series finale with New Yorktomorrow night, the Twins will begin a three-game weekend series
against the Rays with a night game Friday, followed by day games on Saturday and Sunday
the lwins are 18-17 at nome and 15-13 on the road.
The Twine have gone 1.0 in rubber games this season. April 20 May 1 at Tampa Ray May

13-15 vs. Cleveland, May 16-18 at Oakland and June 3-5 at Toronto.

GRAB YOUR DEVICES: Tomorrow night's game against Tampa Bay will be on Apple TV+, the first for the Twins...the game will be available to anyone with internet access, for free, only on Apple TV+.

TWINS KNOCK AROUND NEW YORK: The Twins beat the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 8-1...Chris Archer (1-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched, tying a season high...Griffin Jax (2.0 IP), Emilio Pagán (1.0 IP) and Caleb Thielbar (1.0) combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings of relief with five strikeouts... the offense recorded 11 hits, giving them double-digit hit totals for the fourth time in their last five games...Jose Miranda set career-highs in both hits (3) and RBI (3)...Byron Buxton (13) and Ryan Jeffers (4) both homered off Yankees starter Nestor Cortes...the seven-run win marked the largest margin of victory over the Yankees since a 10-1 victory on July 24, 2015.

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing the third of seven meetings in 2022... the Twins will travel to Yankee Stadium for a four-game series from September 5-8...in head-to-head regular season games since 2015, the Twins have gone 11-30 vs. the Yankees and since 2017, they have gone 8-20...since 2002, they have gone 37-94 against New York.

₱ Jorge Polanco is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with three doubles, seven home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.168 OPS in his last 12 games against the Yankees...he has homered in three of his last four vs. New York.

₱ Carlos Correa is hitting .306 (37-for-121) with seven doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBI. 14 walks, a .375 on-base percentage, a .562 slugging percentage and a .937 OPS in 32 career regular season games against the Yankees...Correa and Gerrit Cole were teammates with Houston from 2018-19.

UR ON FIRE: Gio Urshela has hit safely in six straight and in 18 of his last 22 games since May 14, hitting .346 (27-for-78) with five doubles, four home runs. 17 RBI, seven walks, a .395 on-base percentage, a .564 slugging percentage and a .959 OPS in that span...since that date, he is fifth in the AL in batting average, tied for seventh in RBI and eighth in OPS.

▼ He is hitting .583 (7-for-12) against off-speed pitches this season, the highest in baseball.

MIRANDA RIGHTS: Jose Miranda is hitting .390 (16-for-41) with five doubles, three home runs 11 RBI, seven multi-hit games, a .732 slugging percentage and a 1.136 OPS in his last 13 games...he began his season/career hitting .094 (5-for-53) with 0 multi-hit games, a .189 slugging percentage and a .332 OPS in his first 14 games.

THE DURANTULA: Jhoan Duran enters today's game with an 12.2-inning scoreless streak, the eighth-longest active streak in the AL...his run started on May 7...additionally, he ranks tied for second in the AL in relief strikeouts (36) with Liam Hendriks, trailing Michael King (42).

LAST TIME OUT: Was handed his third loss of the season on June 4 at Toronto...marked his shortest outing in a start since August 24, 2021 at Baltimore (w/ Los Angeles-AL)...tossed 2.1 innings, allowing six runs (five earned), with one walk and two strikeouts in a 12-3 Twins defeat...has now allowed four home runs in his last three starts combined; allowed four home runs total in his six starts prior.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision on May 30 against Detroit at Comerica Park, tying his season high with 6.0 innings and allowing four runs on nine hits, with no walks and three strikeout in a 7-5 Twins defeat...marked his third walkless start of the season (also, April 18 at Boston and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL)...the Twins have now lost five consecutive games that Bundy has started, dating back to April 29...tossed a season-high 95 pitches in his outing, marking his most thrown since May 2, 2021 at Seattle (also 95 pitches).

CAREER VS. NEW YORK-AL: Is making his 16th career appearance (13th start) against the Bronx Bombers this evening...owns a career 2-6 record, 6.42 ERA (61.2 IP, 44 ER) with 33 walks and 60 strikeouts against the Yankees... made two starts against New York-AL last season as a member of the Angels, making one start and one relief appearance, going 0-0, 4.91 ERA (3.2 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and three strikeouts...is 2-3, 5.66 ERA (35.0 IP, 22 ER) with 19 walks and 30 strikeouts in seven career home starts against the Yankees

HOME SWEET HOME: Bundy will be making his fourth start at Target Field this season...has put up impressive numbers so far at home, going 2-0, 0.57 ERA (15.2 IP, 1 ER) with two walks, 12 strikeouts and a .172 (10-for-58) opponent batting average...his one run allowed in his first three home starts mark his lowest allowed to start a season in his career...has shown opposite numbers when facing opponents on the road, going 1-3, 8.54 ERA (26.1 IP, 25 ER) with seven walks and 24 strikeouts in six starts this season

₱ In his career, Bundy has shown slightly better numbers at home than on the road, going 25-32, 4.56 ERA (443.0 IP, 224 ER) with 131 walks and 410 strikeouts in 91 home appearances (77 starts)...compares to 24-28, 5.00 ERA (370.2 IP, 206 ER) with 135 walks and 384 strikeouts in 79 road appearances (65 starts).

SPRING HAS SPRUNG, SUMMER HAS BEGUN: Today marks his second start in the month of June after making four starts in May...was 0-1, 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP, 14 ER) with five walks and 15 strikeouts last month...in his career in the month of June, he is 8-9, 4.71 ERA (112.2 IP, 59 ER) with 40 walks and 106 strikeouts in 26 appearances (19 starts).

WALKING IN STYLE: Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in five of his last six starts (8 BB total)...even with his last six starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 4.7 walk percentage...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (36.0%) and first-pitch strike percentage (68.8%).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: According to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first nine starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Bundy went 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.

- Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-orfewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts)
- The Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (*Elias*).
- Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA,

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on December 1, 2021...this marks his third professional organization, as he spent the previous two seasons with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and his first five major league seasons with Baltimore (2012-19).
