THE TWINS: The Twins went 2-4 on their six-game, pre-All-Star Break homestand (1-1 against the Milwaukee Brewers and 1-3 against the Chicago White Sox)...tonight, the Twins will commence the second half of the season with the first of two games against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park, the first leg of a nine-day, seven-game roadtrip featuring stops in Detroit (2 games, tonight-tomorrow), Milwaukee (2 games, July 26-27) and San Diego (3 games, July 29-31)...Twins are 27-22 at home and 23-22 on the road.
 ☞ According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Twins' five scheduled days off from July 18-22 marks the longest span of scheduled days off since the A's and Mariners went six days from May 21-28, 2019...the Angels also had five scheduled off-days from Sunday, July 17 through Thursday, July 21.
 ☞ Since 2000, the Twins are 12-9 in their first game following the All-Star Break (excluding the shortened 2020 season).

BLANK SLATE: The Twins fell to the Chicago White Sox, 11-0, at Target Field last Sunday, July 17 in their final game prior to the All-Star Break...Chris Archer (2-4) was the starter and took the loss after allowing four runs (all earned) on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in 4.2 innings pitched...Twins were held to just one hit – an Alex Kirilloff fifth-inning single – for the second time this season (also, April 13 vs. Los Angeles-NL).

AND THE SECOND HALF IS UNDERWAY: Since 2017 (excluding 2020), the Twins have hit .257 (2532-for-9836) with 505 doubles, 43 triples, 414 home runs, 1417 RBI, 1464 runs scored and a .772 OPS after the All-Star Break...Twins rank among the MLB leaders in that span in total bases (4365, 4th), runs scored (4th), home runs (5th), batting average (7th) and OPS (8th).
 ☞ The Twins are 153-135 (.531) in the second half since 2017, the seventh-best second-half winning percentage in the American League in that span.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have placed left-handed pitcher Caleb Thielbar on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to July 19) with a left hamstring strain...to replace Thielbar on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Yennier Cano from Triple-A St. Paul, for his third MLB stint this season (previously May 11-28, June 2-11).

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 12th of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 6-5 against Detroit this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 1-4 at Comerica Park...they began the season 5-0 against the Tigers, but have since gone 1-5...after this weekend, these two teams will meet next in a three-game series at Target Field from August 1-3.
 ☞ The Twins have won 23 of their last 37 over the Tigers and 28 of their last 45.
 ☞ The Twins are just 5-12 in their last 17 games at Comerica Park, since Aug. 29, 2020, after going 13-6 in their previous 19, from June 12, 2018-September 26, 2019.

HARD-HITTING INFO: Twins hitters enter today third in the majors in barrels-per-batted ball event (10.0), per Statcast; they trail Atlanta (11.4) and New York-AL (11.1)...Twins also enter fourth in the majors with an 89.9 MPH team average exit velocity, behind Toronto (90.3), New York-AL (90.2) and Atlanta (89.9), and fourth in team hard hit percent (42.8), behind the Blue Jays (44.8), Braves (43.8) and Yankees (43.4).

SEEING STARS: The American League defeated the National League, 3-2, on Tuesday night at Dodger Stadium in the 92nd Major League Baseball All-Star Game...Twins were represented by infielder Luis Arraez and outfielder Byron Buxton – each making their first career All-Star appearance...Twins had two All-Stars for the second-straight year (Cruz and Rogers in 2021).
 ☞ Buxton started in centerfield – the first Twins outfielder to start the ASG since Torii Hunter in 2002 – and went 1-for-2 with a go-ahead solo homer in the fourth inning...he became the fourth Twins hitter to homer in the ASG, joining Harmon Killebrew (3x; 1961, 1965, 1971), Kirby Puckett (1993) and Brian Dozier (2015), as well as the first to hit a go-ahead homer.
 ☞ Buxton and New York-AL's Giancarlo Stanton hit back-to-back, game-tying and go-ahead home runs in the fourth inning, the first players to do so in ASG history (*STATS, Inc.*).
 ☞ Arraez entered the game at first base in the bottom of the fourth inning and singled in the top of the eighth, marking the sixth time in Twins history two different Twins hitters recorded a hit in the ASG (also – 1963: Batted/Versalles, 1965: Killebrew/Oliva, 1970: Killebrew/Oliva, 1977: Carew/Wynegar, 2008: Morneau/Mauer).

