FEELING MINNESOTA: Carlos Correa is hitting .302 (39-for-129) with seven doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, a .357 on-base percentage, a .496 slugging percentage and an .853 OPS in 33 games at Target Field this season...

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Twins have recorded double-digit hit totals 38 times this season, the third-most in baseball, trailing Colorado (41) and Toronto (40)...

- ☞ Facing Chicago-AL for the third time in his career and making his first start...owns a 15.00 ERA (3.0 IP, 5 ER) with one walk and six strikeouts in his two prior relief appearances.
- ☞ Was acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on July 31, 2018 along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 9 at Texas, as the Twins fell 9-7...tossed 3.1 innings and allowed seven runs on eight hits, with three walks and two strikeouts...his seven earned runs are a career high and eight hits are the third most he has allowed in a start in his career (10 hits on September 26, 2019 at Detroit and 9 hits on June 17, 2022 at Arizona)...marked the third time this season and fourth in his career he has allowed three-or-more home runs (also, three on June 10 vs. Tampa Bay and July 3 vs. Baltimore, and a career-high four on June 4, 2019 at Cleveland).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Was dealt a 3-1 loss by Baltimore on July 3 at Target Field, after tossing 6.0 innings and allowing three runs (all on solo home runs) on six hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...was his team-high-tying sixth quality start of the season (with Joe Ryan)...marked the second time this season and third in his career he allowed back-to-back home runs (also June 4, 2019 at Cleveland and June 20, 2022 vs. Tampa Bay).

**QUALITY CONTROL:** Smeltzer has recorded six quality starts through his first 11 starts this season, tied with Joe Ryan for the most quality starts this season by a Twins pitcher...is tied with Los Angeles-NL's Clayton Kershaw for third-most quality starts in baseball among pitchers with 11-or-fewer starts this season, behind Chicago-AL's Johnny Cueto (9 QS) and New York-NL's Max Scherzer (7 QS)...Smeltzer has also recorded quality starts in eight of his 18 career starting assignments.

**STEPPING UP AS A STARTER:** Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 6-4, 3.99 ERA (94.2 IP, 42 ER) with a .243 (86-for-354) opponent batting average and .737 opponent OPS in 18 starts (Twins are 9-9)...by comparison, he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and an .834 opponent OPS in 12 major league relief outings.

☞ His 24 walks allowed through his first 18 career starts are tied for 11th fewest in Twins/Senators history (1901-).

**TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL:** Did not allow a home run in his first four starts (24.0 IP and 88 batters faced), but has been touched for 13 in his last seven trips to the hill (35.2 IP, 152 batters faced)...has allowed one career home run to a left-handed batter through his first 23 career outings (to Jake Bauers on June 4, 2019), but has yielded three in his last two efforts (to Rougned Odor on July 3 and to Kole Calhoun and Corey Seager on July 9).

**A NEW START VS. CHICAGO:** Will make his first career start against the White Sox after two prior relief appearances...owns a 0-0 record, 15.00 ERA (3.0 IP, 5 ER) with one walk and six strikeouts in his career vs. Chicago-AL...numbers are skewed by a difficult relief outing on July 25, 2020 at Chicago-AL (2.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R/ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 5 K)...has faced the White Sox once before at Target Field; tossed 1.0 scoreless inning with one strikeout on September 2, 2020.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Smeltzer has fared much better at Target Field than on the road this season...is 2-1, 2.10 ERA (30.0 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks and 17 strikeouts in five home starts...this compares to 2-1, 5.76 ERA (29.2 IP, 19 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts in six road starts...that trend stays consistent when looking at his career...is 5-2, 2.47 ERA (73.0 IP, 20 ER) with 18 walks and 56 strikeouts in eight career home appearances (6 starts)...is 3-2, 6.23 ERA (56.1 IP, 39 ER) with 15 walks and 36 strikeouts in 13 outings (10 starts) away from Target Field.

**ARSENAL:** Here's a look at Smeltzer's repertoire through his first 11 starts of the 2022 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a five-pitch mix, primarily relying on his four-seam fastball and changeup.

- ☞ Has started to throw his fastball, slider and curveball from a lower-slot arm angle this season to pair with his other offerings and better attack left-handed hitters.
- ☞ Began varying the speeds of his pitches this season with the realization that throwing his fastball between 86-92 mph is better than maxing out at 89-92...aims to throw his changeup with a four-mile variance between the low and upper end.

**THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER:** Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after collapsing during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be caused by a herniated disc in his neck...was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

**SMELTZER THE CANCER SURVIVOR:** When Smeltzer was just nine years old, he was diagnosed with pelvic rhabdomyosarcoma (bladder cancer), as a tumor had formed against his bladder that was connected to his prostate...underwent surgery and chemotherapy at St. Christopher's Hospital for Children in Philadelphia, PA, and sent the cancer into full remission in 2012...the lefty, who's worn glasses and a goatee for the majority of his professional career, continues to offer support to others fighting cancer through his Catch Cancer Looking apparel with his likeness...Smeltzer also frequently hosts fellow cancer-surviving kids at games.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY (2022 SEASON: 5-4, 4.68 ERA // CAREER: 51-61, 4.71 ERA)

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon against the White Sox...earned the win in his last start on July 10 at Texas, tossing 5.0 innings and allowing four runs on six hits, with two walks and four strikeouts in the Twins' 6-5 win...will be facing the White Sox for the third time this season and ninth time in his career (8th start)...is 1-0, 0.90 ERA (10.0 IP, 1 ER) against Chicago-AL this season and is lifetime 5-0, 3.27 ERA (44.0 IP, 16 ER) with eight walks and 47 strikeouts...earned the win on April 23 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field after tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with four hits, no walks and four strikeouts...did not factor into the decision in his most recent start against the White Sox on July 4 at Guaranteed Rate Field (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 6 K).

## CAREER NOTES

- Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL, along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe, in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier at the 2018 trade deadline.
- Made Twins Opening Day roster in 2020, the first of his career...went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances...four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more...held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.
- Combined to post a 3.02 ERA (104.1 IP, 32 ER) in 20 games (19 starts) between Double-A Pensacola and Triple-A Rochester, going 4-5 in 2019... Began season with Double-A Pensacola...earned the Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week and Southern League Pitcher of the Week April 14 after making two starts, going 2-0, 0.00 ERA (14.0 IP) with five hits allowed, two walks and 17 strikeouts...Made five starts with the Blue Wahoos, posting a 0.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 2 ER) before being promoted to Triple-A Rochester May 2...Went 0-1, 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) in four starts for the Red Wings and had contract selected by Minnesota on May 28... Made major league debut May 28 vs. Milwaukee... became fourth Twins starter in history to throw 6.0-or-more shutout innings in his debut, joining Andrew Albers (8.1 on August 6, 2013), Anthony Swarzak (7.0 on May 23, 2009) and Eric Milton (6.0 on April 5, 1998).
- Became the ninth New Jersey-born player (7th pitcher) to make his debut for the Twins, and the first since RHP Rob Delaney on Sept. 4, 2010.
- Won the National Junior College Athletic Association Player of the Week award for April 4-10, 2016, after throwing a complete game no-hitter in an 8-0 win over Wharton County Junior College, a start in which he struck out 16 batters and walked three.
- Was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft, but chose to continue his development at Florida Gulf Coast University.
- Smeltzer was set to transfer to Texas Tech University for the 2017 season, but signed with Los Angeles-NL after being drafted in the fifth round (No. 161 overall).
