THE TWINS: Completed their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 3-3, going 2-1 on the South Side of Chicago, followed by going 1-2 against the Rangers in Arlington...tonight, they will begin a six-game homestand, heading into the All-Star break with two against the Brewers through tomorrow afternoon, followed by four games against the White Sox from Thursday-Sunday...Twins are 25-18 at home and 23-22 on the road.
Twins enter today third in the AL in wins, trailing New York-AL (61-25) and Houston (56-29).
Twins have gone 4-1 in their last five home games...they have won their last two series at Target Field (June 24-26 vs. Colorado and July 1-3 vs. Baltimore).

TWINS TAKE FINALE IN TEXAS: The Twins beat the Rangers on Sunday afternoon at Globe Life Field by a score of 6-5, avoiding the three-game sweep...Dylan Bundy (5-4) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Caleb Thielbar (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0), Jhoan Duran (1.0) and Tyler Duffey (1.0) held the lead for 4.0 innings as Duffey earned his second save of the season and sixth of his career...the offense recorded 10 hits as Jose Miranda and Ryan Jeffers each had two hits with two RBI apiece...Jeffers hit his seventh home run of the season while AL All-Star Byron Buxton hit his 23rd.
After a 19-game stretch during which they did not allow more than three earned runs, Twins starting pitchers compiled an 11.08 ERA in their three-game series vs. the Rangers.

THE STARS HEADED TO HOLLYWOOD: Byron Buxton and Luis Arraez were both named to the American League All-Star team as reserves on Sunday afternoon, marking the first honor for both...they become the 61st and 62nd All-Stars in club history...Buck becomes the first outfielder since Michael Cuddyer in 2011 and Arraez becomes the first infielder since Jorge Polanco in 2019...below are some highlights/rankings on both All-Stars this season:

ARRAEZ: Luis Arraez enters today leading baseball in batting average and passed Paul Goldschmidt recently in on-base percentage to reclaim baseball's top spot...below are his MLB rankings in a few offensive categories:

Table comparing Arraez and Buxton across various offensive categories like AVG, OBP, WHIFF RATE, K's (min. 250 PA), BA w/2K (min. 250 PA), HR, SLG, ISO POWER, G/A HR, AB/HR.

ADDITIONALLY: He is also tied for first in baseball in multi-hit games (32), ranks first in average vs. right-handed pitching (.378), batting average against fastballs (.408), and ranks third in RISP average (.389).

TRIPLE (PLAY) CROWN: Byron Buxton earned his second career Play of the Week Award and his second this season, previously winning in May...with runners on first and second in the bottom of the seventh inning of a tied game on July 4 against the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field, Buxton sprinted to make a running catch on the warning track before firing a throw to his teammate Gio Urshela to kickstart a triple play...the 8-5 triple play was the first of its kind in MLB history.

IL PLAY: The Twins are 3-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field from June 17-19 and 2-1 against the Rockies at Target Field from June 24-26...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is: Milwaukee at American Family Field from July 26-27, San Diego at Petco Park from July 29-31, Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10 and San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28...Twins all-time IL wins ranks to the right.
Max Kepler is hitting .386 (17-for-44) with five doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, nine walks, a .491 OBP, a .636 SLG and a 1.127 OPS in his last 13 IL games.

BATTLE OF I-94: The Twins are 239-228 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and are 66-54 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998...the Twins are 10-5 in their last 15 against the Brewers...the Twins went 4-2 last season, going 2-1 at Milwaukee from April 1-4 and 2-1 at Target Field from August 27-29...Twins outscored the Brewers 25-18 last season and out-hit them 47-38.
Luis Arraez is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with six RBI, eight walks, a .444 on-base percentage and an .823 OPS in 12 career games vs. MIL.
Twins radio stud Cory Provus spent three seasons from 2009-11 with the Brewers, doing play-by-play with Hall of Famer Bob Uecker on WTMJ-AL and the Brewers Radio Network.

OK AK: Since being recalled from St. Paul on June 17, Alex Kirilloff is hitting .297 (22-for-74) with six doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI, a .500 slugging percentage and an .825 OPS in 22 games...additionally, in his last 13 games, he is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with a .966 OPS.
Kirilloff is hitting .190 with no homers and 18 strikeouts in 19 home games this season compared to .356 with three homers and nine strikeouts in 13 road games.

