TO LIVE IN L.A.: The Twins have gone 0-2 through two games on their five-game, seven-day southern California roadtrip, getting swept at Dodger Stadium earlier this week...tonight, the Twins will begin a three-game series in Anaheim...the Twins are 31-25 at home and 26-28 on the road, going just 1-6 in their last seven games away from Target Field.

KEEP YOUR HEAD UP: The Twins lost to the Dodgers on Wednesday night at Dodger Stadium by a score of 8-5, suffering their fourth sweep of the season...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs (3 earned) on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Michael Fulmer was issued the loss in relief, allowing a go-ahead home run to Chris Taylor in the sixth inning, just the second home run allowed by Fulmer all season...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Luis Arraez and two from Jose Miranda...Jorge Polanco hit his 15th home run, a three-run shot in the third inning...the game was played in front of 53,432, marking the highest attendance for a Twins home or road game since Game 163 on October 6, 2009 vs. Detroit at the Metrodome (54,088).

CALIFORNIA LOVE: Tonight marks the first of six scheduled meetings with the Angels this season...Target Field will host the Angels for three games from September 23-25...last season, the Twins went 2-5 against the Angels, going 1-2 in Anaheim on April 16 & May 20 (doubleheader) and 1-3 at Target Field from July 22-25.

- ☞ Twins are 20-14 in their last 34 meetings with the Angels, dating back to September of 2015.
- ☞ Since 2018, 15 of 20 games between these two teams have decided by three runs-or-less.
- ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .307 (31-for-101) with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBI, 16 walks, a .417 on-base percentage and a .951 OPS in 31 career games against the Angels...he has reached safely in 11 straight and 25 of his last 28 vs. the Halos...in his last five games at Angel Stadium, he is hitting .526 (10-for-19) with five walks and a 1.467 OPS.
- ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with two walks and a .988 OPS in six career games vs. the Angels — all in Anaheim...he hit his first career home run here on May 21, 2019, a solo shot off Noé Ramirez.
- ☞ Gary Sánchez has homered four times in 12 career games at Angel Stadium (.927 OPS).
- ☞ Jorge Polanco made his major league debut in this ballpark as a 20-year-old, 10 days before his 21st birthday...he entered the game as a pinch hitter for Pedro Florimon and drew a walk against Ernesto Frieri and eventually scored...Twins first base coach Hank Conger was the starting catcher for the Angels in that game, going 0-for-4.

CAN'T CC ME: Carlos Correa is hitting .294 (95-for-323) with 22 doubles, 16 home runs, 65 RBI, a .364 on-base percentage, a .511 slugging percentage and an .875 OPS in 86 career games against the Angels...the 65 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 16 home runs are his second-most (Texas - 20)...additionally, his 65 RBI are sixth-most among actives.

DEAR MAHLE: Tyler Mahle (name rhymes with rally) will be making his second start with the Twins since being acquired via trade with Cincinnati at the deadline...he is 3-2, 3.13 ERA (63.1 IP, 22 ER) with a .214 (49-for-229) opponent batting average and 69 strikeouts in his last 10 starts, since May 29.

CHANGES: In 59 games, since May 20, Jose Miranda is hitting .328 (64-for-195) with a .917 OPS...below are his first 14 major league games, compared to his last 59:

NOTE: Since that date, he ranks fourth in the AL in batting average (minimum 200 PA), fifth in slugging, sixth in OPS, tied for ninth in RBI and 13th in on-base.

ALL EYES ON ME: Byron Buxton enters tonight with 27 home runs, tied with Anthony Rizzo and Paul Goldschmidt for sixth-most in baseball, trailing Aaron Judge (45), Kyle Schwarber (34), Yordan Alvarez (31), Austin Riley (30) and Pete Alonso (29).

- ☞ Buck has homered at least once in nine consecutive road series: Toronto, Seattle, Arizona, Cleveland, Chicago-AL, Texas, Milwaukee, San Diego and Los Angeles-NL...he has homered in five of his last seven road games.
- ☞ In his last 14 games Buxton is hitting .304 (14-for-46) with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, six RBI, six walks, 10 runs scored, a .385 on-base percentage, a .652 slugging percentage and a 1.037 OPS.
- ☞ He has 97 career home runs, needing three to become the 19th Twin to reach 100 career homers (since 1961)...last Twin to reach 100 was Max Kepler on September 20, 2020 at Chicago-NL.
- ☞ Buck is one of three players in baseball in the 90th percentile in both hard hit percentage (94th% - 51.0%) and sprint speed (93rd% - 29.2 mph), joining Mike Trout (99%/96%) and Julio Rodríguez (95%/97%).

