**THE TWINS:** Minnesota came out of the All-Star Break with a two-game sweep over the Tigers at Comerica Park from Saturday-Sunday...tonight, they will continue their current nine-day, seven-game roadtrip with the first of two at American Family Field in Milwaukee...after this series, they will travel to San Diego to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, followed by a three-game series at Petco Park against the Padres over the weekend...Twins are 27-22 at home and 25-22 on the road.

☞ Twins are looking to extend their road winning streak to four games, which would match a season-long, done twice previously: April 30-May 3 and May 18-22.

**TWINS REPEAT THE HITS IN MOTOWN:** The Twins beat the Tigers on Sunday afternoon at Comerica Park by a score of 9-1, completing the two-game sweep, their fifth sweep of the season...Sonny Gray (5-3) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, led by Jose Miranda, who went 3-for-4 with two RBI and two runs scored...Jorge Polanco and Gio Urshela each had two hits, as Polanco doubled twice and Urshela doubled once...the victory marked the Twins' second sweep of the Tigers this season (other: April 26-28 - 3 games)...the Twins outscored the Tigers 17-5 over the two games and outthit them 23-9.

**WELCOME BACK, BIG MAN:** The Twins have returned infielder Miguel Sanó from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 60-day Injured List...Sanó has missed the Twins' last 75 games after undergoing knee surgery in early May...Sanó hit .333 (13-for-39) with three doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, six walks, eight runs scored, a .422 on-base percentage and a 1.217 OPS in 12 games on rehab assignment with the FCL Twins and Triple-A St. Paul...to make room for Sanó on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Gilberto Celestino to Triple-A St. Paul...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred left-handed pitcher Danny Coulombe to the 60-day Injured List (left hip impingement).

**NATIONAL DILEMMA:** The Twins are 4-6 in Interleague Play this season, going 3-1 in their last four after starting 1-5...they went 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field from June 17-19, 2-1 against the Rockies at Target Field from June 24-26 and 1-1 against the Brewers at Target Field from July 12-13...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is (8 games): three games vs. San Diego at Petco Park from July 29-31, two games vs. Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10 and three games vs. San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28...Twins all-time IL wins ranks to the lower right.

☞ Miguel Sanó has an .859 OPS in 79 career IL games, 14th best among AL actives.

☞ Jose Miranda is 7-for-15 (.467) against IL opponents this season.

**BATTLE OF I-94:** The Twins are 240-229 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 67-55 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998...Twins are 11-6 in their last 17 against the Brewers...Minnesota's last trip to Milwaukee came April 1-4, 2021 in the Opening series with the Twins taking two of three.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with six RBI, 10 walks, a .442 on-base percentage and an .823 OPS in 14 career games vs. MIL...in eight career games at Milwaukee, he is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with a .455 on-base percentage and an .847 OPS.

☞ Miguel Sanó is hitting .321 (27-for-84) with seven doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, 16 walks, a .430 on-base percentage and a 1.049 OPS in 22 career games vs. the Brewers...he has a .453 OBP and a 1.072 OPS in 11 career games at American Family Field.

☞ Twins radio stallion Cory Provus spent three seasons from 2009-11 with the Brewers, doing play-by-play with Hall of Famer Bob Uecker on WTMJ-AM and the Brewers Radio Network.

**CREAM CITY CRUSH:** Since the start of 2016, the Twins have scored 5.2 runs-per-game at Milwaukee, their second-best in an NL park (minimum 5 games), behind only Wrigley Field (6.38 in 8 games).

☞ The Twins have homered in nine-straight games at American Family Field, hitting 17 total homers in those nine...it marks their second-longest active homer streak in an opposing ballpark behind their 14 straight at Rogers Centre...since the start of 2014, the Twins have hit 31 home runs in 20 games at Milwaukee, the best among AL teams and more than four NL clubs (Atlanta - 30, Arizona - 27, New York - 22 and Washington - 21).

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .406 (13-for-32) with two doubles, four home runs and a 1.316 OPS in nine career games at American Family Field...he has homered four times in his last four games here.

**ON THE OFFENSIVE:** The Twins have recorded double-digit hit totals 41 times this season, the third most in baseball, trailing Toronto (44) and Colorado (43)...among AL teams, they rank third in OPS (.743), and fourth in hits (823), batting average (.253), walks (314) and slugging percentage (.419).

☞ In two games coming out of the All-Star Break, the Twins are hitting .303 (23-for-76) with 8.5 runs-per-game.

