†† The Twins have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game homestand, after going 1-1 against the Brewers this week, followed by going 1-2 against the White Sox over the last three daystoday, the Twins will wrap their final series leading up to the All-Star break with the four-game series finale against the White SoxTwins are 27-21 at home and 23-22 on the road.

Coming out of the break, the Twins will begin a nine-day, seven-game roadtrip with two at Detroit (July 23-24), two at Milwaukee (July 26-27) and three at San Diego (July 29-31)... today's game will be the final game until Saturday, July 23, a span of five scheduled off-days... according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it marks the longest span of scheduled games off since the A's and Mariners went six days from May 21-28, 2019...they played a two-game series in Tokyo, then both traveled back to the States to continue their respective schedules on March 28...additionally, the Angels also have five scheduled off-days from today until Friday, July 22.

The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-3, snapping their three-game losing streak to Chicago...Dylan Bundy (6-4) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Jhoan Duran earned his sixth save with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...he became the first Twins rookie since Mike Trombley (1993) to earn a 2.0-inning save...the offense recorded 10 hits, marking their 39th double-digit hit total, third-most in baseball...Luis Arraez hit a leadoff home run (5), while Carlos Correa (11) and Jorge Polanco (14) also homered...the club earned their 50th win; last season they didn't reach 50 victories until August 11 (50-65).

List...Archer has missed the Twins' last 13 games with left hip tightness...to make room for Archer on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer to Triple-A St. Paul...Smeltzer went 4-2, 4.02 ERA (62.2 IP, 28 ER), 17 walks, 37 strikeouts, a .250 BAA and a 1.21 WHIP in 12 starts across two stints with the Twins this season.

Twins and White Sox are playing the 10th of 19 meetings this season...these two will meet again for a three-game series from September 2-4 and meet nine times in the final month...the Iwins are 6-3 against the Sox in 2022, going 4-2 at Target Field and 2-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field.

To lorge Polanco is hitting .339 (19-for-56) with one double, one triple, seven home runs, 17 RBI and a 1.192 OPS in his last 16 games against the White Sox...Polo has 20 career home runs against the Sox, his most against any opponent (90 games).

Luis Arraez has hit safely in 18 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .408 (29-for-71) with a .947 OPS...it marks the longest streak against CWS by any player since Michael Cuddyer hit safely in 18-straight from July 16, 2010-July 8, 2011...Paul Molitor holds the record at 32 games from 193-96.

The Iwins have hit 100 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (57 games), ahead of second place Cleveland's 65...Kepler leads all Twins in that span with 16.

Byron Buxton has 15 career home runs against the Sox (his most against any opponent), including eight in his last 11 games.

Including eight in fits last 11 games.

Twins will be represented by infielder Luis Arraez and outfielder Byron Buxton at Major League Baseball's 92nd All-Star Game this week — each making their first career All-Star appearance... Iwins have two All-Stars for the second-straight year (Cruz and Rogers in 2021).

Arraez's .342 batting average ranks 13th all-time in Twins history Pre-All-Star break (Rod Carew's .394 average in 1977 ranks first), while his .418 on-base percentage ranks 17th...his first-half average is the best since Justin Morneau hit .345 in 2010 (minimum 250 at-bats)...he ranks near the top of baseball's list in several offensive categories: batting average (1st - .342), on-base percentage (1st - .416), whift rate (1st - 7.7%), rewest strikeouts (2nd - 28), multi-hit games (1-2nd - 32), avg. vs. RHP (1st - .370), avg. vs. fastballs (1st - .396), avg. with RISP (5th - .368) and avg. with two strikes (2nd - .279).

Buxton's 23 home runs rank tied for sixth all-time in Twins history Pre-All-Star break (Harmon Killebrew's 30 homers in 1964 rank first), while his 11.78 at-bats-per-home run rank fourth...he ranks near the top of the AL in several offensive categories this season: home runs (5th - 23), SLG (6th - .535), Isolated Power (4th - .317), G/A HR (1st - 14) and at-bats-per-home run (1st - 11.78).

Buck is one of four players in baseball in the 90th percentile in both sprint speed (29.2 mph) and barrel percentage (15.8%)...the others are Mike Irout (29.5 mph/21.1%), Jazz Chisholm Jr. (29.2 mph/16.7%) and Christopher Morel (29.1 mph/15.7%).

The SiriusXM Futures Game was played at Dodger Stadium last night as the AL won 6-4...Matt Wallner started in rightfield and batted fifth for the AL club, going 1-for-2 with a home run and two RBI, his homer registering at 115.8 mph exit velocity... Spencer Steer played second base and went 0-for-2 with one strikeout off the bench.

The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place tonight, starting at 6 pm (CT)...the Twins will select at eighth overall (first round), 48th overall (second round) and 68th overall (Competitive Balance Round B) this evening...they are the only team in baseball that has a winning record, picks within the top 10 of the draft and has a top five aggregate minor league winning percentage...in the 2021 draft, the Twins selected right-handed pitcher Chase Petty (26th) and infielder Noah Miller (36th) on day one.

Double-A Wichita infielder Christian Encarnacion-Strand and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed icher Sean Mooney are the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

Fincarnacion-Strand, 22, played in six games between Cedar Rapids and Wichita, hitting 375 (9-for-24) with three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, a. 464 on-base percentage, a 1.125 slugging percentage and a 1.589 OPS.