EASY COME, EASY GO-RDON: Nick Gordon has hit .322 (19-for-59) with three doubles, three home runs, five RBI, three walks, nine runs scored, a .375 on-base percentage, a .525 slugging percentage and a .900 OPS in his last 23 games...Gordon is starting in leftfield tonight for a team-leading 29th time.

ONE RUN, NO FUN: The Twins have played 28 one-run games this season, tied with Milwaukee (16-12), Arizona (13-15) and San Francisco (10-18) for sixth-most in baseball, going 16-12 in those games...since June 21, 11 of their 20 games have been decided by one run, with the Twins going 4-7 in those 11...in fact, of the Twins 10 losses since June 21, all have been decided by two runs-or-fewer...their run differential since that date is +25 (104-79).

YES WAY, JOSE: Twins Dominican Summer League outfielder Jose Rodriguez has been named DSL Player of the Week...Rodriguez played in six games for the DSL Twins, hitting .478 (11-for-23) with three doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, 11 runs scored, a .520 on-base percentage, a 1.130 slugging percentage and a 1.650 OPS.

- Rookie is making his sixth career major league start tonight...also his 10th career appearance, after making his major league debut in relief on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL.
- Is 4-1, 1.71 ERA (26.1 IP, 5 ER) as a starter; his ERA is the lowest in Minnesota history (since 1961) through a pitcher's first five career starts (min. 25.0 IP).
- Making his first career start and appearance against Milwaukee...lone previous outing against a National League club was his April 12 debut against the Dodgers (1.0 IP, 1 ER).
- Entered 2022 ranked as the seventh-best prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com.
- Selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Virginia Military Institute.

LAST TIME OUT: Was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul to start the July 5 game at Chicago-AL when Chris Archer landed on the 15-day Injured List with a left hip strain; rookie responded by earning an 8-2 win as he pitched the Twins to a series victory...worked 5.0 innings against the White Sox, allowing two runs on seven hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in out-pitching Michael Kopech (whom the Twins touched for 4 HR in 4.2 innings)...limited damage by inducing his third groundball double play (to end a scoreless third after two runners were on), getting AJ Pollock on a pop out to end the fourth with runners at second and third, and retiring José Abreu with two aboard to end the fifth.

- Twins catcher Gary Sánchez threw out Luis Robert trying to steal second to end the first inning, just the second caught stealing in eight attempts off Winder this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Appointed as the 27th man for the June 28 doubleheader in Cleveland and earned the win in the nightcap, combining with two Twins relievers on a five-hit shutout in the 6-0 victory...matched his career high for a third time with 6.0 innings, allowing four hits with one walk and one strikeout...held the Guardians hitless in nine at-bats with runners in scoring position (worked around a two-on, none-out jam in the first, stranded a leadoff double in the second, and was not bothered by a two-out double in the fourth nor a one-out two-bagger in the sixth).

- Threw a career-best 72.8 percent of his pitches for strikes, while his 81 pitches (59 strikes) were two shy of his career high.

VS. THE BREWERS AND THE NATIONAL LEAGUE: Is set to make his first career start and appearance against Milwaukee in tonight's series opener...marks his second outing against a National League club, as his major league debut came in relief on April 12 vs. the Los Angeles Dodgers at Target Field (1.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 1 K).

IT'S TIME TO START: Winder has gone 4-1, 1.71 ERA (26.1 IP, 5 ER) as a major league starter; per Baseball Reference, his 1.71 ERA is lowest in Minnesota history (since 1961) through a pitcher's first five career starts (min. 25.0 IP)...since 1913, when earned runs became an official stat, he is sixth in Twins/Senators annals (behind Milo Candini's 0.61 ERA in 1943, Jack Kralick's 1.21 in 1960, Jack Bentley's 1.29 between 1913 and 1914, Bill Peubus' 1.58 from 1936 to 1937 and Joe Boehling's 1.70 in 1913).

