THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game homestand, after going 1-1 against the Brewers this week...

TWINS DROP ONE TO SOX AGAIN: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 6-2...Devin Smeltzer was the starter but did not factor into the decision...

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the ninth of 19 meetings this season...the Twins are 5-3 against the Sox in 2022...

Jorge Polanco is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with one double, one triple, six home runs, 14 RBI and a 1.150 OPS in his last 15 games against the White Sox...

Luis Arraez has hit safely in 17 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .418 (28-for-67) with a .928 OPS.

The Twins have hit 97 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (56 games), ahead of second place Cleveland's 65.

BYE BYE BYRON: Byron Buxton enters today with 23 home runs, fifth most in the AL, trailing Aaron Judge (31), Yordan Alvarez (26), Giancarlo Stanton (24) and Mike Trout (24)...

Buxton has 15 career home runs against the Sox (his most against any opponent), including eight in his last 10 games.

HOT POLO SUMMER: Jorge Polanco has reached base safely in 12 consecutive games...in that span, he has a .250 batting average, but a .415 on-base percentage (10 hits, 12 walks).

Since July 1 of 2021, he has collected 28 doubles, 37 home runs and 112 RBI, with a .504 slugging percentage and an .840 OPS in 154 games...since that date, he ranks fifth in the AL in RBI, tied for eighth in home runs, 12th in slugging percentage and 15th in OPS.

ARE YOU SIRIUS?: The SiriusXM Futures Game will take place at 3 pm (CT) at Dodger Stadium today...Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Matt Wallner and infielder Spencer Steer will be representing the Twins for the American League team...

Other Twins on the current roster to play in the game include: Dylan Bundy (BAL - 2012), Carlos Correa (HOU - 2014), Jharel Cotton (LAD - 2016) and Gary Sanchez (NYY - 2015).

36: The Twins will honor 2022 National Baseball Hall of Fame electee Jim Kaat, who will have his uniform number 36 retired in an on-field ceremony prior to today's game against the White Sox...

Kaat, 83, joins Harmon Killebrew (No. 3 - 1975), Rod Carew (No. 29 - 1987), Tony Oliva (No. 6 - 1991), Kent Hrbek (No. 14 - 1995), Kirby Puckett (No. 34 - 1997), Bert Blyleven (No. 28 - 2011), Tom Kelly (No. 10 - 2012) and Joe Mauer (No. 7 - 2019) as the ninth Twins player or manager to have his number retired by the organization...

The Zeeland, MI native was elected to the National Baseball Hall of Fame on December 5, 2021, and will join, among others, former teammate Tony Oliva in the Class of 2022.

Kaat went 283-237 (.544) with a 3.45 ERA (4530.1 IP, 1738 ER), 180 complete games, 31 shutouts, 17 saves, 1083 walks, 2461 strikeouts, a 1.26 WHIP and a .264 opponent batting average in 898 career games (625 starts) for Washington/Minnesota (1959-73), Chicago-AL (1973-75), Philadelphia (1976-79), New York-AL (1979-80) and St. Louis (1980-83)...

Kaat's best campaign in Minnesota came in 1966, when he went 25-13 with a 2.75 ERA (304.2 IP, 93 ER), 55 walks and 205 strikeouts in 41 starts and earned the second of his three career All-Star nods (also, 1962 and '75)...the southpaw led the majors in starts that season and was tops in the American League in wins, complete games (19), innings pitched and batters faced (1227)...

- ☞ Making his team-leading 16th start of the season and 149th of his career...177th career appearance.
- ☞ Facing the White Sox for the third time this season and has gone 1-0, 0.90 ERA (10.0 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 10 strikeouts in his two prior starts.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fifth win of the season in his last start on July 10 at Texas...yielded four runs on six hits, with a season-high-tying two walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...pitched his final inning — the bottom of the fifth — with the score tied, 4-4; the Twins took a 5-4 lead on Ryan Jeffers' sixth-inning solo homer, while Bundy was still in the game, garnering him the win.

☞ Was just the third time in his career that Bundy allowed at least four earned runs and still got the win...the other instances occurred on June 14, 2017 at Chicago-AL (5 R/4 ER) and on June 17, 2018 vs. Miami (4 R/ER).

TWO STARTS AGO: Was the Twins' starting pitcher on July 4 as they took on the White Sox in Chicago...yielded three hits and one run (José Abreu solo HR in 2nd inning), with one walk and six strikeouts in a 5.0-inning no-decision...after the White Sox tied the game at 2-2 in the bottom of the seventh, the Twins scored three runs in the top of the 10th inning and held off a Chicago rally in the bottom of the frame to win, 6-3.

