THE TWINS: Completed their nine-day, seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4, going 2-0 at Detroit, 0-2 at Milwaukee and 1-2 at San Diego...tonight, the Twins will begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Tigers through Wednesday afternoon, followed by four against the Blue Jays from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins are 27-22 at home and 26-26 on the road.

TWINS DROP SERIES IN SAN DIEGO: The Twins lost to the Padres yesterday afternoon at Petco Park by a score of 3-2, losing the three-game series...Dylan Bundy (6-5) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched with no walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded just four hits, including home runs from Luis Arraez (6) and Jose Miranda (10)...Minnesota went 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position and left five men on base...they have now gone 4-7-1 in series play in their last 12 chances after starting the season 11-5-4.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins announced today that they have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Aaron Sanchez from Triple-A St. Paul and reinstated infielder Gio Urshela from the Paternity List...Sanchez, 30, has made eight starts for the Saints, going 3-1, 4.26 ERA (38.0 IP, 18 ER), 11 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .259 opponent batting average after signing a minor league contract in early June...Urshela, who was placed on the Paternity List on Friday, has hit .265 (78-for-294) with a .733 OPS in 86 games for the Twins this season...to make room for Sanchez and Urshela on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Yennier Cano to Triple-A St. Paul; he was recalled on July 23 and made one relief appearance during his most recent stint with Minnesota...additionally, the Twins have placed outfielder Gilberto Celestino on the Paternity List, as he and his wife await the arrival of a baby boy...to replace Celestino on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Mark Contreras from Triple-A St. Paul...Contreras was recalled on Saturday, optioned back to the Saints last night and recalled again today...he appeared in one game during the club's series at San Diego this weekend...to make room for Sanchez on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated catcher Jose Godoy for release or assignment.

ADDITIONALLY: Starting tonight, the Twins will host 20 games at Target Field in August - the club's most home contests in a single month since playing a Minnesota-era record 22 at Metropolitan Stadium in June 1977.

WELCOME HOME: The Twins have gone 27-22 at home this season, tied for the sixth-most wins in the American League...they are 2-5 in their last seven home games, but 6-5 in their last 11 at Target Field...below are the offensive and pitching comparisons this season:

NOTABLES AT HOME: Carlos Correa is hitting .300 (42-for-140) with seven doubles, seven home runs and an .851 OPS at home this season...Correa has a slashline of .346/.390/.561 (.951 OPS) in his last 27 home games...Byron Buxton has a .920 OPS and 15 of his 26 home runs at home this season...Luis Arraez is hitting .344 (54-for-157) with an .893 OPS at home this season.

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 14th of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 8-5 against Detroit this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 3-4 at Comerica Park...they began the season 5-0 against the Tigers, but have since gone 3-5...the Twins last played the Tigers in a two-game series last weekend, recording their fifth sweep of the season...the Tigers last visited Target Field for a three-game series from May 23-24 as the Twins won two of three.
 ☞ The Twins have won 25 of their last 39 over the Tigers and 30 of their last 47.
 ☞ Jorge Polanco is a career .295 (110-for-373) hitter with 20 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 55 RBI, 29 walks, 51 runs scored and an .813 OPS in 96 games against the Tigers.
 ☞ Gio Urshela is a career .333 (38-for-114) hitter with an .850 OPS in 37 games against the Tigers...he is hitting .419 (18-for-43) with three doubles, one home run, eight RBI and seven runs scored in 12 games vs. the Tigers this season.
 ☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .381 (8-for-21) in seven games vs. the Tigers this season.

RED HOT JOSE: Jose Miranda finished July hitting .353 (24-for-68) with two doubles, five home runs, 19 RBI, a .405 on-base percentage, a .603 slugging percentage and a 1.008 OPS in 20 games...among AL players last month, he finished fifth in batting average, tied for fifth in RBI, eighth in OPS, ninth in slugging and 12th in on-base percentage.
 ☞ His .353 average in July was the second highest for a Twins rookie in July, trailing only Tony Oliva's 1964 July average of .357.
 ☞ He becomes the first Twins rookie with a July OPS over 1.000 in club history (minimum 70 PA)...in fact, this marks just the 10th time in club history for a rookie to have OPS over 1.000 in any month (minimum 70 PA): Kent Hrbek (April of 1982 - 1.102), Rich Rollins (April of 1962 - 1.059), Tony Oliva (May of 1964 - 1.136), Jimmie Hall (June of 1963 - 1.042), Hall (August of 1963 - 1.114), Matt Lawton (August of 1996 - 1.016), Miguel Sanó (August of 2015 - 1.006), Chris Parmelee (September of 2011 - 1.035) and Dave Engle (September of 1981 - 1.002).

A-ARON: High-A Cedar Rapids first baseman Aaron Sabato has been named Midwest League Player of the Week, marking his second honor this season...the 23-year-old hit .333 (7-for-21) with four home runs, 10 runs scored, 11 RBI, six extra-base hits, a 1.000 slugging percentage and a 1.500 OPS...the Rye, NY native was selected 27th overall by the Twins in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of UNC.

