THE TWINS: Have gone 2-1 through three games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, winning their first two games on the South Side of Chicago this week, followed by a walk-off defeat on Wednesday afternoon...tonight, Minnesota will make its second ever visit to Globe Life Field and play the first of three against the Rangers through the weekend...Twins are 25-18 at home and 22-20 on the road.

Twins enter today third in the AL in wins, trailing New York-AL (60-23) and Houston (54-28).

TWINS DROP FINALE IN 10 ON SOUTH SIDE: The Twins lost to the White Sox on Wednesday afternoon at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 9-8 in 10 innings, losing five different leads... Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs (2 earned) on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined for six runs allowed on nine hits in 5.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded 13 hits, including four from Luis Arraez, matching his career-high...Jorge Polanco hit two home runs, his 11th and 12th of the season, his fifth career multi-homer game...the loss was their sixth one-run defeat in their last 17 games.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other today for the first of seven scheduled meetings in 2022...the Iwins will host the Rangers for four games from August 19-22...the Twins went 4-3 against the Rangers in 2021, going 1-3 at Target Field from May 3-6 and 3-0 at Globe Life Field from June 18-20...all seven games between these two were decided by three runs-or-fewer, while three of the seven went extra innings...the Twins have 10-4 vs. the Rangers in their last 14 games (since 2019).

THE STARS AT NIGHT, ARE BIG AND BRIGHT: Twins have won seven straight at Texas with their last loss coming on September 2, 2018 at Globe Life Park...it marks their longest streak in Texas...seven straight road wins against the Rangers as a franchise ties their longest since they won seven straight at Washington's Robert F. Kennedy Memorial Stadium from June of 1964-May of 1965, when the Rangers were the Senators...additionally, seven straight wins in one road city is their longest active streak:

LONE RANGERS: Individual notable numbers against the Rangers:

₱ Byron Buxton made his major league debut at Globe Life Park on June 14, 2015, going O-for-4 with a run scored and two strikeouts...he has reached base safely in 16 straight games against the Rangers, dating back to April of 2017 (.359 OBP).

₱ Jorge Polanco recorded his first career hit against the Rangers at Globe Life Park in his second career game on June 27, 2014, tripling off Joakim Soria...he became the third player in Twins history to record a triple as his first major league hit and the first since Jimmie Hall on April 16, 1963; the first was Bernie Allen on April 10, 1962 vs. the Kansas City As.

₱ Luis Arraez has reached safely in all 11 career games against the Rangers, hitting .326 (15-for-46) with a .367 on-base percentage and a .911 OPS.

₱ Carlos Correa is hitting .362 (34-for-94) with 13 doubles, seven home runs, 24 RBI, a .400 on-base percentage, a .723 slugging percentage and a 1.123 OPS in his last 23 road games against the Rangers.

₱ Gary Sanchez is hitting .328 (19-for-58) with four doubles, seven home runs, 14 RBI, a .409 on-base percentage, a .759 slugging percentage and a 1.168 OPS in 18 career games vs. the Rangers.

BYE BYRON: Byron Buxton enters today with 22 home runs, tied with Anthony Rizzo for fourth in the AL, trailing Aaron Judge (30), Yordan Alvarez (26) and Mike Trout (23)...Buxton has a .678 slugging percentage against breaking pitches this season, the fourth-highest in baseball, trailing Aaron Judge (.741), Yordan Alvarez (.703) and Bryce Harper (.687)...additionally, he has a barrels-per-plate appearance percentage of 10.2, the eighth-best in the AL and 11th-best in baseball...Sanchez ranks 7th in AL/9th in baseball at 10.8%.

KIRILL-OFF THE CHAIN: Since being recalled from St. Paul on June 17, Alex Kirilloff is hitting .303 (20-for-66) with six doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI, a .530 slugging percentage and an .854 OPS in 19 games...in that span, he is hitting .333 (20-for-60) with a .917 OPS against right-handed pitching.

SHORT SLEEVE POLO SUMMER: Jorge Polanco hit his 11th and 12th home runs of the season on Wednesday afternoon at Chicago-AL... he now has three homers in his last two games, four homers in his last five games and five homers in his last eight games...in his last 14 games, dating back to June 7, he is hitting .314 (16-for-51) with two doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, nine walks, a .410 on-base percentage and a 1.116 OPS...in July of 2021, Polo hit .327 (34-for-104) with a .914 OPS in 26 games.

© Since July 1 of 2021, he has collected 28 doubles, 36 home runs and 111 RBI, with a .510 slugging percentage and an .841 OPS in 148 games...since that date, he ranks fifth in the AL in RBI, tied for seventh in home runs and 10th in slugging percentage.

ARRAEZ TO THE TOP: Luis Arraez enters today leading baseball in batting average at .354, 12 points ahead of Paul Goldschmidt (.342) and ranks second in on-base percentage at .425, trailing Goldschmidt (.427) by two points...he also leads baseball in multi-hit games (32), batting average vs. right-handed pitching (.383), and batting average against fastballs (.409), while ranking second in RISP average (.404).

RATED ROOKIE: Jose Miranda is hitting .313 (35-for-112) with 10 doubles, five home runs, 21 RBI, a .536 slugging percentage and an .883 OPS in his last 36 games, since May 20...since May 20 (minimum 100 at-bats), he leads all MLB rookies in batting average, is second in slugging and OPS, third in on-base and tied for fourth in doubles.