- ☞ Marked Bundy's eighth start this season with one-or-fewer runs allowed, second most among Twins starting pitchers (Chris Archer — 9 such starts).
- ☞ Allowed four base runners in the start, tied with his outings on April 23, May 17 and June 18 for his second fewest in a start this season...yielded just three in his start on April 11.

CLEAN SOCKS: Facing Chicago-AL for the third time this season, after earning the win on April 23 at Target Field (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 4 K) and taking a no-decision on July 4 on the South Side (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 6 K)...is 5-0, 3.27 ERA (44.0 IP, 16 ER) with 34 hits, eight walks and 47 strikeouts in eight career games (7 starts) vs. the White Sox.

- ☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in six of his seven career starts against Chicago-AL (permitted 4 in the other start) and struck out six-or-more batters in four of the seven, including a career-high 14 on May 24, 2018 on the South Side (with Baltimore).
- ☞ His 3.27 ERA vs. the White Sox is his third-lowest career mark against any team he's faced at least thrice, trailing only his 2.44 ERA vs. Seattle (10 games/7 starts) and his 2.96 ERA vs. Cleveland (6 games/5 starts).
- ☞ Bundy's five career wins against the White Sox are tied with his totals against Tampa Bay and Toronto for his second most against any single opponent in his career, behind his seven wins against Texas...**Chicago-AL is the only team he's faced at least four times in his career and never lost against.**

RIGHT ON TARGET: Has pitched well at home this season, going 2-1, 2.10 ERA (25.2 IP, 6 ER) with five walks and 15 strikeouts; however, just five of his 15 starts so far this season have come at Target Field...this compares to his 3-3 record and 6.02 ERA (49.1 IP, 33 ER) in 10 road starts; his 10 road starts are tied for sixth most in the American League.

- ☞ Making his first home start since June 24 vs. Colorado and just his third start at Target Field in his last nine trips to the mound.
- ☞ Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in four of his five home starts this season, including 6.0 innings and a quality start in his most recent home outing on June 24 vs. Colorado (L, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 2 K).

SUMMER BLOOMIN': Has pitched well in his last five starts, going 1-1, 2.79 ERA (29.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks, 20 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .223 (23-for-103) opponent batting average since June 18...has allowed exactly one run in three of his five outings in this current stretch (June 18 at Arizona, June 24 at Cleveland and July 4 at Chicago-AL).

KEEP UP THE TEMPO: Has an average pitch tempo of 15.9 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant...is the fastest worker on the Twins current active roster (min. 100 pitches) with the bases empty, trailing Cole Sands (14.0 seconds) and Bailey Ober (15.7 seconds) overall...works faster than the league average of 18.0 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.4 seconds when there are runners on base, the sixth fastest on the active roster and seventh fastest worker for the Twins this season.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: According to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 15 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

WELL SUPPORTED: The Twins have scored 57 runs in support of Bundy in his 15 starts this season, including five runs of support in his last start...he has a 6.84 run support average this season, good for third in baseball (min. 75.0 IP), behind Atlanta's Ian Anderson (7.53 RSA) and Houston's Jose Urquidy (7.32 RSA).

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Bundy went 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.

- ☞ Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (*Elias*).
- ☞ Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (*Elias*).
- ☞ Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts.
- In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes.
- Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhardt Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season.
- Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City.
- Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th).
- Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta.
- Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012).
- Named Orioles top prospect according to *Baseball America* and *Baseball Prospectus* following the 2014 season.
- Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews.
- Named Carolina League 2012 Midseason All-Star and *Baseball America* Minor League All-Star.
- Named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in April, 2012 (30 consecutive scoreless IP) and named Orioles top prospect by *Baseball America* following the season.
- Originally selected by Baltimore in the first round (4th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 16 batters in 75.0 innings, equating to a career-low 5.0 walk percentage and a 1.92 walks-per-9.0 IP...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (34.4%) and first-pitch strike percentage (68.4%).

- ☞ His 5.0 walk percentage ranks 10th in the American League (min. 75.0 IP), while his 1.92 walks-per-9.0 IP is also 10th under those same parameters.
- ☞ Additionally, his chase rate ranks in the 93rd percentile in baseball this season and his walk percentage ranks in the 89th percentile.

- Is 13-9-11, 3.55 ERA (203.0 IP, 80 ER) w/ 94 walks & 208 strikeouts in 47 home games this season...overall 22-19-19, 3.78 ERA (371.1 IP, 156 ER) with 57 holds, 142 walks & 383 strikeouts in 92 games.
