THE TWINS: After completing their short three-game homestand series with Baltimore by going 2-1, the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a victory over the White Sox in Chicago last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three on the South Side...after tomorrow's series finale, Minnesota will travel to Texas to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then play the Rangers for three games at Globe Life Field over the weekend...Twins are 25-18 at home and 21-19 on the road.

TWINS WIN WITH 10TH INNING 4-SPOT ON THE 4TH: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 6-3 in 10 innings, which included a four-run 10th... Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with six strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, three coming from Luis Arraez...Byron Buxton drove in two runs and hit his 22nd homer of the season, his third homer in his last six games.

In the seventh inning, the Twins turned the first 8-5 triple play in baseball history...with runners on first and second, AJ Pollock flied out to Byron Buxton at the wall, who then threw it to Gio Urshela, who recorded outs on the bases of Yoán Moncada and Adam Engel...it marked the 16th triple play in club history (2nd involving two players) and their fourth in their last four seasons.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Chris Archer on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to July 2) with left hip tightness...Archer, 33, has gone 2-3, 3.08 ERA (61.1 IP, 21 ER), 30 walks, 47 strikeouts, a .208 opponent batting average and a 1.26 WHIP in 15 starts for the Twins this season...to replace Archer on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Josh Winder from Triple-A St. Paul.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the fifth of 19 meetings this season... Twins are 4-0 against the Sox, their best start against Chicago since going 6-0 to start the 2011 season.

Twins have won six straight over the Sox...their last streak longer was a seven-game winning streak from September 28, 2018-May 26, 2019.

Jorge Polanco is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with one double, one triple, three home runs, nine RBI and a .989 OPS in his last 11 games against the White Sox...Polo has 16 career home runs against the Sox, including 11 at Guaranteed Rate Field — both his most against any opponent/ballpark.

Luis Arraez has hit safely in 13 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .429 (21-for-49) with a .972 OPS.

The Twins have hit 88 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (52 games), ahead of second place Cleveland's 65...57 of those 88 have come in Chicago (28 games).

BUX WEARS OUT SOX: Byron Buxton has hit safely in 10 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 27, 2019...in that span, he is hitting .476 (20-for-42) with four doubles, eight home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.643 OPS...he has homered in six straight against the Sox (8 HR total)...below are the club records for a home run streak against a single opponent:

WORTH NOTING: Buxton's streak is the longest for a Twins outfielder against the White Sox since 2013, when Oswaldo Arcia homered in four-straight...Arcia's jersey was spotted behind the Twins dugout pregame last night by MLB.com Twins beat writer Do-Hyoung Park.

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton hit his 22nd home run of the season last night and is tied with Anthony Rizzo for fourth in the AL in home runs, trailing Aaron Judge (29), Yordan Alvarez (24) and Mike Trout (23)...in Buxton's last 162 games, he is hitting .264 (157-for-595) with 36 doubles, two triples, 54 home runs, 99 RBI, 115 runs scored, a .603 slugging percentage and a .920 OPS...Twins are 92-70 in those games...he is on pace for 42 home runs this season.

STARTER STRENGTH: Twins starters have combined to go 6-3, 2.37 ERA (95.0 IP, 25 ER) with 20 walks, 69 strikeouts, a .211 opponent batting average and nine quality starts in their last 17 games...they have not allowed more than three earned runs in any of those 17 and have allowed one run-or-fewer in 10 of those.

ARRAEZING STAR: After going 3-for-5 last night, Luis Arraez now has an MLB-most 31 multi-hit games, including multiple hits in four of his last five games and seven of his last 11...additionally, he has five doubles in his last four games...he enters today leading baseball in batting average at .348, eight points ahead of Paul Goldschmidt (.340) and is tied with Goldschmidt in on-base percentage at .422...he also leads baseball in batting average vs. right-handed pitching (.377), batting average against fastballs (.398) and ranks third in RISP average (.408).

SERIES STUFF: The Twins are 13-8-4 in series play this season, going 8-4-2 at home and 5-4-2 on the road...they are seeking their first series win on the road since June 13-15 at Seattle...Twins are seeking their first series win at Guaranteed Rate Field since taking two of three from July 24-26, 2020, going 0-3-1 here since.

LIVING HIS BEST KIRIL-LIFFE: Alex Kirilloff is hitting .347 (58-for-167) with 13 doubles, 11 home runs, 45 RBI, a .419 on-base percentage, a .623 slugging percentage and a 1.042 OPS in his last 45 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota...in 17 games for the Twins since being recalled from St. Paul on June 17, he has six doubles and 14 RBI.

EASY COME, EASY GO-RDON: Nick Gordon has hit .500 (7-for-14) with one double, two home runs, three RBI and a 1.563 OPS in his last eight games...in fact, in his last 12 starts, dating back to June 10, he is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with one double, three home runs, five RBI, a .575 slugging percentage and a .947 OPS...among all Twins with at least 150 plate appearances, he ranks fourth in OPS (.729), trailing Luis Arraez (.876), Byron Buxton (.875) and Carlos Correa (.824).

