IN THE END: The Twins will conclude their five-game, seven-day southern California roadtrip, after getting swept in two games at Dodger Stadium earlier this week, followed by splitting the first two games with the Angels this weekend...following this afternoon's game, the Iwins will travel home and begin a seven-game, eight-day homestand with three against the Royals from Monday-Wednesday, followed by an off-day on Thursday, then play four against the Rangers from Friday-next Monday...the Iwins will play a stretch of 13 home games in 17 days to finish August, which includes three road games in Houston (August 23-25) and one off day.

TWINS LOSE MINUTES TO MIDNIGHT: The Twins lost to the Angels last night in Anaheim by a score of 5-3 in 11 innings, making them 4-7 in extra-innings this season...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed and three walks against his former club...Jhoan Duran allowed a solo home run to Shohei Ontani in the eighth inning and Jorge Lopez allowed two runs in the bottom of the ninth, suffering his sixth blown save of the season...Taylor Ward hit a two-run homer in the bottom of the 11th off Emilio Pagán, marking the fifth walk-off loss for the Twins this season...it was just the third loss for the Twins in 2022 when leading after eight innings (49-3)...the offense recorded 10 hits, three from Luis Arraez, his AL-best 14th three-plus-hit game this season.

BATTLE SYMPHONY: Today marks the third of six scheduled meetings with the Angels this season...the Twins will host the Angels at Target Field for three games from September 23-25.

▼ Twins are 21-15 in their last 36 meetings with the Angels, dating back to September of 2015.

▼ Since 2018, 16 of 22 games between these two teams have decided by three runs-or-less.

▼ Luis Arraez is hitting .414 (12-for-29) with three walks and a 1.006 OPS in eight career games vs. the Angels — all in Anaheim...he has multiple hits in four of those.

▼ Carlos Correa is hitting .298 (98-for-329) with 22 doubles, 17 home runs, 67 RBI, a .371 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and an .890 OPS in 88 career games against the Angels...the 67 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 17 home runs are his second-most (Texas - 20)...additionally, his 67 RBI are sixth-most among actives.

ARCHER - THE HUNTING PARTY: Chris Archer has gone 6-2, 2.50 ERA (54.0 IP, 15 ER) with 21 walks and 68 strikeouts in nine career starts against the Angels, including 54 strikeouts in 41.0 career innings at Angel Stadium (7 starts)...the 2.50 ERA is his lowest vs. any opponent he has faced a minimum of five times.

THE CATALYST: Entering today, Twins starters have thrown 11.0-straight scoreless innings (Mahle - 6.0 & Bundy - 5.0) with the last runs allowed coming in the fifth inning on Wednesday at Dodger Stadium off Sonny Grav...11.0-straight scoreless ties a season-high, done twice previously, from April 10-12 and May 5-7...additionally, through 11 games this month, Twins starters have allowed more than two runs in an outing just three times in 11 games...below are Twins starting pitching comparisons numbers by month:

WITH LOU: Last night, Luis Arraez recorded his 14th three-hit game on the season and his fourth in his last five games...14 three-hit games leads the AL and trails only Freddie Freeman (15) for the most in baseball...he is hitting .591 (13-for-22) with five doubles, two walks and three RBI in his last five games...at 127 hits, he has now set a single season career-high in hits, passing his previous mark of 126, done last season...he enters today as the MLB leader in batting average at .337, seven points ahead of St. Louis' Paul Goldschmidt (.330).

BREAKING THE HABIT: The Twins are 16-13-5 in series play this season, going 9-5-3 at home and 7-8-2 on the road...they began the season going 11-5-4 in series play, but have gone 5-8-1 since...Minnesota is looking to win their first series against the Angels since sweeping them in three games at Angel Stadium from May 20-23, 2019.

The Twins have gone 7-4 in rubber games this season.

