\$ Has consistently found success at home throughout his career, going 5-1, 2.28 ERA (67.0 IP, 17 ER) with 17 walks, 53 strikeouts, a 0.94 WHIP and a 194 ( 46 -for-237) opponent batting average in 16 appearances ( 7 starts)...this compares to 3-2, 5.43 ERA (53.0 IP, 32 ER) with 12 walks and 34 strikeouts in 12 career road appearances ( 9 starts).

STRIKES AND OUTS: Has been effective so far when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a 165 (15-for-91) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a . 184 (40-for-217) mark in his career.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10 -day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April
24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after collapsing during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be caused by a herniated disc in his neck...was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Was in Twins spring training for the second-consecutive season and was optioned to the alternate training site on March 29...recalled from the Taxi Squad on April 17...appeared in one game for the Twins on April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, allowing one unearned run on one hit in 4.2 innings of relief...marked his only appearance with the Twins or Saints on the season as he was optioned back to the alternate training site on April 25...recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 6 just prior to the minor league season but did not appear for the Twins...placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 12 with left elbow inflammation and missed the remainder of the season...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17.
