THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their six-game homestand, after going 1-1 against the Brewers this week, followed by a loss to the White Sox last night...tonight, the Twins will continue their final series before the All-Star break with the second of four against Chicago-AL at Target Field...Twins are 26-20 at home and 23-22 on the road.

▼ Twins enter today tied with Tampa Bay (49-40) for third in the AL in wins, trailing New York (62-27) and Houston (58-30).

NOT SO SONNY AT TARGET FIELD: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 12-2...Sonny Gray (4-3) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs on nine hits in 3.2 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts...nine hits and six runs both set season-highs for Gray...infielder/outfielder Nick Gordon pitched 1.0 inning in relief, his second career appearance on the mound...the offense recorded 11 hits, as Byron Buxton and Max Kepler each had two hits apiece...Buxton hit his third triple of the season while Kyle Garlick hit his seventh home run of 2022.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the eighth of 19 meetings this season...the Twins are 5-2 against the Sox in 2022, going 3-1 at Target Field and 2-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field.

♣ Jorge Polanco is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with one double, one triple, six home runs, 14 RBI and a 1.137 OPS in his last 14 games against the White Sox...Polo has 19 career home runs against the Sox, including three homers in his last three games.

♣ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 16 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .422 (27-for-64) with a .932 OPS...he has two four-hit games against Chicago this season: April 23 and July 6.

♣ Individuals this season vs. CWS: Luis Arraez is 15-for-32 (.469), Alex Kirilloff is 7-for-17 (.412), Gio Urshela is 7-for-19 (.368), Byron Buxton is 9-for-27 (.333) with four homers.

♣ The Twins have hit 97 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (55 games), ahead of second place Cleveland's 65.

MIRANDA RIGHTS: Jose Miranda is hitting .328 (42-for-128) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 29 RBI, a .570 slugging percentage and an .933 OPS in his last 41 games, since May 20...since that date (minimum 100 at-bats), he leads all MLB rookies in batting average, OPS and slugging percentage, and is second in on-base percentage (.363)...below is his season comparison:

**FEELING MINNESOTA:** Carlos Correa is hitting .302 (39-for-129) with seven doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, a .357 on-base percentage, a .496 slugging percentage and an .853 OPS in 33 games at Target Field this season...in fact, in his last 24 at home, he is hitting .354 (34-or-96) with a .402 on-base, .573 slugging and a .964 OPS.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Twins have recorded double-digit hit totals 38 times this season, the third-most in baseball, trailing Colorado (41) and Toronto (40)...among AL teams, they rank third in OPS (.748), and fourth in hits (781), batting average (.254), walks (302) and slugging percentage (.423).

◆ Through games of June 30, the Twins were tied with Cleveland for the highest batting average with runners in scoring position in the AL at .262...since July 1, they are hitting .208 (20-for-96) with RISP in 12 games...they have now slipped to seventh in the AL in RISP average on the season, hitting .255.

**MAX HEAT:** Max Kepler is hitting .444 (12-for-27) with two doubles, one home run, two RBI, two walks, a .483 on-base percentage, a .630 slugging percentage and a 1.112 OPS in his last eight games...on the season, he has 41 walks and a 12.9 walk percentage, ranking in the top 8% of the league...he ranks fifth in the AL and seventh in baseball in expected on-base percentage (x0BP) at .397.

**WIN-WIN...WIN:** The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place on Sunday night, starting at 6 pm (CT)...the Twins will select at eighth overall (first round), 48th overall (second round) and 68th overall (Competitive Balance Round B) on night one...they are the only team in baseball that has a winning record, picks within the top 10 of the draft and has a top five aggregate minor league winning percentage.

**FANS HIT THE TARGET:** The Twins have drawn 75,985 in total attendance through the first three games of this homestand for an average of 25,328 per opening...the two games against the Brewers this week (37,183 on Tuesday and 38,802 on Wednesday — sellout) marked the two highest attendance totals this season.

KITTY, KITTY, KITTY, KITTY: Tomorrow, the Twins will honor 2022 National Baseball Hall of Fame electee
Jim Kaat, who will have his uniform number 36 retired in an on-field ceremony prior to the
game against the White Sox — the team for which he collected 45 of his 283 career wins...

The first 10,000 fans in attendance will receive a special Jim Kaat bobblehead, courtesy

The Twins will wear a jersey patch bearing a specially-designed Number 36 logo in honor of "Kitty's" number being retired..the logo
will also adorn the bases and baseballs used during the game.

Kaat is scheduled to be joined on the field by his family and friends; past teammates George Mitterwald, Phil Roof and Dick Stigman;
fellow Twins Hall of Famers Michael Cuddyer and Joe Nathan (who also wore No. 36); Minnesota native and former Twins catcher
Terry Steinbach (himself another No. 36); and the Twins' previously retired numbers: Bert Blyleven, Rod Carew, Kent Hrbek, Tom
Kelly, Ken Killebrew (Harmon's son), Joe Mauer, Tony Oliva, Catherine Puckett (Kirby's daughter) and Kirby Puckett Jr. (Kirby's son).

