  
 ☞ He has driven in eight runs in eight games since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on June 17.

**TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS:** Double-A Wichita outfielder Matt Wallner and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl have been named the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.  
 ☞ Wallner, 24, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, 10 walks, a .667 on-base percentage and a 1.125 OPS...he homered twice on Tuesday vs. San Antonio...the Forest Lake, Minnesota native was selected by the Twins in the first round (39th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi.  
 ☞ Ohl, 22, made one start for the Mighty Mussels on Thursday at Lakeland, allowing one run on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...the Moorpark, California native was selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, AZ.

- ☞ Facing Colorado for the first time in his career...making his third career start and appearance against the Senior Circuit...is 1-1, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER) with two walks and 16 strikeouts in his two prior starts, both of which came last September against the Chicago Cubs.
- ☞ Acquired by the Twins from Tampa Bay on July 22, 2021, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his last start in the first game of this homestand on June 21 vs. Cleveland, a 6-5 Twins loss in 11 innings...allowed three runs on a career-high seven hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work...yielded one run on three hits in the first inning, his most hits allowed in the first inning in his career.

- ☞ Tossed 101 pitches, just the second time in his professional career (majors or minors) that he's crossed the century mark in an outing; the other instance occurred on May 15 vs. Cleveland, when he threw a career-high 103 pitches.
- ☞ Marked his sixth career quality start and team-leading fifth this season...also marked the first of his six quality starts that the Twins have lost.
- ☞ Also recorded his second career pickoff (also second this season), nabbing Steven Kwan at first base in the third inning...enters today tied for third in the majors in pitcher pickoffs.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Was reinstated from the COVID Injured List to start on June 14 at Seattle, his first major league appearance since May 21...tossed 4.2 innings and allowed four earned runs on five hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...opened the game with 3.0 hitless innings before allowing a pair of two-run blasts that sent the Twins to a 5-0 defeat...matched his season high with four earned runs allowed on the two homers (Eugenio Suárez in the 4th inning and Ty France in the 5th).

- ☞ Marked just the second start of his career allowing multiple homers, also doing so on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit (2).

**TIME TO ROCK THE SENIOR CIRCUIT:** Facing Colorado for the first time in his career, and is making his third career start and appearance against the National League...is 1-1, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER) with two walks and 16 strikeouts in his two prior starts against the Senior Circuit, both of which occurred against Chicago-NL in September 2021.

- ☞ Made his major league debut vs. the Cubs at Target Field on September 1, 2021...took the loss after permitting three runs on three hits (1 home run), with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
- ☞ Faced the Cubs again, this time at Wrigley Field on September 22...earned the win after tossing 5.0 strong innings (3 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB)...also fanned a career-high 11 batters, including his final seven batters faced – set a Twins rookie record with seven consecutive strikeouts...became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 11 strikeouts in a complete outing of 5.0 innings-or-less.

**DAYTIME EXPERIENCE:** Today marks Ryan's fifth start of the season in a day game and first since May 15 vs. Cleveland (W, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 5 K)...is 3-1, 1.64 ERA (22.0 IP, 4 ER) in day starts this season, compared to 2-2, 3.94 ERA (32.0 IP, 14 ER) in six night starts this season.

- ☞ Owns a .171 (13-for-76) opponent batting average in day games this season, second best in the majors (min. 75 AB) behind New York-AL's Nestor Cortes (.143).

**GETTING BACK ON TARGET:** Making his sixth start at Target Field this season...has gone 2-2, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER) with 11 walks and 28 strikeouts at home...this compares to 3-1, 2.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 8 ER) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in five starts on the road.

- ☞ Has performed better on the road throughout his career, going 5-1, 2.31 ERA (39.0 IP, 10 ER) with six walks and 39 strikeouts in seven starts...is a career 2-3, 4.32 ERA (41.2 IP, 20 ER) with 15 walks and 43 strikeouts in eight starts at Target Field.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 57.9% of the time through his first 10 starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

**MAKING THE LORAX PROUD:** In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 52 batters so far, which will lead to 2,600 new trees planted.

**GOOSE EGGS:** Posted a career-high 20.0-inning scoreless streak from the third inning on April 15 at Boston to the third inning on May 3 at Baltimore...streak is the longest by a Twins pitcher this season...per *Elias*, Ryan's 20.0-inning scoreless streak matched Jim Hughes (20.0 IP; May 14-24, 1975) for the second-longest run by a rookie starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), trailing only Joe Mays (20.1 IP; July 17-29, 1999).

**MONEY MOVES:** Ryan drew attention when chasing after a foul ball and calling off catcher Ryan Jeffers earlier this season...upon catching the ball, Ryan signaled "5-0-0" to the dugout...after the game, Ryan told reporters that each foul ball caught is good for \$100 from each fellow starter.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER – RHP SONNY GRAY (2022 SEASON: 3-1, 2.53 ERA // CAREER: 85-73, 3.57 ERA)**

Right-hander Sonny Gray is scheduled to start tomorrow night's series opener against the Cleveland Guardians at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 22 vs. Cleveland at Target Field...allowed four runs (3 earned) on a season-high eight hits (1 home run), with no walks and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings (plus four batters in the 5th); the Guardians scored four runs in the top of the ninth to win the back-and-forth battle, 11-10...Gray owns no decisions and a 5.40 ERA (8.1 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in two starts against Cleveland this season – both outings have come at Target Field...he's 5-3, 3.47 ERA (72.2 IP, 28 ER) in 13 career starts against the Guardians.
