**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 3-3, going 1-2 against Cleveland and 2-1 against Colorado...tonight, the Twins will begin their sixth roadtrip of the season with the first of five against the Guardians at Progressive Field, which includes a doubleheader tomorrow...Twins are 23-17 at home and 18-16 on the road.

☞ Twins have won two of their last three road series.  
☞ Twins are looking to win their third-straight game tonight, which would mark their longest streak since winning six-straight from May 18-24.

**FIRE ON THE (ROCKY) MOUNTAIN:** The Twins beat the Rockies yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-3, scoring five of the six runs in the first two innings and winning their 12th series of the season (12-7-4)...Joe Ryan (6-3) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on a career-high eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, eclipsing 100 pitches for the third time this season (102)...Jhoan Duran earned his fifth save in as many chances with a scoreless ninth inning...the offense recorded 10 hits, including three from Byron Buxton, who fell a home run short of the cycle...Buck also walked and scored three runs.

**THANK YOU, WES:** The Twins announced today that pitching coach Wes Johnson has accepted the role of pitching coach at Louisiana State University...Johnson's final day with the Twins will be Thursday, June 30, at the conclusion of Minnesota's five-game series against the Cleveland Guardians at Progressive Field...Johnson, 51, has served as the Twins pitching coach since 2019...prior to that season, he was hired by Minnesota from the University of Arkansas, becoming the first pitching coach in major league history to go from the college ranks directly to the majors...though 73 games this season, the Twins pitching staff has posted a 3.79 ERA (646.0 IP, 272 ER) with 212 walks, 598 strikeouts, a 1.23 WHIP and a .237 opponent batting average...under Johnson's guidance, the 2019 Minnesota pitching staff set a single-season club record with 1,463 team strikeouts, while the 2020 staff set a single-season club record for strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (9.38)...that same season, Kenta Maeda finished second in the American League Cy Young Award voting, behind winner Shane Bieber of Cleveland... additionally, three Twins pitchers - José Berrios and Jake Odorizzi in 2019, and Taylor Rogers in 2021 - were named to the American League All-Star team during his tenure.

**TWINS AND GUARDIANS:** The Twins are playing the Guardians for the seventh of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 3-3 against the Guardians this season, going 2-1 from May 13-15 and 1-2 from June 21-23 - both at Target Field.

☞ Since the start of 2020, 28 of the 35 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 18 have been decided by two runs-or-less...four of the six games this season have been decided by one run.

**HANG ON SLOOPY:** The Twins are playing a series at Progressive Field for the first time since September 6-9, 2021, when they won three of four...the Twins are 4-1 in their last five at Cleveland and 6-2 in their last eight here.

☞ The Twins went 6-4 at Progressive Field last season, out-scoring the Guardians 50-30...Twins led all opponents with 17 home runs at Progressive Field last season...their 17 home runs in 2021 were the most they hit outside of Target Field.

☞ For his career, Max Kepler has 40 hits, 13 home runs, 28 runs scored and 29 RBI at Progressive Field (43 games), all his most in any opposing ballpark...he is hitting .322 (19-for-59) with three doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.138 OPS in his last 15 games at Cleveland...he is one of two players to have multiple three homer games in his ballpark (Jim Thome the other): August 1, 2016 and June 6, 2019.

**ARRAEZ-ING UP THE CHARTS:** After going 2-for-4 yesterday, Luis Arraez is now tied with Rafael Devers for first in baseball with 26 multi-hit games...10 of his 26 multi-hit games have come this month...below are his ranks in several categories in baseball:

**BUCK SZN:** Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (20-for-65) with four doubles, two triples, eight home runs, a .400 on-base percentage, an .800 slugging percentage and a 1.200 OPS in 18 games this month...among all AL players in June, he ranks second in OPS and slugging percentage, and tied for third in home runs.

**YOU GOT IT:** Alex Kirilloff is hitting .353 (49-for-139) with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, 40 RBI, a .431 on-base percentage, a .648 slugging percentage and a 1.079 OPS in his last 37 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota.

☞ He has driven in nine runs and recorded four doubles for the Twins in eight games since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on June 17.

**SAVE A PRAYER:** Jhoan Duran saved his fifth game in as many chances yesterday...his five saves are already the third most in a single season by a Twins rookie, trailing only Bill Campbell (7 saves in 1973) and Doug Corbett (23 saves in 1980)...Duran ranks second in the AL in relief strikeouts with 46 (King (54)...he has thrown 171 pitches of 100-plus mph this season, the most in baseball (next is Emmanuel Clase - 124)...he has an average pitch velocity of 95.8 mph this season, third-highest in baseball among pitchers with at least 400 pitches thrown, trailing Los Angeles' NL's Brusdar Graterol (96.7) and Detroit's Gregory Soto (96.3).

☞ Duran's 4-seam fastball has averaged 100.6 mph, his curve has averaged 87.5 mph, and his splitter has averaged 96.2 mph, all the highest in baseball.

