LAST TIME OUT：Bundy did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 26 at Milwaukee．．．allowed five runs on seven hits（2 home runs），with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work．．． departed atter completing 4.0 innings with the Twins trailing $5-3$ ；Minnesota took a 6 －5 lead in the top of the fifth inning on Gio Urshela＇s three－run homer．．．however，the Brewers tied the game in the bottom of that frame and won the game on Luis Urías＇s walk－off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth．

TWO STARTS AGO：Was credited with the win on July 16 vs．Chicago－AL as the Twins won， $6-33$ ．．．tossed 5.1 innings and allowed three runs on five hits，with one walk and three strikeouts．．．marked his sixth win of the season，second most for a Twins starter this season，trailing Joe Ryan＇s seven wins．．．threw 88 pitches，the most he has thrown in a start since tossing 107 on June 18 at Arizona．
$\Phi$ He is now $6-0$ against the White Sox，the only opponent he＇s started against at least thrice and never lost to．

FRIAR FUN：Bundy is facing the Padres for the second time in his career today，after taking the loss in a 10－5 Baltimore defeat on June 26， 2019 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards；allowed five runs on six hits（2 home runs）with three walks and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings．．．．also facing the National League West division for the 14th time（13th start）in his career；is 4－8，4．92 ERA（64．0 IP， 35 ER） with 25 walks and 60 strikeouts in his 13 prior outings（ 12 starts）．

INTERLEAGUE SHOWDOWN：Will make his fourth Interleague start of the season，going 1－1， 3.50 ERA（ $18.0 \mathrm{IP}, 7$ ER）in his prior outings．．．previously started at Arizona on June 18 （W， 8.0 IP， 4 H， 1 R／ER， 0 BB， 7 K ），vs．Colorado on June 24 （L， 6.0 IP， $4 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{ER}, 2 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}$ ）and his last start at Milwaukee on July 26 （ND， 4.0 IP， 5 ER， 2 BB， 5 K ）．．．his 8.0 innings pitched and seven strikeouts at Arizona are both his season high．

ROUGH TIME ON THE ROAD：Bundy struggled on the road this season，going 3－3，6．41 ERA（53．1 IP， 38 ER）with 13 walks and 47 strikeouts in 11 starts（the Twins are 4－7 in those games）．．．however，has been better in his last four road starts，going 2－0，4．33 ERA（ $27.0 \mathrm{IP}, 13 \mathrm{ER}$ ）with six walks and 23 strikeouts，as the Twins have gone 3－2 in those games．．．his five earned runs allowed in his last start on July 26 at Milwaukee were his most in a road start since permitting six runs（ 5 earned）on June 4 at Toronto．．．．has not recorded loss on the road since June 4 at Toronto（ $2.1 \mathrm{IP}, 6 \mathrm{R} / 5 \mathrm{ER}, 2 \mathrm{HR}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}$ ）．

WELL SUPPORTED：The Twins have scored 69 runs in support of Bundy in his 16 starts this season， including six runs of support in each of his last two starts．．．．he has a 7.36 run support average this season，good for second in baseball（min．75．0 IP），behind Atlanta＇s lan Anderson（7．40 RSA）．
WALKING IN STYLE：Has walked just 19 batters in 84.1 innings，equating to a career－low 5.3 walk percentage and a 2.03 walks－per－9．0 IP．．．．also has a career－high first－pitch swing percentage（ $34.0 \%$ ） and first－pitch strike percentage（ $68.0 \%$ ）．

His 5.3 walk percentage ranks 12th in the American League（min． 75.0 IP ），while his 2.03 walks－per－9．0 IP is 14th under those same parameters．