WHAT I'VE DONE: In 61 games, since May 20, Jose Miranda is hitting .327 (67-for-205) with a .906 OPS...among all AL players since that date (minimum 100 PA), he ranks fifth in batting average, sixth in OPS, eighth in slugging (.537), and tied for 11th in RBI (44)...on the season, he is fitting .300 (12-for-40) vs. off-speed pitches.

LEFT HANDS HELD HIGH: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the fourth time in five games on this roadtrip...they will face two more lefties next series vs. Kansas City in Kris Bubic and Daniel Lynch...through these two games in Anaheim, they are hitting .279

(12-for-43) with an .838 OPS against left-handed pitching.

The last time Minnesota faced three lefties in a three-game series was June 20-22, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL (Derek Holland, David Holmberg and José Quintana), taking two of three.

Which was a compared to a .747 OPS against righties.

Byron Buxton has a .607 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching, the eighth-best in baseball and third-best in the AL... his nine home runs vs. lefties are field for third-most among AL players.

POINTS OF AUTHORITY: Byron Buxton enters today with 27 home runs, tied with Anthony Rizzo for third-best in the AL, trailing Aaron Judge (46) and Yordan Alvarez (31)...he has 12 road homers this season (T-7th in AL), including five in his last nine games away from Target Field...he has homered in each of his last nine road series (chart upper right) with his last homerless road series being a five-game series in Detroit from May 30-June 2.

REMEMBER THE NAMES: The Twins have named Double-A Wichita infielder/outfielder Anthony Prato and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Louie Varland as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

Prato, 24, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .421 (8-for-19) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBI, four walks, a .542 on-base percentage, an .842 slugging percentage and a 1.384 OPS...the Brooklyn, New York native was selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Connecticut.

Varland, who was recently promoted from Double-A Wichita, made the start for St. Paul on Friday night vs. Columbus, pitching 5.1 innings, with one hit allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts, carrying a no-hitter into the sixth inning...the St. Paul native was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul.

PRESS PLAY: Twins will host National PLAY Campaign on Tuesday, August 16, which promotes the importance of children living a healthy lifestyle and disability inclusion...in 2014, the PLAY Campaign became the first program in professional sports to include children with disabilities... PBATS partnered with the National Down Syndrome Society in 2017 to enhance this effort...members of the Twins' athletic training staff and players from the Minnesota RBI Youth Baseball Leagues will participate in the event...it will take place at Target Field from 10am-12pm.

LAST TIME OUT: Matched his season high (4th time) with 5.0 innings pitched, allowing two runs on four hits, with no walks and four strikeouts, but did not factor in the decision vs. Toronto a week ago today at Target Field...departed trailing 2-0; the Twins rallied to tie it in the ninth, only to fall, 3-2 in 10 innings when the Blue Jays scored on an overturned out call at home plate.

4 After walking 16 batters in 16.0 innings over his previous four starts, logged his fifth effort without issuing a base-on-balls.

5 Threw 52 of 79 pitches for strikes (65.8%), just his third start this season with a strike percentage over 65...marked his second-highest percentage of the season (behind 68.4% on May 5 at Baltimore).

6 The Twins have now dropped five-straight Archer starts, after going 7-7 in his first 14 trips

TWO STARTS AGO: Turned in his most effective outing since June on August 2 vs. Detroit at Target Field, but did not factor in the decision as the Tigers rallied for a 5-3 win (4.1 IP, 2 H, 2 R/ER, 3 BB, 8 K)...eight strikeouts were a season high and his most since fanning 10 on August 14, 2019 at Los Angeles-AL (with Pittsburgh)...blanked the Tigers on one hit through 4.0 innings, took a 2-0 lead into the fifth and struck out the first batter he faced in the frame, before walking the next hitler and allowing an RBI double to Jonathan Schoop before being removed (Schoop later scored)...marked the second time in three starts he took a shutout into the fifth inning and retired at least the first batter in that inning, before then failing to complete the frame (also, July 17 vs. Chicago-AL).

© Induced a season-high 15 swings-and-misses (his 8th start this season with double-digit whiffs on his pitches).

