THE TWINS: After completing their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 3-5 (1-4 at Detroit and 2-1 at Toronto), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a loss to the Yankees last night...tonight, they will play the second of three with New York through Thursday...following this series, the Twins will host the Rays for three games over the weekend...the Twins are 17-12 at home and 15-13 on the road.

GRAB YOUR DEVICES: Tonight's game against the Yankees will be broadcast on FS1 and Bally Sports North and Friday night's game against Tampa Bay will be on Apple TV+, the first for the Twins...Friday's game is available to anyone with internet access, for free, only on Apple TV+.

POLO CAN'T PULL TWINS UP: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 10-4, losing their fifth straight to New York...Cole Sands (0-2) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on eight hits in 3.2 innings pitched, including a three-run first inning featuring homers by Aaron Judge and Giancarlo Stanton...the offense recorded 12 hits, four from Jorge Polanco (season-high), who homered (7), doubled (9) and singled twice...Luis Arraez added two hits, giving him a team-leading 18 multi-hit games on the season...Rocco Baldelli was ejected for the seventh time in his career, arguing balls and strikes in the bottom of the seventh inning.

WELCOME BACK, 'LOS: The Twins have reinstated shortstop Carlos Correa from the COVID Injured List and selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton from Triple-A St. Paul...Correa has missed the Twins' last eight games since being placed on the Injured List on May 31...Cotton will be making his fourth stint with the Twins this season...he was most recently with the club last weekend in Toronto...to make room for Correa and Cotton on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned infielder Jermaine Palacios to Triple-A St. Paul and designated right-handed pitcher Juan Minaya for release or assignment.

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing the second of seven meetings in 2022...the Twins will travel to Yankee Stadium for a four-game series from September 5-8...in regular season play, the Twins have lost five straight to the Yankees and nine of their last 10...their only win in that span came on June 10, 2021 in Minnesota, a 7-5 victory...in head-to-head regular season games since 2015, the Twins have gone 10-30 vs. the Yankees and since 2017, they have gone 7-20...since 2002, they have gone 36-94 against New York.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with three doubles, seven home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.227 OPS in his last 11 games against the Yankees...he has homered in three straight vs. New York.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .305 (36-for-118) with seven doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBI, 13 walks, a .371 on-base percentage, a .568 slugging percentage and a .939 OPS in 31 career regular season games against the Yankees.

LEFT SIDE IS OUR BEST SIDE: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the 19th time (11-7) in 57 games...they are hitting .249 (138-for-554) with 57 walks, 31 doubles and 16 home runs against lefties this season...however, in 28 games since May 1, the Twins have hit .264 (78-for-296) with a .335 on-base percentage, the third-highest average in the AL and seventh best in baseball.

☞ Individuals vs. lefties: Carlos Correa is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with six doubles and a .440 on-base percentage...Gilberto Celestino is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with a .400 on-base percentage.

ALL ARRAEZ: Luis Arraez has reached base safely in seven of his last nine plate appearances (6 hits, 1 walk)...he has hit .433 (29-for-67) in his last 17 games, since May 21, raising his batting average 48 points since that date (.313 to .361)...below are his MLB ranks in a few offensive categories on the season:

ADDITIONALLY: Arraez is hitting .412 (40-for-97) off fastballs this season, the highest in baseball (minimum 400 pitches)...hitting .350 (7-for-20) against off-speed pitches, 11th in baseball (min. 750 pitches).

UR ON FIRE: Gio Urshela has hit safely in five straight and in 17 of his last 21 games since May 14, hitting .338 (25-for-74) with four doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI, seven walks, a .390 on-base percentage, a .554 slugging percentage and a .944 OPS in that span...since that date, he is seventh in the AL in batting average, tied for eighth in RBI and 10th in OPS. ☞ He is hitting .583 (7-for-12) against off-speed pitches this season, the highest in baseball.

CELE-BRATE GOOD TIMES: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .389 (28-for-72) with four doubles, four RBI, six walks, eight runs scored, a .443 on-base percentage and an .887 OPS in his last 24 games, since April 28...among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 75 at-bats, he ranks first in batting average (.345), second in on-base percentage (.409), fourth in OPS (.801) and 12th in hits (29).

