THE TWINS: Completed their five-game, seven-day southern California roadtrip with a record of 1-4, going 0-2 against the Dodgers and 1-2 against the Angels...tonight they will begin a seven-game, eight-day homestand with three against the Royals from tonight-Wednesday, followed by an off-day on Thursday, then play four against the Rangers from Friday-next Monday...tonight marks a stretch of 13 home games in 17 days to finish August, which includes three road games in Houston (August 23-25) and one off day.

TWINS DROP SERIES IN ANAHEIM: The Twins lost the three-game series finale to the Angels yesterday afternoon by a score of 4-2...Chris Archer (2-6) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded five hits, two from both Carlos Correa and Byron Buxton...Correa singled twice, while Buxton singled and homered, marking his 28th home run of the season...Minnesota went 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position and went 0-for-18 in their final two games of the series...the Twins are now 16-14-6 in series play this season.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 11th of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 6-4 against Kansas City this season, going 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 2-2 at Target Field...their last meeting came in four games from May 26-29 at Target Field as the two teams split 2-2.

- ☞ Twins batters have hit .289 (99-for-343) with 15 doubles, three triples, seven home runs, 42 walks and 48 runs scored against the Royals this season...they have recorded double-digit hit totals in five straight against KC.
- ☞ Twins batters hit just one home run against KC pitching over the first seven meetings this season but have since hit six in three games.
- ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .376 (50-for-133) with five doubles, one triple, 11 RBI, 18 walks, a .452 on-base percentage and an .880 OPS in 37 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 32 of those 37...his batting average is best among actives (min. 100 AB)... additionally, he has reached safely in 17 of his last 29 plate appearances vs. KC...in his last 12 games vs. KC, he has multiple hits eight times.
- ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .304 (17-for-56) with seven doubles, three home runs, six RBI, 14 runs scored and a .944 OPS in his last 13 games against the Royals, reaching safely in all 13.
- ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .342 (26-for-76) with three doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks, a .425 on-base percentage and a .965 OPS in 20 games against the Royals since 2019.

LUKEY ON TOP: Luis Arraez is hitting .500 (13-for-26) with five doubles, two walks and three RBI in his last six games...he enters today as the MLB leader in batting average at .333, five points ahead of St. Louis' Paul Goldschmidt (.328).

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton hit his 28th home run of the season yesterday afternoon...he enters today tied with Paul Goldschmidt for sixth in baseball in homers, trailing Aaron Judge (46), Kyle Schwarber (34), Yordan Alvarez (31), Austin Riley (30) and Pete Alonso (29)...he ranks third in baseball in at-bats-per-home run at 11.39, trailing Judge (9.04) and Alvarez (11.06)... Bucky is on pace to hit 40 home runs and become the fourth Twin to reach that mark, joining Harmon Killebrew (7x), Brian Dozier and Nelson Cruz... additionally, he has 98 career home runs, needing two to become the 20th player in club history to reach 100.

YES WAY JOSE: In 62 games, since May 20, Jose Miranda is hitting .321 (67-for-209) with an .890 OPS...among all AL players since that date (minimum 100 PA), he ranks seventh in batting average, ninth in OPS, 11th in slugging (.526), and tied for 13th in RBI (44).

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the fourth-straight game and fifth time in their last six games overall.

- ☞ Twins have gone 18-16 this season when facing a left-handed starter...they have an OPS of .709 vs. lefties this season, compared to a .746 OPS against righties.
- ☞ Byron Buxton has a .641 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching, the sixth-best in baseball and third-best in the AL...his nine home runs vs. lefties are tied for second-most among AL players.

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE: The Twins have gone 27-20 against the AL Central this season...27 wins trail Cleveland (28-21) for the most wins against the division...Minnesota is 6-4 against Kansas City, 6-4 against Chicago-AL, 10-6 against Detroit and 5-6 against Cleveland.

NATIONAL PLAY CAMPAIGN: Twins will host National PLAY Campaign tomorrow at Target Field from 10am-12pm, which promotes the importance of children living a healthy lifestyle and disability inclusion...in 2014, the PLAY Campaign became the first program in professional sports to include children with disabilities...PBATS partnered with the National Down Syndrome Society in 2017 to enhance this effort... members of the Twins' athletic training staff and players from the Minnesota RBI Youth Baseball Leagues will participate in the event.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2011, Jim Thome hit two home runs in a 9-6 win at Detroit to become the eighth player to reach 600 home runs; Thome hit a two-run homer off Rick Porcello in the sixth for number 599, then a three-run shot against Daniel Schlereth in the seventh...in 2020, in front of the big head cutouts debut at Target Field, Nelson Cruz homered in each game of a doubleheader against the Royals...for Cruz, it marked the first of three times in 2020 to homer in both games of a doubleheader (also 8/29 at DET & 9/8 at STL).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, TK!: Former manager Tom Kelly is celebrating his 72nd birthday today...TK shares a birthday with actress Jennifer Lawrence (31), actor Ben Affleck (49), The Walking Dead star Emily Kinney (36), former Twins player Chad Allen (54) and former Vikings quarterback Bobby Brister (60) - Dan Gladden's starting quarterback on his fantasy football team in 2000 (0 TD, 1 INT, 82 Yards)... Kelly is the Twins all-time managerial wins leader (1,140)...on his birthday, Kelly held a managerial record of 7-6.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan took his fifth loss of the season in his last start on August 9 against Los Angeles-L at Dodger Stadium, as the Twins fell 10-3...allowed six runs (5 earned) on a career-high nine hits (1 home run), with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...also tossed a career-high 110 pitches, his fourth time crossing the century mark this season and in his career (also, 103 on May 15 vs. Cleveland, 101 on June 21 vs. Cleveland and 102 on June 26 vs. Colorado).