ANGELIC: Archer is set to make his 10th career start and appearance against Los Angeles-AL, but first since August 14, 2019 (with Pittsburgh)...is 6-2, 2.50 ERA (54.0 IP, 15 ER) in his first nine starts vs. the Angels...his career ERA vs. the Halos is his lowest against any opponent he has faced at least five times, while the six wins match his total against Baltimore for his second-most victories against any opponent (1 shy of the 7 he's compiled against New York-AL and Minnesota).

4 Handed the loss in that August 14, 2019 game here in Anaheim (5.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 10 K).

5 His last win vs. LAA came here on May 17, 2018, with Tampa Bay (6.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 4 BB, 5 K).

5 Set his career high with 15 strikeouts in a 6-1 Rays win in this ballpark on June 2, 2015 (8.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB).

A FEEL FOR THE ROAD: Archer has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in eight of his nine road starts this season, going 0-2, 3.96 ERA (36.1 IP, 16 ER), 23 walks, 30 strikeouts and a .205/.331/.402 opponent slash line (27-for-132, with 5 2B and 7 HR)...numbers are skewed by his last road start, a 10-4 loss July 27 at Milwaukee (3.0 IP, 3 H, 6 R/ER, 1 HR, 6 BB, 2 K).

To looking for his first road win since September 25, 2018 at Chicago-NL (with Pittsburgh)...is 0-8, 5.54 ERA (104.0 IP, 64 ER) in 23 road games (22 starts) since.

HOPING FOR MORE EVEN-MONTH SUCCESS: Archer's 2022 season has rotated between solid and poor months...he is a combined 2-1, 2.44 ERA (51.2 IP, 14 ER) with a .173 opponent batting average (31-for-179) in 11 "even" month starts (April, June and August) this season...by contrast, he is 0-4, 7.09 ERA (26.2 IP, 21 ER) with a .252 batting average against (30-for-119) in seven "odd" month outings (May and July).

That is 3.86 ERA (9.1 IP, 4 ER) with a .188 opponent batting average (6-for-32) in his first two August starts, after going 0-2, 11.74 ERA (7.2 IP, 10 ER) and a .267 (8-for-30) opponent batting average in two July outings.

BEWARE THE SUN: Despite a solid effort in last Sunday's matinee, Archer has scuffled to an 0-4 mark with a 5.40 ERA (36.2 IP, 22 ER) in nine day starts this season...by contrast, he is 2-1, 2.81 ERA (41.2 IP, 13 ER) in 10 starts at night.

SOFT CONTACT: Among American League pitchers with at least 75.0 innings pitched this season, Archer ranks sixth in opponent batting average on balls in play (.242), ninth in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (7.01) and 11th in opponent batting average (.212, 61-for-288) — all of which would be career bests over a full season...he has allowed an average exit velocity of 89.2 mph, which would also stand as a career-best mark over a full season.

WALKS WILL HAUNT: Archer is walking a career-worst 4.60 batters per 9.0 innings (78.1 IP, 40 BB), which is the third-highest mark in the majors this season (min. 75.0 IP).

♣ Has walked three-or-more batters eight times this season, accounting for 31 of his free passes on the year...in those games, is 1-2, 5.58 ERA (30.2 IP, 19 ER) despite yielding only 22 hits in 109 at-bats (.202).

♣ In his 11 starts with two-or-fewer walks issued (nine total), he has a 3.02 ERA (47.2 IP, 16 ER) despite a higher opponent batting average (.218, 39-for-179).

THE ARSENAL: Archer has relied on four pitches during his inaugural Twins season, per Baseball Savant... below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

His velocity has been up, when compared with his 2021 numbers...averging 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.8 mph on the slider this season (92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year).

Opponents are a combined 34-for-202 (.168) with 13 doubles, four homers and 54 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball.

Has faced just 10 batters a third time through the order (3-for-6, 2 2B, 3 BB, SF)...opponents are hitting .184 (26-for-141) with a .620 OPS the first time through; .228 (28-for-123) with a .722 OPS the second time.
