THE TWINS: Have gone 1-4 through five games on their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip, all against the Tigers...tonight, the Twins will begin a three-game series with the Blue Jays in Toronto through the weekend...after this series, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Monday, followed by a six-game homestand against the Yankees (June 7-9) and Rays (June 10-12)...the Twins are 17-11 at home and 13-12 on the road.

☞ The Twins have lost three straight, tying their season long for a losing streak, done previously from May 10-12, when they were swept in three games by the Astros.

MOTOWN LETDOWN: The Twins lost to the Tigers on Thursday afternoon by a score of 3-2...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits over a season-high 5.0 innings pitched...Jhoan Duran pitched 2.0 perfect innings of relief to hold a 2-1 lead, but Emilio Pagan allowed a two-run homer to Daz Cameron with one out in the bottom of the eighth...the offense recorded just five hits, two from Nick Gordon, who walked, scored the Twins' first run and doubled in their second...the loss marked just the Twins' second this season (26-2) when leading after seven innings.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed right-handed pitchers Trevor Megill and Emilio Pagan, left-handed pitcher Caleb Thielbar and outfielder Max Kepler on the Restricted List...details on the four players replacing them on the 26-man roster are below:

☞ Right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton is in his third stint with the Twins this season (previously Opening Day-April 13, May 10-17), going 0-1, 1.35 ERA (6.2 IP, 1 ER), six walks and seven strikeouts in four games.

☞ Right-handed pitcher Chi Chi Gonzalez went 2-2, 3.44 ERA (36.2 IP, 14 ER), 14 walks and 35 strikeouts in eight games (5 starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season...the 30-year-old signed a minor league contract with the Twins in March and owns a career 9-23 record, 5.64 ERA (261.2 IP, 164 ER), 112 walks and 155 strikeouts in 61 MLB games (47 starts).

☞ Right-handed pitcher Ian Hamilton posted a 0.71 ERA (12.2 IP, 1 ER) with five walks, 17 strikeouts and a .178 (8-for-45) opponent batting average in 10 relief appearances for the Saints this season...the 26-year-old has made 14 career major league appearances, all with Chicago-AL from 2018-20, going 1-2, 4.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 6 ER), seven walks and nine strikeouts.

☞ Outfielder Mark Contreras is in his second stint with the Twins, after making his major league debut on May 11, appearing in two games from May 11-14 and going 0-for-2 with one RBI, one sacrifice fly and one run scored.

ADDITIONALLY: Chi Chi González will be the 10th different pitcher to make a start this season...the others are Chris Archer (10), Dylan Bundy (8), Joe Ryan (8), Sonny Gray (7), Bailey Ober (7), Chris Paddack (5), Devin Smeltzer (4), Josh Winder (3) and Cole Sands (1).

LET'S GET IT ON(TARIO): The Twins are playing the first of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they will host the Jays for four games at Target Field from August 4-7...they went 3-4 against the Jays last season, going 1-2 at Rogers Centre from September 17-19 and 2-2 at Target Field from September 23-26...the Twins have won the season series against the Blue Jays in three of their last four chances, going 3-4 in 2021, DNP in 2020, 4-3 in 2019, 4-2 in 2018 and 4-3 in 2017...the Twins have gone just 29-46 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 11-7 in their last 18, dating back to May 2018.

☞ Twins are 8-2 in their last 10 at Rogers Centre...they won eight straight here from August 27, 2017-September 17, 2021, prior to losing their last two games.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .313 (25-for-80) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.038 OPS in 21 career games vs. the Jays...he is hitting .324 (12-for-37) in nine career games at Rogers Centre...Buck hit three home runs in this ballpark on August 26, 2017.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .309 (34-for-110) with eight doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and an .868 OPS in 28 career games vs. the Jays...in 14 career games at the Rogers Centre, he is hitting .390 (23-for-59) with six doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.090 OPS...one of his two career-high five-hit games came here on May 8, 2019 (the other was April 5, 2019 at PHI).

☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .319 (30-for-94) with four doubles, six home runs, 20 RBI and a .907 OPS in 24 career games at Rogers Centre...he played for the Blue Jays for 19 games in 2018.

CHECK URSHELF: Gio Urshela has hit safely in 14 of his last 18 games since May 14, hitting .333 (21-for-63) with three doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI, seven walks, a .394 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .966 OPS in that span...since that date, he is tied for third in the AL in RBI, tied for ninth in batting average and 10th in OPS.