IT'S JORGE DAY!: Jorge Polanco is celebrating his 29th birthday today...he has played four career games on his birthday, going 3-for-18 with one double, one home run and two RBI...he shares a birthday with former Twin Jesse Crain (41) and LAA's Shohei Ohtani (28).

THE FUTURE: Major League Baseball plans to announce the rosters for the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game tomorrow and Thursday...the following players have represented the Twins over the last 10 years: Josh Winder in 2021, Jordan Balazovic and Royce Lewis in 2019, Alex Kirilloff and Lewis Thorpe in 2018, Nick Gordon in 2017, JT Chargois in 2016, José Berrios in 2015 & '14, Max Kepler in 2015, Trevor May and Kennys Vargas in 2014, Byron Buxton and Miguel Sanó in 2013, and Oswaldo Arcia in 2012.

- Was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul today after Chris Archer was placed on the 15-day Injured List with left hip tightness...was added to Minnesota's "taxi squad" prior to yesterday's series opener.
- Rookie is making his fifth career major league start tonight...also his ninth career appearance, after making his major league debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL.
- Making his first career start and second appearance against Chicago-AL...worked 4.0 relief innings on April 24 at Target Field, allowing one run on three hits with no walks and two strikeouts.
- Entered 2022 ranked as the seventh-best prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com.
- Selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Virginia Military Institute.

BACK IN THE BIG LEAGUES: Winder was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul today when Chris Archer was placed on the 15-day Injured List with left hip tightness...marks his third stint with the Twins this season...made his first career Opening Day roster and made seven appearances (three starts) before landing on the 15-day IL on May 21 with right shoulder impingement...was returned from his rehab assignment, reinstated from the IL and optioned to St. Paul on June 23 after missing 33 games; was appointed as the 27th man for the Twins' June 28 doubleheader in Cleveland.

- Made three starts on rehab assignment with the Saints (June 10, June 16 and June 22), with a 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP, 4 ER)...did not pitch for St. Paul upon his most recent stay.

LAST MAJOR LEAGUE START: Appointed as the 27th man for the June 28 doubleheader in Cleveland and earned the win in the nightcap, combining with two Twins relievers on a five-hit shutout in the 6-0 victory...matched his career high for a third time with 6.0 innings, allowing four hits with one walk and one strikeout...held the Guardians hitless in nine at-bats with runners in scoring position (worked around a two-on, none-out jam in the first, stranded a leadoff double in the second, and was not bothered by a two-out double in the fourth nor a one-out two-bagger in the sixth).

- Threw a career-best 72.8 percent of his pitches for strikes, while his 81 pitches (59 strikes) were two shy of his career high.

TWO MLB APPEARANCES AGO: Winder's last major league outing before landing on the Injured List occurred on May 17 at Oakland...took his second-straight loss after yielding a career-high five runs on nine hits (1 home run), with two walks and one strikeout in 3.2 innings of relief in a 5-2 Twins setback...piggybacked off starting pitcher Dylan Bundy, who worked 3.0 scoreless innings (2 H, 2 BB, 3 K) to begin the game, in his first start since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List.

VS. THE WHITE SOX: Is set to make his first career start and second appearance against Chicago-AL...worked 4.0 innings of relief in the Twins' 6-4, 10-inning victory (via a Byron Buxton 3-run, walk-off HR) on April 24 at Target Field, allowing one run (on a Danny Mendick solo HR) on three hits, with no walks and two strikeouts.

- Combined with his June 28 start at Cleveland, is 1-0, 0.90 ERA (10.0 IP, 1 ER) in his first two career outings (1 start) against the American League Central.

IT'S TIME TO START: Winder has gone 3-1, 1.27 ERA (21.1 IP, 3 ER) as a major league starter; per Baseball Reference, his 1.27 ERA is fifth lowest in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first four career starts (since 1913, when earned runs became an official stat)...Milo Candini posted a 0.77 ERA (35.0 IP, 3 ER) in 1943, Joe Mays opened at 0.82 (22.0 IP, 2 ER) in 1999, Horace Lisenbee logged a 1.09 mark (33.0 IP, 4 ER) in 1927 and Jack Kralick pitched to a 1.19 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER) in 1960.

