THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 3-3 (2-1 at Chicago-AL and 1-2 at Texas), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a loss to the Brewers last night...

- ☞ Facing Milwaukee for the first time in his career...also making his fourth career start and appearance against the National League; is 2-1, 4.80 ERA (15.0 IP, 8 ER) in his three prior starts.
- ☞ Acquired by the Twins from Tampa Bay on July 22, 2021, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 6 at Chicago-AL...allowed three runs (2 earned) on five hits (1 home run), with two walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...4.0 innings pitched matched the fewest he's thrown in a start in his career, for the third time (also: April 8 vs. SEA and May 10 vs. Houston)...yielded an unearned run in the first inning, when his throwing error on a pickoff attempt allowed Tim Anderson to advance to second base and later score on José Abreu's double...marked the first unearned run of his major league career.

- ☞ The White Sox won 9-8, on Leury Garcia's walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th inning.
- ☞ Ryan is 1-1, 4.39 ERA (26.2 IP, 13 ER) in five starts since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List on June 14; has two quality starts in that span...was 5-2, 2.28 ERA (43.1 IP, 11 ER) in eight starts prior to his IL stint.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on July 1 vs. Baltimore at Target Field; departed with the score tied 1-1 – after the O's took a one-run lead in the eighth, the Twins scored twice in the ninth on Byron Buxton's two-run, walk-off home run to claim a 3-2 win...Ryan allowed one run on two hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in a career-high-tying 7.0 innings of work...marked his sixth quality start of the season – matching Devin Smeltzer for the team lead – and his eighth allowing two-or-fewer runs.

- ☞ Four of his seven strikeouts were looking, his most in a start this season and the second most in a start in his career, behind his career-best six on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL.

FIRST-TIME BREWER: Ryan is due to face Milwaukee for the first time in his career...owns three prior starts against the National League, facing Chicago-NL twice and Colorado once; is 2-1, 4.80 ERA (15.0 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 17 strikeouts in those outings.

- ☞ Made his major league debut on September 1, 2021 vs. the Cubs at Target Field; took the loss after permitting three runs on three hits (1 home run), with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
- ☞ Today is his second start against the National League this season, after earning the 6-3 win over the Rockies on June 26 at Target Field (5.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 1 K).

A SUNNY DISPOSITION: Is making his seventh daytime start this afternoon; has gone 4-1, 2.61 ERA (31.0 IP, 9 ER) with eight walks and 25 strikeouts in his six prior starts...has performed better under the sun than under the lights this season, going 2-2, 3.46 ERA (39.0 IP, 15 ER) with 12 walks and 38 strikeouts in seven night starts.

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his eighth start at Target Field this season...has gone 3-2, 3.23 ERA (39.0 IP, 14 ER) with 13 walks and 36 strikeouts at home...this compares to 3-1, 2.90 ERA (31.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 27 strikeouts in six starts on the road.

- ☞ Has performed better on the road throughout his career, going 5-1, 2.51 ERA (43.0 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 42 strikeouts in eight starts...is a career 3-3, 4.02 ERA (53.2 IP, 24 ER) with 17 walks and 51 strikeouts in 10 starts at Target Field.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 58.1% of the time through his first 13 starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

- ☞ Ryan is averaging 16.6 seconds between pitches with the bases empty this season, faster than league average (18.0 seconds) and sixth among Twins pitchers (min. 100 pitches)...averages 21.0 seconds between pitches with runners on, fourth on the Twins (min. 100 pitches), again faster than league average (23.4 seconds).

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 63 batters so far, which will lead to 3,150 new trees planted.

GOOSE EGGS: Posted a career-high 20.0-inning scoreless streak from the third inning on April 15 at Boston to the third inning on May 3 at Baltimore...streak is the longest by a Twins pitcher this season...per *Elias*, Ryan's 20.0-inning scoreless streak matched Jim Hughes (20.0 IP; May 14-24, 1975) for the second-longest run by a rookie starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), trailing only Joe Mays (20.1 IP; July 17-29, 1999).

MONEY MOVES: Ryan drew attention when chasing after a foul ball and calling off catcher Ryan Jeffers earlier this season...upon catching the ball, Ryan signaled "5-0-0" to the dugout...Ryan told reporters that each foul ball caught is good for \$100 from each fellow starter.

TOMORROW'S STARTER – RHP SONNY GRAY [2022 SEASON: 4-2, 3.03 ERA // CAREER: 86-74, 3.58 ERA]

Right-hander Sonny Gray is scheduled to start tomorrow night's series opener against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field...took the loss in his last start on July 8 at Texas, after yielding five runs (all earned) on four hits, with two walks and no strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...marked his sixth career appearance and fifth start with no strikeouts...is due to face the White Sox for the first time this season and ninth time in his career (8th start); is 4-1, 3.63 ERA (44.2 IP, 18 ER) with 19 walks, 43 strikeouts and a .190 (30-for-158) opponent batting average in his prior outings...is also 2-0, 2.83 ERA (35.0 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks and 42 strikeouts in seven starts at Target Field this season (Twins are 5-2).

CAREER NOTES

- 2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Single-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
- Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts...earned the win in his professional debut on June 22 vs. Vermont, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings (2 H, 3 K).
- Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
- Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams, including first team All-America honors by the Division II Conference Commissioners Association...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.

THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: Below are some facts that summarize Ryan's career to date.

- ☞ Ryan has 93 career strikeouts through his first 18 games, second most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first 18 career games, trailing only Tyler Duffey (97 from 2015-16)...the record for most strikeouts in the first 19 career games is 100, held by Duffey from 2015-16.
- ☞ His .202 opponent batting average through his first 18 career games is second lowest in Twins/Senators history (min. 75.0 IP); behind George Dumont (.173 from 1915-16).
- ☞ Owns a 3.72 strikeout-to-walk ratio (93 K, 25 BB) through his first 18 career outings, fourth best in Twins/Senators history (min. 75.0 IP), behind teammate Bailey Ober (5.12 in 2021), Doc Ayers (5.00 from 1913-14) and Kevin Slowey (3.82 from 2007-08).
- ☞ Ryan posted a 0.74 WHIP through his first nine career starts, the lowest WHIP by any MLB pitcher through his first nine career starts since Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson from 1900-01 (0.70) (*Stats Perform*).
- ☞ Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.
- ☞ He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.

- Has combined to go 0-1-1, 4.28 ERA (33.2 IP, 16 ER) with 22 walks, 32 strikeouts in 9 Interleague games this season (3 holds) & a opponent batting average of .220 (27-for-123) in that span.
- Combined to go 1-1-3, 0.32 ERA (28.1, 1 ER) with four walks, 33 strikeouts, nine holds & a opponent batting average of .180 (18-for-100) in seven games against MIL since the start of last season.
- Enters today 1st in the AL (369) & 2nd in MLB in SO (behind CHC, 417)...5th in MLB in IP (356.1)...5th in wins w/ 21, T-11th AL in saves w/ 19 (KC, OAK, SEA) & T-3rd in holds w/ 57 (BOS) in the AL.