ARE YOU SIRIUS?: Rosters for the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, which will be played at 7:00 p.m. (ET)/4:00 p.m. (PT) on Saturday, July 16th at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles, were announced vesterday by Major League Baseball...representing the Twins for the American League squad will be infielder Spencer Steer and outfielder Matt Wallner.

♣ Steer, 24, has split the season between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combining to hit. 273 (80-for-293) with 22 doubles, two triples, 19 home runs, 58 RBI, 58 runs scored, 32 walks, a. 356 on-base percentage, a. 556 slugging percentage and a. 913 OPS in 72 games...the Long Beach, CA native was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2019 draft out of the University of Oregon.

♣ Wallner, 24, has hit. 286 (72-for-252) with 14 doubles, 20 home runs, 58 RBI, a. 425 on-base percentage, a. 587 slugging percentage and a 1.012 OPS in 74 games for Wichita this season...the Forest Lake, MN native was selected 39th overall by the Twins in the 2019 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi.

I'D LIKE TO BUY A VOWEL: High-A Cedar Rapids third baseman Christian Encarnacion-Strand earned his second Midwest League Player of the Month award in 2022, receiving the June honor as announced today by Minor League Baseball...Encarnacion-Strand also earned the April Player of the Month award earlier this season...he slashed .287/.368/.702 for a 1.070 OPS in June, hitting 12 doubles and nine home runs with 21 RBI...he led the Midwest League in home runs, total bases, slugging and OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2015, Bally Sports North analyst, Glen Perkins, converted his 28th-straight save opportunity, setting a club record, passing Joe Nathan's 27 straight (May 8-August 15, 2004)...it marked his 116th career save, tying Eddie Guardado for third on the Twins all-time list (Joe Nathan - 260, Rick Aguilera - 254)...Perkins finished his career with 120 saves.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on July 2 vs. Baltimore...tossed 5.0 innings, allowing a season-high-tying three earned runs on six hits, with three walks and five strikeouts...has pitched 5.0-or-more innings in six of his last seven starts...Twins scored four runs in the final three innings,

including Jose Miranda's walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the ninth to win, 4-3.

Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in each of his 11 starts this season, the longest such streak to begin a season in his career... such streak overall of his career (career-best 13-game run from August 4, 2019-August 3, 2020)...11-straight starts with three-or-fewer earned runs also ties the longest single-season streak of his career, also doing so from June 25-August 26, 2017 and from April 22-June 14, 2015.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his fourth win of the season on June 27 at Cleveland...tossed a seasonhigh-tying 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits and one walk, with three strikeouts in an 11-1 Twins victory...marked his second start this season with 7.0-or-more shutout innings (other: May 24 vs. Detroit, 7.0 IP, 4 H).

To be storing the starter this season with multiple starts of 7.0+ shutout innings, the first Twin to do so since José Berríos had four such starts in 2019.

NOT MY FIRST RODEO: Gray is slated to make his 16th career appearance (15th start) against Texas, going 9-3, 2.86 ERA (94.1 IP, 30 ER) with 29 walks and 83 strikeouts in his prior outings...nine wins

- going 9-3, 2.86 EKA (94.1 IP, 30 EK) with 29 walks and 83 strikeouts in his prior outings...nine wins are his most against any single opponent in his career, while his 83 strikeouts are his third most... facing the Rangers for the first time since June 16, 2019 (W, 5.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 8 K)... © Gray has thrown two complete-game shutouts at Texas, both in 2014 as a member of the Oakland Athletics...first came on April 23 (W, 9.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K) and second on September 28 (W, 9.0 IP, 6 H, 0 R/ER, 0 BB, 5 K)...his two complete games against the Rangers are his most against any single opponent in his career (has also pitched one complete game against Cleveland, Houston, Los Angeles-NL and Tampa Bay).

WINNING THE BATTLE: Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs each of his 11 starts this season, his longest streak to begin a season in his career..allowed two-or-fewer runs in his first eight starts of the season, also his longest such streak to begin a season (prior career best was three starts, done four times)...his streak of two-or-fewer runs allowed in eight-straight starts to begin the season is the longest such streak by a starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present).

SONNY-SHINE ROAD: Gray will be making his fifth start on the road this season and is 2-1, 1.83 ERA (19.2 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts in his first four starts...marks his second-lowest ERA through the first four road starts of the season in his career (1.29 ERA through first four road starts in 2014)...has not allowed a run in his last two road starts, June 15 at Seattle (ND, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R/ER, 0 BB, 3 K) and June 27 at Cleveland (W, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...by comparison, is 2-0, 2.83 ERA (35.0 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks and 42 strikeouts in seven home starts this season.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: Gray has a .205 opponent average (18-for-88) with four walks and 21 strikeouts against left-handed hitters this season...this compares to a .219 batting average (25-for-114) with 10 walks and 33 strikeouts against right-handed hitters.

◆ In his career, Gray has limited left-handers to a .223 batting average (545-for-2442) with 640 strikeouts and right-handed hitters to a .236 batting average (591-for-2500) with 635 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...30 of his 54 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .148 (13-for-88) against the pitch...here's a look at his repertoire.
