THE TWINS: After completing their five-game roadtrip in Cleveland with a record of 2-3, which included walk-off losses in the final two games, the Twins began their three-game homestand with consecutive walk-off victories over the Orioles...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale against Baltimore...following the game, the Twins will travel to Chicago for a three-game series at Guaranteed Rate Field from Monday-Wednesday, followed by an off-day on Thursday, then play the Rangers for three at Globe Life Field next weekend.
 ☞ Twins are 25-17 at home and 20-19 on the road...25 home wins are tied with New York-NL, Tampa Bay and Toronto for the second-most in baseball, trailing New York-AL (34-9).

FIREWORKS WEEKEND CONTINUES: The Twins beat the Orioles yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-3 in walk-off fashion, their second consecutive walk-off victory and fifth this season...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched with three walks...the offense recorded 10 hits, including a game-tying home run by Jorge Polanco to lead-off the ninth inning...Jose Miranda, who entered the game as a defensive replacement, had the walk-off single in the ninth, marking his first career walk-off plate appearance.
 ☞ The Twins are now 13-8-4 in series play this season...they are now 4-0-1 in series play against Baltimore at Target Field in their last five chances.
 ☞ The Twins have five walk-off victories this season (full list on page 6 of game notes)...the last time Minnesota won three-straight games in walk-off fashion came September 3-5, 1987...they had nine walk-off wins last season.

STARTER STRENGTH: Twins starters have combined to go 6-2, 2.25 ERA (84.0 IP, 21 ER) with 18 walks, 60 strikeouts, a .209 opponent batting average and eight quality starts in their last 15 games...they have not allowed more than three earned runs in any of those 15...below are the starting pitcher ranks among AL teams in a few categories:

BIRD WATCHING: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the seventh and final time in 2022...Twins are 4-2 against Baltimore this season, securing the season series for the fifth consecutive season since 2017 (excludes 2020 pandemic season)...Twins vs. Baltimore since 2017 in box to the right.

- ☞ Gary Sanchez has 20 home runs in 67 career games vs. the O's, his most vs. any opponent.
- ☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .348 (47-for-135) with nine doubles, six home runs, 26 RBI, a .392 on-base percentage and a .940 OPS in 42 career games against the O's.
- ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .360 (31-for-86) with seven doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 22 RBI, 12 walks, a .434 OBP and a 1.213 OPS in 24 career games against Baltimore...he has seven homers and 11 RBI in his last 16 games against the O's.

👏👏👏👏👏👏: Luis Arraez went 2-for-4 yesterday, giving him multiple hits in six of his last nine games and 30 on the season, which leads baseball...the Twins record for multi-hit games in a season is held by Kirby Puckett, who had 74 in 1989...Arraez is on pace for 60, which would mark the most since 1996, when Paul Molitor had 72 and Chuck Knoblauch had 61.

BRING A BROOM: The Twins are seeking their fifth sweep of the season today...their four sweeps were April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games), April 26-28 vs. Detroit (3 games), May 6-8 vs. Oakland (3 games) and May 20-22 at Kansas City (3 games)...their last sweep of the O's came May 24-26, 2021 at Target Field (3 games).

☞ Since 2014, the Twins have swept the O's seven times (16 total series), tied for their second-most sweeps of one opponent since that season (Chicago-AL - 8, Kansas City - 7, Detroit - 7).

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Double-A Wichita infielder Edouard Julien and right-handed pitcher Louie Varland have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...this marks Varland's second honor this season, the other coming June 12.

- ☞ Julien, 23, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .348 (8-for-23) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, five walks, and a .464 OBP, an .826 SLG and a 1.290 OPS...the Quebec, Canada native was selected by the Twins in the 18th round in 2019.
- ☞ Varland, 24, made two starts for the Wind Surge on the 25th vs. San Antonio and 30th at Springfield, combining to go 0-1, 4.35 ERA (10.1 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 13 strikeouts...his highlight of the week was his nine strikeouts over 5.1 innings on Thursday at Springfield...the St. Paul, MN native was selected by the Twins in the 15th round in 2019.

