SOGGY NIGHT SPOILED BY BREW CREW: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night at Target Field by a score 6-3, as the game experienced three separate rain delays...Josh Winder (4-3) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Emilio Pagán pitched 1.0 inning of relief, striking out all three batters faced...the offense recorded six hits, two from Jorge Polanco, who hit his 13th home run of the season...Max Kepler played in his 800th career game.

The Last night's attendance of 37,183 marked a season-high and most since September 21, 2019, when they drew 37,750...their previous high in 2022 was 35,462 on Opening Day, April 8 vs. Seattle.

TWINS GOING VIRAL: Fans can watch today's game on YouTube...it marks the third time the Twins play on YouTube this season...the first came on May 25, as the Twins lost to the Tigers 4-2 in 10 innings...the second came on June 15 at Seattle as Luis Arraez went 1-for-3 with a walk and two RBI, earning YouTube Player of the Game, following a 5-0 Twins win.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have reinstated right-handed pitcher Joe Smith from the 15-day Injured List...Smith, who missed the Twins' last 18 games with upper trap tightness, has appeared in 28 games this season, going 1-1, 2.78 ERA (22.2 IP, 7 ER), eight walks, 13 strike-outs and 14 holds...to make room for Smith on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Josh Winder to Triple-A St. Paul...Winder, who made the start last night against the Milwaukee Brewers, started twice in his most recent stint with the Twins, going 1-1, 6.30 ERA (10.0 IP, 7 ER), four walks and five strikeouts.

IL PLAY: The Twins are 3-6 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field from June 17-19, 2-1 against the Rockies at Target Field from June 24-26 and 0-1 after last night's game with the Brewers...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is: Milwaukee at American Family Field from July 26-27, San Diego at Petco Park from July 29-31, Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10 and San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28...Twins all-time IL wins ranks to the right.

The Max Kepler is hitting 362 (17-for-47) with five doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, nine walks, a .464 OBP, a .596 SLG and a 1.060 OPS in his last 14 IL games.

BATTLE OF I-94: The Twins are 239-229 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 66-55 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998...the Twins are 10-6 in their last 16 against the Brewers...the Twins went 4-2 last season, going 2-1 at Milwaukee from April 1-4 and 2-1 at Target Field from August 27-29...Twins outscored the Brewers 25-18 last season and outhit them 47-38.

◆ Luis Arraez is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with six RBI, nine walks, a .440 on-base percentage and an .830 OPS in 13 career games vs. MIL.

SERIES FINALE: The Twins are looking to avoid being swept for the third time this season...their previous sweeps were in two games vs. Los Angeles-NL from April 12-13 and three games vs. Houston from May 10-12, both at Target Field...Milwaukee's last sweep of Minnesota came in three games from July 2-4, 2018...last time being swept at home by the Brewers came in two games at the Metrodome from June 24-25, 1998.

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 25th time (14-10) in 89 games...they have a .708 OPS against lefties, compared to a .760 OPS against righties...they had a .753 OPS against lefties in their first 37 games but have a .656 OPS in their last 32.

▼ Kyle Garlick is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with five home runs, 11 RBI, a .659 slugging percentage and a 1.051 OPS against lefties this season...his OPS against lefties ranks third-best in the AL and ninth-best in baseball (minimum 45 plate appearances).

▼ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .302 (16-for-53) with a .901 OPS against lefties this season.

HOT POLO SUMMER: In his last 18 games, dating back to June 7, Jorge Polanco is hitting .313 (20-for-64) with two doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBI, 13 walks, a .423 on-base percentage, a .672 slugging percentage and a 1.095 OPS.

◆ Since July 1 of 2021, he has collected 28 doubles, 37 home runs and 112 RBI, with a .510 slugging percentage and an .845 OPS in 151 games...since that date, he ranks ninth in baseball in RBI, tied for 11th in home runs and 22nd in slugging percentage.

ALL-STAR FLASHBACKS: Notables on past All-Star games played on this day:

In 1993 in Oriole Park at Camden Yards, Kirby Puckett won the game MVP after going 2-for-3 with a double, a home run and two RBL...Rick Aguilera was the other Twins representative, pitching 1.0 inning with two hits allowed and two strikeouts.

In 1965, Minnesota and Metropolitan Stadium played host to their first All-Star Game...the Twins were represented by six players: Earl Battey (0-for-2), Harmon Killebrew (1-for-3 w/ HR & 2 BB), Mudcat Grant (2.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R), Jimmie Hall (0-for-2), Tony Oliva (1-for-2 w/ 2B) and Zoilo Versalles (0-for-1)...the NL won 6-5 in front of 46,706 fans.

In 1999 at Fenway Park, Ron Coomer represented the Twins going 0-for-1 and played first base.

In 2021, Nelson Cruz, who was one of two Twins representatives (other was Taylor Rogers) at Coors Field, went 0-for-1 with a groundout.

FIRST-TIME BREWER: Ryan is due to face Milwaukee for the first time in his career...owns three prior starts against the National League, facing Chicago-NL twice and Colorado once; is 2-1, 4.80 ERA (15.0 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 17 strikeouts in those outings.

- Today is his second start against the National League this season, after earning the 6-3 win over the Rockies on June 26 at Target Field (5.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 1 K).

A SUNNY DISPOSITION: Is making his seventh daytime start this afternoon; has gone 4-1, 2.61 ERA (31.0 IP, 9 ER) with eight walks and 25 strikeouts in his six prior starts...has performed better under the sun than under the lights this season, going 2-2, 3.46 ERA (39.0 IP, 15 ER) with 12 walks and 38 strikeouts in seven night starts.

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his eighth start at Target Field this season...has gone 3-2, 3.23 ERA (39.0 IP, 14 ER) with 13 walks and 36 strikeouts at home...this compares to 3-1, 2.90 ERA (31.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 27 strikeouts in six starts on the road.

◆ Has performed better on the road throughout his career, going 5-1, 2.51 ERA (43.0 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 42 strikeouts in eight starts...is a career 3-3, 4.02 ERA (53.2 IP, 24 ER) with 17 walks and 51 strikeouts in 10 starts at Target Field.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 58.1% of the time through his first 13 starts of 2022, here's a look at the region, reporting this season, per Rasaball Savant.

The Ryan is averaging 16.6 seconds between pitches with the bases empty this season, faster than league average (18.0 seconds) and sixth among Twins pitchers (min. 100 pitches)...averages 21.0 seconds between pitches with runners on, fourth on the Twins (min. 100 pitches), again faster than league average (23.4 seconds).

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 63 batters so far, which will lead to 3,150 new trees planted.

THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: Below are some facts that summarize Ryan's career to date.

Ryan has 93 career strikeouts through his first 18 games, second most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first 18 career games, trailing only Tyler Duffey (97 from 2015-16)...the record for most strikeouts in the first 19 career games is 100, held by Duffey from 2015-16.

His .202 opponent batting average through his first 18 career games is second lowest in Twins/Senators history (min. 75.0 IP), behind George Dumont (.173 from 1915-16).

Owns a 3.72 strikeout-to-walk ratio (93 K, 25 BB) through his first 18 career outings, fourth best in Twins/Senators history (min. 75.0 IP), behind teammate Bailey Ober (5.12 in 2021), Doc Ayers (5.00 from 1913-14) and Kevin Slowey (3.82 from 2007-08).

He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.