RANGES IN THE OUTFIELD: Twins outfielders have combined for 15 defensive runs saved this season, second to only Houston's 17 (per FanGraphs)...additionally, they lead baseball in ARM at 4.9 (Outfield Arm Runs - fielder credited not only for runners thrown-out, but keeping runners from advancing extra bases)...Nick Gordon's fourth-inning assist from leftfield yesterday gave the Twins 11 on the season, tied for second most in baseball with Cincinnati, trailing Cleveland (15)...additionally, Twins outfielders have combined to commit just two errors this season (Kepler and Kirilloff).

POWER OUTAGE: After hitting .319 (59-for-185) with 17 walks, a .377 on-base percentage, a .514 slugging percentage and an .891 OPS in five games from May 26-30, the Twins have hit .147 (19-for-129) with 10 walks, a .209 on-base percentage, a .209 slugging percentage and a .418 OPS in their last four games.

HAPPY JEFFIN' BIRTHDAY!!: Happy birthday to catcher Ryan Jeffers, who turns 25 today...Jeffers has played in one career major league game on his birthday, coming last season at Kansas City when he went 2-for-4 with two singles.

EARS PERK UP: Former All-Star closer Glen Perkins will join Twins Hall of Fame electee Dan Gladden this weekend on WCCO Radio for the three-game series against the Blue Jays...all games will be broadcast from Target Field.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1967, Harmon Killebrew hit the longest home run ever by a Twin at an estimated 520 feet...Killebrew hit a three-run shot off California right-hander Lew Burdette, which landed in the sixth row of the upper deck at Metropolitan Stadium...the ball cracked the seat, and was later painted orange to commemorate the event...the seat is now located in the Mall of America...the former site of "Met" Stadium - bolted to a wall in the amusement park, marking the height and position where the ball would have landed in the upper deck.

Made 12 starts for Colorado in 2019, following two seasons without a major league appearance.
Became the first free agent signing to pitch for Colorado since 2015.
Missed the entire 2017 season while recovering from Tommy John surgery.
Made major league debut on May 30, 2015 vs. Boston as a member of the Texas Rangers.
Pitched a complete-game shutout in his second career start, June 5, 2015 vs. Kansas City.
Missed the entire 2017 season due to "Tommy John" surgery on right elbow.
Made his major league debut on May 30 with Texas...threw a complete-game shutout on June 5 vs. the Kansas City Royals, his second career start, allowing three hits with two walks and two strikeouts...had three stints with the major league club, going 4-6 with a 3.90 ERA (67.0 IP, 29 ER) in 14 games, 10 starts...made his Triple-A debut and, in 16 starts, went 8-7 with a 3.57 ERA (88.1 IP, 35 ER).

WHAT'S IN A NAME: González's given name is Alexander, but he's gone by "Chi Chi" - a nickname given to him by his great uncle - since childhood..."We don't ever go by our first names. It was only in school that we'd go by our first names, but our parents always call us by our nicknames or 'Hey you,'" he said in an interview in 2015.

In seven games vs. TOR last season Twins' pen went 0-0-2, 1.97 ERA (32.0 IP, 7 ER) with 16 walks, 32 strikeouts, three holds & an opponent batting average of .200 (23-for-115). Entering today the 3.68 ERA is currently 9th lowest in the AL...3rd with most strikeouts in the league & leads the AL (220)...is T-7th with 13 saves in the AL. 1.26 ERA (14.1 IP, 2 ER) with nine walks & 16 strikeouts in three games at Rogers Centre in 2021...4-5-5, 4.08 ERA (88.1 IP, 40 ER) with 15 walks, 16 holds & 97 strikeouts in 25 road games.

He has appeared in six games for MIN this season, allowing 11 runs on 12 hits in 7.1 innings pitched, with four walks and seven strikeouts. Made his major league debut on 5/11 vs. HOU, warmed up but did not throw a pitch prior to the suspension of the game...joined Larry Young as the only other pitcher in baseball history to be announced in a game without facing a batter...threw his first pitch in a major league game on 5/12...struck out the first batter he faced, on his way to retiring the first six batters faced...went 2.1 innings and gave up three runs on three hits (one HR) & recorded two strikeouts...became the first Cuban-born player to pitch for the Twins since Liván Hernández in 2008.
