THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their current nine-day, seven-game roadtrip...

The Twins are looking to avoid losing four straight, which would mark their longest losing streak since August 31-September 4, 2021 (also 4), when they dropped two to the Cubs and two to the Rays.

TWINS DROP GAME ONE TO PADRES: The Twins lost to the Padres at Petco Park last night by a score of 10-1...

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed outfielder Max Kepler (right fifth toe fracture) and infielder Miguel Sanó (left knee inflammation) on 10-day Injured List...

IL PLAY: The Twins are 4-9 in Interleague Play this season...against National League opponents this season, they have gone 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field from June 17-19...

TWINS AND PADRES: The Twins are 15-6 all-time against the Padres (8-3 in San Diego), posting a .714 winning percentage, their highest vs. any NL opponent...

MIRANDA WATCH: In 18 July games, Jose Miranda is hitting .361 (22-for-61) with two doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI, a .409 on-base percentage, a .590 slugging percentage and a .999 OPS...

Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 200 at-bats this season, he ranks second in batting average (.275), OPS (.784) and slugging percentage (.469), and third in on-base percentage (.315).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1966, Dave Boswell threw the third one-hitter in Twins history against Baltimore, the lone hit being a seventh-inning single by Russ Snyder...

- ☞ Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in his first start of the second half, as the Twins defeated the Tigers 9-1 on July 24 at Comerica Park...allowed just one run on two hits and one walk, while striking out seven batters in 6.0 innings of work...Twins scored six runs in the final three innings to secure the victory...marked Gray's longest outing (6.0 IP) and fewest runs allowed (1 ER) since June 27 at Cleveland (W, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K)...also was the fewest hits allowed since May 29 vs. Kansas City (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K)...marked his fifth quality start of the season, third most by a Twins starter (Joe Ryan and Devin Smeltzer have 6 QS each).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on July 14 as the Twins fell to the White Sox, 12-2...allowed a season-high six runs on nine hits (1 home run), with one walk and three strikeouts in 3.2 innings of work...gave up a pair of first-inning runs and then surrendered a grand slam to Luis Robert in the fourth inning, the fifth grand slam he has given up in his career and first since Jason Heyward on June 28, 2019.

☞ Marked his second-shortest start of the season behind only his 1.2-inning outing on April 16 at Boston, when he departed the game due to injury.

MONTHLY BLUES: Provided a quality start in his last effort on July 24 at Detroit, snapping a two-game losing streak and easing a stretch of struggle in July...went 0-2, 9.45 ERA (13.1 IP, 14 ER) with six walks and eight strikeouts in his three July starts prior to the outing in Detroit.

☞ Currently has a 6.98 ERA (19.1 IP, 15 ER) through four starts this month, his fourth-highest ERA in a single month (min. 4 starts) in his career (9.61 ERA in May 2016, 8.79 ERA in September 2020 and 7.79 ERA in July 2016)...in contrast, has a career 3.49 ERA (242.1 IP, 94 ER) in the month of July, the second-lowest monthly ERA (min. 3 starts) in his career, trailing his 2.78 career ERA in August.

☞ With his starts on July 8 at Texas (5 ER) and July 14 vs. Chicago-AL (6 ER), Gray allowed five-or-more earned runs in back-to-back starts for the seventh time in his career, and the first time since July 18-25, 2021 with Cincinnati...marked the first time he lost back-to-back starts since September 12 (at St. Louis) and September 18, 2021 (vs. Los Angeles-NL).

YOU STAY CLASSY, SAN DIEGO: Gray is slated to make his second career start and appearance against San Diego tonight and his first at Petco Park...earned the win in his one prior start on August 20, 2019 as a member of the Cincinnati Reds at Great American Ball Park (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 10 K)...holds a 4-5 record, 2.74 ERA (69.0 IP, 21 ER) with 24 walks and 78 strikeouts in 11 career games/starts against the National League West division.

☞ Making his first Interleague start of the season and 30th appearance (29th start) of his career...most recently started against the opposing league on September 29, 2021 in his last start of the season, facing Chicago-AL as a member of the Reds (L, 4.2 IP, 5 H, 5 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 6 K).

☞ Gray made his major league debut in an Interleague relief appearance on July 10, 2013 vs. Pittsburgh as a member of the Oakland Athletics...pitched 2.0 scoreless innings with one hit and three strikeouts in the outing.

ROAD TRIPPING: Making his seventh start on the road this season...has found success away from home, going 3-2, 2.97 ERA (30.1 IP, 10 ER) with five walks and 19 strikeouts in his six prior starts (Twins are 4-2 in those games)...this compares to 2-1, 3.96 ERA (38.2 IP, 17 ER) with 13 walks and 45 strikeouts in eight starts at Target Field this season.

☞ Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in five of his six road starts, with the exception coming on July 8 at Texas (4.2 IP, 5 R/ER)

☞ Gray has not given up a home run on the road since April 16 at Boston, a two-run shot by Alex Verdugo.

KEEP IT IN THE PARK: Has allowed just six home runs through his first 14 starts of the season (69.0 IP)...is tied for second-fewest home runs allowed by an American League starter this season (min. 14 GS), trailing Patrick Sandoval (4 HR in 84 IP) and tied with Kevin Gausman, Ross Stripling and Framber Valdez...also tied for second fewest in all of baseball (min 14 GS)...six home runs allowed are his fewest in his first 14 starts of the season since he allowed only four home runs through his 11 starts in 2020.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...33 of his 64 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .184 (19-for-103) against the pitch...here's a look at his repertoire.

☞ His fastball spin ranks in the 95th percentile per among all major league pitchers this season and his curve spin is in the 87th percentile.

EYE ON THE CLOCK: Has an average pitch tempo of 18.0 seconds when the bases are empty this season, slightly faster than league average (18.1 seconds)...has the fifth slowest tempo among qualified Twins pitchers with the bases empty...his tempo slows to 25.1 seconds with runners on, 1.7 seconds slower than the league average of 23.4, and falls to fourth slowest among qualified Twins pitchers.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY (2022 SEASON: 6-4, 5.02 ERA // CAREER: 52-61, 4.75 ERA)

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is slated to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the San Diego Padres at Petco Park...did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 26 at Milwaukee, after allowing five runs on seven hits (2 home runs), with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.0 innings; the Twins lost, 7-6, in walk-off fashion...his two walks and two home runs allowed both matched season highs...will be facing the Padres for the second time in his career after a start on June 26, 2019 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards with Baltimore; took the loss after yielding five runs on six hits (2 home runs), with three walks and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...tomorrow will also mark his fourth Interleague start/appearance of the season and is 1-1, 3.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 14 strikeouts in his three prior starts against the National League.

- Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

SONNY AND HOT STREAK: Won three consecutive starts from May 18-29...is the third Twins starter this season to win three consecutive starts, joining Dylan Bundy (April 11-April 23) and Joe Ryan (April 15-April 27)...the Twins have also won in nine of his last 12 starts dating back to May 7, including six straight from May 7-June 15, marking the longest streak for a Twins starter this season; the Twins have won in four consecutive starts by Joe Ryan (April 15-May 3) and Bailey Ober (April 22-May 27).

WINNING THE BATTLE: Allowed three-or-fewer earned runs each of his first 11 starts this season, his longest streak to begin the season in his career...allowed two-or-fewer runs in his first eight starts of the season, also his longest such streak to begin the season (prior career best was three starts, done four times)...his streak of two-or-fewer runs allowed in eight-straight starts to begin the season is the longest such streak by a starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present).
