I'M KIND OF A BIG DEAL: The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their current nine-day, seven-game roadtrip, sweeping the Tigers in two games at Comerica Park, followed by a two-game sweep at the hands of the Brewers at American Family Field this week...tonight, the Twins will begin a three-game series against the Padres at Petco Park over the weekend... Twins are 27-22 at home and 25-24 on the road.

© Since April 21, the Twins have gone 48-38, tied with Toronto (48-39) for the third most wins in the AL since that date, trailing New York (60-28) and Houston (59-29).

© Twins are looking to avoid losing three straight road games, which would match a season-high, done twice previously: May 31-June 2 and July 6-9.

BOY, THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY, I MEAN THAT REALLY GOT OUT OF HAND FAST: The Twins lost to the Brewers on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 10-4 at American Family Field, suffering their third sweep of the season...Chris Archer (2-5) was the starter and loser, allowing a season-high six runs on three hits in 3.0 innings pitched...eight of the Brewers' 10 runs came in the first four innings, including two three-run homers from Rowdy Tellez, off Archer and Jharel Cotton...the Twins offense recorded seven hits, three from Jose Miranda, who hit his ninth home run of the season.

GLASS CASE OF EMOTION: The Twins have placed infielder Gio Urshela on the Paternity List as he and his wife are expecting the arrival of a baby girl...to replace Urshela on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Gilberto Celestino from Triple-A St. Paul...Celestino, who was optioned to St. Paul on July 26, has hit .268 (41-for-153) with seven doubles, one triple, eight RBI, 12 walks and 17 runs scored in 66 games for Minnesota this season.

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 4-8 in Interleague Play this season, going 3-3 in their last six after starting 1-5...they went 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field from June 17-19, 2-1 against the Rockies at Target Field from June 24-26, 1-1 against the Brewers at Target Field from July 12-13 and 0-2 against Milwaukee at American Family Field this week...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is (5 games): two games vs. Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10 and three games vs. San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28.

© Jose Miranda is 13-for-23 (.565) against IL opponents this season.

YOU STAY CLASSY SAN DIEGO: The Twins are 15-5 all-time against the Padres (8-2 in San Diego), posting a .750 winning percentage, their highest vs. any NL opponent and the best record for any club vs. any single opponent since 1900 (minimum 20 games played)...they last played the Padres in 2017, splitting a two-game series at Petco Park from August 1-2 and sweeping them in two games at Target Field from September 12-13...the Twins are 6-1 all-time against the Padres at Target Field, 6-1 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium, and 1-2 at Metrodome.

◆ Blake Snell has not faced the Twins since 2019 but has 7.15 ERA (22.2 IP, 18 ER) in five career starts against them, his highest mark vs. any club he has faced at least five times.

JAZZ F-LU-TE: Luis Arraez ranks near the top of several offensive categories in baseball, despite hitting just 1.190 (8-for-42) with four walks in his last 11 games:

DON'T ACT LIKE YOU'RE NOT IMPRESSED!: Joe Ryan has held hitters to a .198 (78-for-394) batting average in his career, the second-lowest mark by any Twin through 20 career starts, trailing only Francisco Liriano's .190 mark...Ryan is 1-0, 2.05 ERA (22.0 IP, 5 ER) and a .169 (13-for-77) opponent batting average in four starts this month...Ryan is tied with Atlanta's Spencer Strider with a 2.2 WAR (per BBREF), the best among MLB rookie pitchers.

MIRANDA WATCH!!!: Jose Miranda has recorded three hits in three-straight games and four times in his last eight games...he is the first Twins rookie with a streak of three-or-more games with three-plus hits since Danny Valencia did it in four straight from July 24-27, 2010 (3, 3, 4, 4)...in 17 July games, Miranda is hitting .386 (22-for-57) with two doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI, a .435 on-base percentage, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.067 OPS...among AL players this month, he ranks third in batting average, fourth in OPS, sixth in RBI, tied for sixth in OBP and seventh in slugging.

The Miranda has nine hits and five RBI over his last three games and 26 hits and 21 RBI over his last 20...he is the first Twins rookie with 25-plus hits and 20-plus RBI in a 20-game span since Miguel Sanó in 2015.

WHAMMY!: Byron Buxton enters today with 24 home runs, tied for third most in the AL with Giancarlo Stanton and Mike Trout, trailing Aaron Judge (39) and Yordan Alvarez (29).

Buxton has posted a .598 slugging percentage on breaking pitches this season, the sixth best in baseball (minimum 1,000 pitches seen).

Since 2020, Buck has an at-bat-per-home run ratio of 11.55, the best in baseball (minimum 500 AB), ahead of Aaron Judge (11.72) and Fernando Tatis Jr. (11.90).

(ALMOST) 60 PERCENT OF THE TIME IT WORKS, EVERY TIME: The Twins are 15-11 this season when facing a left-handed starter, posting a .577 winning percentage....they had a .753 OPS against lefties in their first 37 games but have just a .694 OPS in their last 39.

CHANNEL 4 NEWS TEAM: Carlos Correa is hitting .303 (69-for-228) with 12 doubles, 11 home runs, 31 RBI, a .369 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS in his last 58 games...on the season, Correa leads the team in average exit velocity at 90.6 mph...additionally, Correa has homered three times in his last five games against the Padres, including twice in his last three at Petco Park.

