sweeping the Tigers in two games at Comerica Park, followed by a two-game sweep at the hands of the Brewers at American Family Field, then a loss to the Padres at Petco Park last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three at San Diego...the Twins are 27-22 at home and 25-25 on the road.

The Twins are looking to avoid losing four straight, which would mark their longest losing streak since August 31-September 4, 2021 (also 4), when they dropped two to the Cubs and two to the Rays.

TWINS DROP GAME ONE TO PADRES: The Twins lost to the Padres at Petco Park last night by a score of 10-1...loe Ryan (7-4) was the starter and loser, allowing a career-high 10 runs on eight hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with two walks, seven strikeouts and five home runs allowed... the five homers allowed tied a club record, previously done by Bert Blyleven (September 13, 1986 vs. Texas) and Carlos Silva (August 22, 2006 at Baltimore)...the offense recorded just five hits, two from Luis Arraez...Byron Buxton hit his team-leading 25th home run, his third homer in his last four road games...the homer was measured at 113.5 mph exit velocity, the fifth-hardest hit ball by a Twin this season.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed outfielder Max Kepler (right fifth toe fracture) and infielder Miguel Sanó (left knee inflammation) on 10-day Injured List...Kepler has missed the Twins' last three games since sustaining the injury on July 24 in Detroit...he has hit .244 (70-for-287) with 13 doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 39 RBI, 41 walks, 41 runs scored and a .344 on-base percentage in 85 games this season...Sanó, who missed 75 games this season after undergoing surgery on his left knee, was reinstated from the Injured List on Tuesday...he played in three games upon his return and has gone 0-for-6...to replace Kepler and Sanó on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of infielder Tim Beckham and recalled outfielder Mark Contreras from Triple-A St. Paul...Beckham, who was signed to minor league contract this offseason, played in 33 games for the Saints this season, hitting .413 (52-for-126) with six doubles, five home runs, 31 RBI, a .483 on-base percentage and a 1.062 OPS...Contreras, who will be making his third stint with the Twins this season, has played in six games for Minnesota in 2022, going 1-for-9 with two RBI...to make room for Beckham on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober (right groin strain) to the 60-day Injured List.

IL PLAY: The Twins are 4-9 in Interleague Play this season...against National League opponents this season, they have gone 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field from June 17-19, 2-1 against the Rockies at Target Field from June 24-26, 1-1 against the Brewers at Target Field from July 12-13, 0-2 against Milwaukee at American Family Field this week and 0-1 against the Padres...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is (5 games): two games vs. Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10 and three games vs. San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28.

© Jose Miranda is 13-for-27 (.481) against IL opponents this season.

TWINS AND PADRES: The Twins are 15-6 all-time against the Padres (8-3 in San Diego), posting a .714 winning percentage, their highest vs. any NL opponent and the best record for any club vs. any single opponent since 1900 (minimum 20 games played)...the Twins are 6-1 all-time against the Padres at Target Field, 6-2 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium, and 1-2 at Metrodome.

MIRANDA WATCH: In 18 July games, Jose Miranda is hitting .361 (22-for-61) with two doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI, a .409 on-base percentage, a .590 slugging percentage and a .999 OPS...among AL players this month, he ranks fourth in batting average, tied for eighth in RBI, ninth in OPS, 11th in slugging and 12th in on-base.

Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 200 at-bats this season, he ranks second in batting average (.275), OPS (.784) and slugging percentage (.469), and third in on-base percentage (.315).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1966**, Dave Boswell threw the third one-hitter in Twins history against Baltimore, the lone hit being a seventh-inning single by Russ Snyder...in **2001**, the Twins acquired right-handed starter Rick Reed for outfielder Matt Lawton...Reed went 4-6, 5.19 ERA (67.2 IP, 39 ER) in 12 starts for the Twins that season...in **2021**, Joe Ryan led Team USA to an 8-1 win over Team Israel at the Tokyo Olympics, in the USA's first Olympic baseball game since 2008...Ryan started and tossed 6.0 strong innings, allowing one run on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in his first start of the second half, as the Twins defeated the Tigers 9-1 on July 24 at Comerica Park...allowed just one run on two hits and one walk, while striking out seven batters in 6.0 innings of work...Twins scored six runs in the final three innings to secure the victory...marked Gray's longest outing (6.0 IP) and fewest runs allowed (1 ER) since June 27 at Cleveland (W, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K)...also was the fewest hits allowed since May 29 vs. Kansas City (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K)...marked his fifth quality start of the season, third most by a Twins starter (long Ryan and Devin Smeltzer have 6 (OS each) ns starter (Joe Ryan and Devin Smeltzer have 6 QS each).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on July 14 as the Twins fell to the White Sox, 12-2...allowed a season-high six runs on nine hits (1 home run), with one walk and three strikeouts in 3.2 innings of work...gave up a pair of first-inning runs and then surrendered a grand slam to Luis Robert in the fourth inning,

the fifth grand slam he has given up in his career and first since Jason Heyward on June 28, 2019.

