THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 1-4 in Detroit and 1-0 over the Blue Jays last nighttoday, the Twins will play the second of

three against the Blue Javs in Toronto through the weekendafter this series, the Twins will
travel home to enjoy an off-day on Monday, followed by a six-game homestand against the Yankees (June 7-9) and Rays (June 10-12)the Twins are 17-11 at home and 14-12 on the road.

TWINS FLIP POWER SWITCH IN TORONTO: The Twins beat the Blue Jays last night at Rogers Centre by a score of 9-3, snapping a three-game losing streak and snapping Toronto's eightgame winning streak...Chi Chi González was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 3.0 innings pitched...five relievers combined to pitch 6.0 scoreless innings, highlighted by Jharel Cotton's 2.0 perfect innings...the offense recorded 12 hits, five going for home runs, including two from both Kyle Garlick and Jose Miranda and one from Byron Buxton.

Five home runs marked the most ever for the Twins in a single game at the Rogers Centre.

Last night marked the 13th time in Twins history to have multiple players with two-plus home runs in a road game (last: 6/29/19 at CWS - Nelson Cruz and Max Kepler).

TWINS AND TORONTO: The Twins are playing the second of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they will host the Jays for four games at Target Field from August 4-7...the Twins have gone just 30-46 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 12-7 in their last 19, dating back to May 2018.

▼ Twins are 9-2 in their last 11 at Rogers Centre.

▼ Byron Buxton is hitting .329 (28-for-85) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.093 OPS in 22 career games vs. the Jays...he is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with a 1.110 OPS in 10 career games at Rogers Centre.

▼ Jorge Polanco is hitting .304 (35-for-115) with eight doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and an .848 OPS in 29 career games vs. the Jays...in 15 career games at the Rogers Centre, he is hitting .375 (24-for-64) with six doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.038 OPS.

#OLDFRIEND: Today's Jays starter José Berríos was traded by Minnesota to Toronto on July 30, 2021 in exchange for infielder/outfielder Austin Martin (Twins No. 2 prospect per MLB.com) and right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson (Twins No. 4 prospect per MLB.com) — both currently with Double-A Wichita...Berríos was selected by the Twins in the first round (32nd overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Papa Juan High School in Bayamón, Puerto Rico...the 27-year-old pitched for the Twins from 2016-21, going 55-43, 4.08 ERA (781,1 IP, 354 ER), 253 walks and 779 strikeouts in 136 games (135 starts)...he ranks 12th on Twins all-time list (since 1961) in strikeouts and 15th in wins.

MIRANDA RIGHTS: Jose Miranda is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .786 slugging percentage and a 1.143 OPS in his last nine games...he began his season/career hitting .094 (5-for-53) with a .189 slugging percentage and a .332 OPS in his first 14 games...additionally, all four of his home runs this season have come while playing in a ballpark for the first time: May 6 at Target Field vs. Oakland, May 30 at Comerica Park and last night at Rogers Centre.

◆ Last night, he became the first Twins rookie with a two-plus homer game on the road since August 1, 2016 at Cleveland, when Max Kepler did it.

EMP-LUEY OF THE MONTH: Since the beginning of May, Luis Arraez is hitting .359 (33-for-92) with 16 walks and a .459 on-base percentage...in that span, he ranks second in baseball in on-base percentage and seventh in batting average.

▼ Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .378 (31-for-82) with 14 walks, a .474 on-base percentage and an .889 OPS in 22 games.

▼ On the season, Arraez is hitting .342 (53-for-155), the third-highest average in the AL and fifth highest in baseball, trailing only J.D. Martinez (.357), Tim Anderson (.356), Paul Goldschmidt (.349) and Manny Machado (.344)...additionally, he has posted a .430 on-base percentage, the highest in baseball.

THE BUCK STARTS HERE: Byron Buxton has hit safely in seven-straight starts...in those games, since May 26, he is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with two doubles, one home run, two RBI, two walks, a .364 on-base percentage and an .830 OPS...leading up to this current stretch, he was hitting .067 (3-for-45) with a .373 OPS in 12 games from May 7-25.

▼ 19 of his 32 hits on the season have gone for extra bases.

'PEN POLISH: Through six games on this roadtrip, the Twins bullpen has posted a 1.40 ERA (19.1 IP, 3 ER) with one home run allowed (Daz Cameron on 6/2 at DET), five walks, 23 strikeouts and a .121 (8-for-66) opponent batting average.

SERIES-LY?: The Twins are looking for their first series win since May 23-25 vs. Detroit...they are 8-4-4 in series play this season...the Twins have won three of their last four series' in Toronto, dating back to 2017...series results on the season to the right.