THE HUMAN TORCH (WAS DENIED A BANK LOAN): Jhoan Duran has thrown 235 pitches of 100-plus mph this season, the most in base-ball...he has an average pitch velocity of 95.8 mph this season, second-highest in baseball among pitchers with at least 600 pitches thrown, trailing Gregory Soto (96.3).

▼ Duran's 4-seam fastball has averaged 100.5 mph, his curveball has averaged 87.6 mph, and his splitter has averaged 96.2 mph, all the highest in baseball.

THAT'S HOW I ROLL!: Miguel Sanó needs one home run to reach 163 for his career and tie Tom Brunansky for 10th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...his only home run this season came on April 15 at Boston, a two-run shot in the second inning off Nick Pivetta...Sanó has a 32.4 strikeout percentage this season and a 13.2 walk percentage, both the best of his career.

HEY EVERYONE! COME AND SEE HOW GOOD I LOOK!: Twins pitching coach Pete Maki is celebrating his 40th birthday today.

LASTLY: The Twins have signed shortstop Omari Daniel, their 14th round pick from the 2022 Draft...Daniel was drafted out of The Walker School in Georgia.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan earned the win in his last start on July 23 at Detroit, yielding one run on four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.2 innings, as the Twins beat the Tigers 8-4...cruised through 5.0 scoreless frames before allowing a Riley Greene triple leading off the sixth, Greene later scored on Javier Báez's single and Ryan retired Robbie Grossman (flyout) and Miguel Cabrera (strikeout) before departing the game...his seven strikeouts matched his second-highest single-start total of the season for the fourth time (season high is nine).

4 Ryan is 1-0, 2.05 ERA (22.0 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 20 strikeouts and a .169 (13-for-77) opponent batting average in four July starts...has allowed exactly one run in three of those efforts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on July 13 vs. Milwaukee...yielded two hits and one run — a third-inning solo homer by Jace Peterson — with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work...departed with the score tied 1-1; the Twins won, 4-1, on Jose Miranda's three-run walk-off homer off Josh Hader in the bottom of the ninth inning.

MEET THE FRIARS: Facing the Padres for the first time in his career...owns one career start against the National League West division, earning the 6-3 win over the Colorado Rockies on June 26 at larget Field (5.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 1 HB, 1 K)...is 1-0, 3.48 ERA (10.1 IP, 4 ER) with three walks and four strikeouts in two starts against the National League this season — his outing on June 26 vs. Colorado and his start on July 13 vs. Milwaukee (ND, 5.1 IP, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 3 K).

© Ryan is 2-1, 3.98 ERA (20.1 IP, 9 ER) with five walks, 20 strikeouts and a .213 opponent batting average in four career Interleague starts/appearances.

© Made his major league debut in Interleague Play on September 1, 2021 against the Chicago Cubs at Target Field (L. 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).

© Tonight marks just his second career Interleague start and appearance on the road...his other start was one of the most dominant of his career, when he earned the 5-4 win over the Cubs at Wrigtey Field on September 22, 2021; fanned a career-high 11 batters in 5.0 innings, with three filts allowed, two earned runs and one walk in 5.0 innings.

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Is starting under the lights for the ninth time this season...has a 3-2 record, 3.22 ERA (44.2 IP, 16 ER) with 13 walks and 45 strikeouts in his eight prior night starts, compared to 4-1, 2.48 ERA (36.1 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks and 28 strikeouts in seven day games...is also 2-1, 3.48 ERA (20.2 IP, 8 ER) with five walks and 19 strikeouts in four road night starts this season.

The transport of the strikeouts in 15-0, 2.41 ERA (18.2 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and 21 strikeouts in his last three night starts since June 21, after going 1-2, 5.65 ERA (14.1 IP, 9 ER) with eight walks and 12 strikeouts in his three night starts from May 10-June 14.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Due to make his eighth road start of the season tonight and has gone 4-1, 2.70 ERA (36.2 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks and 34 strikeouts in his seven starts thus far...has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in six of his seven road starts this season; the lone exception has been his start on June 14 at Seattle (4.2 IP, 4 ER)...by comparison, is 3-2, 3.05 ERA (44.1 IP, 15 ER) with 15 walks and 39 strikeouts in eight home starts this season.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball— he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 57.7% of the time through his first 15 starts of

THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: Below are some facts that summarize Ryan's career to date.

Ryan has 103 career strikeouts through his first 20 games, most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first 20 career games...the record for most strikeouts in the first 21 career games is 106, held by Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven in 1970.

His .198 opponent batting average through his first 20 career games is third lowest in Twins/Senators history (min. 85.0 IP), behind George Dumont (.183 from 1915-16) and Jim Roland (.186 from 1962-64).

Mowns a 3.68 strikeout-to-walk ratio (103 K, 28 BB) through his first 20 career outings, fourth best in Twins/Senators history (min. 85.0 IP), behind teammate Bailey Ober (5.05 in 2021), Doc Ayers (4.64 from 1913-14) and Kevin Slowey (4.29 from 2007-08).

Ryan posted a 0.74 WHIP through his first nine career starts, the lowest WHIP by any MLB pitcher through his first nine career starts since Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson from 1900-01 (0.70) (Stats Perform).

Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.

He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.
