a victory over the Guardians last nighttoday, the Twins will play games two and three of
a victory over the Guardians last nighttoday, the Twins will play games two and three of this five-game series against the Guardians at Progressive FieldTwins are 23-17 at home
and 19-16 on the road.
& Twins are looking to win their fourth-straight game this afternoon, which would mark

their longest streak since winning six-straight from May 18-24.

PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS: The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 11-1, tied for their largest margin of victory this season (14-4 on May 18 at 0AK and 11-1 on June 18 at ARI)...Sonny Gray (4-1) was the starter and winner, pitching a season-high tying 7.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...the offense recorded 14 hits as Alex Kirilloff, foo Urshela and Gary Sánchez each had three hits apiece... Mark Contreras recorded his first major league hit with a ninth-inning single...Sánchez (9), Nick Gordon (3), and Carlos Correa (8) each homered, while Urshela doubled twice (12, 13). The win marked the largest margin of victory over Cleveland since a 10-0 win on May 21, 2021 at Progressive Field.

JOSH WHAT I AM: Right-handed pitcher Josh Winder has been appointed as the club's 27th man for today's doubleheader and will start game two... Winder was on the Twins' Opening Day roster and began the season in the bullpen... he made three relief appearances in April and made his first career start on May I at Tampa Bay, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, earning his first career win...he was placed on the 15-day Injured List from May 21-June 23 (right shoulder impingement) and was optioned directly from his rehab assignment to Triple-AST. Paul...since then, he has made three starts for the Saints, going 0-0, 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP, 4 ER) with four walks and six strikeouts, which includes one rehab start.

SHOW OUT: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the eighth and ninth times of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 4-3 against the Guards this season, going 2-1 from May 13-15, 1-2 from June 21-23 and 1-0 this series.

▼ Two more wins in this series and the Twins will secure their sixth series victory in their last eight chances against the Guardians.
▼ Since the start of 2020, 28 of the 36 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 18 have been decided by two runs-or-less...four of the seven games this season have been decided by one run.

MOJO SO DOPE: The Twins are 5-1 in their last six at Cleveland and 7-2 in their last nine at Progressive Field...two wins today and they will secure their third-straight series win in Cleveland.

♣ The Twins have out-scored the Guards 61-31 at Progressive Field since the start of last season...they have hit 20 home runs at Cleveland since the start of 2021, their most outside of Target Field...additionally, the Twins have homered in 12-straight games in Cleveland, their longest streak in at city.

♣ For his career, Max Kepler has 40 hits, 13 home runs, 28 runs scored and 29 RBI at Progressive Field (44 games), all his most in any opposing ballpark...he is hitting .302 (19-for-63) with three doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.067 OPS in his last 16 games at Cleveland...he is one of two players to have multiple three-homer games in this ballpark (Jim Thome the other). August 1, 2016 and June 6, 2019.

ENTER GALACTIC LU AND ME: Luis Arraez enters the day first in the AL and second in baseball in both batting average and on-base percentage...after going 0-for-3 last night, he does not lead baseball in average for the first time since June 4...below are his ranks in several

MAN ON THE MOON-SHOTS: Byron Buxton enters today fifth in the AL in home runs (19), trailing Aaron Judge (28), Yordan Alvarez (22), Mike Trout (22) and Anthony Rizzo (20)...the 19 home runs are tied for his single-season career-high, done in 2021...his last home run came on June he has homered three times in his last six games at Progressive Field, since the start of 2021. Tampa Bay 17 at Arizona, off Madison Bumgarner..

Sollo DO'LOS: Carlos Correa has hit safely in seven-straight games, tying his season-high, done twice previously...his last streak that was longer than seven games came May 14-22, 2021 (8 games)...his career-high is 16, from April 19-May 6, 2019...in 17 June games, he is hitting 343 (24-for-70) with three doubles, five home runs, 10 RBI, a 373 on-base percentage, a 600 slugging percentage and a .973 OPS.

SOUNDTRACK TO MY KIRIL-LIFE: Alex Kirilloff is hitting .366 (52-for-142) with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, 41 RBI, a .442 on-base percentage, a .655 slugging percentage and a 1.097 OPS in his last 38 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota.

The Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on June 17, he is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with four doubles and 10 RBI in 10 games.

SPEEDIN' BULLET: Jhoan Duran saved his fifth game in as many chances on Sunday...his five saves are already the third most in a single season by a Twins rookie, trailing only Bill Campbell (7 saves in 1973) and Doug Corbett (23 saves in 1980)...Duran ranks second in the AL in relief strikeouts with 46, trailing only Michael King (54)...he has thrown 171 pitches of 100-plus mph this season, the most in baseball (next is Emmanuel Clase - 124)...he has an average pitch velocity of 95.8 mph this season, third-highest in baseball among pitchers with at least 400 pitches thrown, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Brusdar Graterol (96.7) and Detroit's Gregory Soto (96.3).

© Duran's 4-seam fastball has averaged 100.6 mph, his curve has averaged 87.5 mph, and his splitter has averaged 96.2 mph, all the highest in baseball.

STARS IN THE SKY: Outfielder Matt Wallner was named Texas League Player of the Week yesterday...the 24-year-old Forest Lake, MN native played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .429 (9-for-21) with two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, six walks, a .556 on-base percentage, a .952 slugging percentage and a 1.508 OPS...he was also named Twins minor league Player of the Week on Sunday.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fourth victory of the season in the series finale against Cleveland on June 23 at Target Field...threw 6.0 shutout innings, allowing three hits and no walks, with three strikeouts... Twins won by a final of 1-0, with the lone run of the game coming on a Nick Gordon solo home run.

Marked his second scoreless start this season (other: May 26 vs. Kansas City, ND, 7.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K).

His two 6.0-or-more scoreless inning starts this season are tied for the most among Twins starters, with Joe Ryan...also marked his second start without a walk allowed (other: May 31 at Detroit).

- ₱ Has tossed 5.0-or-more innings in six of his eight starts this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was dealt his first loss of the season on June 17 at Arizona after he allowed a career-high seven runs (6 earned) on nine hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in 4.1 innings... gave up two home runs to Jordan Luplow (2-run shot in the first and solo home run in the third)... Byron Buxton opened the game with a solo homer but the Twins fell, 7-2.

SUCCESS AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 6-3, 3.52 ERA (79.1 IP, 31 ER) with a .232 (68-for-293) opponent batting average and .682 opponent OPS in 15 starts (Twins are 9-6)...to compare, he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and an .834 opponent OPS in 12 major league relief outings.

ROLLING INTO CLEVELAND: Is facing Cleveland for the third time this season after previously going 1-0, 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and five strikeouts in two starts at Target Field...faced the Guardians in his most recent start on June 23 (W, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R/ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...is a career 2-2, 4.31 ERA (31.1 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 19 strikeouts vs. Cleveland...will mark his third start at Progressive Field, first since September 14, 2019 (ND, 3.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 K) in the 2-0 Twins victory...is 0-1, 4.82 ERA (9.1 IP, 5 ER) in Cleveland.

CITY OF LIGHT, CITY OF MAGIC: Making his fifth road start...is 2-1, 4.87 ERA (20.1 IP, 11 ER) with five walks and eight strikeouts in his four prior road starts...this compares to a 2-0 record, 1.50 ERA (24.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks and 14 strikeouts at home.

To sa career 3-2, 5.94 ERA (47.0 IP, 31 ER) with one save, 12 walks and 25 strikeouts in 11

games (8 starts) on the road.

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Smeltzer's repertoire through his first eight starts of the 2022 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a five-pitch mix, primarily relying on his four-seam fastball and changeup.

STRIKES AND OUTS: Has been effective so far when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .179 (14-for-78) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .191 (39-for-204) mark in his career.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 lP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after collapsing during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be caused by a herniated disc in his neck...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Was in Twins spring training for the second-consecutive season and was optioned to the alternate training site on March 29...recalled from the Taxi Squad on April 17...appeared in one game for the Twins on April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, allowing one unearned run on one hit in 4.2 innings of relief...marked his only appearance with the Twins or Saints on the season as he was optioned back to the alternate training site on April 25...recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 6 just prior to the minor league season but did not appear for the Twins...placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 12 with left elbow inflammation and missed the remainder of the season...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17.
