**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-2, through four games on their five-game roadtrip, going 2-2 against the Guardians in Cleveland over the last three days...today, the Twins will play the five-game series finale at Progressive Field...after today's game, the Twins will travel home and play a three-game series against Baltimore at Target Field over the weekend...Twins are 23-17 at home and 20-18 on the road.

☞ The Twins have gone 6-2 in rubber games this season.  
☞ Twins have gone 12-7-4 in series play this season, including 8-4-1 in their last 13 chances.

**'PEN CAN'T GUARD LEAD IN CLEVELAND:** The Twins lost to the Guardians at Progressive Field last night by a score of 6-5 in 10 innings, falling to 1-4 in extra innings this season and suffering their first walk-off loss of 2022...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs (2 earned) on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Emilio Pagan and Jharel Cotton combined to allow four runs (3 earned) in 0.2 innings of relief as Cotton allowed a walk-off homer to Josh Naylor...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Alex Kirilloff, who fell a triple short of the cycle...Kirilloff hit his first home of the season, while Max Kepler hit his eighth and Gio Urshela hit his seventh.

**THANK YOU, WES:** Today is pitching coach Wes Johnson's final game with the Twins as he has accepted the role of pitching coach at Louisiana State University...Johnson, 51, has served as the Twins pitching coach since 2019...prior to that season, he was hired by Minnesota from the University of Arkansas, becoming the first pitching coach in major league history to go from the college ranks directly to the majors...though 78 games this season, the Twins pitching staff has posted a 3.70 ERA (690.2 IP, 284 ER) with 221 walks, 627 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP and a .237 opponent batting average...under Johnson's guidance, the 2019 Minnesota pitching staff set a single-season club record with 1,463 team strikeouts, while the 2020 staff set a single-season club record for strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (9.38)...that same season, Kenta Maeda finished second in the American League Cy Young Award voting, behind winner Shane Bieber of Cleveland...additionally, three Twins pitchers - Jose Berrios and Jake Odorizzi in 2019, and Taylor Rogers in 2021 - were named to the AL All-Star team during his tenure...below are the starting pitcher ranks among AL teams:

**ON GUARD:** The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 11th of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 5-5 against the Guardians this season...their next series will be three games from September 9-11 at Target Field...Twins will visit Cleveland again for five games from September 16-19.

☞ A win today and the Twins will secure their sixth series victory in their last eight chances against the Guardians...Twins have outscored Cleveland 58-40 this season.  
☞ Since the start of 2020, 30 of the 39 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 20 have been decided by two runs-or-less...six of the 10 games this season have been decided by one run...since the start of last season, eight of the 29 games between these two have gone into extra innings.

**NOW THAT'S PROGRESSIVE:** The Twins are 6-3 in their last nine games at Cleveland and 8-4 in their last 12 at Progressive Field...a win today and they will secure their third-straight series win in Cleveland.

☞ The Twins have hit 27 home runs at Cleveland since the start of 2021, their most outside of Target Field in that span...additionally, the Twins have homered in 15-straight games in Cleveland, their longest streak in that city...it marks their longest streak in an opposing ballpark since homering in 21 straight at Kauffman Stadium from July 30, 1998-August 25, 2001.

☞ For his career, Max Kepler has 42 hits, 14 home runs, 29 runs scored and 31 RBI at Progressive Field (46 games), all his most in any opposing ballpark.

**BYE BYE BYRON:** Byron Buxton hit his 20th home run of the season Tuesday night, setting single-season career-high, passing his previous high of 19, done last season...he enters today tied with Anthony Rizzo for fourth in the AL in home runs, trailing Aaron Judge (29), Yordan Alvarez (23) and Mike Trout (23)...he has homered four times in his last eight games at Progressive Field, since the start of 2021.  
☞ In Buck's last 162 games, he is hitting .268 (155-for-578) with 36 doubles, two triples 52 home runs, 95 RBI, 113 runs scored, a .607 slugging percentage and a .929 OPS...Twins are 93-69 in those games...he is on pace for 41 home runs this season.

**C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE:** Carlos Correa has a hard hit rate of 50.0%, which is in the top 9% of the league and also a career-high, up from 42.7% in 2021, a 7.3% increase...additionally, he has a 91.9 mph average exit velocity this season, also the highest of his career.  
☞ Correa is hitting .353 (55-for-156) with 10 doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBI, a .407 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .977 OPS in his last 39 games, dating back to April 28.

**KIRILL-ON POINT:** Alex Kirilloff is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with five doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, a .525 slugging percentage and an .866 OPS in 12 games since being recalled on June 17...in five games since June 25 he is slugging .813, which ranks sixth-best in the AL since that date...in 22 games this season, Kirilloff is hitting .395 (17-for-43) against fastballs.

- ☞ Making his team-leading 15th start of the season and 230th of his career...marks his 233rd career appearance.
- ☞ Is 2-1, 1.57 ERA (23.0 IP, 4 ER) in five June starts and has a 2.31 ERA (35.0 IP, 9 ER) in his last eight trips to the mound (Twins are 5-3).
- ☞ Today marks his eighth career start and appearance against Cleveland, but first since August 12, 2017 (with Tampa Bay)...is 0-7, 5.87 ERA (38.1 IP, 25 ER) in his first seven outings.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Delivered his latest in a string of outstanding efforts; this was arguably his finest as he earned the win in a combined 6-0 shutout over Colorado last Saturday at Target Field...blanked the Rockies on just one hit over a season-high-tying 5.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts...worked a 1-2-3 first inning, allowed a leadoff single and walk to start the second, then retired the final 12 hitters he faced.

