TWINS SLUG ON SOUTH SIDE TO TAKE SERIES: The Twins beat the White Sox last night a Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 8 -2....Jsh Winder (4-2) was the starter last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 8 -2....osh winder (4-2) was the starter and winner,
allowing two runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Caleb Thielbar (1.0), Tyler Duffey (1.0), Trevor Megill ( (0.1) and Harel Cotton (1.2) combined for 4.0 scoreless innings with no walk's allowed and seven strikeouts..the offense recorded 12 hits, five being home runs from fourth game this season with five-plus homers, one short of their season-high of six done on Apriil 10 vs. Seattle...the win secured the series victory, their 14th of the season (14-8-4).

Twins have won seven straight over the Sox...their last streak as long was a seven-game winning streak from September 28, 2018-May 26 , 2019...their last eight-plus-game

streak was September 14 2010-July 8 , 2011 when they won nine straight
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is hitting 326 (14-for-43) with one double, one triple, four home runs, 11 home runs against the Sox, including 12 at Guaranteed Rate Field - both his most against any opponent/ballpark.

2021 ...n that span he is hitting . 40 (22-for-54) with a 920 OPS.

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton enters today with 22 home runs, tied with Anthony Rizzo for fourth in the AL, trailing Aaron Judge (29), Yordan Alvarez (25) 'and Mike Trout (23)...Buxton has hit a home run every 11.09 at-bats since 2020 which leads baseball among players with a
minimum of 500 plate appearances, ahead of Fernando Tatis Jr. (11.90), Mike Trout (12.00) minimum of 500 plate appearances, ahead of Fernando Tatis Jr . (11.90),
and Aaron Judge (12.34)...Buck is on pace to hit 42 homers this season.
KINGS OF THE HILL: Twins starters have combined to go 7-3,2.43 ERA (100.0 IP, 27 ER) with 22 walks, 72 strikeouts, a 219 opponent batting average and nine quality starts in their last 18 games...they have not allowed more than three earned runs in any of those 18 and have allowed one run-or-fewer in 10 of those.
$\Phi$ Additionally, the Twins' ${ }^{\prime}$. 62 team ERA through the first 84 games of the season is their lowest mark since 1992 (3.54 ERA).
LIVING HIS BEST KIRIL-LIFFE: Alex Kirilloff is hitting. 357 ( 61 -for-171) with 13 doubles, 13 home runs. 48 RBI, a. 426 on-base percentage, a 661 slugging percentage and a 1.086 OPS
in his last 46 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota in 18 games for the Twins since being recalled from St. Paul on June 17, he is hitting. 306 (19-for-62) with six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, a .548 slugging percentage and an . 877 OPS.
EASY COME, EASY GO-RDON: Nick Gordon has hit . 533 (8-for-15) with one double, two home runs, three RBI and a 1.588 OPS in his last nine games...in fact, in his last 12 starts, dating .575 slugging percentage and a .9470 OPS .
HOT JORGE SUMMER: Jorge Polanco hit his 10th home run of the season last night, giving him double-digit homers for the fourth time in his career (career-high 33 in 2021 )..in his last 13
games, dating back to June 7 , he is hitting . 298 (14-for-47) with two doubles four home runs. I2 RBI, eight walks, a 393 on-base percentage and a 989 OPS...in July of 2021 , Polo hit . 327 (34-for-184) with a. 9140 OPS in 26 games..in fact, from July 1,2021 through the end of the
season, he hit 24 home runs with a 570 slugging percentage and an 8950 OS in 81 game season, he hit 24 home runs with a .570 slügging percentage and an .895 OPS in 81 games. MIRANDA RIGHTS: Jose Miranda is hitting. 306 (33-for-108) with nine doubles, five home 20 since Ma 20 (minimim 00 at-bats) he leads all MLB rookies in batting average, third in slugging and OPS, fifth in on-base and sixth in doubles.
ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2014, Glen Perkins and Kurt Suzuki were named to the AL All-Star team as they combined to pitch/catch the ninth inning and secure the 5-3 AL victory with a 20-14 win in game one of a DH at Chicago-AL; Joe Mauer had four hits and five RBI SPEAKING OF PERK: Bally Sports North analyst, Glen Perkins, saved 16 games in his career against the White Sox ( 47 games), tied for his most against any opponent (also Cleveland)...Perk's last save against the White Sox came on September 1, 2015 at Target Field,
closing out a game started by Tyler Duffey...Perk recorded the final out, getting Jose Abreu to fly out to Byron Buxton as the Twins won 8-6.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 1 vs. Baltimore at Target Field; departed with the score tied 1-1 - after the 0's took a one-run lead in the eighth, the Twins scored twice in the ninth on Byron Buxton's two-run, walk-off home run to claim a 3-2 walk-off win...Ryan allowed one run on two hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in a career-high-tying 7.0 innings of work....marked his sixth quality start of the season - matching Devin Smeltzer for the team lead - and his eighth allowing two-or-fewer runs.
$\Phi$ Four of his seven strikeouts were looking, his most in a start this season and the second most in a start in his career, behind his career-best six on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL.
Ryan is 1-1, 4.37 ERA (22.2 IP, 11 ER ) in four starts since being reinstated from the COVID
STARTS AGO. Ryan earned the win on June 26 vs Colorado a 6-3 Twins victory vielded three runs on a career-high eight hits, with one walk and one strikeout in 5.0 innings pitched...marked his first career start with just one strikeout.
$\Phi$ Tossed 102 pitches, the third time this season and in his professional career in which he threw over 100 (also 101 on June 21 vs. Cleveland and 103 on May 15 vs. Cleveland)...became the first Twins rooking pitcher to throw 100-plus pitches in consecutive games since Adalberto Mejia did so in three-straight starts from June 23-July 3, 2017 (104, 101, 102).

CENTRAL FOCUS: Is facing Chicago-AL for the first time in his career this afternoon...is 4-0, 1.47 ERA ( 30.2 IP, 5 ER) with five walks, 32 strikeouts and a 176 (19-for-108) opponent batting average in five starts against the American League Central division so far this season...also 5-0, 2.28 ERA (47.1 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks, 46 strikeouts and a 173 (29-for-168) opponent batting average in eight career starts vs. the AL Central.
$\Phi$ Since the start of 2021, owns the second-lowest opponent batting average (.173) against the AL Central (min. 40.0 IP), behind Toronto's Ross Stripling (.170)...Ryan's . 544 opponent OPS is fourth in that span under those parameters, while his 2.28 ERA is seventh.
A SUNNY DISPOSITION: Is making his sixth daytime start this afternoon; has gone 4-1, 2.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 7 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts in his five prior starts... has performed better in daylight than under the lights this season, going 2-2, 3.46 ERA (39.0 IP, 15 ER) with 12 walks and 38 strikeouts in seven night starts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Due to make his sixth road start of the season this afternoon and has gone 3-1, 2.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 8 ER) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in his five starts thus far...yielded four runs in 4.2 innings while taking the loss in his last road start on June 14 at Seattle; had permitted four earned runs combined between four road starts before that outing...by comparison, is 3-2, 3.23 ERA ( 39.0 IP, 14 ER) with 13 walks and 36 strikeouts in seven home starts this season.

GOOSE EGGS: Posted a career-high 20.0-inning scoreless streak from the third inning on April 15 at Boston to the third inning on May 3 at Baltimore...streak is the longest by a Twins pitcher this season...per Elias, Ryan's 20.0 -inning scoreless streak matched Jim Hughes (20.0 IP; May 14-24, 1975) for the second-longest run by a rookie starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), trailing only Joe Mays (20.1 IP; July 17-29, 1999).
