THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 3-3 (2-1 at Chicago-AL and 1-2 at Texas), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a 1-1 series split against the Brewers...tonight, the Twins will begin their final series leading up to the All-Star break with the first of four against the White Sox...Twins are 26-19 at home and 23-22 on the road.

☞ Twins enter today third in the AL in wins, trailing New York-AL (62-26) and Houston (57-30).

MIRANDA SENDS CREW PACKING: The Twins beat the Brewers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-1, splitting the two-game series...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor in to the decision, allowing one run on two hits in 5.1 innings pitched...the bullpen combined for 3.2 scoreless innings, while Jhoan Duran was named the winning pitcher, the first victory of his career...Jose Miranda had three of the Twins' 10 hits, including a walk-off three-run homer in the bottom of the ninth inning off Josh Hader...it marked Miranda's eighth home run this season and his second walk-off hit this season (other: July 2 vs. Baltimore).

☞ The attendance was 38,802, marking the club's first sellout at Target Field this season.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the seventh of 19 meetings this season...Twins hosted the White Sox for three games from April 22-24, marking their first sweep of the season...their last head-to-head series came at Guaranteed Rate Field from July 4-6 as the Twins won the first two of three...Twins are 5-1 against the Sox in 2022, outscoring them 39-21.

☞ The Twins' 5-1 start against the Sox is their best since starting the 2018 season 5-1...their last start even better than that was when they went 7-1 in their first eight of 2011.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .340 (16-for-47) with one double, one triple, six home runs, 14 RBI and a 1.195 OPS in his last 13 games against the White Sox...Polo has 19 career home runs against the Sox, including three homers in his last two games.

☞ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 15 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .441 (26-for-59) with a .976 OPS...he has two four-hit games against Chicago this season: April 23 and July 6.

☞ Individuals this season vs. CWS: Luis Arraez is 14-for-27 (.519), Alex Kirilloff is 6-for-13 (.462), Gio Urshela is 6-for-15 (.400), Byron Buxton is 7-for-23 (.304).

☞ The Twins have hit 96 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (54 games), ahead of second place Cleveland's 65...full chart lower right.

HOT POLO SUMMER: In his last 19 games, dating back to June 7, Jorge Polanco is hitting .294 (20-for-68) with two doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBI, 14 walks, a .410 on-base percentage, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.042 OPS...additionally, he has reached base safely in 10 consecutive games.

☞ Since July 1 of 2021, he has collected 28 doubles, 37 home runs and 112 RBI, with a .507 slugging percentage and an .841 OPS in 152 games...since that date, he ranks fifth in the AL in RBI, tied for eighth in home runs, 12th in slugging percentage and 15th in OPS.

MIRANDA RIGHTS: Jose Miranda is hitting .331 (41-for-124) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 29 RBI, a .581 slugging percentage and an .947 OPS in his last 40 games, since May 20...since that date (minimum 100 at-bats), he leads all MLB rookies in batting average, on-base percentage (.366), slugging percentage and OPS...below is his season comparison:

FEELING MINNESOTA: Carlos Correa is hitting .304 (38-for-125) with seven doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, a .360 on-base percentage, a .504 slugging percentage and an .864 OPS in 32 games at Target Field this season...in fact, in his last 23 at home, he is hitting .359 (33-or-92) with a .408 on-base, .576 slugging and a .984 OPS.

MIGGY UPDATE: Miguel Sanó played in his seventh game on rehab assignment yesterday...in seven rehab games between the FCL Twins and Triple-A St. Paul Saints, he has hit .313 (5-for-16) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, four walks and a 1.117 OPS...he has missed the Twins' last 69 games recovering from left knee surgery.

WIN-WIN...WIN: The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place on Sunday night, starting at 6 pm (CT)...the Twins will select at eighth overall (first round), 48th overall (second round) and 68th overall (Competitive Balance Round B) on night one...they are the only team in baseball that has a winning record, picks within the top 10 of the draft and has a top five aggregate minor league winning percentage.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2014, Target Field hosted the Home Run Derby as part of the 85th Midsummer Classic...Yoenis Cespedes was the winner hitting a total of 28 home runs...second place Todd Frazier hit 10 total, José Bautista hit 14, Giancarlo Stanton hit six, Adam Jones hit seven, Troy Tulowitzki hit six, Josh Donaldson hit three, Justin Morneau hit two, Brian Dozier hit two and Yasiel Puig hit none...the contest started late due to rain...in 2015, Brian Dozier and Glen Perkins represented the Twins at the All-Star Game in Cincinnati...Dozier hit a pinch-hit home run off Mark Melancon...Perkins closed the game, pitching the ninth inning...additionally, current Twins starter Chris Archer appeared in the game representing the Tampa Bay Rays.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt his second loss of the season in his last start on July 8 at Texas...tossed 4.2 innings and allowed five runs on four hits, with two walks and no strikeouts...Texas scored all six runs in the bottom of the fifth inning to win, 6-5...his five runs allowed marked a season high (previously 4 R/3ER on June 22 at Cleveland) and were the most he has given up in a start since September 19, 2021 at Chicago-AL (also 5)...did not record a strikeout, marking the fifth time in his career he did not strikeout a batter in a start and first since March 31, 2019 vs. Pittsburgh (2.2 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 4 BB) as a member of the Cincinnati Reds.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on July 2 vs. Baltimore...tossed 5.0 innings, allowing a then-season-high-tying three earned runs on six hits, with three walks and five strikeouts...Twins scored four runs in the final three innings, including Jose Miranda's walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the ninth to win, 4-3.

