LAST TIME OUT: Delivered his latest in a string of outstanding efforts; this was arguably his finest as he earned the win in a combined 6-0 shutout over Colorado last Saturday at Target Field...blanked the Rockies on just one hit over a season-high-tying 5.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts... worked a 1-2-3 first inning, allowed a leadoff single and walk to start the second, then retired the final 12 hitters he faced.
♥ His 78 pitches matched his second-highest of the season (also on May 28 vs. Kansas City), one shy of his season-high 79 on April 30 at Tampa Bay..his 65.4 strike percentage was also his second-best mark of 2022, behind only the 68.4% on May 5 at Baltimore.
♥ Marked his fewest hits allowed in a start of 5.0-or-more innings since April 30, 2016 vs. Toronto, with Tampa Bay (6.0 IP, 1 H in a no-decision; Rays won, 4-3).
♥ Joined Dylan Bundy (April 11 vs. Seattle; 5.0 IP, 1 H) and Joe Ryan (April 27 vs. Detroit; 7.0 IP, 1 H) as the three Twins starters this season to work 5.0-or-more innings while yielding one-or-fewer hits.

- TWO STARTS AGO: Was saddled with his third loss of the season in the June 19 roadtrip finale at Arizona...worked 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits, with no walks and three strikeouts; both Diamondbacks runs came via solo home runs off the bat of Christian Walker (leading off the second inning and with one out in the fourth)...Twins lost to Merrill Kelly and the D-Backs, 7-1.
   Walker's first solo blast snapped a stretch of 120 consecutive batters Archer had faced without allowing a home run...the streak began with the final seven batters he faced in a May 11 start vs. Houston, spanned six-consecutive starts from May 16 June 13, and finished with a 1-2-3 first inning at Chase Field.
   All eight home runs Archer has allowed this season have been solo...the last longball he allowed with runners on base was a two-run shot by the Twins' Jorge Polanco on September 4, 2021 at Tropicana Field (with Tampa Bay).

VS. THE GUARDIANS: Archer is set to make his eighth career start and appearance against Cleveland, but first since August 12, 2017 (with Tampa Bay)...will be looking for his first career victory against the Guardians, as he been dealt the loss in each of his prior seven outings (all with the Rays between 2013-17); is 0-7, 5.87 ERA (38.1 IP, 25 ER) in those starts.
Cleveland (0-7 in 7 starts), St. Louis (0-1 in 6 starts) and Los Angeles (0-3 in 4 starts) are the three MLB teams he has started against at least four times without defeating.
Is 0-4, 6.35 ERA (22.2 IP, 16 ER) in four career starts here at Progressive Field...he last pitched here on May 15, 2017, taking an 8-7 loss (5.0 IP, 5 H, 7 R/6 ER, 6 BB, 6 K).

**SOFT CONTACT:** Archer has allowed an average exit velocity of 89.2 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (besting the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .235 opponent batting average on balls in play would also be the lowest of his career, besting the .254 of his first full season in 2013; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

THE ARSENAL: In his first three starts of the season, just 3.5 percent of Archer's pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed, per Baseball Savant...in 10 starts since, he has thrown his changeup and curveball 21.8 percent of the time (169 of 775 pitches)...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

 Copponents are a combined 26-for-149 (174) with 10 doubles, three homers and 36 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball; they are hitting .313 (20-for-64) with three doubles, five home runs and seven strikeouts against his fastball...however, opponents are 5-for-27 (.185) with one homer off Archer's fastball in June.

ONE STEP AT A TIME: Archer is the lone Twins starter to make of each of his scheduled turns through the rotation, as today will be his team-leading 15th start of the season, his most since logging 23 with Pittsburgh in 2019...missed the final month of that season with right shoulder inflammation, all of 2020 following thoracic outlet surgery and most of 2021 due to right lateral forearm tightness and left hip soreness (made 6 appearances/5 starts for Tampa Bay).
Is one of 10 American League starting pitchers this season to make at least 14 starts with an ERA under 3.20(3.14; 57.1 IP, 20 ER) and an opponent batting average below. 220 (.216; 46-for-213)...the others are Shane McClanahan, Alek Manoah, Justin Verlander, Logan Gilbert, Nestor Cortes, Dylan Cease, Framber Valdez, Gerrit Cole and Michael Kopech.
Has faced just six batters a third time through the order (1-for-3, 2 BB, SF)...opponents are hitting .179 (20-for-112) with a .595 OPS the first time through; .255 (25-for-98) with a .775 OPS the second time.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2022 SEASON: 6-3, 3.20 ERA // CAREER: 8-4, 3.47 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow night's series and homestand opener vs. Baltimore at Target Field...will mark his fourth start since being reinstated from the COVID IL on June 14; is 1-1, 5.74 ERA (15,2 IP, 10 ER) in those efforts, after going 5-2, 2.28 ERA (43,1 IP, 11 ER) in eight starts prior...has topped the 100-pitch plateau in consecutive starts, including 102 in a 6-3 victory over Colorado last Sunday at Target Field...allowed at least one hit in each of his 5.0 innings against the Rockies and a career-high eight total, but allowed just three runs to earn the win (1 BB, 1 K)...has faced Baltimore once in his career, a no-decision in a 7-2 Twins win on May 3 at Camden Yards (4.2 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K).

- CAREER NOTES
  Twins are his fifth organization, following time with Cleveland (2006-08), Chicago-NL (2009-10), Tampa Bay (2011-18 and 2021) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).
  Has recorded double-digit strikeout totals 30 times in career...also boasts three seasons with at least 200.0 innings pitched and 200-plus strikeouts (212.0 IP and 252 K in 2015, 201.1 and 233 in 2016, and 201.0 and 249 in 2017).
  Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks fifth in the American League with 1176 strikeouts since 2013 (his first full season)...is also fifth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 9.53 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched (1110.1 IP).
  Missed the 2020 season recovering from thoracic outlet surgery...procedure was performed on June 2, 2020 by Dr. Robert Thompson at Washington University in St. Louis.
  Twice named to the American League All-Star Team (2015 and 2017).
  Pitched for Team USA in 2017 World Baseball Classic, starting and tossing 4.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts in an eventual 3-2, 10-inning walk-off win over Columbia to open Pool Play...Team USA would go on to win the 2017 WBC.
  Led Major League Baseball and tied the Tampa Bay record with 34 starts in 2017.
  Posted a Rays-record 252 strikeouts in 2015, second in the AL behind the White Sox' Chris Sale (274) and fourth in the majors...finished the season 12-13, becoming the seventh pitcher in the modern era (since 1900) to record 250 strikeouts without posting a winning record...four of the previous six are Hall of Famers: Nolan Ryan (three times), Steve Carlton, Phil Niekro and Ed Walsh.