THE DURANTULA: Jhoan Duran enters today's game with an 12.2 scoreless inning streak, tied for fifth-longest active streak in the AL...his run started on May 7...additionally, he ranks tied for second in the AL in relief strikeouts (36) with Liam Hendriks, trailing Michael King (42). ☞ He has an average pitch velocity of 96.1 mph this season, fourth highest in baseball among pitchers with at least 300 pitches thrown, trailing Cleveland's Emmanuel Clase (97.6), Los Angeles-NL's Brusdar Graterol (96.6) and Detroit's Gregory Soto (96.4).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2013, Joe Mauer hit his 100th career home run at Washington, a fifth-inning solo shot off Gio González...19 players in Twins history have hit 100 home runs as a Twin.

- Making his team-leading 11th start of the season and 226th of his career...marks his 229th career appearance.
Today marks his 20th career start and appearance against New York-AL...is 6-7, 3.08 ERA (119.2 IP, 41 ER) in his previous outings, all with Tampa Bay (last on April 10, 2021).
Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Turned in his best performance in a Twins uniform June 2 at Detroit, allowing one run on three hits in a season-long 5.0 innings; did not factor in the decision as the Tigers rallied to win the five-game series finale, 3-2...worked through the Detroit lineup exactly twice on just 57 pitches, a season-low, before exiting with a 2-1 lead (the Tigers won on a two-run homer in the eighth by Daz Cameron off Emilio Pagán)...allowed a first-inning run within the first three batters (hit-by-pitch, walk, single), but blanked Detroit on just two singles after that.

- Fanned Koby Clemens leading off the second inning for his 1400th career strikeout...is one of 23 active pitchers and 251 in American/National League history (since 1901) to reach the milestone (per Statspass).
Marked his longest start since also working 5.0 innings on September 4, 2021 against, ironically, the Twins (for Tampa Bay, at Tropicana Field)...that game marked Archer's last victory.

TWO STARTS AGO: Shouldered his second loss of the season May 28 vs. Kansas City after allowing a season-high-tying five runs (3 earned) on a season-worst seven hits in 4.0 innings of the Twins' 7-3 setback at Target Field.

- The loss snapped the Twins' two-game winning streak in Archer starts (May 16 at Oakland and May 23 vs. Detroit), during which he fashioned a 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER).

YANKEE DOODLE DANDY: Archer is set to make his 20th career start and appearance against New York-AL, as the Yankees will become the fourth team he has faced at least 20 times (25 starts against Toronto, 22 games and 21 starts vs. Baltimore and 21 starts opposite Boston)...has gone 6-7, 3.08 ERA (119.2 IP, 41 ER) with 119 strikeouts and 14 quality starts in his first 19 efforts, all of which came with Tampa Bay.

- Last faced the Yankees on April 10, 2021 at Tropicana Field, striking out four in 2.1 shutout innings of the Rays' 4-0 victory (3 H, 0 BB).
His last victory over New York came six starts ago, in a 7-3 triumph on April 2, 2017 at the Trop (7.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 5 K).
Archer won each of his first four starts against the Bronx Bombers, while Tampa Bay won his first seven efforts (between June 23, 2013 and May 12, 2015), while he personally went 5-0, 2.02 ERA (49.0 IP, 11 ER).
His six wins against the Yankees are tied for third most among all opponents, behind Minnesota and Toronto (each 7), while his ERA against the Bombers is third lowest among teams he has faced at least 10 times (has a 2.77 mark in 7 starts against the Twins and a 3.01 ledger in 25 outings vs. the Blue Jays).

OFF-TARGET ARCHER: Following 4.0-scoreless innings against Los Angeles-NL in his Twins debut on April 12, Archer boasted a perfect 4-0 mark and a 2.06 ERA (39.1 IP, 9 ER) in seven lifetime starts at Target Field...however, has been touched for 13 runs (10 earned) on 18 hits in 14.0 innings over his last four starts in downtown Minneapolis.

- In five home starts overall this season, he is 0-1, 5.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 10 ER) with a .270/.345/.446 opponent slash line (20-for-74 with 7 2B and 2 HR).
Owns a 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) in his five road starts, with nine walks, 20 strikeouts and a .205/.295/.410 opponent slash line (16-for-78 with 4 2B and 4 HR).

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: After allowing a solo home run to Houston's Jose Altuve leading off the third inning of his start May 11 - marking the fifth-straight outing he had yielded a longball (six total, all solo) - Archer has kept the last 79 batters he has faced in the yard...that stretch spans the final seven faced in the Astros game and his last four starts...in those starts, he has posted a 3.18 ERA (17.0 IP, 6 ER).