- ☞ His 78 pitches matched his second-highest of the season (also on May 28 vs. Kansas City), one shy of his season-high 79 on April 30 at Tampa Bay...his 65.4 strike percentage was also his second-best mark of 2022, behind only the 68.4% on May 5 at Baltimore.
- ☞ Marked his fewest hits allowed in a start of 5.0-or-more innings since April 30, 2016 vs. Toronto, with Tampa Bay (6.0 IP, 1 H in a no-decision; Rays won, 4-3).
- ☞ Joined Dylan Bundy (April 11 vs. Seattle; 5.0 IP, 1 H) and Joe Ryan (April 27 vs. Detroit; 7.0 IP, 1 H) as the three Twins starters this season to work 5.0-or-more innings while yielding one-or-fewer hits.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Was saddled with his third loss of the season in the June 19 roadtrip finale at Arizona...worked 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits, with no walks and three strikeouts; both Diamondbacks runs came via solo home runs off the bat of Christian Walker (leading off the second inning and with one out in the fourth)...Twins lost to Merrill Kelly and the D-Backs, 7-1.

- ☞ Walker's first solo blast snapped a stretch of 120 consecutive batters Archer had faced without allowing a home run...the streak began with the final seven batters he faced in a May 11 start vs. Houston, spanned six-consecutive starts from May 16 - June 13, and finished with a 1-2-3 first inning at Chase Field.
- ☞ All eight home runs Archer has allowed this season have been solo...the last longball he allowed with runners on base was a two-run shot by the Twins' Jorge Polanco on September 4, 2021 at Tropicana Field (with Tampa Bay).

**JUNE BOON CONTINUES STRONG STRETCH:** In five June starts, Archer is 2-1, 1.57 ERA (23.0 IP, 4 ER) with eight walks, 16 strikeouts and a .169/.253/.273 opponent slash line (13-for-77 with 2 2B, 2 HR and a HBP)...he has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in all five efforts, while the Twins are 3-2.

- ☞ Among American League starters with at least 23.0 innings pitched in June, he ranks second in opponent batting average, fourth in WHIP (0.91) and fifth in ERA.
- ☞ Going back even further, Archer has a 2.31 ERA (35.0 IP, 9 ER) with 12 walks, 23 strikeouts and a .198/.277/.310 opponent slash line (25-for-126 with 8 2B, 2 HR and 2 HBP) in his last eight starts (he is 2-2, while the Twins are 5-3)...he has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in seven of those eight starts and one-or-fewer in six efforts (since May 16).

**VS. THE GUARDIANS:** Archer is set to make his eighth career start and appearance against Cleveland, but first since August 12, 2017 (with Tampa Bay)...will be looking for his first career victory against the Guardians, as he been dealt the loss in each of his prior seven outings (all with the Rays between 2013-17); is 0-7, 5.87 ERA (38.1 IP, 25 ER) in those starts.

- ☞ Cleveland (0-7 in 7 starts), St. Louis (0-1 in 6 starts) and Los Angeles (0-3 in 4 starts) are the three MLB teams he has started against at least four times without defeating.
- ☞ Is 0-4, 6.35 ERA (22.2 IP, 16 ER) in four career starts here at Progressive Field...he last pitched here on May 15, 2017, taking an 8-7 loss (5.0 IP, 5 H, 7 R/6 ER, 6 BB, 6 K).

**A FEEL FOR THE ROAD:** Archer has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his seven road starts this season, going 0-1, 2.76 ERA (29.1 IP, 9 ER), 11 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .213/.292/.426 opponent slash line (23-for-108, with 5 2B and 6 HR)...has departed all six of his seven road efforts with the Twins either tied or ahead (Minnesota is 3-4).

- ☞ Is looking for his first road win since September 25, 2018 at Chicago-NL (with Pittsburgh)...is 0-7, 5.29 ERA (97.0 IP, 57 ER) in 21 road games (20 starts) since.

**SOFT CONTACT:** Archer has allowed an average exit velocity of 89.2 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (besting the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .235 opponent batting average on balls in play would also be the lowest of his career, besting the .254 of his first full season in 2013; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

**THE ARSENAL:** In his first three starts of the season, just 3.5 percent of Archer's pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed, per Baseball Savant...in 10 starts since, he has thrown his changeup and curveball 21.8 percent of the time (169 of 775 pitches)...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

- ☞ His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.7 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.
- ☞ Opponents are a combined 26-for-149 (.174) with 10 doubles, three homers and 36 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball; they are hitting .313 (20-for-64) with three doubles, five home runs and seven strikeouts against his fastball...however, opponents are 5-for-27 (.185) with one homer off Archer's fastball in June.

**ONE STEP AT A TIME:** Archer is the lone Twins starter to make of each of his scheduled turns through the rotation, as today will be his team-leading 15th start of the season, his most since logging 23 with Pittsburgh in 2019...missed the final month of that season with right shoulder inflammation, all of 2020 following thoracic outlet surgery and most of 2021 due to right lateral forearm tightness and left hip soreness (made 6 appearances/5 starts for Tampa Bay).

- ☞ Is one of 10 American League starting pitchers this season to make at least 14 starts with an ERA under 3.20 (3.14; 57.1 IP, 20 ER) and an opponent batting average below .220 (.216; 46-for-213)...the others are Shane Bieber, Alek Manoah, Justin Verlander, Logan Gilbert, Nestor Cortes, Dylan Cease, Framer Valdez, Gerrit Cole and Michael Kopech.
- ☞ Has faced just six batters a third time through the order (1-for-3, 2 BB, SF)...opponents are hitting .179 (20-for-112) with a .595 OPS the first time through; .255 (25-for-98) with a .775 OPS the second time.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2022 SEASON: 6-3, 3.20 ERA // CAREER: 8-4, 3.47 ERA)
