**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-1 through three games on their current nine-day, seven-game roadtrip, sweeping the Tigers in two games at Comerica Park, followed by a loss to the Brewers at American Family Field last night...today, the Twins will play the second of two at Milwaukee...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to San Diego to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then play a three-game series against the Padres at Petco Park over the weekend...Twins are 27-22 at home and 25-23 on the road.

**TWINS GET WALKED OFF IN MILWAUKEE:** The Twins lost to the Brewers last night at American Family Field by a score of 7-6, suffering their fourth walk-off defeat of the season...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched, including two home runs...Tyler Duffey (2-4) was issued the loss, allowing a walk-off sacrifice fly to Luis Urias in the bottom of the ninth, snapping his scoreless streak at 17.1 innings...the offense recorded seven hits, including three from Jose Miranda...Byron Buxton hit his 24th home run of the season, a 449-foot shot, marking his ninth career leadoff homer and fourth of the season, tied for fourth most in baseball.

**NATIONAL DILEMMA:** The Twins are 4-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 3-2 in their last five after starting 1-5...they went 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field from June 17-19, 2-1 against the Rockies at Target Field from June 24-26, 1-1 against the Brewers at Target Field from July 12-13 and 0-1 against Milwaukee at American Family Field...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is (8 games): three games vs. San Diego at Petco Park from July 29-31, two games vs. Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10 and three games vs. San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28...Twins all-time IL wins ranks to the lower right.  
 ☞ Jose Miranda is 10-for-19 (.526) against IL opponents this season.

**YOUTUBE SENSATIONS:** Fans can watch today's game on YouTube...it marks the fourth time the Twins play on YouTube this season...the first came on May 25, as the Twins lost to the Tigers 4-2 in 10 innings...the second came on June 15 as the Twins beat the Mariners 5-0...the third time came on July 13 vs. Milwaukee, as Jose Miranda hit a walk-off, three-run homer off Josh Hader, securing a 4-1 victory.

**BORDER BATTLE:** The Twins are 240-230 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 67-56 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998...Twins are 11-7 in their last 18 against the Brewers.  
 ☞ Jose Miranda is 6-for-9 with one double, one home run and five RBI in two career games against the Brewers, recording back-to-back three-hit games.

**CREAM CITY CRUSH:** Since the start of 2016, the Twins have scored 5.3 runs-per-game at Milwaukee, their second best in an NL park (min. 6 games), behind only Wrigley Field (6.38 in 8 games).  
 ☞ The Twins have homered in 10-straight games at American Family Field, hitting 19 total homers in those 10...it marks their second-longest active homer streak in an opposing ballpark behind their 14 straight at Rogers Centre...since the start of 2014, the Twins have hit 33 home runs in 21 games at Milwaukee, the best among AL teams and more than four NL clubs (Atlanta - 30, Arizona - 27, New York - 22 and Washington - 21).

**RAKING ROOKIE:** Jose Miranda is hitting .336 (49-for-146) with 11 doubles, seven home runs, 33 RBI, a .555 slugging percentage and an .929 OPS in his last 46 games, since May 20...since that date (minimum 100 at-bats), he leads all MLB rookies in batting average, OPS, on-base percentage and slugging percentage...below is his season comparison:

**MILWAUKEE BUX:** Byron Buxton is hitting .405 (15-for-37) with three doubles, five home runs and a 1.355 OPS in 10 career games at American Family Field...he has homered five times in his last five games here...he has hit safely in six straight in Milwaukee.  
 ☞ Buxton has one home run in five career at-bats vs. Corbin Burnes, a 411-foot shot on April 3, 2021 in this ballpark...he is one of nine AL players to homer off Burnes in his career.

**FEAR THE BEER BUCK:** Byron Buxton enters today with 24 home runs, tied for third most in baseball with Giancarlo Stanton and Mike Trout, trailing Aaron Judge (38) and Yordan Alvarez (28)...he has homered nine times in 34 road games and seven times in his last 19 games away from Target Field, including two straight (July 10 at Texas).  
 ☞ Buxton is on pace to hit 40 home runs this season...three Twins have reached the 40 home run plateau; Harmon Killebrew seven times, Brian Dozier once and Nelson Cruz once.  
 ☞ Buxton has posted a .604 slugging percentage on breaking pitches this season, the sixth best in baseball (minimum 1,000 pitches seen)...he has a .568 slugging percentage on fastballs, 20th best in baseball.

**SERIES FINALE:** The Twins are looking to avoid being swept for the third time this season...their previous sweeps were in two games vs. Los Angeles-NL from April 12-13 and three games vs. Houston from May 10-12, both at Target Field...Milwaukee's last sweep of the Twins came in three games from July 2-4, 2018 at American Family Field...they have been swept at American Family Field just three times in their history, all in three-game series (2018, 2011 and 2010).