TROUBLESOME: The Twins are facing three-straight left-handed starters this series...the last time they faced all lefties in one series was April 12-13 vs. Los Angeles-NL (Andrew Heaney and Clayton Kershaw) and were swept...the last time they faced three lefties in a three-game series was June 20-22, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL (Derek Holland, David Holmberg and José Quintana), taking two of three.

☞ Twins have gone 17-14 this season when facing a left-handed starter...they have dropped four of their last six games started by a lefty (last was Urias on Tuesday night)...they have an OPS of .708 vs. lefties this season, compared to a .748 OPS against righties...Byron Buxton has a .635 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching, the fifth-best in baseball and third in the AL...his nine home runs vs. lefties are tied for second-most among AL players.

I GET AROUND THE BASES: The Twins have homered in 14 of their last 15 away from Target Field since July 4, hitting 28 road homers since that date, trailing only New York-AL (29) for the most in baseball...Twins have 136 homers on the season, fifth in the AL and ninth in baseball.

STILL I ARRAEZ: Luis Arraez went 3-for-4 with two doubles on Wednesday night and is now 9-for-14 with five doubles in his last three games...he has 13 three-hit games on the season, tied with Xander Bogaerts and Amed Rosario for second-most in baseball, trailing Freddie Freeman (15).

☞ Arraez (3 G, 8/6-present) and Jose Miranda (3 G, 7/24-27) have each had a streak of three-straight games with three-plus hits this season, marking the fourth time in Twins history that at least two different players had such streaks in the same season...they join Kent Hrbek and Kirby Puckett (2x) in 1986, Puckett and Dan Gladden in 1988, and Alex Cole and Jeff Reboulet in 1994 (side note: Tony Oliva had two such streaks by himself in 1969, which is not included in this count)...the Twins record for most consecutive three-plus hit games is five, done by Rod Carew from May 31-June 5, 1975.

PICTURE ME ROLLIN': Jhoan Duran enters today with a 9.2 scoreless inning streak...in his last 31 games, he has posted a 1.25 ERA (36.0 IP, 5 ER) with 42 strikeouts and one home run allowed (Seager)...he ranks tied for fifth among AL relievers with 61 strikeouts, third among rookies (Bautista, BAL - 64 and Burke, TEX - 64)...additionally, he has thrown 269 pitches at 100-plus mph this season, the most in baseball.

STILL BALLIN': Former Twins outfielder Lew Ford is celebrating his 46th birthday today...Ford is currently playing independent ball for the Long Island Ducks of the Atlantic League and is hitting .277 (23-for-83) with three doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI in 22 games.

- ⊕ Makes his second start with the Twins tonight and his 21st start and appearance overall this season (including 19 with the Cincinnati Reds)...also his 116th career appearance and 115th start.
- ⊕ Making his second career start and appearance against the Los Angeles Angels tonight...previously started on June 25, 2019 at Angel Stadium with Cincinnati (L, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R/ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 4 K).
- ⊕ Acquired from the Cincinnati Reds via trade on August 2, in exchange for minor league infielders Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer, and left-handed pitcher Steve Hajjar.

LAST TIME OUT: Mahle did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 5 vs. Toronto at Target Field, his first outing with Minnesota since being acquired from Cincinnati on August 2...allowed four runs on five hits (3 home runs), with one walk and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work...marked his 11th start (out of 20 on the season) in which he worked at least 6.0 innings...yielded a career-high-tying three home runs, doing so for the fifth time in his career and first since May 2, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (with Cincinnati).

- ⊕ Mahle threw 61 of his 83 pitches for strikes, good for a 70.9 strike percentage – his first time throwing at least 70 percent of his pitches for strikes in a start this season (11th time in his career)...his best single-start strike percentage is 75.7, done on September 29, 2019 (his birthday) at Pittsburgh (with Cincinnati).
- ⊕ Departed with Minnesota ahead, 5-4...after Toronto tied it at 5-5 in the top of the ninth, the Twins won, 6-5, on Tim Beckham's RBI fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the win in what was his final start for Cincinnati, on July 30 vs. Baltimore, his second-straight victory...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in the Reds' 8-2 win...his 27 pitches in the first inning were his second-highest pitch total in the opening frame this season (trailing the 31 pitches he threw in the first inning on May 3 at Milwaukee)...was the first time he won back-to-back games this season and was the fifth time in his career he has won back-to-back starts (longest winning streak is 5-straight games from May 25 to June 16, 2021).

