THE TWINS: Have gone 2-5 through seven games on their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 1-4 in Detroit and 1-1 in Toronto...today, the Twins will complete the trip with the three-game series finale in Toronto...after today's game, the Twins will travel back to Minneapolis...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, before beginning a six-game homestand, with three against New York-AL from Tuesday-Thursday and three against Tampa Bay next weekend...the Twins are 17-11 at home and 14-13 on the road.

BLACK AND BLUE JAYS: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays yesterday afternoon at Rogers Centre by a score of 12-3, the largest margin of defeat this season...Dylan Bundy (3-3) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs (5 earned) on eight hits in 2.1 innings pitched...Ian Hamilton made his Twins debut with 2.2 innings of relief...he became the 28th pitcher used by the Twins this season, marking the most in baseball...it is also already the sixth most the Twins have used in a season (36 in 2017)...the offense recorded six hits and struck out a season-high 15 times...Jorge Polanco provided the only offensive highlight, hitting a two-run homer in the top of the first inning.

TWINS AND TORONTO: The Twins are playing the third of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they will host the Jays for four games at Target Field from August 4-7...the Twins have gone just 30-47 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 12-8 in their last 20, dating back to May 2018.

☞ Twins are 9-3 in their last 12 at Rogers Centre.
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .318 (28-for-88) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.063 OPS in 23 career games vs. the Jays...he is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with a 1.051 OPS in 11 career games at Rogers Centre.
 ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .305 (36-for-118) with eight doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI and an .869 OPS in 30 career games vs. the Jays...in 16 career games at Rogers Centre, he is hitting .373 (25-for-67) with six doubles, four home runs, nine RBI and a 1.066 OPS.

CHECK URSELF: Gio Urshela has hit safely in 15 of his last 19 games since May 14, hitting .338 (22-for-65) with four doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI, seven walks, a .397 on-base percentage, a .585 slugging percentage and a .982 OPS in that span...since that date, he is tied for fifth in the AL in RBI, seventh in batting average and eighth in OPS.

ARRAEZ-ING TO THE OCCASION: Luis Arraez is hitting .342 (54-for-158), the third-highest average in the AL and fourth highest in baseball, trailing only Tim Anderson (.356), J.D. Martinez (.353) and Manny Machado (.342)...additionally, he has posted a .432 on-base percentage, the highest in baseball.

☞ Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .376 (32-for-85) with 14 walks, a .475 on-base percentage and an .887 OPS in 23 games.

MIRANDA RIGHTS: Jose Miranda is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .774 slugging percentage and a 1.149 OPS in his last 10 games...he began his season/career hitting .094 (5-for-53) with a .189 slugging percentage and a .332 OPS in his first 14 games.

CELEBRATE GOOD TIMES: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .381 (24-for-63) with four doubles, four RBI, six walks, eight runs scored, a .443 on-base percentage and an .887 OPS in his last 22 games, since April 28...among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 50 at-bats, he ranks first in batting average (.333), second in on-base percentage (.405), sixth in OPS (.791) and 15th in slugging percentage (.387).

HUNGRY LIKE THE WOLF: Jhoan Duran enters today's game with an 11.2 scoreless inning streak, tied for fourth-longest active streak in the AL and tied for ninth-longest in baseball...his run started on May 7...additionally, he ranks tied for second in the AL in relief strikeouts (35) with Liam Hendriks, trailing Michael King (39).

☞ He has an average pitch velocity of 96.2 mph this season, third-highest in baseball among pitchers with at least 300 pitches thrown, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Brusdar Graterol (96.6) and Detroit's Gregory Soto (96.4).

DOUBLE UP: The Twins have hit 93 doubles on the season, third most in the AL, trailing Boston (134) and Toronto (96)...Gary Sánchez has 13 doubles on the season, tied for 12th-most in the AL...more on Sánchez and where he ranks among catchers listed as their primary position to the lower right.

SERIES-LY?: The Twins are looking for their first series win since May 23-25 vs. Detroit...they are 8-4-4 in series play this season...the Twins have won three of their last four series in Toronto, dating back to 2017...series results on the season to the right.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Emanuel Rodriguez and left-handed pitcher Steven Hajar as the minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Rodriguez, 19, played in four games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .636 (7-for-11) with one double, two triples, two home runs, five RBI, six walks, a .765 OBP, a 1.636 SLG and a 2.401 OPS...the Santiago, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins as an undrafted free agent on July 2, 2019.
 ☞ Hajar, 21, started for the Mighty Mussels on Wednesday vs. Tampa, allowing one run on two hits in 4.1 innings pitched, while walking two and striking out seven...this marks his second-consecutive weekly honor...the Andover, Massachusetts native was selected by the Twins in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Michigan.

HBD ROYCE!: Twins infielder Royce Lewis is celebrating his 23rd birthday today...Royce has missed the Twins' last seven games on the 10-day Injured List with a right knee bone bruise.

DID YOU KNOW?: Bally Sports North analyst LaTroy Hawkins spent part of the 2015 season with Toronto, going 1-0, 2.76 ERA (16.1 IP, 5 ER) with one save, three walks and 14 strikeouts...on August 5 of that season, he saved a 9-7 win for the Jays over the Twins and became the 13th player in baseball history to record at least one save against all 30 teams.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2014, the Twins selected Nick Gordon with the fifth overall pick in the MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Olympia High School in Orlando, FL.

- ☞ Making his fifth major league start and appearance of the season...also 24th career appearance and 12th start.
- ☞ Facing Toronto for the first time in his career...also his second career appearance (1st start) against the American League East division, after tossing 5.0 innings of relief (5 H, 1 R/ER, 4 K) on July 24, 2019 vs. New York-AL.
- ☞ Was acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on July 31, 2018 along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win of the season in his last start on May 31 at Detroit, earning the 8-2 win in the first game of the doubleheader...allowed two runs on a season-high six hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 6.2 innings of work...6.2 innings is the second most he's pitched in an outing in his career, behind his career-best 7.0-inning performance on May 26 vs. Kansas City... did not walk a batter for the third time in a start in his career, first such instance since September 26, 2019 at Detroit.

