**TWINS BATS BEAT JAYS:** The Twins beat the Blue Jays on Sunday afternoon at Rogers Centre by a score of 8-6, winning the three-game series...Devin Smeltzer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched...six relievers were used, highlighted by Jovani Moran earning his first career save, securing the final out... the offense recorded a season-high with 16 hits...Luis Arraez reached safely five times, going 4-for-4 with a walk...Gilberto Celestino went 3-for-5...the win made them 9-4-4 in series play this season, 4-2-2 on the road.

TWINS CREATE NEW TEAM FOR HOMESTAND: The Twins have reinstated outfielder Max Kepler, right-handed pitchers Trevor Megill and Emilio Pagán, and left-handed pitcher Caleb Thielbar from the Restricted List.

Kepler has hit .253 (39-for-154) with seven doubles, one triple, six home runs, 25 RBI, 23 runs scored and a .786 OPS in 47 games for the Twins this season.

Megill has pitched in five games for Minnesota since joining the club on May 21, going 1-1, 1.04 ERA (8.2 IP, 1 ER), three walks and 12 strikeouts.

Pagán has gone 1-2, 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 6 ER), 11 walks, 22 strikeouts and a team-leading seven saves in 18 games this season.

Thielbar has made a team-high-tying 22 relief appearances for the Twins this season, going 1-0 with a 5.59 ERA (19.1 IP, 12 ER), 10 walks and 23 strikeouts.

Domake room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have returned right-handed pitchers Jharel Cotton and lan Hamilton, and outfielder Mark Contreras to Triple-A St. Paul.

Additionally, they have placed right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to June 2) with a right groin strain and Kyle Garlick on the 10-day IL with a left hamstring strain...Garlick opens a roster spot for Cole Sands.

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing the first of seven meetings in 2022... the Twins will travel to Yankee Stadium for a four-game series from September 5-8...last season the Twins went 1-6 against the Yankees, going 1-4 at Target Field and 0-4 at Yankee Stadium...in head-to-head regular season games since 2015, the Twins have gone 10-29 vs. the Yankees and since 2017, they have gone 7-19.

■ Gary Sánchez was signed by the Yankees as an undrafted free agent on July 2, 2009... he made his major league debut with New York in 2015 and played seven seasons with the Yankees from 2015-21...he played in 538 games, hitting .230 (444-for-1932) with 78 doubles, 138 home runs, 340 RBI and an .804 OPS...he was named an AL All-Star in both 2017 and 2019.

■ Jorge Polanco is hitting .302 (13-for-43) with two doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.094 OPS in his last 10 games against the Yankees.

FEELING URSHELF: Gio Urshela has hit safely in 16 of his last 20 games since May 14, hitting 329 (23-for-70) with four doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI, seven walks, a .385 on-base percentage, a .557 slugging percentage and a .942 OPS in that span...since that date, he is tied for fifth in the AL in RBI, eighth in batting average and 11th in OPS.

▼ Gio played three seasons with the Yankees from 2019-21, hitting .292 (296-for-1013) with 63 doubles, 41 home runs, 153 RBI and an .815 OPS in 291 games.

**CELE-BRATE GOOD TIMES:** Gilberto Celestino is hitting .397 (27-for-68) with four doubles, four RBI, six walks, eight runs scored, a .453 on-base percentage and a .909 OPS in his last 23 games, since April 28...among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 75 at-bats, he ranks first in batting average (.350), second in on-base percentage (.416), third in OPS (.816) and tied for 12th in hits (28).

WELCOME BACK TO THE BIG LEAGUES: Sands was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul prior to tonight's game and is slated to make his fourth career major league appearance (2nd start) this evening. is his fifth stint with the Twins this season — was previously with the big league club from April 30-May 2, May 6-7 and as the 27th man for the second game on May 12 and the second game on May 31.

LAST TIME OUT IN THE MAJORS: Was appointed as the 27th man for the May 31 doubleheader at Detroit and made his first career major league start in game two...was dealt the loss after allowing four runs (1 home run) on five hits, with four walks and four strikeouts...his four strikeouts matched a career high (also on May 12 vs. Houston) and his 91 pitches thrown were also a career high.

© In three major league appearances (2 starts) this season, he is 0-1 with a 7.88 ERA. He has

- thrown 8.0 innings, allowing nine hits, seven runs (all earned), while striking out 10 and walking four.
