THE TWINS: After completing their five-game roadtrip in Cleveland with a record of 2-3, which included getting walked-off in the final two games, the Twins began their three-game homestand with a walk-off victory over the Orioles last night...today, the Twins will play the second of three against Baltimore...following tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Chicago for a three-game series at Guaranteed Rate Field from Monday-Wednesday, followed by an off-day on Thursday, then play the Rangers at Globe Life Field next weekend. ☞ Twins are 24-17 at home and 20-19 on the road...Twins have the fourth-most home wins in the AL and tied for fifth-most in baseball.

BUCK STARTS THE FIREWORKS EARLY: The Twins beat the Orioles last night at Target Field by a score of 3-2 in walk-off fashion, their fourth walk-off victory of the season and third career walk-off home run by Byron Buxton...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on two hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, two from Luis Arraez...Buxton hit his 21st home run of the season on a 2-1 pitch off Jorge López, with nobody out in the ninth inning.

ROTATIONAL PULL: Twins starters have combined to go 6-2, 2.05 ERA (79.0 IP, 18 ER) with 15 walks, 55 strikeouts, a .202 opponent batting average and eight quality starts in their last 14 games...below are the starters, the last time through the rotation:

BIRD WATCHING: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the sixth of seven scheduled meetings this season...Twins are 3-2 against Baltimore this season...one more win in this series and the Twins will secure the season series for the fifth consecutive season since 2017 (excludes 2020 pandemic season)...Twins vs. Baltimore since 2017 in box to lower right. ☞ The Twins are 35-16 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014.

☞ Gary Sánchez has 20 home runs in 66 career games vs. the O's, his most vs. any opponent. ☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .341 (45-for-132) with nine doubles, six home runs, 26 RBI, a .386 on-base percentage and a .932 OPS in 41 career games against the O's. ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .373 (31-for-83) with seven doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 22 RBI, 11 walks, a .442 OBP and a 1.249 OPS in 23 career games against Baltimore...he has seven homers and 11 RBI in his last 15 games against the O's.

BUCK STOMP: Byron Buxton hit his 21st home run of the season last night and is tied with Anthony Rizzo for fourth in the AL in home runs, trailing Aaron Judge (29), Yordan Alvarez (23) and Mike Trout (23)...15 of his 21 homers have come at Target Field...he has 46 career home runs at Target Field, seventh most in the park's history, needing one to tie Nelson Cruz (47) for sixth.

☞ In Buxton's last 162 games, he is hitting .266 (156-for-586) with 36 doubles, two triples, 53 home runs, 97 RBI, 114 runs scored, a .606 slugging percentage and a .925 OPS...Twins are 92-70 in those games...he is on pace for 42 home runs this season. ☞ Twins are 13-4 this season when Buxton homers and 49-33 in games in which he homers since his first career home run on September 27, 2015. ☞ Buxton has hit a home run every 11.06 at-bats since 2020, which leads baseball among players with a minimum of 500 plate appearances, ahead of Mike Trout (11.77), Fernando Tatis Jr. (11.90) and Aaron Judge (12.18).

👏👏👏👏👏: Luis Arraez went 2-for-4 last night, giving him multiple hits in five of his last eight games and 29 on the season, which leads baseball...the Twins record for multi-hit games in a season is held by Kirby Puckett, who had 74 in 1989...Arraez is on pace for 58 multi-hit games, which would mark the most since 1996, when Paul Molitor had 72 and Chuck Knoblauch had 61. ☞ He enters the day second in baseball in batting average (.344) and on-base percentage (.421), trailing Paul Goldschmidt in both (.344/.425).

C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE: Correa has reached safely in 12 straight...in his last 41 games, dating back to April 28, he is hitting .352 (57-for-162) with 10 doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBI, a .408 on-base percentage, a .562 slugging percentage and a .970 OPS...since that date (among players with a minimum of 175 PA), he ranks second in baseball in batting average and eighth in OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2012, the Twins beat the Tigers by a score of 6-4 at Comerica Park to give Ron Gardenhire his 900th career managerial victory...in 2015, Miguel Sanó made his major league debut at Kansas City, going 1-for-4, hitting an infield single off Greg Holland...Sanó has been on the Injured List since May 2 with a left knee sprain.

