Cleveland and 2-1 against Colorado), the Twins began their five-game roadtrip by going 2-1
against the Guardians in Cleveland over the last two daystonight, the Twins will play game four
of this five-game series at Progressive FieldTwins are 23-17 at home and 20-17 on the road.
$\Phi$ Twins are 4-1 in their last five and 5-2 in their last seven overall.

STRONG STARTS BUT DAY ENDS WITH SPLIT: The Twins and Guardians split the doubleheader yesterday at Progressive Field as Minnesota lost game one by a score of 3-2, but won game two by a score of 6-0... Iwins starters Devin Smeltzer (Game 1) and Josh Winder (Game 2) combined to go 1-0, 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER), with eight hits allowed, one walk and 10 strike-outs... Smeltzer set a career-high with nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings pitched, while Winder made his return to the Twins from St. Paul with 6.0 shutout innings... the offense recorded 19 hits on the day, including six in their first game and 13 in the second... six different Twins had multiple hits in game two... the shutout in game two marked the ninth for Minnesota this season, tied for fourth-most in baseball.

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 10th of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 5-4 against the Guards this season, going 2-1 from May 13-15, 1-2 from June 21-23 and 2-1 this series.

▼ A win tonight and the Twins will secure their sixth series victory in their last eight chances against the Guardians...Twins have outscored Cleveland 52-33 this season.

▼ Since the start of 2020, 29 of the 38 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 19 have been decided by two runs-or-less...five of the nine games this season have been decided by one run.

NOW THAT'S PROGRESSIVE: The Twins are 6-2 in their last eight games at Cleveland and 8-3 in their last 11 at Progressive Field...a win tonight and they will secure their third-straight series win in Cleveland.

The Twins have hit 24 home runs at Cleveland since the start of 2021, their most outside of Target Field in that span...additionally, the Twins have homered in 14-straight games in Cleveland, their longest streak in that city...it marks their longest streak in an opposing ballpark since also homering in 14 straight at Rogers Centre from August 26, 2017-June 5, 2022...the last time they homered in 15 straight in an opposing ballpark was in 21 straight at Kauffman Stadium from July 30, 1998-August 25, 2001.

For his career, Max Kepler has 40 hits, 13 home runs, 28 runs scored and 29 RBI at Progressive Field (44 games), all his most in any opposing ballpark...he is hitting .302 (19-for-63) with three doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.067 OPS in his last 16 games at Cleveland.

BUCK BLAST-OFF: Byron Buxton hit his 20th home run of the season last night, setting single-season career-high, passing his previous high of 19, done last season...he enters today tied with Anthony Rizzo for fourth in the AL in home runs, trailing Aaron Judge (28), Yordan Alvarez (23) and Mike Trout (23)...he has homered four times in his last seven games at Progressive Field, since the start of 2021.

■ Buck is the first Twin with 20-plus homers in the first 77 team games of the season since Eddie Rosario in 2019 (also 20 HR); Buxton, Rosario and Justin Morneau (20 HR in 2007) are only Twins to do so since 2000...he is also the second hitter (4th instance) in Twins/ Senators franchise history (since 1901) with 20-plus homers in his first 57 games of a season, joining Harmon Killebrew 3x (20 HR in 1959, 20 HR in 1961, 21 HR in 1964).

■ In Buck's last 162 games, he is hitting .269 (155-for-577) with 36 doubles, two triples 52 home runs, 95 RBI, 112 runs scored, a .608 slugging percentage and a .930 OPS... Twins are 94-68 in those games...he is on pace for 41 home runs this season.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, JOSE!: Jose Miranda is celebrating his 24th birthday today...last year, he celebrated his 23rd birthday, by going 5-for-6 with one double, three home runs and six RBI for Triple-A St. Paul, against the Omaha Storm Chasers.

◆ In his last 28 games, he is hitting .329 (28-for-85) with eight doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .360 on-base percentage, a .565 slugging percentage and a .924 OPS.

DURAN DURAN: Jhoan Duran ranks second in the AL in relief strikeouts with 46, trailing only Michael King (56) and ahead of teammate Griffin Jax (43)...Duran has thrown 171 pitches of 100-plus mph this season, the most in baseball (next is Emmanuel Clase − 129)...he has an average pitch velocity of 95.8 mph this season, third-highest in baseball among pitchers with at least 400 pitches thrown, trailing Brusdar Graterol (96.7) and Gregory Soto (96.3). 

₱ Duran's 4-seam fastball has averaged 100.6 mph, his curve has averaged 87.5 mph, and his splitter has averaged 96.2 mph, all the highest in baseball.