Mooney, 24, made two starts for the Kernels, allowing three runs (2 earned) on five hits in 8.0 innings pitched, with three walks and 12 strikeouts...he struck out nine batters in 5.0 innings on Friday at Beloit.

ARCHER REINSTATED: Veteran right-hander was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List today and will start the Twins' final game before the All-Star break...was placed on the IL on July 5 (retro to July 2) with left hip tightness and has missed Minnesota's last 13 games.

4 Had made each of his first 15 starts as scheduled from April 12 through June 30, a stretch in which each of the Twins' other five starters from the season-opening six-man rotation had landed on the IL due to injury and/or illness.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on June 30 in Cleveland, as the Guardians rallied late for a 5-3, walk-off win in the five-game series finale...worked the first 4.0 innings and allowed just one run on one hit, but was undone by a lack of command in issuing a career-high-tying six walks (3rd time, also May 15, 2017 at Cleveland with Tampa Bay and May 26, 2019 vs. Los Angeles-NL with Pittsburgh)...retired the first two batters in the bottom of the second inning, but then walked four-straight to force in a run.

Threw a season-high 90 pitches (45 strikes), his most since logging 98 on August 14, 2019 at Los Angeles-AL (with Pittsburgh), his penultimate start of that season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Delivered arguably his finest start in a Twins uniform to earn the win in a combined 6-0 shutout over Colorado on June 25 at Target Field...blanked the Rockies on just one hit over a season-high-tying 5.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts...worked a 1-2-3 first inning, allowed a leadoff single and walk to start the second, then retired the final 12 hitters he faced.

◆ Marked his fewest hits allowed in a start of 5.0-or-more innings since April 30, 2016 vs. Toronto, with Tampa Bay (6.0 IP, 1 H in a no-decision; Rays won, 4-3).

◆ Joined Dylan Bundy (April 11 vs. Seattle; 5.0 IP, 1 H) and Joe Ryan (April 27 vs. Detroit; 7.0 IP, 1 H) as the three Twins starters this season to work 5.0-or-more innings while yielding one-or-fewer hits.

JUNE BOON CONTINUES STRONG STRETCH: In six June starts, Archer went 2-1, 1.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 5 ER) with 14 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .156/.280/.244 opponent slash line (14-for-90 with 2 2B, 2 HR and 2 HBP)...he allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in all six efforts, while the Twins went 3-3.

Among American League starters with at least 23.0 innings pitched in June, he ranked first in opponent batting average, fourth in opponent OPS (.525) and sixth in ERA.
Going back even further, Archer has a 2.31 ERA (39.0 IP, 10 ER) with 18 walks, 25 strikeouts and a .187/.292/.288 opponent slash line (26-for-139 with 8 2B, 2 HR and 3 HBP) in his last nine starts (he is 2-2, while the Twins are 5-4)...he has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in eight of those nine starts and one-or-fewer in seven efforts (since May 16).

VS. THE WHITE SOX: Archer is set to make his second start/appearance of 2022 against Chicago-AL and his 11th career start (12th appearance)...is lifetime 4-2, 4.27 ERA (52.2 IP, 25 ER) vs. the White Sox...has a 3.73 ERA (50.2 IP, 21 ER) in his 10 prior starts against the South Siders, with all six career decisions (Archer's teams are 7-3 in those games).

◆ Started against the White Sox here at Target Field on April 24 in a planned 3.0-inning effort... did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on three hits (including a leadoff HR by Tim Anderson), with three walks and two strikeouts...the Twins won, 6-4 in 10 innings that Sunday afternoon on Byron Buxton's walk-off, three-run homer off Liam Hendricks.

ARCHER ON TARGET: Archer is 2-0, 0.90 ERA (10.0 IP, 1 ER) with three hits, five walks and seven strikeouts in his last two home starts...he pitched the Twins to a 6-0 shutout victory over Colorado on June 25 (5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) and an 8-1 win over New York-AL on June 25 (5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 4 BB, 2 K).

The first seven home starts overall this season, he is 2-2, 3.54 ERA (28.0 IP, 11 ER) with a .219/.306/.352 opponent slash line (23-for-105 with 8 2B and 2 HR).

In 13 career starts at Target Field (7 with Minnesota, 5 with Tampa Bay and 1 with Pittsburgh), Archer is 6-2, 2.84 ERA (63.1 IP, 20 ER).

SOFT CONTACT: Archer has allowed an average exit velocity of 89.0 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (besting the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .225 opponent batting average on balls in play ranks fourth in the American League (min. 60.0 IP) and would also be the lowest of his career, besting the .254 of his first full season in 2013; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

THE ARSENAL: In his first three starts of the season, just 3.5 percent of Archer's pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed, per Baseball Savant... in 10 starts since, he has thrown his changeup and curveball 21.6 percent of the time (187 of 864 pitches)... below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

This velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers... he has averaged 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.7 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.

Deponents are a combined 26-for-158 (165) with 10 doubles, three homers and 38 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball; they are hitting .309 (21-for-68) with three doubles, five home runs and seven strikeouts against his fastball...however, opponents went 6-for-31 (.194) with one home off Archer's fastball in June.