**RAKING ROOKIE:** Jose Miranda is hitting .324 (46-for-142) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 31 RBI, a .542 slugging percentage and an .906 OPS in his last 45 games, since May 20...since that date (minimum 100 at-bats), he leads all MLB rookies in batting average, OPS and slugging percentage, and is second in on-base percentage (.364)...below is his season comparison:

**HOT POLO SUMMER:** Jorge Polanco has reached base safely in 16-consecutive games, dating back to July 2...in that span, he has a .273 batting average, but a .423 on-base percentage (15 hits, 15 walks) and a 1.059 OPS...Polanco has a career slashline of .287/.341/.482 Post-All-Star Break (.823 OPS), compared to .262/.334/.433 Pre-All-Star Break (.767 OPS).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2010, Joe Mauer went 5-for-5 with seven RBI as the Twins beat Zack Greinke and the Royals, 19-1...Danny Valencia also went 4-for-4 and hit a grand slam for his first major league home run.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was credited with the win in his last start on July 16 vs. Chicago-AL as the Twins won, 6-3...tossed 5.1 innings and allowed three runs on five hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...marked his sixth win of the season, second most for a Twins starter this season, trailing Joe Ryan's seven wins...threw 88 pitches, the most he has thrown in a start since tossing 107 on June 18 at Arizona.  
🌀 He is now 6-0 against the White Sox, the only opponent he's started against at least thrice and never lost to.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Earned his fifth win of the season on July 10 at Texas...yielded four runs on six hits, with a season-high-tying two walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...pitched his final inning – the bottom of the fifth – with the score tied, 4-4; the Twins took a 5-4 lead on Ryan Jeffers' sixth-inning solo homer, while Bundy was still in the game, earning him the win.  
🌀 Was just the third time in his career that Bundy allowed at least four earned runs and still got the win...the other instances occurred while with Baltimore on June 14, 2017 at Chicago-AL (5 R/4 ER) and on June 17, 2018 vs. Miami (4 R/ER).

**WHO ARE YOU?:** Bundy is scheduled to face the Brewers for the first time in his career tonight, one of six teams he's yet to face (also, Chicago-NL, Cincinnati, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and St. Louis)...will also be his first career start against the National League Central division...Bundy will have faced every division in MLB after tonight's start.

**INTERLEAGUE SHOWDOWN:** Will make his third Interleague start of the season, posting a combined 1.29 ERA (14.0 IP, 2 ER) in starts...previously started at Arizona on June 18 (W, 8.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 7 K) and vs. Colorado on June 24 (L, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 2 K)...his 8.0 innings pitched and seven strikeouts at Arizona are both his season high.  
🌀 Bundy is 8-10, 4.74 ERA (100.2 IP, 53 ER) with 36 walks and 93 strikeouts in 19 career Interleague games (18 starts)...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 12 of those 19 efforts.

**ROUGH TIME ON THE ROAD:** Bundy struggled on the road this season, going 3-3, 6.02 ERA (49.1 IP, 33 ER) with 11 walks and 42 strikeouts in 10 starts (the Twins are 4-6 in those games)...however, has been better in his last four road starts, going 2-0, 3.13 ERA (23.0 IP, 8 ER) with four walks and 18 strikeouts...has not been dealt a loss on the road since June 4 at Toronto (2.1 IP, 6 R/5 ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 2 K).  
🌀 Eight of the 11 home runs Bundy has allowed this season have come on the road.  
🌀 Bundy is 3-1, 2.61 ERA (31.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts in six starts at Target Field this season

**SUMMER BLOOMIN':** Has pitched well in his last six starts, going 3-1, 3.15 ERA (34.1 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks, 23 strikeouts, a 1.02 WHIP and a .228 (28-for-123) opponent batting average since June 18...has allowed exactly one run in three of his six outings in this current stretch (June 18 at Arizona, June 24 at Cleveland and July 4 at Chicago-AL).

**KEEP UP THE TEMPO:** Has an average pitch tempo of 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant...is the fastest worker on the Twins current active roster (min. 100 pitches) with the bases empty, trailing Cole Sands (14.0 seconds) and Bailey Ober (15.7 seconds) overall...works faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.2 seconds when there are runners on base, the fourth fastest on the active roster and 10th fastest worker for the Twins this season.

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 16 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

**WELL SUPPORTED:** The Twins have scored 63 runs in support of Bundy in his 16 starts this season, including six runs of support in his last start...he has a 7.06 run support average this season, good for third in baseball (min. 75.0 IP), behind Houston's Jose Urquidy (7.33 RSA) and Atlanta's Ian Anderson (7.29 RSA).

**WALKING IN STYLE:** Has walked just 17 batters in 80.1 innings, equating to a career-low 5.0 walk percentage and a 1.90 walks-per-9.0 IP...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (34.6%) and first-pitch strike percentage (68.6%).  
🌀 His 5.0 walk percentage ranks 11th in the American League (min. 75.0 IP), while his 1.90 walks-per-9.0 IP is 12th under those same parameters.  
🌀 Additionally, his chase rate ranks in the 93rd percentile in baseball this season and his walk percentage ranks in the 88th percentile.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 2-4, 3.41 ERA // CAREER: 63-85, 3.85 ERA)**