Kaat will be available for interviews in the Herb Carneal Press Box following the conclusion of the on-field ceremonies.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2014, Target Field hosted Major League Baseball's 85th All-Star Game as the American League won 5-3...the Twins two representatives both entered the game in the ninth inning as Glen Perkins earned the save (2nd career ASG game, 1st appearance) and Kurt Suzuki caught the inning (1st career ASG game)...Ron Gardenhire was the AL's Bench Coach...in 2018, Alex Kirilloff played for Team USA in the SiriusXM Futures Game at Nationals Park, going 2-for-2 with two singles and a run scored...Torii Hunter managed the US squad while LaTroy Hawkins was the pitching coach.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 9 at Texas, as the Twins fell 9-7...tossed 3.1 innings and allowed seven runs on eight hits, with three walks and two strikeouts... his seven earned runs are a career high and eight hits are the third most he has allowed in a start in his career (10 hits on September 26, 2019 at Detroit and 9 hits on June 17, 2022 at Arizona)... marked the third time this season and fourth in his career he has allowed three-or-more home runs (also, three on June 10 vs. Tampa Bay and July 3 vs. Baltimore, and a career-high four on June 4, 2019 at Cleveland)

TWO STARTS AGO: Was dealt a 3-1 loss by Baltimore on July 3 at Target Field, after tossing 6.0 innings and allowing three runs (all on solo home runs) on six hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...was his team-high-tying sixth quality start of the season (with Joe Ryan)...marked the second time this season and third in his career he allowed back-to-back home runs (also June 4, 2019 at Cleveland and June 20, 2022 vs. Tampa Bay).

QUALITY CONTROL: Smeltzer has recorded six quality starts through his first 11 starts this season, tied with Joe Ryan for the most quality starts this season by a Twins pitcher…is tied with Los Angeles-NL's Clayton Kershaw for third-most quality starts in baseball among pitchers with 11-or-fewer starts this season, behind Chicago-AL's Johnny Cueto (9 QS) and New York-NL's Max Scherzer (7 QS)...Smeltzer has also recorded quality starts in eight of his 18 career starting assignments.

STEPPING UP AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 6-4, 3.99 ERA (94.2 IP, 42 ER) with a .243 (86-for-354) opponent batting average and .737 opponent OPS in 18 starts (Twins are 9-9)...by comparison, he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and an .834 opponent OPS in 12 major league relief outings.

This 24 walks allowed through his first 18 career starts are tied for 11th fewest in Twins/

Senators history (1901-).

**TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL:** Did not allow a home run in his first four starts (24.0 IP and 88 batters faced), but has been touched for 13 in his last seven trips to the hill (35.2 IP, 152 batters faced)...has allowed one career home run to a left-handed batter through his first 23 career outings (to Jake Bauers on June 4, 2019), but has yielded three in his last two efforts (to Rougned Odor on July 3 and to Kole Calhoun and Corey Seager on July 9).

**A NEW START VS. CHICAGO:** Will make his first career start against the White Sox after two prior relief appearances...owns a 0-0 record, 15.00 ERA (3.0 IP, 5 ER) with one walk and six strikeouts in his career vs. Chicago-AL...numbers are skewed by a difficult relief outing on July 25, 2020 at Chicago-AL (2.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R/ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 5 K)...has faced the White Sox once before at Target Field; tossed 1.0 scoreless inning with one strikeout on September 2, 2020.

HOME SWEET HOME: Smeltzer has fared much better at Target Field than on the road this season...is 2-1, 2.10 ERA (30.0 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks and 17 strikeouts in five home starts...this compares to 2-1, 5.76 ERA (29.2 IP, 19 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts in six road starts...that trend stays consistent when looking at his career...is 5-2, 2.47 ERA (73.0 IP, 20 ER) with 18 walks and 56 strikeouts in eight career home appearances (6 starts)...is 3-2, 6.23 ERA (56.1 IP, 39 ER) with 15 walks and 36 strikeouts in 13 outings (10 starts) away from Target Field.

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Smeltzer's repertoire through his first 11 starts of the 2022 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a five-pitch mix, primarily relying on his four-seam fastball and changeup.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after collapsing during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be caused by a herniated disc in his neck...was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

SMELTZER THE CANCER SURVIVOR: When Smeltzer was just nine years old, he was diagnosed with pelvic rhabdomyosarcoma (bladder cancer), as a tumor had formed against his bladder that was connected to his prostate...underwent surgery and chemotherapy at St. Christopher's Hospital for Children in Philadelphia, PA, and sent the cancer into full remission in 2012...the lefty, who's worn glasses and a goatee for the majority of his professional career, continues to offer support to others fighting cancer through his Catch Cancer Looking apparel with his likeness...Smeltzer also frequently hosts fellow cancer-surviving kids at games.

  Made Twins Opening Day roster in 2020, the first of his career...went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances...four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more...held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

  Combined to post a 3.02 ERA (104.1 IP, 32 ER) in 20 games (19 starts) between Double-A Pensacola and Triple-A Rochester, going 4-5 in 2019...
