MIRANDA RIGHTS: Jose Miranda is hitting . 357 ( 10 -for- 28 ) with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a 786 slugging percentage and a 1.143 OPS in his last nine games...h began his season/career hitting. 094 (5-0r-53) with a .189 slugging percentage and a 332 playing in a ballpark for the first time: May 6 at Target Field vs. Oakland, May 30 at Comerica ark and last night at Rogers Centre
© Last night, ,he became the first Twins rookie with a two-plus homer game on the road

EMP-LUEY OF THE MONTH: Since the beginning of May, Luis Arraez is hitting . 359 (33-for-92 with 16 walks and a 459 on-base percentage...in that span, he ranks second in baseball in on-base percentage a ard seventh in batting average.

HUNGRY LIKE THE WOLF: Jhoan Duran enters today's game with an 11.2 scoreless inning streak, tied for third-longest active streak in the AL and tied for seventh-longest in baseball.... his run started on May $7 . .$. additionally, he ranks second in the AL in relief strikeouts (35), railing only Michael King (38)
\$ He has an average pitch velocity of 96.2 mph this season, third-highest in baseball
among pitchers with at least 300 pitches thrown, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Brusdar Graterol (96.6) and Detroit's Gregory Soto (96.4).
SERIES-LY?: The Twins are looking for their first series win since May 23-25 vs. Detroit...they are 8-4-4 in series play this season...the Twins have won three of their last four series' in Toronto, dating back to 2017...series results on the season to the right
DID YOU KNOW?: Manager Rocco Baldelli homered in his first career game at Rogers Centre on May 13, 2003 , a solo shot off Irever Miller, while playing for the Devil Rays.. he hit safely BIRTHDAY SHOUTS FOR 'SHAK: Right-handed reliever Cody Stashak is celebrating his 28th birthday today...Stashak has missed the club's last 14 games on the 15-day Injured List with right shoulder impingement.
EARS PERK UP: Former All-Star closer Glen Perkins will join Twins Hall of Fame electee Dan Gladden this weekend on WCCO Radio for the three-game series against the Blue Jays... all games will be broadcast from Target Field.
ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1976, Larry Hisle became the third Twin ( 10 now) to ever hit for the cycle, doing so at Baltimore. in 2002, the Twins scored 10 runs in the seventh inning in a 23-2 win over Cleveland...they also recorded a franchise-best 25 hits and Luis Rivas in 2012 the Twins selected Byron Buxton with the second overall selection int the M1 B First-Year Player Draft after Houston selected Carlos Correa first overall...Buxton came out of Appling County High School in Baxley, Georgia.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his last start on May 30 against Detroit at Comerica Park, tying his season high with 6.0 innings and allowing four runs on nine hits, with no walks and three strikeout in a 7-5 Twins defeat...marked his third walkless start of the season (also, April 18 at Boston and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL)...the Twins have now lost five consecutive games that Bundy has started, dating back to April 29...tossed a season-high 95 pitches in his outing, marking his most thrown since May 2, 2021 at Seattle (also 95 pitches).

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his seventh start of the season and third home start on May 25 vs. Detroit... did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.2 innings and allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts....was removed from the game with a 2-1 lead in the sixth inning; the Tigers tied the game in the eighth inning and the Twins eventually fell, 4-2, in 10 innings...marked his second start since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List on May 17.
$\Phi$ Marked his third consecutive home start allowing one-or-fewer earned runs with at least 5.0 innings pitched, marking the first time in his career he tossed at least 5.0 innings with one-or-fewer earned runs in his first three home starts of a season.

CAREER VS. TORONTO: Will be making his 17 th career appearance (13th start) against the Blue Jays... is 5-4, 3.27 ERA (74.1 IP, 27 ER ) with 19 walks, 77 strikeouts and a . 226 (62-for-274) opponent batting average against Toronto...made one start against the Blue Jays last season; was dealt the loss in a 10-2 defeat ( $4.0 \mathrm{IP}, 4 \mathrm{H}, 3 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{ER}, 2 \mathrm{HR}, 0 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}$ )...has recorded six-or-more strikeouts in five of his last six starts against the Jays and has allowed two runs-or-fewer in four of his last five starts.

क Is 4-1, 3.89 ERA ( 37.0 IP, 16 ER) with eight walks, 35 strikeouts and a .230 (32-for-139) opponent batting average in seven career appearances ( 6 starts) at Rogers Centre.

ROCKY ROADS: Bundy will be starting his sixth start on the road this season...is 1-2, 7.50 ERA (24.0 IP, 20 ER ) with six walks and 22 strikeouts in five starts on the road, compared to 2-0, 0.57 ERA (15.2 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts in three home starts this season...has shown slightly better numbers when pitching at home in his career, going 25-32, 4.56 ERA ( 442.0 IP, 224 ER) with 131 walks and 410 strikeouts in 91 home appearances (77 starts)...is 24-27, 4.91 ERA (368.1 IP, 201 ER) with 134 walks and 382 strikeouts in 78 road appearances ( 64 starts).

GETTING BACK ON TRACK: Allowed just one earned run in 15.1 innings pitched in his first three starts of the season, to then allow 15 earned runs in his next two starts ( 13.97 ERA) in 9.2 innings pitched, before going on the COVID Injured List on May 6 ...since being reinstated, Bundy owns a 3.07 ERA (14.2 IP, 5 ER ) with three walks and 12 strikeouts in his last three starts.

SPRING HAS SPRUNG, SUMER HAS BEGUN: Today marks his first start in the month of June after making four starts in May...was 0-1, 6.87 ERA ( 18.1 IP, 14 ER) with five walks and 15 strikeouts last month... in his career in the month of June, he is 8-8, 4.40 ERA ( $110.1 \mathrm{IP}, 54 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with 39 walks and 104 strikeouts in 25 appearances ( 18 starts).

WALKING IN STYLE: Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in each of his last five starts (7 BB total)...even with his last four starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 4.7 walk percentage...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage ( $34.9 \%$ ) and first-pitch strike percentage ( $69.2 \%$ ).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy's pitch usage has resulted in his highest career groundball percentage (44.4\%)...according to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first eight starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Bundy went $3-0,0.59$ ERA ( $15.1 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.
$\Phi$ Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-orfewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (Elias)
$\Phi$ Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (Elias).
$\Phi$ Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero ( 0.54 ERA, $5 / 2-5 / 13 / 18$ ) and Ervin Santana ( 0.41 ERA, $4 / 3-4 / 14 / 17$ ).

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on December 1, 2021...this marks his third professional organization, as he spent the previous two seasons with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and his first five major league seasons with Baltimore (2012-19).
