LAST TIME OUT: Was handed his third loss of the season on June 4 at Toronto...marked his shortest outing in a start since August 24, 2021 at Baltimore (w/ Los Angeles-AL)...tossed 2.1 innings, allowing six runs (five earned), with one walk and two strikeouts in a 12-3 Twins defeat... has now allowed four home runs in his last three starts combined; allowed four home runs total in his six starts prior.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision on May 30 against Detroit at Comerica Park, tying his season high with 6.0 innings and allowing four runs on nine hits, with no walks and three strikeout in a 7-5 Twins defeat....marked his third walkless start of the season (also, April 18 at Boston and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL)...the Twins have now lost five consecutive games that Bundy has started, dating back to April 29...tossed a season-high 95 pitches in his outing, marking his most thrown since May 2, 2021 at Seattle (also 95 pitches).

CAREER VS. NEW YORK-AL: Is making his 16th career appearance (13th start) against the Bronx Bombers this evening...owns a career 2-6 record, 6.42 ERA ( 61.2 IP, 44 ER) with 33 walks and 60 strikeouts against the Yankees... made two starts against New York-AL last season as a member of the Angels, making one start and one relief appearance, going 0-0, 4.91 ERA (3.2 IP, 2 ER ) with one walk and three strikeouts...is 2-3, 5.66 ERA (35.0 IP, 22 ER) with 19 walks and 30 strikeouts in seven career home starts against the Yankees.

HOME SWEET HOME: Bundy will be making his fourth start at Target Field this season...has put up impressive numbers so far at home, going 2-0, 0.57 ERA (15.2 IP, 1 ER ) with two walks, 12 strikeouts and a. 172 (10-for-58) opponent batting average...his one run allowed in his first three home starts mark his lowest allowed to start a season in his career...has shown opposite numbers when facing opponents on the road, going 1-3, 8.54 ERA (26.1 IP, 25 ER) with seven walks and 24 strikeouts in six starts this season.
$\boldsymbol{\Phi}$ In his career, Bundy has shown slightly better numbers at home than on the road, going 25-32, 4.56 ERA ( 443.0 IP, 224 ER) with 131 walks and 410 strikeouts in 91 home appearances ( 77 starts)...compares to 24-28, 5.00 ERA ( 370.2 IP, 206 ER) with 135 walks and 384 strikeouts in 79 road appearances ( 65 starts).

SPRING HAS SPRUNG, SUMMER HAS BEGUN: Today marks his second start in the month of June after making four starts in May...was 0-1, 6.87 ERA ( 18.1 IP, 14 ER) with five walks and 15 strikeouts last month...in his career in the month of June, he is 8-9, 4.71 ERA ( $112.2 \mathrm{IP}, 59 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with 40 walks and 106 strikeouts in 26 appearances ( 19 starts).

WALKING IN STYLE: Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in five of his last six starts ( 8 BB total)...even with his last six starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 4.7 walk percentage...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (36.0\%) and first-pitch strike percentage (68.8\%).

© Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-orfewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (Elias).
$\Phi$ Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (Elias).