COOPERSTOWN CALLING: Following their election last December, Twins legends Tony Oliva and Jim Kaat will be enshrined in the National Baseball Hall of Fame tomorrow, Sunday, July 24...Kaat and Oliva will become the fifth and sixth Twins to go into the Hall of Fame, as well as the first two to be inducted in the same class (see box at right)...they join former Twin David Ortiz and the late Bud Fowler, Gil Hodges, Minnie Miñoso and Buck O'Neil in the Class of 2022.
 ☞ The ceremony will be televised live on MLB Network and simulcast on MLB.com, with coverage starting at 10:00 a.m. CT leading up to the ceremony itself at 12:30 p.m. CT.
 ☞ Kaat, 83, played in the majors from 1959-83, including for the Twins/Senators from 1959-73...he won 10-or-more games for the Twins every season except for 1961 and is the club's all-time leader in wins (189), starts (422) and innings pitched (2959.1), while ranking second in complete games (133), shutouts (23) and strikeouts (1824)...his 25 seasons pitched are tied for third all-time, trailing only Hall of Famer Nolan Ryan (27 seasons) and Tommy John (26 seasons)...won 16 career Gold Glove Awards, tied with fellow Hall of Famer Brooks Robinson for second most all-time, behind Hall of Famer Greg Maddux (18).
 ☞ Oliva, who turned 84 on July 20, spent his entire 15-season playing career from 1962-76 with the Twins...he won three American League batting titles (1964, '65, '71) and was named the 1964 AL Rookie of the Year after leading the majors in hits (217) and total bases (374) that season...Oliva was also an eight-time All-Star (1964-71) and finished in the Top 10 in the Most Valuable Player Award voting five times (1964-66, '70-71)...he is one of six players in AL/NL history to lead their respective leagues in hits at least five times (also, Ty Cobb-8, Tony Gwynn-7, Ichiro Suzuki-7, Stan Musial-6).

HEARING (NEW) VOICES: Twins regular play-by-play broadcaster Dick Bremer will not be in the booth for this weekend's series in Detroit, as he attends the National Baseball Hall of Fame festivities...Chris Vosters will handle the play-by-play duties on Bally Sports North this weekend, accompanied by former Twins All-Star and BSN analyst Glen Perkins...Vosters has been on the mic with BSN before for Hockey Day Minnesota broadcasts and his experience includes covering games for the Los Angeles Dodgers, Olympic events and most recently he was introduced as the main play-by-play announcer for the NHL's Chicago Blackhawks this past April.

Facing Detroit for the second time this season and third time in his career...earned the win on April 27 at Target Field, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings (1 H, 1 BB, 9 K). Acquired by the Twins from Tampa Bay on July 22, 2021, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 13 vs. Milwaukee...yielded two hits and one run... Ryan is 1-1, 3.94 ERA (32.0 IP, 14 ER) in six starts since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List on June 14; has two quality starts and four starts at least 5.0 innings in that span... was 5-2, 2.28 ERA (43.1 IP, 11 ER) in eight starts prior to his IL stint.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan did not factor into the decision on July 6 at Chicago-AL...allowed three runs (2 earned) on five hits (1 home run), with two walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work... The White Sox won 9-8, on Leury Garcia's walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th inning.

TIGER TAMER IN TRAINING: Facing Detroit for the second time this season and third time in his career tonight; also making his first career start at Comerica Park...did not factor into the decision on September 30, 2021 at Target Field, after allowing a career-high six runs on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.2 innings as the Twins fell, 10-7...dominated Detroit earlier this season on April 27 at Target Field, allowing just one hit and one walk, with a season-high nine strikeouts over 7.0 shutout innings in a 5-0 Twins win.

