THE TWINS: Have gone 3-3 through six games on their current nine-day, seven-game roadtrip, going 2-0 at Detroit, 0-2 at Milwaukee and a split of the first two games in San Diego this weekend...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale at San Diego...following today's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Tigers from Monday-Wednesday, then four against the Blue Jays from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins are 27-22 at home and 26-25 on the road.
⚡ The Twins have gone 6-3 in rubber games this season.

PETCO POSITIVE: The Twins beat the Padres yesterday at Petco Park by a score of 7-4, evening the three-game series at one game apiece...Minnesota held a 2-1 lead until scoring five runs in the top of the eighth inning...Sonny Gray (6-3) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by home runs from Byron Buxton (26) and Carlos Correa (13).

AUGUST RUSH: Starting tomorrow night against the Tigers, the Twins will host 20 games at Target Field in August – the club's most home contests in a single month since playing a Minnesota-era record 22 at Metropolitan Stadium in June 1977.

100 GREATEST HITS: Byron Buxton hit his 26th home run last night, which ranks tied for fifth most in baseball with Pete Alonso, trailing Aaron Judge (42), Kyle Schwarber (32), Yordan Alvarez (30) and Austin Riley (29)...the 26th home run came in the club's 100th game of the season...below are the all-time Twins (since 1961) to reach 25 home runs in the first 100 games of a season:

THE BUCK TRUCK AMERICAN TOUR: 11 of Buxton's 26 home runs have come on the road, tied for 11th most in baseball...he has homered four times in his last five road games and six times in his last 14...additionally, he has homered in each of his last nine road cities he has played in: Toronto, Seattle, Arizona, Cleveland, Chicago, Texas, Los Angeles (All-Star Game), Milwaukee and San Diego.

IL PLAY: The Twins are 5-9 in Interleague Play this season...against National League opponents this season, they have gone 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field from June 17-19, 2-1 against the Rockies at Target Field from June 24-26, 1-1 against the Brewers at Target Field from July 12-13, 0-2 against Milwaukee at American Family Field this week and 1-1 against the Padres this weekend...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is (5 games): two games vs. Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10 and three games vs. San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28.

⚡ Jose Miranda is 14-for-30 (.467) against IL opponents this season.

TWINS AND FRIARS: The Twins are 16-6 all-time against the Padres (9-3 in San Diego), posting a .727 winning percentage, their highest vs. any NL opponent and the best record for any club vs. any single opponent since 1900 (minimum 20 games played)...the Twins are 6-1 all-time against the Padres at Target Field, 7-2 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium, and 1-2 at Metrodome.

MIRANDA WATCH: In 19 July games, Jose Miranda is hitting .359 (23-for-64) with two doubles, four home runs, 18 RBI, a .414 on-base percentage, a .578 slugging percentage and a .992 OPS...among AL players this month, he ranks fourth in batting average, tied for sixth in RBI, eighth in OPS, 10th in on-base and 12th in slugging.
⚡ Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 200 at-bats this season, he ranks second in batting average (.276), OPS (.785) and slugging percentage (.467), and third in on-base percentage (.318).

HE IS I AND I AM TIM: Tim Beckham is getting his first start in a major league game today since August 4, 2019 at Houston, while playing for Seattle...the 2008 first overall pick by the Tampa Bay Rays has played in 472 career major league games, hitting .249 (402-for-1614) with 75 doubles, 15 triples, 63 home runs, 198 RBI and a .733 OPS...he had his contract selected by Minnesota yesterday...in 33 games for Triple-A St. Paul, he hit .413 (52-for-126) with six doubles, five home runs, 31 RBI, a .483 on-base percentage, a .579 slugging percentage and a 1.062 OPS.

SERIES FINALE: The Twins are 15-11-5 in series play this season, going 8-5-3 at home and 7-6-2 on the road...they began the season going 11-5-4 in series play, but have gone 4-6-1 since...Minnesota's last series victory came at the beginning of this roadtrip, sweeping Detroit in two games...the Twins last series win in Interleague Play came June 24-26, taking two of three against Colorado at Target Field...the Twins are seeking their first series win in a National League city since sweeping the Cubs in two games in Chicago from September 21-22, 2021.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul infielder Jermaine Palacios and right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

⚡ Palacios, 26, played in six games for the Saints this week, hitting .409 (9-for-22) with one double, three home runs, five RBI, three walks, a .500 on-base percentage, an .864 slugging percentage and a 1.364 OPS...the shortstop's week included a two-homer game on Friday vs. Iowa and three multi-hit games.

