THE TWINS: Went 2-1 on their short three-game homestand series with Baltimore, winning the first two games in walk-off fashion, followed by a loss yesterday afternoon...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with the first of three against the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field through Wednesday...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Texas to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then play the Rangers for three games at Globe Life Field over the weekend...Twins are 25-18 at home and 20-19 on the road.

SOLO HOME RUNS CAN'T BEAT YOU, BUT THREE MIGHT: The Twins lost to the Orioles on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-1, failing to record their fifth sweep of the season... Devin Smeltzer (4-2) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on six hits (3 home runs) in 6.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded just four hits, went 1-for-5 with runners in scoring position and left six men on base.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Trevor Megill from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Megill, who missed the Twins' last 18 games with right shoulder impingement, made one rehab appearance with Triple-A St. Paul on Saturday night vs. Omaha, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning with one strikeout...to make room for Megill on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Juan Minaya for release or assignment...Minaya, who had his contract selected on July 1, appeared in two games for the Twins during last weekend's series against Baltimore, pitching 3.1 scoreless innings with four strikeouts.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the fourth of 19 meetings this season...the Twins swept their first series from April 22-24 at Target Field, the club's first sweep of the 2022 season...this series marks the Twins' first trip to Guaranteed Rate Field since July 19-21, 2021, when they split the four-game series...Twins went just 2-8 at Chicago-AL last season.

Twins have won five straight over the Sox...their last streak longer was a seven-game winning streak from September 28, 2018-May 26, 2019.
Jorge Polanco is hitting .351 (13-for-37) with one double, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI and a 1.160 OPS in his last 10 games against the White Sox...Polo has 16 career home runs against the Sox, including 11 at Guaranteed Rate Field — both his most against any opponent/ballpark.
Luis Arraez has hit safely in 12 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .409 (18-for-44) with a .901 OPS.
The Twins have hit 87 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (51 games), ahead of second place Cleveland's 65...56 of those 87 have come in Chicago (27 games).

FIREWORX: Byron Buxton has hit safely in nine straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 27, 2019...in that span, he is hitting .514 (19-for-37) with four doubles, seven home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.728 OPS...he has homered in five straight against the Sox (7 HR total)...below are the club records for a home run streak against a single opponent:

STARTER STRENGTH: Twins starters have combined to go 6-3, 2.40 ERA (90.0 IP, 24 ER) with 19 walks, 63 strikeouts, a .213 opponent batting average and nine quality starts in their last 16 games...they have not allowed more than three earned runs in any of those 16...below are the starting pitcher ranks among AL teams in a few categories:

LUKEY GOOD AS GOLD: Luis Arraez enters today leading baseball in batting average at .344, three points ahead of Paul Goldschmidt (.341)...he ranks second in on-base percentage at .419, trailing Goldschmidt by four points (.423)...he also leads baseball in multi-hit games (30), batting average vs. right-handed pitching (.372), batting average against fastballs (.394) and ranks fifth in RISP average (.396).

GETTING OFFENSIVE: The Twins finished their three-game series against Baltimore going 19-for-93 (.204) with just eight extra-base hits, five walks and 2.7 runs-per-game...despite the three-game stretch, they still rank second in the AL in total bases (1,140), fourth in batting average (.251), runs (364), walks (266), on-base percentage (.321), slugging percentage (.414), and fifth in OPS (.735).

ON THIS DAY IN 1961: At Metropolitan Stadium, the Twins swept a pair from the White Sox, behind Julio Becquer's ninth-inning, pinch-hit grand slam...in the second game, Harmon Killebrew hit an inside-the-park homer, marking the first in Twins history.

- Making his 14th start of the season and 147th of his career...175th career appearance. Will be his first career start and appearance on the Fourth of July...pitched on July 5 in 2019 in Toronto (as a member of the Orioles) and in 2021 vs. Boston (as a member of the Angels). Tonight will be Bundy's second start against Chicago-AL this season, after starting on April 23 (W, 5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 4 K)...marks his eighth career appearance (7th start) vs. Chicago-AL and he is 5-0, 3.46 ERA (39 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks and 41 strikeouts in his prior outings. Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed three runs (2 earned) on six hits, with one walk and one strikeout in 5.0 innings pitched in a no-decision at Cleveland on June 29...loaded the bases on three-straight singles to begin the bottom of the first inning; two of those runners would score on a Franmil Reyes RBI ground out and a throwing error by second baseman Luis Arraez...the Guardians also plated one run in the bottom of the third inning on a Josh Naylor sacrifice fly...the game entered extra innings tied at 3-3 and the Twins scored three runs in the top of the 10th...Cleveland scored four in the bottom half of the frame to walk off on Josh Naylor's two-out, two-run home run to win, 7-6.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was dealt the loss against the Rockies on June 24 at Target Field...tossed his second consecutive quality start after going 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits, with two walks and two strikeouts in a pitching duel opposite the Rockies' Germán Márquez, resulting in a 1-0 Twins defeat...marked his first back-to-back quality starts since April 25-May 2, 2021 (with Los Angeles-AL)...has allowed two earned runs in his last two starts combined (14.0 IP), after allowing 13 earned runs in his previous three starts combined (12.1 IP)...the last time Bundy went 6.0-or-more innings with one-or-fewer runs allowed in consecutive starts was August 6-11, 2020 (with Los Angeles-AL).