DID YOU KNOW?: Manager Rocco Baldelli homered in his first career game at Rogers Centre on May 13, 2003, a solo shot off Trever Miller, while playing for the Devil Rays...he hit safely in each of his first 11 games at the Rogers Centre from May 13, 2003-June 22, 2004.

BIRTHDAY SHOUTS FOR 'SHAK: Right-handed reliever Cody Stashak is celebrating his 28th birthday today...Stashak has missed the club's last 14 games on the 15-day Injured List with right shoulder impingement.

EARS PERK UP: Former All-Star closer Glen Perkins will join Twins Hall of Fame electee Dan Gladden this weekend on WCCO Radio for the three-game series against the Blue Jays...all games will be broadcast from Target Field.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1976, Larry Hisle became the third Twin (10 now) to ever hit for the cycle, doing so at Baltimore... in 2002, the Twins scored 10 runs in the seventh inning in a 23-2 win over Cleveland...they also recorded a franchise-best 25 hits and tied the AL record (5th team to do so) as four players recorded four-or-more hits — Jacque Jones, Dustan Mohr, A.J. Pierzynski and Luis Rivas...in 2012, the Twins selected Byron Buxton with the second overall selection in the MLB First-Year Player Draft after Houston selected Carlos Correa first overall...Buxton came out of Appling County High School in Baxley, Georgia.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his last start on May 30 against Detroit at Comerica Park, tying his season high with 6.0 innings and allowing four runs on nine hits, with no walks and three strikeout in a 7-5 Twins defeat...marked his third walkless start of the season (also, April 18 at Boston and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL)...the Twins have now lost five consecutive games that Bundy has started, dating back to April 29...tossed a season-high 95 pitches in his outing, marking his most thrown since May 2, 2021 at Seattle (also 95 pitches).

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his seventh start of the season and third home start on May 25 vs. Detroit... did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.2 innings and allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts...was removed from the game with a 2-1 lead in the sixth inning; the Tigers tied the game in the eighth inning and the Twins eventually fell, 4-2, in 10 innings...marked his second start since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List on May 17.

The Marked his third consecutive home start allowing one-or-fewer earned runs with at least 5.0 innings pitched, marking the first time in his career he tossed at least 5.0 innings with oneor-fewer earned runs in his first three home starts of a season.

CAREER VS. TORONTO: Will be making his 17th career appearance (13th start) against the Blue Jays... is 5-4, 3.27 ERA (74.1 IP, 27 ER) with 19 walks, 77 strikeouts and a .226 (62-for-274) opponent batting average against Toronto...made one start against the Blue Jays last season; was dealt the loss in a 10-2 defeat (4.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R/ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 2 K)...has recorded six-or-more strikeouts in five of his last six starts against the Jays and has allowed two runs-or-fewer in four of his last five starts.

- The Bundy's 3.27 ERA vs. Toronto marks his lowest against any opponent that he's started against at least 10 times
- ₱ Is 4-1, 3.89 ERA (37.0 IP, 16 ER) with eight walks, 35 strikeouts and a .230 (32-for-139) opponent batting average in seven career appearances (6 starts) at Rogers Centre

ROCKY ROADS: Bundy will be starting his sixth start on the road this season...is 1-2, 7.50 ERA (24.0 IP, 20 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts in five starts on the road, compared to 2-0, 0.57 ERA $(15.2\,IP,\,1\,ER)$ with two walks and 12 strikeouts in three home starts this season...has shown slightly better numbers when pitching at home in his career, going 25-32, 4.56 ERA (442.0 IP, 224 ER) with 131 walks and 410 strikeouts in 91 home appearances (77 starts)...is 24-27, 4.91 ERA (368.1 IP, 201 ER) with 134 walks and 382 strikeouts in 78 road appearances (64 starts).

GETTING BACK ON TRACK: Allowed just one earned run in 15.1 innings pitched in his first three starts of the season, to then allow 15 earned runs in his next two starts (13.97 ERA) in 9.2 innings pitched, before going on the COVID Injured List on May 6...since being reinstated, Bundy owns a 3.07 ERA (14.2 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and 12 strikeouts in his last three starts.

SPRING HAS SPRUNG, SUMER HAS BEGUN: Today marks his first start in the month of June after making four starts in May...was 0-1, 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP, 14 ER) with five walks and 15 strikeouts last month... in his career in the month of June, he is 8-8, 4.40 ERA (110.1 IP, 54 ER) with 39 walks and 104 strikeouts in 25 appearances (18 starts).

WALKING IN STYLE: Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in each of his last five starts (7 BB total)...even with his last four starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 4.7 walk percentage...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (34.9%) and first-pitch strike percentage (69.2%).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy's pitch usage has resulted in his highest career groundball percentage (44.4%)...according to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first eight starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.