BROOKS IS HERE: Twins first round pick, Brooks Lee, will have media availability at 4:30 today in the Twins dugout and will throw out a ceremonial first pitch prior to the game (to be caught by his father, Cal Poly baseball coach Larry Lee)...he was selected with the eighth overall pick in the 2022 First-Year Player Draft and signed on July 26...the 6-foot-2, 205-pound infielder hit .357/.462/.664 (84-for-235) with 25 doubles, one triple, 15 home runs, 55 RBI, 46 walks and 56 runs scored in 58 games as a sophomore for the Mustangs in 2022...that season, he was named a D1Baseball.com Preseason and Midseason First-Team All-American, and a First-Team Preseason All-American by *Baseball America*, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game...after being a finalist last season, Lee also won the Brooks Wallace Award, given to the nation's top college shortstop...the San Luis Obispo, California native was ranked as the second-best overall prospect entering the 2022 draft by *Baseball America* and the fifth best by MLB.com.

WELCOME BACK TO THE BIG LEAGUES: Sanchez's contract was selected from Triple-A St. Paul today and he is making his Twins debut tonight...signed a minor league contract with Minnesota on June 6 after beginning the year with the Washington Nationals...is back pitching for an American League team for the first time since 2019 with Toronto and Houston.

2022 NATIONALS SUMMARY: Sanchez signed a minor league contract with the Washington Nationals on March 16 and was a non-roster invitee to spring training...pitched in one Grapefruit League game, working a scoreless inning on March 19 vs. New York-NL (1 H, 1 BB, 1 K)...began the season with Triple-A Rochester and went 1-0, 3.60 ERA (15.0 IP, 6 ER) with two walks, two strikeouts and a 1.47 WHIP in three starts for the Red Wings before having his contract selected by Washington on April 23.

- Made his Nats debut on April 23 vs. San Francisco...took the 5-2 loss after allowing four runs on six hits, with one walk and one strikeout in 4.1 innings.
- Earned the 14-4 win in his next outing on April 29 in San Francisco, yielding three runs on six hits (1 home run), with no walks and four strikeouts.
- Overall made eight starts for Washington between April 23 and May 28...tossed at least 5.0 innings in three of his five starts and allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in each of those three (April 29 at San Francisco, May 11 vs. New York-NL and May 22 at Milwaukee).
- His final outing with the Nationals came on May 28 vs. Colorado (L, 3.2 IP, 8 H, 7 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 3 K)...was designated for release or assignment on May 28 and declared free agency on May 31.

2022 ST. PAUL SUMMARY: Signed a minor league contract with the Twins on June 6 and was assigned to Triple-A St. Paul...made his Saints debut in a start on June 8 vs. Rochester -- his old team; did not factor into the decision of a 12-2 St. Paul win at CHS Field, allowing two runs on three hits (2 home runs), with one walk and four strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work.

- Posted a 1-0 record and 5.87 ERA (15.1 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks and 13 strikeouts in four starts for the Saints in June.
- Improved significantly in July, going 2-1 with a 3.18 ERA (22.2 IP, 8 ER), one walk, 13 strikeouts, a 0.93 WHIP and a .238 (20-for-84) opponent batting average in four starts prior to his contract selection today.

DETROIT DOMINANCE: Sanchez is facing Detroit for the first time since a pair of starts in 2019 for Toronto and Houston; went 1-0, 3.68 ERA (7.1 IP, 3 ER) with five walks, seven strikeouts and a .250 (7-for-28) opponent batting average combined across the two outings...is 3-0, 1.93 ERA (37.1 IP, 8 ER) with 14 walks, 37 strikeouts, a .194 (26-for-134) opponent batting average and a 1.07 WHIP in nine games (6 starts) lifetime against the Tigers...this includes 3-0, 2.23 ERA (32.1 IP, 8 ER) with 13 walks, 34 strikeouts and a .203 (24-for-118) opponent batting average in his six starts.

- His 1.93 career ERA vs. Detroit is his second lowest against any single opponent in his career (min. 3 GS), behind his 1.01 ERA in seven games (4 starts) vs. Seattle...his .194 career opponent batting average vs. the Tigers is also his second best behind his .189 mark against the Mariners.

CENTRAL COMFORT: Is making his 33rd career appearance and 23rd start against the teams of the American League Central division tonight, going 8-5, 3.72 ERA (135.1 IP, 56 ER) with 49 walks, 123 strikeouts, 10 quality starts and a .240 (122-for-509) opponent batting average in his prior outings.

ON TARGET: Sanchez last pitched at Target Field on April 16, 2019 for Toronto; earned the 6-5 win in a near-quality start (6.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R/ER, 2 HR, 4 BB, 5 K)...is 3-0, 4.32 ERA (25.0 IP, 12 ER) with 10 walks and 19 strikeouts in four career starts at Target Field.

WHAT'S IN A NAME: Gary Sánchez is slated to catch Aaron Sanchez tonight...when that happens, the duo of Sanchezes will form the second same-last-name battery in Twins history (1961-present), joining right-handed pitcher Travis Miller and catcher Damian Miller, who paired up on five different occasions in August-September of 1997.

ARSENAL: Sanchez displayed a four-pitch mix in his eight major league outings for Washington earlier this season, relying primarily on his sinker, the pitch he's used most throughout his career...he's thrown it 47.0 percent of the time in 2022 and has used it as much as 77.2 percent of the time in 2014.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 2-5, 4.04 ERA // CAREER: 63-86, 4.04 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Archer is scheduled to start tomorrow night against the Detroit Tigers at Target Field...was saddled with his fifth loss of the season in his last start on July 27 at Milwaukee, yielding six runs on three hits (1 home run) with six walks and two strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work...was his second start with six walks this season (also, June 30), becoming the first Twins pitcher with multiple six-walk outings in a season since Rich Robertson had four in 1996...is due to face Detroit for the third time this season, posting no record, a 2.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 2 ER), three walks and seven strikeouts in his two prior starts.