SUCCESS IN THE WINDY CITY: Facing Chicago-AL for the second time this season, after earning the win on April 23 at Target Field (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 4 K)...is 5-0, 3.46 ERA (39.0 IP, 15 ER) with 31 hits, seven walks and 41 strikeouts in seven career games (6 starts) vs. the White Sox. Bundy's five career wins against the White Sox are tied with his totals against Tampa Bay and Toronto for his most against any single opponent in his career, behind his six wins against Texas...Chicago-AL is the only team he's faced at least four times in his career and never lost against. In his career, Bundy is 3-0, 4.05 ERA (20.0 IP, 9 ER) with 12 hits allowed, five walks and 27 strikeouts at Guaranteed Rate Field...his last start on the South Side came on May 24, 2018 as a member of the Baltimore Orioles (W, 9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 14 K).

ON THE ROAD: Bundy will be making his ninth start away from Target Field this season...has struggled more on the road than at home this season, going 2-3, 6.41 ERA (39.1 IP, 28 ER) with eight walks, 32 strikeouts and a .315 opponent batting average (52-for-165) in eight starts, although he dominated the Diamondbacks over 8.0 innings in his second-to-last road start on June 18...has pitched well when facing opponents at home this season, going 2-1, 2.10 ERA (25.2 IP, 6 ER) with five walks, 15 strikeouts and a .200 opponent batting average (19-for-95). In his career, Bundy has posted slightly better numbers at home than on the road, going 25-33, 4.56 ERA (452.0 IP, 229 ER) with 134 walks and 413 strikeouts in 93 home appearances (79 starts)...this compares to 25-28, 4.90 ERA (383.2 IP, 209 ER) with 136 walks and 392 strikeouts in 81 road appearances (67 starts).

GOOD THINGS COME IN THREES: Has pitched well in his last three starts, going 1-1, 1.89 ERA (19.0 IP, 4 ER) with three walks and 10 strikeouts...earned the win at Arizona on June 18 after tossing 8.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts...was dealt the loss on June 24 vs. Colorado despite throwing 6.0 innings and giving up just one run (4 H, 2 BB, 2 K)...did not factor into the decision in his most recent start on June 29 vs. Cleveland.

WALKING IN STYLE: Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in eight of his last 10 starts (12 BB total)...even with his last 10 starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 4.7 walk percentage and a 1.80 walks-per-nine...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (33.7%) and first-pitch strike percentage (68.1%). His chase rate ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball this season and his walk percentage ranks in the 91st percentile.

KEEP UP THE TEMPO: Has an average pitch tempo of 15.9 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant...is the fastest worker on the Twins active roster with the bases empty, followed by Joe Smith (16.0 seconds) and Joao Duran (16.3 seconds)...trails Cole Sands (14.0 seconds) and Bailey Ober (15.7 seconds) as the fastest workers for Minnesota this season...works 2.2 seconds faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds. His pitch tempo falls to 22.5 seconds when there are runners on base, the fifth fastest on the active roster and sixth fastest worker for the Twins this season.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: According to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 13 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Bundy went 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.

- Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (Elias). Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (Elias). Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 2-3, 3.08 ERA // CAREER: 63-84, 3.84 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Archer is scheduled to start tomorrow night's game against Chicago-AL...did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 30 at Cleveland...tossed 4.0 innings and allowed one run on one hit, with a career-high-tying six walks and two strikeouts...faced the White Sox earlier this season on April 24 (ND, 3.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 3 BB, 2 K)...is a career 4-2, 4.27 ERA (52.2 IP, 25 ER) with 48 hits, 17 walks and 51 strikeouts in 11 games (10 starts) against Chicago-AL.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts. In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes. Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhardt Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season. Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City. Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th). Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta. Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012). Named Orioles top prospect according to Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus following the 2014 season. Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews. Named Carolina League 2012 Midseason All-Star and Baseball America Minor League All-Star. Named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in April, 2012 (30 consecutive scoreless IP) and named Orioles top prospect by Baseball America following the season. Originally selected by Baltimore in the first round (4th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

BUNDY VS. CHICAGO-AL