SOFT CONTACT: Archer has allowed an average exit velocity of just 88.8 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (beating the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .261 opponent batting average on balls in play would also be the lowest of his career, better than the .254 mark of his 2013 rookie campaign; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

THE ARSENAL: Archer has upped his changeup and curveball usage the last six starts, throwing those 21.4 percent of the time (107 of 499 pitches), per Baseball Savant...just 3.5 percent of his pitches (7 of 200) were off-speed over his first three efforts...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

- His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.7 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.
Opposing batters are hitting .372 (16-for-43) with three doubles, four home runs and four strikeouts against Archer's fastball; opponents are a combined 20-for-109 (.183) with eight doubles, two homers and 28 strikeouts against his slider, change and curve.

ONE STEP AT A TIME: Archer is the lone Twins starter to make of each of his scheduled turns through the rotation, as tonight will be his team-leading 11th start of the season, his most since logging 23 with Pittsburgh in 2019...missed the final month of that season with right shoulder inflammation, all of 2020 following thoracic outlet surgery and most of 2021 due to right lateral forearm tightness and left hip soreness (made 6 appearances/5 starts for Tampa Bay).

- Also had an even more abbreviated 2022 spring training than most after signing with Minnesota on March 27...has thrown 70-plus pitches in six starts (topping out at 79 on April 30 at Tampa Bay), while his 699 pitches overall are already twice more than the 327 he threw in 2021.
Has pitched into the fifth inning just twice in his first 10 starts (April 19 at Kansas City and June 2 at Detroit), but has departed with the Twins either tied (3 times) or ahead (4 times) in seven of his efforts.
Has faced just four batters a third time through the order (1-for-2, 2 BB)...opponents are hitting .198 (16-for-81) with a .649 OPS the first time through; .275 (19-for-69) with an .823 OPS the second time.
Is looking for his first win in a Minnesota uniform...last victory came September 4, 2021 against the Twins, with Tampa Bay at Tropicana Field.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY [2022 SEASON: 3-3, 5.57 ERA // CAREER: 49-60, 4.76 ERA]

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is scheduled to take the Target Field mound tomorrow night in the series finale vs. New York-AL...shouldered a 12-3 loss last Saturday at Toronto after surrendering six runs (5 earned) on eight hits (2 homers) in just 2.1 innings, with one walk and two strikeouts...Twins have lost each of his last six starts, while he is 0-3, 8.44 ERA (26.2 IP, 25 ER)...opened his Twins career 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) in his first three trips to the hill...will make his 16th career appearance and 13th start vs. the Yankees...is 2-6, 6.42 ERA (61.2 IP, 44 ER) in his first 15 outings (12 starts)...his last win against the Bronx Bombers came on May 29, 2017.

CAREER NOTES

- Twins are his fifth organization, following time with Cleveland (2006-08), Chicago-NL (2009-10), Tampa Bay (2011-18 and 2021) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).
Has recorded double-digit strikeout totals 30 times in career...also boasts three seasons with at least 200.0 innings pitched and 200-plus strikeouts (212.0 IP and 252 K in 2015, 201.1 and 233 in 2016, and 201.0 and 249 in 2017).
Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks sixth in the American League with 1163 strikeouts since 2013 (his first full season)...is fifth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 9.58 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched.
Missed the 2020 season recovering from thoracic outlet surgery...procedure was performed on June 2, 2020 by Dr. Robert Thompson at Washington University in St. Louis.
Twice named to the American League All-Star Team (2015 and 2017).
Pitched for Team USA in 2017 World Baseball Classic, starting and tossing 4.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts in an eventual 3-2, 10-inning walk-off win over Columbia to open Pool Play...Team USA would go on to win the 2017 WBC.
Led Major League Baseball and tied the Tampa Bay record with 34 starts in 2017.
Posted a Rays-record 252 strikeouts in 2015, second in the AL behind the White Sox' Chris Sale (274) and fourth in the majors...finished the season 12-13, becoming the seventh pitcher in the modern era (since 1900) to record 250 strikeouts without posting a winning record...four of the previous six are Hall of Famers: Nolan Ryan (three times), Steve Carlton, Phil Niekro and Ed Walsh.
Finished fifth in 2015 AL Cy Young Award voting after leading the big leagues and tying Tampa's club mark with 34 starts...also ranked sixth in the AL with a 3.23 ERA.
Finished third in 2013 AL Rookie of the Year balloting...named AL Pitcher of the Month and AL Rookie of the Month for July 2013.
Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 2 prospect in the Rays' system following the 2012 season...was tabbed by the same organization as the top prospect in the Chicago-NL organization following the 2010 campaign.