- Has 18 strikeouts against five walks as a starter, with a 0.94 WHIP and a .197/.253/.316 opponent slash line (15-for-76 with 6 2B, 1 HR and 1 HBP).
- Rookie has worked 6.0 innings while allowing zero earned runs in three of his first four big league starts (May 1 at Tampa Bay, May 6 vs. Oakland and in Game 2 of the June 28 doubleheader at Cleveland).
- His major league debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL marked his first career professional relief outing...is 0-1, 5.79 ERA (14.0 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and six strikeouts in four appearances out of the Twins bullpen.
- All 44 of his career minor league outings from 2018-21 were starts, going 14-3, 2.82 ERA (236.1 IP, 74 ER) with 49 walks and 240 strikeouts over three seasons...15 of his 44 starts were quality and recorded eight starts of at least 7.0 innings (including two of 8.0 IP)...also fanned seven-or-more batters in 17 starts, including a career-high nine batters thrice

THE ARSENAL: Winder has displayed a four-pitch mix through his first eight career appearances, relying primarily on his four-seam fastball, which he's thrown 40.3 percent of the time...his put-away pitch has been his slider, as 12 of his 24 career strikeouts have come on the pitch...opponents are a combined 9-for-65 (.138) with 15 strikeouts off his slider and curveball...here is a look at the rookie's arsenal this season, per Baseball Savant:

2022 SUMMARY: Winder was named to the Twins' Opening Day roster this year, the first of his career.

- Made his major league debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL at Target Field...entered the game in the top of the fifth and struck out Will Smith, his first batter faced.
- In his second appearance April 16 at Boston, tossed 5.1 relief innings and permitted two runs on four hits (1 HR), with one walk and two strikeouts...became the first Twins rookie to pitch at least 5.1 innings in relief since Kohl Stewart (6.0 IP) on September 2, 2018 vs. Detroit...also became the first Twins pitcher to work at least 5.1 innings in relief within his first two career games since Pat Dean (5.1 IP) on May 16, 2016 at Detroit.
- Made his first career major league start on May 1 at Tampa Bay...tossed 6.0 shutout innings, giving up only two hits and one walk while striking out seven batters, en route to his first career major league win...Twins scored five runs in the first inning and went on to win, 9-3.
- Was the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) and fifth in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with at least 6.0 shutout innings and two-or-fewer hits allowed in his first career start...the others are Mike Fomiele on September 2, 1952 (9.0 IP, 1 H, 6 BB, 4 K), Wally Holborow on August 4, 1945 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K), Claude Thomas on September 18, 1916 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 5 BB, 2 K) and George Dumont on September 14, 1915 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 4 BB, 2 K).
- Made his second career start on May 6 against Oakland, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one unearned run, with no walks and a career-high eight strikeouts as the Twins won, 2-1.
- His 15 strikeouts between his May 1 and May 6 starts tied for the most within a player's first two career starts in Twins/Senators history (other: Doc Ayers, Sept. 22-30, 1913)...became the sixth pitcher in American/National League history to record at least 15 strikeouts with one or fewer walks within his first two career starts.
- Was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 21 (retroactive to May 18) with right shoulder impingement...returned from rehab, reinstated from the Injured List and optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on June 23 after missing 33 games.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2022 SEASON: 6-3, 3.00 ERA // CAREER: 8-4, 3.30 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale vs. the Chicago White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field...will mark his fifth start since being reinstated from the COVID IL on June 14; is 1-1, 4.37 ERA (22.2 IP, 11 ER) in those efforts, after going 5-2, 2.28 ERA (43.1 IP, 11 ER) in eight starts prior...matched his career high with 7.0 innings in his last start on July 1 vs. Baltimore, holding the Orioles to one run on two hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in a no-decision (Twins won, 3-2, on Byron Buxton's 2-run, walk-off homer in the 9th)...will face the White Sox for the first time in his career...is 4-0, 1.47 ERA (30.2 IP, 5 ER) in five starts against the American League Central in 2022; is 5-0, 2.28 ERA (47.1 IP, 12 ER) in eight career starts within the division.

- Entered the 2022 season ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com; has since graduated from the prospect ranks...2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
- Made his major league debut in a relief appearance for the Twins on April 12, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-NL (1.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 1 K).
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.
- In 2021, went a combined 4-0, 2.63 ERA (72.0 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks, 80 strikeouts and a .211 (55-for-261) opponent batting average in 14 starts between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul.
- Selected to the American League team in the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field...tossed 0.1 inning (1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 K, 1 WP).
- Did not play in a professional game in 2020, as the minor league season was cancelled due to COVID-19...was not part of Twins' 60-man player pool...participated in instructional league in October in Fort Myers, FL.
- Spent the 2021 season with Low-A Cedar Rapids, going 7-2, 2.65 ERA (125.2 IP, 37 ER) with 30 walks and 118 strikeouts in 21 starts...went 5-1, 2.50 ERA (68.1 IP, 19 ER) with 19 walks and 56 strikeouts prior to the All-Star Game, earning a spot on the Midwest League Midseason All-Star team...tossed 0.2 scoreless inning with two strikeouts for the West All-Stars.
- Made professional debut with Rookie-Elizabethton in 2018, after being drafted by Minnesota...went 3-1, 3.72 ERA (38.2 IP, 16 ER) with six walks and 42 strikeouts in nine starts for the E-Twins.
- Selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Virginia Military Institute; signed by scout Matt Williams.