DIVISIONAL DO'S AND DON'TS: Ryan is making his seventh start of the season against an American League Central division opponent tonight; is 4-0, 1.82 ERA (34.2 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks, 35 strikeouts and a .194 (24-for-124) opponent batting average in his six prior divisional starts. Owns the lowest opponent batting average (min. 30.0 IP) against the AL Central this season and third-lowest ERA, behind Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease (1.58) and Devin Smeltzer (1.82). Is 5-0, 2.45 ERA (51.1 IP, 14 ER) with 10 walks, 49 strikeouts and a .185 (34-for-184) opponent batting average in nine career starts against the AL Central, including 3-0, 1.19 ERA (22.2 IP, 3 ER) in four divisional road starts.

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Is starting under the lights for the eighth time this season...has a 2-2 record, 3.46 ERA (39.0 IP, 15 ER) with 12 walks and 38 strikeouts in his seven prior night starts, compared to 4-1, 2.48 ERA (36.1 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks and 28 strikeouts in seven day games...is also 1-1, 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in three road night starts this season.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Due to make his seventh road start of the season tonight and has gone 3-1, 2.90 ERA (31.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 27 strikeouts in his six starts thus far...has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in five of his six road starts this season; the lone exception has been his start on June 14 at Seattle (4.2 IP, 4 ER)...by comparison, is 3-2, 3.05 ERA (44.1 IP, 15 ER) with 15 walks and 39 strikeouts in eight home starts this season.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball...he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 58.0% of the time through his first 14 starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant. PITCH (AVG. MPH) PCT. (# OF PITCHES, VS. RHB/LHB) RESULTS 4- Seam Fastball (91.7)...58.0% (701 pitches, 357/344)... 159 (24-for-151), 4 2B, 5 HR, 41 K Slider (81.2)...23.6% (285 pitches, 264/21)... 241 (20-for-83), 7 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 21 K Changeup (83.9)...12.4% (150 pitches, 5/145)... 233 (7-for-30), 3 2B, 2 HR, 3 K Curveball (73.6)...6.0% (73 pitches, 17/56)... 500 (7-for-14), 3 2B, 1 K

Ryan is averaging 16.5 seconds between pitches with the bases empty this season, faster than league average (18.0 seconds) and sixth among Twins pitchers (min. 100 pitches)...averages 20.8 seconds between pitches with runners on, fourth on the Twins (min. 100 pitches), again faster than league average (23.4 seconds).

THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: Below are some facts that summarize Ryan's career to date. Ryan has 96 career strikeouts through his first 19 games, third most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first 19 career games, behind Tyler Duffey (100 from 2015-16) and Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (98 in 1970)...the record for most strikeouts in the first 20 career games is 102, shared by Duffey (2015-16), Blyleven (1970) and Hall of Famer Walter Johnson (1907-08). His .198 opponent batting average through his first 19 career games is lowest in Twins/Senators history (min. 85.0 IP). Owns a 3.56 strikeout-to-walk ratio (96 K, 27 BB) through his first 19 career outings, fifth best in Twins/Senators history (min. 85.0 IP), behind Doc Ayers (4.77 from 1913-14), teammate Bailey Ober (4.74 in 2021), Kevin Slowey (4.18 from 2007-08) and Blyleven (3.63 in 1970). Ryan posted a 0.74 WHIP through his first nine career starts, the lowest WHIP by any MLB pitcher through his first nine career starts since Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson from 1900-01 (0.70) (Stats Perform). Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so. He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY [2022 SEASON: 4-3, 3.71 ERA // CAREER: 86-75, 3.61 ERA]

Right-hander Sonny Gray is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...took the loss in his final outing prior to the All-Star Break, on July 14 against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field...yielded a season-high six runs on nine hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts in 3.2 innings...marked his second-shortest start of the season, behind only his outing on April 16 at Boston in which he departed due to injury after 1.2 innings...is slated to face the Tigers for the second time this season, after earning the win on May 24 at Target Field; tossed the first 7.0 innings (4 H, 1 BB, 10 K) of a 2-0 Twins shutout victory and recorded his 11th career 10+ strikeout game.

CAREER NOTES

- 2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020. Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K). Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts. Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA. In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season. In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Single-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts). Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August. Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts...earned the win in his professional debut on June 22 vs. Vermont, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings (2 H, 3 K). Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