**BALLOT BOX:** Major League Baseball released its second All-Star ballot update today...Byron Buxton ranks eighth among AL outfielders with 629,216 votes, Luis Arraez ranks fourth among first basemen with 462,319 votes, Carlos Correa ranks seventh among shortstops with 274,727 votes, Gary Sánchez ranks sixth among catchers with 226,415 votes, Jorge Polanco ranks sixth among second basemen with 190,018 votes, Gio Urshela ranks eighth among third basemen with 172,945 votes, and Kyle Garlick ranks ninth among designated hitters with 110,679 votes...fans can vote on the current ballot format until 1:00 pm (CT) on Thursday...the next MLB ASG announcement will be later that day, when the ballot finalists are revealed at 4:00 pm (CT) on MLB Network.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .442 (19-for-43) with RISP, the highest in baseball.  
☞ Twins have a .746 OPS against right-handed pitching, compared to a .700 OPS against left-handed pitching.  
☞ The Twins' 13 outfield assists this season are fourth-most in the AL, trailing Texas (18), Cleveland (17) and Baltimore (16).

Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on June 22 against the Guardians at Target Field...tossed 4.0 innings, allowing a season-high three runs on eight hits, with no walks and four strikeouts... Twins lost 11-10 as the bullpen blew a sox-run lead...allowed a solo home run to Austin Hedges in the fifth inning, his first allowed since another Austin Hedges solo home run on May 13...marked his shortest start since May 7 vs. Oakland (also 4.0 IP)...has not allowed a walk in a career-high three consecutive starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 15 at Seattle...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits with no walks and three strikeouts in a 5-0 Twins victory...was his first start since being placed on the 15-day Injured List on June 2 (right pectoral strain)...marked his eighth consecutive start with two-or-fewer runs allowed and fourth consecutive with one-or-fewer walks.

WINNING THE BATTLE: Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in nine consecutive starts, marking the eighth time in his career he has done so...allowed two-or-fewer runs in his eight starts prior, marking the second-longest streak in his career, trailing the 11 straight he accomplished from June 25-August 26, 2017 (with Oakland/New York-AL)...his streak of two-or-fewer runs allowed in eight-straight starts marked the longest streak to start a season by a starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), surpassing Jim Kaat (7 from April 29-May 28, 1972) and John Butcher (7 from April 7-May 15, 1984).

THERE'S NO GUARDING GRAY: Is making is 14th career start against Cleveland this evening and third this season...in his two starts against Cleveland this season, he is 0-0, 5.40 ERA (8.1 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts, both at Target Field...has made five career starts at Progressive Field, going 2-3, 5.28 ERA (29.0 IP, 17 ER) with 11 walks and 27 strikeouts...tossed a complete-game shutout (third career at the time) at Progressive Field on July 12, 2015, where he allowed just two hits with one walk and six strikeouts (with Oakland)...is 5-3, 3.47 ERA (72.2 IP, 25 ER) with 29 walks and 79 strikeouts in 13 career starts against the Guardians in his career overall...has allowed two-or-fewer runs with six-or-more strikeouts in five of his last six starts vs. Cleveland.

ON THE ROAD: Is making his fourth road start this season...is 1-1, 2.84 ERA (12.2 IP, 4 ER) with one walk, nine strikeouts and a .208 (10-for-49) opponent batting average in three road starts this season...this compares to 2-0, 2.40 ERA (30.0 IP, 8 ER) with nine walks, 37 strikeouts and a .212 batting average (24-for-113) at home this season.

Has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road over his career...has posted a 37-37 record, 3.21 ERA (619.1 IP, 221 ER), with 232 walks and 607 strikeouts in 110 career appearances (105 starts) on the road...has gone 48-36, 3.90 ERA (690.2 IP, 299 ER) with 231 walks and 660 strikeouts in 122 appearances (118 starts) at his home ballpark.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: This season, Gray has posted a .200 opponent average (14-for-70) with two walks and 19 strikeouts against left-handed hitters...this compares to a .220 batting average (20-for-91) with eight walks and 27 strikeouts against right-handed hitters.

In his career, Gray has limited left-handers to a .223 batting average (541-for-2424) with 638 strikeouts and right-handed hitters to a .237 batting average (586-for-2477) with 629 strikeouts. Gray's .200 opponent batting average against left-handers is tied for the ninth-lowest in the American League among right-handed starting pitchers (min. 70 opponent at-bats).

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOUR LAST: Gray has allowed just one run, five hits, one walk and eight strikeouts in the first inning this season...his one run and one walk allowed is tied for the fewest among American League starters in the first inning (min. 9 starts)...has also allowed the fewest base runners (6) in the first inning among all major league starters (min. 9 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...24 of his 37 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .115 (3-for-26) against his curveball, which ranks 10th-lowest among American League starters (min. 30 at-bats)...here's a look at his repertoire.
