The outing marked Bundy＇s fifth start this season in which he did not walk a batter and fourth such start on the road

STAYING IN THE ZONE：Bundy threw 56 of his 78 pitches for strikes on July 31 ，good for a 71.8 strike percentage．．．has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent in a single start in 10 of his 19 starts this season owns a 69.20 strike percentage on the season，third best in the majors（min 90.0 IP），behind Toronto＇s Kevin Gausman（70．35）and Los Angeles－NL＇s Julio Urías（69．34）．
