- Making his 14th start and appearance of the season...will mark his 237th career appearance and 228th start.
Will be his second start against Detroit this season, after earning the win on May 24 at Target Field (7.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 10 K)...is 3-1, 2.63 ERA (37.2 IP, 11 ER) in seven career games (6 starts) against the Tigers.
Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss on July 14 as the Twins fell to the White Sox, 12-2...allowed a season-high six runs on nine hits (1 home run), with one walk and three strikeouts in 3.2 innings of work...gave up a pair of first inning runs and then surrendered a grand slam to Luis Robert in the fourth inning, the fifth grand slam he has given up in his career and first since Jason Heyward on June 28, 2019.

- Marked his second-shortest start of the season behind only his 1.2-inning outing on April 16 at Boston, when he departed the game due to injury.
Paired with his start on July 8 at Texas (5 ER), Gray has allowed five-or-more earned runs in back-to-back starts for the seventh time in his career, and the first time since July 18-25, 2021 with Cincinnati.
Marked the first time he lost back-to-back starts since September 12 (at St. Louis) and September 18, 2021 (vs. Los Angeles-NL)...is 0-2, 11.88 ERA (8.1 IP, 11 ER) in his last two efforts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was dealt his second loss of the season on July 8 at Texas...tossed 4.2 innings and allowed five runs on four hits, with two walks and no strikeouts...Texas scored all six runs in the bottom of the fifth inning to win, 6-5...did not record a strikeout, marking the fifth time in his career he did not strikeout a batter in a start and first since March 31, 2019 vs. Pittsburgh (2.2 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 4 BB) as a member of the Cincinnati Reds.

TIGER TAMER: Will be making his second start of the season against Detroit and eighth appearance (7th start) of his career...turned one of his most effective starts of this season vs. the Tigers on May 24, earning the win after tossing a season-high 7.0 shutout innings with four hits, one walk and season-high 10 strikeouts in a 2-0 Twins victory...last appeared at Comerica Park on April 27, 2016 as a member of the Oakland Athletics (L, 2.0 IP, 4 R/ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 2 K)...is 3-1, 2.63 ERA (37.2 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks and 38 strikeouts in his prior efforts against the Tigers.

- Has allowed one-or-fewer earned runs in his last four appearances (3 starts) against the Tigers, dating back to May 7, 2017...is 2-0, 1.25 ERA (21.2 IP, 3 ER) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in that span.
His 2.63 career ERA against Detroit his third-lowest ERA against a single opponent in which he has faced four-or-more times (trails his 2.08 ERA in 8 games/starts vs. Kansas City and his 2.48 ERA in 5 games/starts vs. Miami).
Gray has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18 of his last 20 games (18 starts) against American League Central opponents, going 10-3, 2.89 ERA (106.0 IP, 34 ER) with 38 walks, 110 strikeouts and a .217 (85-for-291) opponent batting average in that span.

TRAVELING TO DETROIT: Is scheduled to start his sixth road game of the season, going 2-2, 3.33 ERA (24.1 IP, 9 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in his five prior starts...has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in four of his five starts and two of his starts (June 15 at Seattle and June 27 at Cleveland) were scoreless...has not allowed a home run on the road since he gave one up to Xander Bogaerts on April 16 at Boston...is a career 38-38, 3.22 ERA (631.0 IP, 226 ER) with 235 walks and 610 strikeouts in 112 games on the road (107 starts)...this compares to 48-37, 3.96 ERA (699.1 IP, 308 ER) with 235 walks and 668 strikeouts in 124 games (120 starts) at his home ballpark.

SONNY DAYS AHEAD: Making his eighth day start of the season and has been more effective in the sunlight than under the stadium lights...is 2-1, 2.78 ERA (32.1 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 29 strikeouts in his previous daytime action this season...this compares to 2-2, 4.70 ERA (30.2 IP, 16 ER) with nine walks and 28 strikeouts in six starts at night...is a career 32-26, 3.33 ERA (495.1 IP, 183 ER) with 167 walks and 468 strikeouts in 89 day games (85 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...31 of his 57 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .182 (18-for-99) against the pitch...here's a look at his repertoire.

- His fastball spin ranks in the 95th percentile per among all major league pitchers this season and his curve spin is in the 87th percentile.

SIGHTS SET ON THE SECOND HALF: Will be making his first start of the second half...is a career 37-35, 3.58 ERA (547.2 IP, 218 ER) with 200 walks and 516 strikeouts after the All-Star Break...this compares to 44-37, 3.63 ERA (726.2 IP, 293 ER) with 244 walks and 690 strikeouts before the break.

- His best post-All-Star Break performance came in 2019 with the Reds, going 6-3, 2.12 ERA (85.0 IP, 20 ER) with 35 walks, 102 strikeouts and a .165 opponent average in 14 starts.

EYE ON THE CLOCK: Has an average pitch tempo of 18.0 seconds when the bases are empty this season, a smidge faster than league average (18.1 seconds)...has the fifth slowest tempo among qualified Twins pitchers with the bases empty...his tempo slows to 25.4 seconds with runners on, 2.0 seconds slower than the league average of 23.4, and falls to third slowest among qualified Twins pitchers.

TUESDAY'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY [2022 SEASON: 6-4, 4.71 ERA // CAREER: 52-61, 4.72 ERA]

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is slated to start the Twins' series opener on Tuesday in Milwaukee, following tomorrow's off-day...earned his second-straight win in his last start on July 16 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field, allowing three runs on five hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work...is due to face the Brewers for the first time in his career, one of six teams he's yet to face (also, Chicago-NL, Cincinnati, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and St. Louis)...Bundy is 8-10, 4.74 ERA (100.2 IP, 53 ER) with 36 walks and 93 strikeouts in 19 career Interleague games (18 starts), including 1-1, 1.29 ERA (14.0 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in two starts against the National League this season.

Acquired by Minnesota on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.
Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
Named to Baseball America's 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Baseball America Triple-A All-Star.
Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

SONNY AND HOT STREAK: Won three consecutive starts from May 18-29...is the third Twins starter this season to win three consecutive starts, joining Dylan Bundy (April 11-April 23) and Joe Ryan (April 15-April 27)...the Twins have also won in eight of his last 11 starts dating back to May 7, including six straight from May 7-June 15, marking the longest streak for a Twins starter this season; the Twins have won in four consecutive starts by Joe Ryan (April 15-May 3) and Bailey Ober (April 22-May 27).

WINNING THE BATTLE: Allowed three-or-fewer earned runs each of his first 11 starts this season, his longest streak to begin the season in his career...allowed two-or-fewer runs in his first eight starts of the season, also his longest such streak to begin the season (prior career best was three starts, done four times)...his streak of two-or-fewer runs allowed in eight-straight starts to begin the season is the longest such streak by a starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present).

No career appearances vs. DET...is in his 3rd stint with the Twins after previously being with the club from May 11-28 & June 2-11.