⚡ Henriquez, 22, appeared in one game in relief for the Saints this week on Thursday vs. Iowa, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with five hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...the Bonaio, Dominican Republic native has gone 1-1, 3.12 ERA (26.0 IP, 9 ER) with eight walks and 29 strikeouts in his last six games (4 starts) for the Saints...he was acquired by the Twins via trade with Texas on March 12, along with infielder Isiah Kiner-Falefa, in exchange for catcher Mitch Garver.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1989, the Twins traded the previous season's AL Cy Young Award winner, Frank Viola, to the Mets for five players, including pitchers Rick Aguilera, David West and minor leaguer Kevin Tapani...Viola became the first Cy Young Award winner to be traded during the following season, while Aguilera (42 saves), West (4 wins) and Tapani (16-9, 2.99 ERA) all helped the Twins win the 1991 World Series...in 2018, the Twins traded second baseman Brian Dozier to the Dodgers, in exchange for second baseman Logan Forsythe, outfielder Luke Raley and left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer.

LAST TIME OUT: Bundy did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 26 at Milwaukee...allowed five runs on seven hits (2 home runs), with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...departed after completing 4.0 innings with the Twins trailing 5-3; Minnesota took a 6-5 lead in the top of the fifth inning on Gio Urshela's three-run homer...however, the Brewers tied the game in the bottom of that frame and won the game on Luis Urias's walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was credited with the win on July 16 vs. Chicago-AL as the Twins won, 6-3...tossed 5.1 innings and allowed three runs on five hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...marked his sixth win of the season, second most for a Twins starter this season, trailing Joe Ryan's seven wins...threw 88 pitches, the most he has thrown in a start since tossing 107 on June 18 at Arizona.

- ⌘ He is now 6-0 against the White Sox, the only opponent he's started against at least thrice and never lost to.

FRIAR FUN: Bundy is facing the Padres for the second time in his career today, after taking the loss in a 10-5 Baltimore defeat on June 26, 2019 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards; allowed five runs on six hits (2 home runs) with three walks and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings...also facing the National League West division for the 14th time (13th start) in his career; is 4-8, 4.92 ERA (64.0 IP, 35 ER) with 25 walks and 60 strikeouts in his 13 prior outings (12 starts).

INTERLEAGUE SHOWDOWN: Will make his fourth Interleague start of the season, going 1-1, 3.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 7 ER) in his prior outings...previously started at Arizona on June 18 (W, 8.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 7 K), vs. Colorado on June 24 (L, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 2 K) and his last start at Milwaukee on July 26 (ND, 4.0 IP, 5 ER, 2 BB, 5 K)...his 8.0 innings pitched and seven strikeouts at Arizona are both his season high.

- ⌘ Bundy is 8-10, 4.99 ERA (104.2 IP, 58 ER) with 38 walks and 98 strikeouts in 20 career Inter-league games (19 starts)...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 12 of those 20 efforts.

ROUGH TIME ON THE ROAD: Bundy struggled on the road this season, going 3-3, 6.41 ERA (53.1 IP, 38 ER) with 13 walks and 47 strikeouts in 11 starts (the Twins are 4-7 in those games)...however, has been better in his last four road starts, going 2-0, 4.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 13 ER) with six walks and 23 strikeouts, as the Twins have gone 3-2 in those games...his five earned runs allowed in his last start at July 26 at Milwaukee were his most in a road start since permitting six runs (5 earned) on June 4 at Toronto...has not recorded loss on the road since June 4 at Toronto (2.1 IP, 6 R/5 ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 2 K).

- ⌘ 10 of the 13 home runs Bundy has allowed this season have come on the road.
- ⌘ Bundy is 3-1, 2.61 ERA (31.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts in six starts at Target Field this season