**BROOKS IS HERE:** The Twins announced yesterday the signing of their 2022 first round pick, shortstop Brooks Lee from California Polytechnic State University, whom they selected eighth overall in the 2022 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft...the 6-foot-2, 205-pound infielder hit .357/.462/.664 (84-for-235) with 25 doubles, one triple, 15 home runs, 55 RBI, 46 walks and 56 runs scored in 58 games as a sophomore for the Mustangs in 2022...that season, he was named a D1Baseball.com Preseason and Midseason First-Team All-American, and a First-Team Preseason All-American by *Baseball America*, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game...after being a finalist last season, Lee also won the Brooks Wallace Award, given to the nation's top college shortstop...the San Luis Obispo, California native was ranked as the second-best overall prospect entering the 2022 draft by *Baseball America* and the fifth best by MLB.com...Lee, 21, is the highest overall pick out of Cal Poly as well as the fourth player from the school taken in the first round (including supplemental picks)...his father, Larry Lee, is the head baseball coach at Cal Poly and played one season of professional baseball in 1983 with the Utica Blue Sox of the New York-Penn League...two of Brooks' uncles, Terry Lee and Mike Lee, also played in the minors; Terry was a first-round selection (19th overall) by the San Francisco Giants in 1974 out of San Luis Obispo High School, while Mike spent 1974-75 in the Giants' system...Lee will report to Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, Florida...the Twins have signed 17 of their 20 selections from the 2022 First-Year Player Draft:

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was saddled with the loss on July 17, as the Twins dropped an 11-0 decision to the Chicago White Sox at Target Field in the final game prior to the All-Star Break...blanked the White Sox on two singles (with 0 walks and 5 strikeouts) over his first 4.0 innings, then retired the first two batters he faced in the top of the fifth inning on just two pitches, before his day quickly unraveled...walked Chicago's number-eight hitter (Seby Zavala), allowed a single to Adam Engel (with both runners advancing on an error), a two-run single to Tim Anderson and a ground-rule double to Yoán Moncada before departing trailing 2-0...both runners came around to score, ending his day with a line of 4.2 innings pitched, five hits, four runs (all earned), one walk and the five strikeouts.

- ☞ Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to the game, after having missed the Twins' prior 13 games with left hip tightness (was placed on the IL on July 5, retroactive to July 2).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Did not factor in the decision on June 30 in Cleveland, as the Guardians rallied late for a 5-3, walk-off win in the five-game series finale...worked the first 4.0 innings and allowed just one run on one hit, but was undone by a lack of command in issuing a career-high-tying six walks (3rd time, also May 15, 2017 at Cleveland with Tampa Bay and May 26, 2019 vs. Los Angeles-NL with Pittsburgh)...retired the first two batters in the bottom of the second inning, but then walked four straight to force in a run.

- ☞ Threw a season-high 90 pitches (45 strikes), his most since logging 98 on August 14, 2019 at Los Angeles-AL (with Pittsburgh), his penultimate start of that season.

**VS. THE BREWERS:** Archer is set to make his sixth career start and appearance vs. Milwaukee, but his first since June 28, 2019 (with Pittsburgh)...is 1-2, 5.88 ERA (26.0 IP, 17 ER) in his first five efforts vs. the Brewers, while his teams are 3-2 in those games...missed the series at Target Field earlier this month while on the Injured List.

- ☞ Lone career win vs. Milwaukee came on May 31, 2019 at PNC Park, as he pitched the Pirates to a 9-4 triumph (7.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R/ER, 2 BB, 7 K).
- ☞ Is 0-2, 8.31 ERA (13.0 IP, 12 ER) here at American Family Field, with his last appearance coming in that June 28, 2019 game (ND; 4.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 6 K).

**JUNIOR CIRCUIT LEADS TO SENIOR CIRCUIT SUCCESS:** While pitching for either the Rays or Twins, Archer has posted a 3.26 ERA (141.0 IP, 51 ER) in 25 career Interleague games (24 starts)...however, in a Pirates uniform, he logged a 4.99 ERA (155.0 IP, 86 ER) in 30 starts against National League teams.

- ☞ Today will be Archer's fourth Interleague start of 2022, having gone 1-1, 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP, 2 ER), one walk, 11 strikeouts and a .133/.152/.311 slash line (6-for-45 with 2 2B and 2 HR) in his first three efforts...made his Twins debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL (ND; 4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 3 K), took the loss on June 19 at Arizona (4.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 0 BB, 3 K) and defeated Colorado on June 25 (5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K).
- ☞ All told, he is 8-12, 3.36 ERA (158.0 IP, 59 ER) in 28 career Interleague games (27 starts).

**A FEEL FOR THE ROAD:** Archer has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his eight road starts this season, going 0-1, 2.70 ERA (33.1 IP, 10 ER), 17 walks, 28 strikeouts and a .198/.307/.388 opponent slash line (24-for-121, with 5 2B and 6 HR)...has departed seven of his eight road efforts with the Twins either tied or ahead; however, Minnesota is just 3-5 in those games.

- ☞ Is looking for his first road win since September 25, 2018 at Chicago-NL (with Pittsburgh)...is 0-7, 5.17 ERA (101.0 IP, 58 ER) in 22 road games (21 starts) since.

**SOFT CONTACT:** Archer has allowed an average exit velocity of 89.1 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (besting the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .235 opponent batting average on balls in play ranks sixth in the American League (min. 60.0 IP) and would also be the lowest of his career, besting the .254 of his first full season in 2013; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

**THE ARSENAL:** In his first three starts of the season, just 3.5 percent of Archer's pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed, per Baseball Savant...in 13 starts since, he has thrown his changeup and curveball 21.7 percent of the time (202 of 932 pitches)...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

- ☞ His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.7 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.
- ☞ Opponents are a combined 29-for-171 (.170) with 11 doubles, three homers and 39 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball.