Marked his second-shortest start of the season behind only his 1.2-inning outing on April 16 at Boston, when he departed the game due to injury.

- MONTHLY BLUES: Provided a quality start in his last effort on July 24 at Detroit, snapping a two-game losing streak and easing a stretch of struggle in July...went 0-2, 9.45 ERA (13.1 IP, 14 ER) with six walks and eight strikeouts in his three July starts prior to the outing in Detroit.

 ❖ Currently has a 6.98 ERA (19.1 IP, 15 ER) through four starts this month, his fourth-highest ERA in a single month (min. 4 starts) in his career (9.61 ERA in May 2016, 8.79 ERA in September 2020 and 7.79 ERA in July 2016)...in contrast, has a career 3.49 ERA (242.1 IP, 94 ER) in the month of July, the second-lowest monthly ERA (min. 3 starts) in his career, trailing his 2.78 career ERA in August.

 ❖ With his starts on July 8 at Texas (5 ER) and July 14 vs. Chicago-AL (6 ER), Gray allowed five-or-more earned runs in back-to-back starts for the seventh time in his career, and the first time
 - or-more earned runs in back-to-back starts for the seventh time in his career, and the first time since July 18-25, 2021 with Cincinnati...marked the first time he lost back-to-back starts since September 12 (at St. Louis) and September 18, 2021 (vs. Los Angeles-NL).

YOU STAY CLASSY, SAN DIEGO: Gray is slated to make his second career start and appearance against San Diego tonight and his first at Petco Park...earned the win in his one prior start on August 20, 2019 as a member of the Cincinnati Reds at Great American Ball Park (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 10 K)...holds a 4-5 record, 2.74 ERA (69.0 IP, 21 ER) with 24 walks and 78 strikeouts in 11 career

 Making his first Interleague start of the season and 30th appearance (29th start) of his career...
 most recently started against the opposing league on September 29, 2021 in his last start of the season, facing Chicago-AL as a member of the Reds (L, 4.2 IP, 5 H, 5 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 6 K).
 Gray made his major league debut in an Interleague relief appearance on July 10, 2013 vs. Pittsburgh as a member of the Oakland Athletics...pitched 2.0 scoreless innings with one hit and three strikeouts in the outing. and three strikeouts in the outing.

ROAD TRIPPIN': Making his seventh start on the road this season...has found success away from home, going 3-2, 2.97 ERA (30.1 IP, 10 ER) with five walks and 19 strikeouts in his six prior starts (Twins are 4-2 in those games)...this compares to 2-1, 3.96 ERA (38.2 IP, 17 ER) with 13 walks and 45 strikeouts in eight starts at Target Field this season.

- That allowed two-or-fewer runs in five of his six road starts, with the exception coming on July 8 at Texas (4.2 IP. 5 R/ER)
- ♥ Gray has not given up a home run on the road since April 16 at Boston, a two-run shot by Alex Verdugo

KEEP IT IN THE PARK: Has allowed just six home runs through his first 14 starts of the season (69.0 IP)...is tied for second-fewest home runs allowed by an American League starter this season (min. 14 GS), trailing Patrick Sandoval (4 HR in 84 IP) and tied with Kevin Gausman, Ross Stripling and Framber Valdez...also tied for second fewest in all of baseball (min 14 GS)...six home runs allowed are his fewest in his first 14 starts of the season since he allowed only four home runs through his

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...33 of his 64 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .184 (19-for-103) against the pitch...here's a look at his repertoire.

EYE ON THE CLOCK: Has an average pitch tempo of 18.0 seconds when the bases are empty this season, slightly faster than league average (18.1 seconds)...has the fifth slowest tempo among qualified Twins pitchers with the bases empty...his tempo slows to 25.1 seconds with runners on, 1.7 seconds slower than the league average of 23.4, and falls to fourth slowest among qualified Twins pitchers.