- ☞ Paired with his start on May 26, has quality starts in back-to-back outings for the first time in his career.
- ☞ Threw a career-high 101 pitches in the start, the second Twins starting pitcher to cross the 100-pitch threshold this season, alongside Joe Ryan (103 pitches on May 15 vs. Cleveland).
- ☞ Tossed 71 of his 101 pitches for strikes, recording a 70.3 strike percentage...marked the third time in his career that he surpassed 70 percent strikes in a start, alongside his major league debut on May 28, 2019 vs. Milwaukee (76.8%, 69/53) and September 26, 2019 at Detroit (70.4%, 81/57).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on May 26 against Kansas City at Target Field...tossed a career-high 7.0 scoreless innings and yielded just two hits, with one walk and a season-high six strikeouts, one shy of his career high...departed with the Twins ahead 2-0; the Royals scored thrice in the eighth inning en route to a 3-2 win...was recalled the day prior when Joe Ryan was placed on the COVID IL.

- ☞ Tossed a then-season-high 80 pitches, then the fifth time in his major league career that he crossed the 80-pitch threshold and first time since September 26, 2019 at Detroit (81 pitches).
- ☞ Became the third Twins starting pitcher to throw 7.0 shutout innings this season, joining Joe Ryan (April 27 vs. Detroit) and Sonny Gray (May 24 vs. Detroit).

SUCCESS AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 4-2, 3.05 ERA (59.0 IP, 20 ER) with a .223 (48-for-215) opponent batting average and .618 opponent OPS in 10 starts...to compare, he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and .834 opponent OPS in 12 big league relief outings.

NEW TO THE NORTH: Facing the Blue Jays for the first time in his career...today also marks his first career start and second appearance against an American League East division club...tossed 5.0 innings in relief against New York-AL on July 24, 2019 at Target Field; yielded one run on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts as the Twins lost, 10-7.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Smeltzer is making his third start and appearance of the season on the road and is 2-0, 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER) with one walk and four strikeouts in his two prior road outings.

- ☞ Is 3-1, 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP, 13 ER) with six walks, 13 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP and a .265 (31-for-117) opponent batting average in six career road starts...after yielding five earned runs in 6.1 innings in his first career road start on June 4, 2019, has permitted three-or-fewer runs in each of his last five, including two-or-fewer in each of his last two (2.76 ERA, 16.1 IP, 5 ER).

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Smeltzer's repertoire through his first four starts of the 2022 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a five-pitch mix, primarily relying on his four-seam fastball and changeup...see the bullet below for more information on Smeltzer's changeup usage.

☞ Prior to his May 26 outing against Kansas City, Smeltzer's wife, Brianne — a former college softball player — advised him to throw more changeups down and away when attacking hitters...he's followed her advice over his last two starts, using his changeup more often (it's now his second-most-used pitch) while posting a 1.32 ERA (13.2 IP, 2 ER) and 10 strikeouts combined in those two outings.

HOMER UNHAPPY: Smeltzer last allowed a home run in a start on June 4, 2019 at Cleveland, when he permitted a career-high four...since then, he's recorded nine-straight starts without allowing a ball to leave the yard, dating back to August 4, 2019 vs. Kansas City.

- ☞ Smeltzer's streak tied for the fifth longest in Twins history (1961-present) and the longest since Francisco Liriano worked a club-record 15 consecutive homerless starts from May 26-August 12, 2010.
- ☞ Smeltzer also enters today with a streak of 42.2 innings without allowing a home run (as both a starter and a reliever), dating back to the third inning on August 2, 2020...that streak is the fourth-longest active run in the American League and the seventh longest in the majors entering today.

STRIKES AND OUTS: Has been effective so far in his career when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .158 (6-for-38) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .189 (31-for-164) mark in his career.

SO FAR IN ST. PAUL: Appeared in five games (all starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-2, 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts...did not pitch for the Saints in his most recent stint (was scheduled to pitch on May 25 before being recalled).

- ☞ Extended his scoreless innings streak to 11.0 innings to start the season before he permitted two runs on five hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings in his third start of the season on April 21 at Toledo...took the loss as the Saints fell, 2-1.
- ☞ Took the loss for St. Paul on May 3 vs. the Iowa Cubs and allowed six of his nine runs of the season in that single start.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after collapsing during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be caused by a herniated disc in his neck...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

CAREER NOTES

- Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL, along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe, in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier at the 2018 trade deadline.
- Made Twins Opening Day roster in 2020, the first of his career...went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances...four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more...held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.
- Combined to post a 3.02 ERA (104.1 IP, 32 ER) in 20 games (19 starts) between Double-A Pensacola and Triple-A Rochester, going 4-5 in 2019... Began season with Double-A Pensacola...earned the Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week and Southern League Pitcher of the Week April 14 after making two starts, going 2-0, 0.00 ERA (14.0 IP) with five hits allowed, two walks and 17 strikeouts...Made five starts with the Blue Wahoos, posting a 0.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 2 ER) before being promoted to Triple-A Rochester May 2...Went 0-1, 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) in four starts for the Red Wings and had contract selected by Minnesota on May 28... Made major league debut May 28 vs. Milwaukee... became fourth Twins starter in history to throw 6.0-or-more shutout innings in his debut, joining Andrew Albers (8.1 on August 6, 2013), Anthony Swarzak (7.0 on May 23, 2009) and Eric Milton (6.0 on April 5, 1998).