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan earned his team-leading eighth win on August 3 vs. Detroit, allowing one run on three hits, with no walks and nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...recorded his fourth career start with no walks (third this season), while his nine strikeouts matched the second-highest single-start total of his career for the second time (also 9 on April 27 vs. Detroit; career high is 11 on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-ML)...Twins won, 4-1, in the series rubber match at Target Field.

☞ Ryan tossed 63 of his 78 pitches for strikes, good for an 80.8 strike percentage – the highest single-start mark of his career (previous high was 74.6 percent in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland).

☞ The win marked his 10th career victory in his 22nd career start/appearance, becoming the eighth pitcher in Twins/Senators history to earn at least 10 wins within his first 22 career games, joining Wyatt Lee (11 wins, 22 G/20 GS in 1901), Casey Patten (12 wins, 22 G/20 GS in 1901), Horace Lisenbee (10 wins, 22 G/18 GS in 1927), Monte Weaver (10 wins, 22 G/13 GS from 1931-32), Milo Candini (10 wins, 22 G/17 GS in 1943), Scott Diamond (10 wins, 22 G/GS from 2011-12) and José Berrios (10 wins, 22 G/GS from 2016-17)...also joined Diamond and Berrios as the only pitchers to do so whose first 22 career games were all starts.

ROYAL WELCOME: Ryan is slated to face the Royals for the third time this season and in his career... is 2-0, 0.77 ERA (11.2 IP, 1 ER) with three walks, 11 strikeouts and a .175 (7-for-40) opponent batting average in his two prior starts, which occurred on April 21 and May 21 at Kauffman Stadium... tonight marks his first career start against Kansas City at Target Field.

CENTRIFUGAL FORCE: Making his ninth start and appearance against the American League Central division tonight; is 6-0, 1.79 ERA (45.1 IP, 9 ER) with eight walks, 51 strikeouts and a .190 (31-for-163) opponent batting average in his eight prior starts.

☞ Owns the lowest opponent batting average (min. 35.0 IP), second lowest opponent OPS (.560, behind Devin Smeltzer - .511) and third lowest ERA against the AL Central this season, trailing Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease (1.40) and Smeltzer (1.62).

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his 10th start at Target Field this season; has gone 4-2, 2.92 ERA (49.1 IP, 16 ER) with 15 walks and 48 strikeouts at home...this compares to 4-3, 5.05 ERA (46.1 IP, 26 ER) with 11 walks and 45 strikeouts in nine starts on the road...his road numbers are skewed by the 10 earned runs he permitted on July 29 at San Diego; prior to that start, had posted a 2.70 ERA on the road.

☞ Has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in six of his nine home starts this season, including one apiece in each of his last three since July 1; has a 1.56 ERA (17.1 IP, 3 ER) with three walks, 19 strikeouts and a .121 (7-for-58) opponent batting average in that span.

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Is starting under the lights for the 11th time this season...has a 3-4 record, 5.13 ERA (54.1 IP, 31 ER) with 16 walks and 56 strikeouts in his 10 prior night starts, compared to 5-1, 2.40 ERA (41.1 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts in eight day games...is also 1-1, 3.00 ERA (24.0 IP, 8 ER) with eight walks, 26 strikeouts and a .165 (14-for-85) opponent batting average in four home night starts this season.

☞ Has allowed 15 earned runs combined across his last two night starts, including 10 on July 29 at San Diego and five on August 9 at Los Angeles-NL; had yielded five total earned runs in his three night starts prior to his current stretch, posting a 2.41 ERA (18.2 IP, 5 ER) at night from June 21-July 23.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 58.9% of the time through his first 18 starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

☞ Ryan has a .276 wOBA on his four seamer, fifth best in the majors this season (min. 200 PA)... also has a -.11 run value on the pitch, seventh among major league pitchers under those same parameters.

☞ Ryan is averaging 16.4 seconds between pitches with the bases empty this season, faster than league average (18.1 seconds) and seventh among all Twins pitchers (min. 100 pitches)... averages 21.0 seconds between pitches with runners on, fifth on the Twins (min. 100 pitches), again faster than league average (23.4 seconds).

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 93 batters so far, which will lead to 4,650 new trees planted.
