Facing Texas for the third time in his career and making his first start against the Rangers...owns a 4.32 ERA (8.1 IP, 4 ER) with one save, two walks and six strikeouts in his prior two relief appearances.
Was acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on July 31, 2018 along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier.

LAST TIME OUT: Dealt a 3-1 loss by Baltimore on July 3 at Target Field, after tossing 6.0 innings and allowing three runs (all on solo home runs) on six hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...was his team-high-tying sixth quality start of the season (with Joe Ryan)...marked the second time this season and third in his career he has allowed three-or-more home runs (also, three on June 10 vs. Tampa Bay and four on June 4, 2019 at Cleveland)...also the second time this season and third in his career he allowed back-to-back home runs (also June 4, 2019 at Cleveland and June 20, 2022 vs. Tampa Bay).

The home run allowed to Rougned Odor was only the second home run he has given up to a lefty in his career (also, Jake Bauers on June 4, 2019).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the first game of the doubleheader on June 28 at Cleveland; the Twins lost, 3-2, after the Guardians scored two runs in the bottom of the eighth inning...allowed one run on four hits in 6.0 innings, his fifth major league quality start of the season...recorded a career-high nine strikeouts in the start and did not walk a batter.

QUALITY CONTROL: Smeltzer has recorded six quality starts through his first 10 starts this season, tied with Joe Ryan for the most quality starts this season by a Twins pitcher...is tied with New York-NL's Max Scherzer for second-most quality starts in baseball among pitchers with 10-or-fewer starts this season, behind Chicago-AL's Johnny Cueto (7 QS)...Smeltzer has also recorded quality starts in eight of his 17 career starts.

SUCCESS AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 6-4, 3.45 ERA (91.1 IP, 35 ER) with a .231 (78-for-337) opponent batting average and .692 opponent OPS in 17 starts (Twins are 9-8)...by comparison, he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and an .834 opponent OPS in 12 major league relief outings.

His 21 walks allowed through his first 17 career starts are tied for eighth fewest in Twins/Senators history (1901-)...trails Kevin Slowey (15 from 2007-08), Nick Blackburn (16 in 2008), Bill Burns (16 in 1908), Bailey Ober (17 in 2021), Doc Ayers (19 from 1913-14), Kevin Tapani (20 from 1989-90) and Scott Baker (20 from 2005-06)...is tied with Cole De Vries (21 from 2012-13) and Randy Dobnak (21 from 2019-21).

TEXAS SHOWDOWN: Will make his first career start against the Rangers after two previous relief outings...owns a 4.32 ERA (8.1 IP, 4 ER) with one save, two walks and six strikeouts in those two prior appearances...has made one appearance at Texas on August 15, 2019 (SV, 4.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 2 K).

Made his first major league relief appearance vs. Texas on July 7, 2019 (had two prior major league starts before the outing) and tossed 4.1 innings, allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and four strikeouts.
Recorded his first (and, to date, only) career save on August 15, 2019 at Globe Life Park, pitching the final 4.0 innings of a 13-6 Twins win.

BATTLING ON THE ROAD: Has struggled slightly on the road this season compared to at home; however numbers are skewed due to his June 17 start at Arizona (L, 4.1 IP, 7 R/6 ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 3 K)...is 2-1, 4.10 ERA (26.1 IP, 12 ER) with five walks and 17 strikeouts in five starts away from Minnesota...this compares to 2-1, 2.10 ERA (30.0 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks and 17 strikeouts at Target Field.

Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in four of his five road starts this season and has walked two-or-fewer in all five starts (including two starts without a walk allowed, May 31 at Detroit & June 28 at Cleveland-1).
Recorded a career-high nine strikeouts in his last road start at Cleveland on June 28 (G1).

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Smeltzer's repertoire through his first 10 starts of the 2022 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a five-pitch mix, primarily relying on his four-seam fastball and changeup.

Has started to throw his fastball and slider from a lower-slot arm angle this season to pair with his other offerings and better attack left-handed hitters.
Began varying the speeds of his pitches this season with the realization that throwing his fastball between 86-92 mph is better than maxing out at 89-92...aims to throw his changeup with a four-mile variance between the low and upper end.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after collapsing during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be caused by a herniated disc in his neck...was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY (2022 SEASON: 4-4, 4.50 ERA // CAREER: 50-61, 4.70 ERA)

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against Texas at Globe Life Field...did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 4 at Chicago-AL, tossing 5.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in the Twins' 6-3, 10-inning win...will be facing the Rangers for the 12th time in his career (10th start) and is a lifetime 6-2, 3.12 ERA (57.2 IP, 20 ER) with 15 walks and 55 strikeouts vs. Texas...recorded 12 strikeouts at Texas on September 10, 2020 (W, 7.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB), tied for the second-highest single-game total in his career (14 on May 24, 2018 at Chicago-AL and 12 on August 29, 2017 vs. Seattle)...is 1-0, 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER) in his last three road starts.

CAREER NOTES

- Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL, along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe, in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier at the 2018 trade deadline.
Made Twins Opening Day roster in 2020, the first of his career...went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances...four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more...held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.
Combined to post a 3.02 ERA (104.1 IP, 32 ER) in 20 games (19 starts) between Double-A Pensacola and Triple-A Rochester, going 4-5 in 2019... Began season with Double-A Pensacola...earned the Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week and Southern League Pitcher of the Week April 14 after making two starts, going 2-0, 0.00 ERA (14.0 IP) with five hits allowed, two walks and 17 strikeouts...Made five starts with the Blue Wahoos, posting a 0.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 2 ER) before being promoted to Triple-A Rochester May 2...Went 0-1, 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) in four starts for the Red Wings and had contract selected by Minnesota on May 28... Made major league debut May 28 vs. Milwaukee... became fourth Twins starter in history to throw 6.0-or-more shutout innings in his debut, joining Andrew Albers (8.1 on August 6, 2013), Anthony Swarzak (7.0 on May 23, 2009) and Eric Milton (6.0 on April 5, 1998).
Became the ninth New Jersey-born player (7th pitcher) to make his debut for the Twins, and the first since RHP Rob Delaney on Sept. 4, 2010.
Won the National Junior College Athletic Association Player of the Week award for April 4-10, 2016, after throwing a complete game no-hitter in an 8-0 win over Wharton County Junior College, a start in which he struck out 16 batters and walked three.
Was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft, but chose to continue his development at Florida Gulf Coast University.
Smeltzer was set to transfer to Texas Tech University for the 2017 season, but signed with Los Angeles-NL after being drafted in the fifth round (No. 161 overall).

STRIKES AND OUTS: Has been effective so far when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .180 (18-for-100) batting average with 34 strikeouts in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .190 (43-for-226) mark with 90 strikeouts in his career.

SMELTZER THE CANCER SURVIVOR: When Smeltzer was just nine years old, he was diagnosed with pelvic rhabdomyosarcoma (bladder cancer), as a tumor had formed against his bladder that was connected to his prostate...underwent surgery and chemotherapy at St. Christopher's Hospital for Children in Philadelphia, PA, and sent the cancer into full remission in 2012...the lefty, who's worn glasses and a goatee for the majority of his professional career, continues to offer support to others fighting cancer through his Catch Cancer Looking apparel with his likeness.