ANGELS AND DEMONS: Tonight marks Mahle's second career start and appearance against Los Angeles-AL, after he took the loss on June 25, 2019 at Angel Stadium as a member of the Reds (5.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R/ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 4 K)...tonight also marks his sixth career start and appearance against the American League West division and he's 0-3, 4.91 ERA (25.2 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks, 29 strikeouts and a .248 (25-for-101) opponent batting average in his five prior starts...the Angels are the first team in the division he's facing for a second time – enters tonight with precisely one start against each of the five teams in the division.

- ⊕ The AL West is the only division he's yet to earn a win against in his career (1-0 in 2 GS vs. AL East, 5-2 in 14 G/13 GS vs. AL Central, 5-8 in 18 GS vs. NL East, 15-15 in 50 GS vs. NL Central, 5-10 in 26 GS vs. NL West).

MASTER OF THE OPEN ROAD: Tonight marks Mahle's eighth road start and appearance this season; has gone 3-2, 3.83 ERA (40.0 IP, 17 ER) with 11 walks, 45 strikeouts and a .189 (28-for-148) opponent batting average in his seven prior starts...has performed better on the road than in his home ballpark this season, going 2-5, 4.86 ERA (70.1 IP, 38 ER) with 29 walks, 74 strikeouts and a .256 (68-for-266) opponent batting average in 13 home starts.

- ⊕ His .244 opponent on-base percentage on the road is third best in the majors (min. 40.0 IP), while his .189 opponent batting average is seventh best and his .561 opponent OPS is ninth best under those same parameters.

WORKING THE NIGHT SHIFT: Mahle is slated to start his ninth game under the lights this season; has been consistent both at night and during the day...is 3-3, 4.76 ERA (45.1 IP, 24 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts at night, compared to 2-4, 4.29 ERA (65.0 IP, 31 ER) with 29 walks and 68 strikeouts during the day.

- ⊕ Mahle's most dominant start of the season came at night on June 14 at Arizona...did not factor into the decision after he went 9.0 scoreless innings and allowed just three hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the Reds won 5-3 in 12 innings.

GOING THE DISTANCE: Mahle has thrown over 100 pitches in 10 of his 20 starts this season, and has gone over 110 pitches on three occasions (June 14 at Arizona - 119, June 21 at Los Angeles-NL - 111 and July 2 vs. Atlanta - 110)...he has also produced 11 starts of at least 6.0 innings pitched and four starts where he has recorded at least one out in the seventh inning-or-later...the rest of the Twins starters this season have a combined six starts with 100-or-more pitches (Joe Ryan - 4 starts, Dylan Bundy - 1 start, Cole Sands - 1 start and Devin Smeltzer - 1 start).

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Mahle's repertoire in his first 20 starts of the season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his two fastballs, the 4-seam and split finger.

WITH THE REDS: Went 5-7, 4.40 ERA (104.1 IP, 51 ER) with 39 walks, 114 strikeouts and a .248 (91-for-393) opponent batting average in 19 starts with the Reds this season...had an 18-day stint on the 15-day Injured List from July 6-23 with a right shoulder strain...in his last nine starts for the Reds, he went 3-2, 2.83 ERA (57.1 IP, 18 ER) with seven quality starts, 16 walks and a .212 (44-for-208) opponent batting average.

- ⊕ Produced four consecutive quality starts from May 29-June 14, the longest such streak of his career.
- ⊕ In his outing on May 29 vs. San Francisco, did not allow a hit until Thairo Estrada, Mahle's final batter, doubled with two outs in the seventh inning...left the game with a 2-0 lead but was the victim of a blown save when the Giants scored six runs in the eighth inning, all with two outs...the Reds lost, 6-4.
- ⊕ In the 12-inning, 5-3 win on June 14 at Arizona, Mahle became the first pitcher in the major leagues since 1900 to not earn a win after throwing at least 9.0 scoreless innings on the road with zero walks and at least 12 strikeouts (*Elías*)...became the first Reds pitcher to throw at least 9.0 scoreless innings without earning a win since left-handed pitcher Travis Wood (9 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 8 K) did so in an 11-inning, 1-0 loss on July 10, 2010 at Philadelphia.
- ⊕ Made the first Opening Day start of his career and earned the 6-3 win on April 7 at Atlanta (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/0 ER, 2 BB, 7 K) at Atlanta.