WELCOMING THE WHITE SOX: Facing Chicago-AL for the ninth time in his career (8th start) and first since September 29, 2021 (L, 4.2 IP, 5 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 6 K) as a member of the Cincinnati Reds...has been considerably better against the White Sox at his home ballpark, going 2-0, 1.35 ERA (20.0 IP, 3 ER) with eight walks and 18 strikeouts in three starts...this compares to 2-1, 5.47 ERA (24.2 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 25 strikeouts in five outings (4 starts) on the South Side.

- ☞ Won four-straight starts against the White Sox from April 6, 2016 to August 7, 2018...tied for his second-longest winning streak against a single opponent in his career (won five straight against Kansas City from April 16, 2016 to May 29, 2022 and four against Seattle from September 29, 2013 to July 13, 2014).

HEADING HOME: Scheduled to make his eighth start at Target Field this season and is 2-0, 2.83 ERA (35 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks and 42 strikeouts in his seven prior efforts...this compares to 2-2, 3.33 ERA (24.1 IP, 9 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts on the road...the Twins are 5-2 when Gray starts at Target Field this season.

- ☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in each of his home starts this season and two-or-fewer in five of the seven.
- ☞ Has been consistent on home and on the road throughout his career...is 48-36, 3.91 ERA (695.2 IP, 302 ER) with 234 walks and 665 strikeouts in 123 appearances (119 starts) at his home ballparks...this compares to 38-38, 3.22 ERA (631.0 IP, 226 ER) with 235 walks and 610 strikeouts in 112 games (107 starts) on the road.

SONNY UNDER THE LIGHTS: Making his sixth start in a night game this season...is 2-1, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 25 strikeouts under the lights...to compare, is 2-1, 2.78 ERA (32.1 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 29 strikeouts in seven starts during the day.

- ☞ Is 54-48, 3.73 ERA (831.1 IP, 345 ER) with 302 walks and 807 strikeouts in 146 career appearances (141 starts) at night.

WINNING THE BATTLE: Allowed three-or-fewer earned runs each of his first 11 starts this season, his longest streak to begin the season in his career...allowed two-or-fewer runs in his first eight starts of the season, also his longest such streak to begin the season (prior career best was three starts, done four times)...his streak of two-or-fewer runs allowed in eight-straight starts to begin the season is the longest such streak by a starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present).

LEADING THE WAY: Enters today ranked among the top American League starters in a few categories (min. 50.0 IP).

☞ His fastball spin ranks in the 95th percentile and his curve spin ranks in the 87th percentile.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...30 of his 54 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .154 (14-for-91) against the pitch...here's a look at his repertoire.

EYE ON THE CLOCK: Has an average pitch tempo of 18.0 seconds when the bases are empty this season, equal to the league average...has the fifth slowest tempo among qualified Twins pitchers with the bases empty...his tempo slows to 25.2 seconds with runners on, 1.8 seconds slower than the league average of 23.4, and falls to fourth slowest among qualified Twins pitchers.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP DEVIN SMELTZER (2022 SEASON: 4-2, 3.92 ERA // CAREER: 8-4, 4.11 ERA)

Left-hander Devin Smeltzer is scheduled to start tomorrow night against the White Sox at Target Field...did not factor into the decision in his last start at Texas on July 9 (3.1 IP, 8 H, 7 R/ER, 3 HR, 3 BB, 2 K)...his seven earned runs are a career high and eight hits are the third most he has allowed in a start in his career...has faced Chicago-AL twice in his career, both in relief...is 0-0, 15.00 ERA (3.0 IP, 5 ER) with one walk and six strikeouts in his prior two outings against the White Sox...made one appearance vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field on September 2, 2020, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning and recording one strikeout.