- Has 21 strikeouts against seven walks as a starter, with a 1.10 WHIP and a .229/.286/.344 opponent slash line (22-for-96 with 8 2B, 1 HR and 1 HBP).
- Rookie has worked 6.0 innings while allowing zero earned runs in three of his first five big league starts (May 1 at Tampa Bay, May 6 vs. Oakland and in Game 2 of the June 28 doubleheader at Cleveland)...has gone at least 5.0 innings in four of his five starting efforts.
- His major league debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL marked his first career professional relief outing...is 0-1, 5.79 ERA (14.0 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and six strikeouts in four appearances out of the Twins bullpen.
- All 44 of his career minor league outings from 2018-21 were starts, going 14-3, 2.82 ERA (236.1 IP, 74 ER) with 49 walks and 240 strikeouts over three seasons...15 of his 44 starts were quality and recorded eight starts of at least 7.0 innings (including two of 8.0 IP)...also fanned seven-or-more batters in 17 starts, including a career-high nine batters thrice

LEADING THE WAY: Looking just at Winder's stats as a starter, he enters today ranked among rookie pitching leaders in several categories (min. 5 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Winder has displayed a four-pitch mix through his first eight career appearances, with his four-seam fastball leading the way at a 39.5-percent use rate...his put-away pitch has been his slider, as 14 of his 27 career strikeouts have come on the pitch...opponents are hitless off his curveball (0-for-12) and are a combined 12-for-78 (154) with 17 strikeouts off his slider and curve...here is a look at the rookie's arsenal this season, per Baseball Savant:

2022 SUMMARY: Winder was named to the Twins' Opening Day roster this year, the first of his career.

- Made his major league debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL at Target Field...entered the game in the top of the fifth and struck out Will Smith, his first batter faced.
- Made his first career major league start on May 1 at Tampa Bay...tossed 6.0 shutout innings, giving up only two hits and one walk while striking out seven batters, en route to his first career major league win...Twins scored five runs in the first inning and went on to win, 9-3.
- Was the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) and fifth in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with at least 6.0 shutout innings and two-or-fewer hits allowed in his first career start...the others are Mike Fornieles on September 2, 1952 (9.0 IP, 1 H, 6 BB, 4 K), Wally Holborow on August 4, 1945 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K), Claude Thomas on September 18, 1916 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 5 BB, 2 K) and George Dumont on September 14, 1915 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 4 BB, 2 K).
- Made his second career start on May 6 against Oakland, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one unearned run, with no walks and a career-high eight strikeouts as the Twins won, 2-1.
- His 15 strikeouts between his May 1 and May 6 starts tied for the most within a player's first two career starts in Twins/Senators history (other: Doc Ayers, Sept. 22-30, 1913)...became the sixth pitcher in American/National League history to record at least 15 strikeouts with one or fewer walks within his first two career starts.
- Was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 21 (retroactive to May 18) with right shoulder impingement...returned from rehab, reinstated from the Injured List and optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on June 23 after missing 33 games.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN [2022 SEASON: 6-3, 3.09 ERA // CAREER: 8-4, 3.35 ERA]

Right-hander Joe Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow's series finale against Milwaukee at Target Field...will mark his sixth start since being reinstated from the COVID IL on June 14; is 1-1, 4.39 ERA (26.2 IP, 13 ER) in those five efforts, after going 5-2, 2.28 ERA (43.1 IP, 11 ER) in eight starts prior...last pitched on July 6 at Chicago-AL in the series finale against the White Sox, but did not factor in the decision (4.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 3 K) as the Twins lost, 9-8 in 10 innings...will face the Brewers for the first time in his career...is 2-1, 4.80 ERA (15.0 IP, 8 ER) in three career Interleague starts, including his September 1, 2021 debut vs. Chicago-NL...defeated Colorado, 6-3, on June 26 at Target Field in his lone 2022 start vs. the National League (5.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 K).

- Entered the 2022 season ranked as the No. 7 prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com; has since graduated from the prospect ranks...2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
- Made his major league debut in a relief appearance for the Twins on April 12, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-NL (1.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 1 K).
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.
- In 2021, went a combined 4-0, 2.63 ERA (72.0 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks, 80 strikeouts and a .211 (55-for-261) opponent batting average in 14 starts between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul.
- Selected to the American League team in the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field...tossed 0.1 inning (1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 K, 1 WP).
- Did not play in a professional game in 2020, as the minor league season was cancelled due to COVID-19...was not part of Twins' 60-man player pool...participated in instructional league in October in Fort Myers, FL.