THIS AND THAT: ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .396 (19-for-48) with RISP, the third highest in the AL, trailing Ji-Man Choi (.418) and Andrés Giménez (.410). ☞ Twins have a .748 OPS against right-handed pitching, compared to a .712 OPS against left-handed pitching.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fourth win of the season on June 27 at Cleveland...tossed a season-high-tying 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits and one walk, with three strikeouts in an 11-1 Twins victory...marked his second start this season with 7.0-or-more shutout innings (other: May 24 vs. Detroit, 7.0 IP, 4 H).

- ☞ Is the only Twins starter this season with multiple starts of 7.0+ shutout innings and is the first Twin to do so since José Berrios had four such starts in 2019.
- ☞ Has now allowed two-or-fewer runs in nine of his 10 starts and three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts, tying his career high (also done from March 31-May 22, 2014).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on June 22 against the Guardians at Target Field...tossed 4.0 innings, allowing a season-high four runs (three earned) on eight hits, with no walks and four strikeouts...Twins lost 11-10 as the bullpen blew a six-run lead...allowed a solo home run to Austin Hedges in the fifth inning, his first allowed since another Austin Hedges solo home run on May 13...marked his shortest start since May 7 vs. Oakland (also 4.0 IP).

BIRD IS THE WORD: Today will mark Gray's 12th career appearance (all starts) against the Orioles...is 6-5, 4.53 ERA (57.2 IP, 29 ER) with 20 walks and 60 strikeouts against Baltimore in his career...last faced them on August 25, 2018 (with New York-AL), where he tossed 6.1 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in a 5-1 Yankees victory...is a career 16-23, 4.48 ERA (281.0 IP, 140 ER) with 108 walks and 255 strikeouts against American League East opponents

- ☞ In his last six appearances (two starts) against the AL East, he has allowed one-or-fewer runs in five of those six appearances, going 2-1, 2.08 ERA (17.1 IP, 4 ER) with seven walks and 16 strikeouts in that span.

WINNING THE BATTLE: Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10 consecutive starts, tying a career-high, also done March 31-May 22, 2014 (with Oakland)...allowed two-or-fewer runs in his first eight starts of the season, marking the second-longest streak in his career, trailing the 11 straight he accomplished from June 25-August 26, 2017 (with Oakland/New York-AL)...his streak of two-or-fewer runs allowed in eight-straight starts marked the longest streak to start a season by a starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present).

SONNY DAYS AT TARGET FIELD: Is making his seventh home start this season...is 2-0, 2.40 ERA (30.0 IP, 8 ER) with nine walks, 37 strikeouts and a .212 batting average (24-for-113) at home this season...this compares to 2-1, 1.83 ERA (19.2 IP, 4 ER) with two walks, 12 strikeouts and a .186 (13-for-70) opponent batting average in four road starts this season.

- ☞ Has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road over his career...has gone 48-36, 3.90 ERA (690.2 IP, 299 ER) with 231 walks and 660 strikeouts in 122 appearances (118 starts) at his home ballpark...has posted a 38-37 record, 3.18 ERA (626.1 IP, 221 ER), with 233 walks and 610 strikeouts in 111 career appearances (106 starts) on the road.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: This season, Gray has posted a .200 opponent average (16-for-80) with three walks and 19 strikeouts against left-handed hitters...this compares to a .204 batting average (21-for-103) with eight walks and 30 strikeouts against right-handed hitters.

- ☞ In his career, Gray has limited left-handers to a .223 batting average (543-for-2434) with 638 strikeouts and right-handed hitters to a .236 batting average (587-for-2489) with 632 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...27 of his 49 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .152 (5-for-33)...here's a look at his repertoire.

- Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.
