no strikeouts...it marked Gray's first start without a strikeout since March 31, 2019 (2.2 P), a span of 78 starts in between...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from both Max Kepler and Ryan Jeffers..Jeffers hit his sixth home run and Carlos Correa hit his 10th, marking the seventh time in his eight seasons to reach the double-digit mark (except for 2'020, 5 HR ).
RANGER THINGS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other today for the second of seven scheduled meetings in 2022...the Twins will host the Rangers for four games from August 1922...since the start of last season, all eight games between these two have been decided by the Rangers in their last 15 games (since 2019)

SUCCESS AS A STARTER：Over the course of his major league career，Smeltzer has gone 6－4， 3.45 ERA（91．1 IP， 35 ER）with a 231 （78－for－337）opponent batting average and ． 692 opponent OPS in 17 starts（Twins are 9－8）．．．by comparison，he＇s 2－0， 4.41 ERA（34．2 IP， 17 ER）with a ． 281 （38－for－135） opponent batting average and an .834 opponent OPS in 12 major league relief outings．