**EXP-'LOS-IVE**: Carlos Correa has a hard hit rate of 49.7%, which is in the top 10% of the league and also a career-high, up from 42.7% in 2021, a 7.0% increase...additionally, he has a 91.8 mph average exit velocity this season, also the highest of his career.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: Hall of Famer Harmon Killebrew was born on this date in 1938 in Payette, Idaho...Killebrew signed with the Senators at age 17 and made his MLB debut on June 23, 1954 and would finish his career with 2,086 hits, 573 home runs and 1,584 RBI...he was a 13-time All-Star, the AL MVP in 1969, a six-time home run champion and three-time RBI champ... Killebrew passed away in 2011...also, 28 years ago in 1994: Manager Billy Heywood led a miraculous comeback as the Twins tied the Seattle Mariners, forcing a one-game playoff to decide the final Postseason berth in the American League, with the game to be played in the Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome...Game No. 163 headed to extra innings, but the Mariners took the lead in the top of the 10th...with two outs in the bottom half, Lou Collins cracked a ball deep to center field, only to watch as Ken Griffey Jr. robbed the game-winning, potential walk-off home run, ending the Twins' season...Heywood would never manage again, as he decided to retire and return to junior high.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt the loss against the Rockies on June 24 at Target Field...tossed his second consecutive quality start after going 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits, with two walks and two strikeouts in a pitching duel opposite the Rockies' Germán Márquez, resulting in a 1-0 Twins defeat...marked his first back-to-back quality starts since April 25-May 2, 2021 (with Los Angeles-AL)...has allowed two earned runs in his last two starts combined (14.0 IP), after allowing 13 earned runs in his previous three starts combined (12.1 IP)... the last time Bundy went 6.0-or-more innings with one-or-fewer runs allowed in consecutive starts was August 6-11, 2020 (with Los Angeles-AL).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his fourth victory of the season and first since April 23 vs. Chicago-AL. tossed a season-high 8.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in a 11-1 Twins victory against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field on June 18...marked the longest outing by a Twins starter this season; Joe Ryan, Sonny Gray and Devin Smeltzer all had 7.0-inning outings...Bundy's outing also marked his longest since August 6, 2020 at Seattle (with Los Angeles-AL), where he pitched a complete game (W, 4 H, 1 R/FR, 0 BB, 10 K)...his seven strikeouts also set a season high, marking his highest since April 6, 2021 vs. Houston (10 K, with Los Angeles-AL).

His start marked the first appearance by a Twins starter with least 8.0 innings pitched, one-or-fewer runs allowed and seven-or-more strikeouts since Kenta Maeda on August 18, 2020

vs. Milwaukee.

ROCK N' ROLLIN IN CLEVELAND: Will be making his sixth career appearance (5th start) against Cleveland in his career...is 4-1, 2.82 ERA (22.1 IP, 7 ER) with eight walks, and 23 strikeouts against the Guardians...his last start came on May 17, 2019 (with Baltimore), when he earned the victory after tossing 5.2 innings, allowing one run (unearned) on three hits with three walks and seven strikeouts here at Progressive Field...has made two career appearances (1 start) at Progressive Field (7.0 IP, 1R/OER, 3 BB, 7 K).

The Has allowed no earned runs in four of his five appearances (2 starts w/1 unearned run) against Cleveland...his 2.82 ERA is his second-lowest against any team he has faced (min. 5 starts), tailing his 2.44 ERA mark against Seattle

ON THE ROAD: Bundy will be making his eighth start away from Target Field this season...has struggled more on the road than at home this season, going 2-3, 6.82 ERA (34.1 IP, 26 ER) with seven walks, 31 strikeouts and a .315 opponent batting average (46-for-146) in seven starts, although he dominated the Diamondbacks over 8.0 innings in his last road start on June 18...has pitched well when facing opponents at home this season, going 2-1, 2.10 ERA (25.2 IP, 6 ER) with five walks, 15 strikeouts and a .200 opponent batting average (19-for-95).

This career, Bundy has posted slightly better numbers at home than on the road, going 25-33, 4.56 ERA (452.0 IP, 229 ER) with 134 walks and 413 strikeouts in 93 home appearances (79 starts)...compares to 25-28, 4.92 ERA (378.2 IP, 207 ER) with 135 walks and 391 strikeouts in 80 road appearances (66 starts).

WALKING IN STYLE: Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in seven of his last nine starts (11 BB total)...even with his last nine starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 4.7 walk percentage and a 1.80 walks-per-nine...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (33.3%) and first-pitch strike percentage (67.4%).

MAKING THE SOONER STATE PROUD: After his start on June 18 at Arizona, Bundy became the 29th Oklahoma-born pitcher in major league history to earn 50 career wins...is also the second Oklahoma-born pitcher to earn his 50th career win this season, joining Texas hurler Jon Gray.

Φ Owasso High School, his alma mater, won the Class 6A State Championship this year, the school's first title since 2015 and 14th overall.

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** According to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 12 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.