START SPREADING THE NEWS, I'M LEAVING TODAY. I WANT TO BE A PART OF IT, NEW YORK, NEW YORK: Twins communications intern Parker Lougee is celebrating his final day with the department today, as he has accepted the role of Assistant, Communications and Media Relations with the New York Yankees media relations department...he plans to start with the Yankees around July 17...best of luck in the Big Apple.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2020, the Twins officially began Summer Camp at Target Field...it served as the club's "second spring training"...the Twins originally played 19 spring training games from February 21-March 11, going 7-8-4, prior to leaving camp due to the COVID-19 pandemic and flew home to Minnesota on March 15...the Twins held Summer Camp from July 3-21 and played intrasquad scrimmages near the back half, with team Polanco (white tops) vs. team Kepler (blue tops)...they opened the 2020 regular season at Chicago-AL on July 24...in 2010, Jim Thome hit career home runs 573 and 574 at Target Field vs. Tampa Bay, both off Wade Davis...his 574th moved him past Harmon Killebrew and into sole possession of 10th on baseball's all-time home run list.

- ☞ Making his 10th major league start and appearance of the season...also 29th career appearance (17th start).
- ☞ Facing Baltimore for the first time in his career...is 1-0, 3.60 ERA (15.0 IP, 6 ER) in three career appearances (2 starts) against the American League East division.
- ☞ Was acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on July 31, 2018 along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last outing in the first game of the doubleheader on June 28 at Cleveland; the Twins lost, 3-2, after the Guardians scored two runs in the bottom of the eighth inning...allowed one run on four hits in 6.0 innings, his fifth major league quality start of the season...has tossed 5.0-or-more innings in seven of his nine starts this season.

- ☞ Recorded a career-high nine strikeouts in the start and did not walk a batter.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his fourth victory of the season in the series finale against Cleveland on June 23 at Target Field...threw 6.0 shutout innings, allowing three hits and no walks, with three strikeouts...Twins won 1-0, with the lone run of the game coming on a Nick Gordon solo home run.

- ☞ Marked his second scoreless start this season (other: May 26 vs. Kansas City, ND, 7.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K).

SUCCESS AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 6-3, 3.38 ERA (85.1 IP, 32 ER) with a .229 (72-for-314) opponent batting average and .671 opponent OPS in 16 starts (Twins are 9-7)...by comparison, he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and an .834 opponent OPS in 12 major league relief outings.

NOT SO FAMILIAR FOE: Will make his first career appearance against the Orioles in this afternoon's game...is 1-0, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and four strikeouts in two starts against the American League East this season after starting at Toronto on June 5 and vs. Tampa Bay on June 10...is a lifetime 1-0, 3.60 ERA in three games (2 starts) against the AL East.

HOME SWEET HOME: Smeltzer is making his fifth start and appearance of the season at Target Field and is 2-0, 1.50 ERA (24.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks and 14 strikeouts in his four prior home outings...this compares to 2-1, 4.87 ERA (26.1 IP, 12 ER) with five walks and 17 strikeouts in five starts away from Target Field.

- ☞ Has consistently found success at home throughout his career, going 5-1, 2.28 ERA (67.0 IP, 17 ER) with 17 walks, 53 strikeouts, a 0.94 WHIP and a .194 (46-for-237) opponent batting average in 16 appearances (7 starts)...this compares to 3-2, 5.43 ERA (53.0 IP, 32 ER) with 12 walks and 34 strikeouts in 12 career road appearances (9 starts).

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Smeltzer's repertoire through his first nine starts of the 2022 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a five-pitch mix, primarily relying on his four-seam fastball and changeup.

- ☞ Prior to his May 26 outing against Kansas City, Smeltzer's wife, Brienne – a former college softball player – advised him to throw more changeups down and away when attacking hitters...he's followed her advice over his last six starts, using his changeup more often (it's now his second-most-used pitch).

- ☞ Has started to throw his fastball and slider from a lower-slot arm angle this season to pair with his other offerings and better attack left-handed hitters.

- ☞ Began varying the speeds of his pitches this season with the realization that throwing his fastball between 86-92 mph is better than maxing out at 89-92...aims to throw his changeup with a four-mile variance between the low and upper end.

STRIKES AND OUTS: Has been effective so far when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .165 (15-for-91) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .184 (40-for-217) mark in his career.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after collapsing during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be caused by a herniated disc in his neck...was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Was in Twins spring training for the second-consecutive season and was optioned to the alternate training site on March 29...recalled from the Taxi Squad on April 17...appeared in one game for the Twins on April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, allowing one unearned run on one hit in 4.2 innings of relief...marked his only appearance with the Twins or Saints on the season as he was optioned back to the alternate training site on April 25...recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 6 just prior to the minor league season but did not appear for the Twins...placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 12 with left elbow inflammation and missed the remainder of the season...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17.
