LAST TIME OUT：Did not factor into the decision against the Dodgers in Los Angeles on August 10，as the Twins fell，8－5．．．allowed four runs（3 ER）on six hits，with two walks and five strikeouts over 4.2 innings of work．．．left with the lead after being supported by a Jorge Polanco three－run homer，however the Dodgers scored two runs in the fifth inning，one in the sixth and three in the seventh to solidify their victory．．．．marked the first time Gray was unable to complete 5.0 innings since July 14 vs．Chicago－AL （ 3.2 IP ）and was also the first time he has given up more than one run in a start over that stretch．
TWO STARTS AGO：Did not factor into the decision on August 4 vs．Toronto at Target Field，despite tossing 5.0 scoreless innings，with one hit and five walks allowed，and five strikeouts．．．the Blue Jays plated three runs in the sixth inning and six runs in the eighth to win，9－3．．．marked his second score－ less start of at least 5.0 innings this season in which he had no part in the decision（also June 15 at Seattle， $5.0 \mathrm{IP}, 3 \mathrm{H}, 0 \mathrm{BB}, 3 \mathrm{~K}$ ）．．．walked at least five batters for the sixth time in his career（career high is 7）and first time since August 26， 2019 at Miami（with Cincinnati）．．．became the second Twins pitcher this season to allow one－or－fewer hits while also walking at least five batters in a start，joining Chris Archer on June 30 at Cleveland（ 4.0 IP， 1 H， 6 BB）

ROYAL CONQUEROR：Will be facing the Royals for the second time this season，after earning the win on May 29 at Target Field（ $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 2 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{R} / E R, 0 \mathrm{BB}, 4 \mathrm{~K}$ ）．．．that game also featured a Gray vs．Greinke pitching matchup，with Greinke taking the loss（ 4.0 IP， $6 \mathrm{H}, 5 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{ER}, 2 \mathrm{HR}, 2 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}$ ）．．．Gray is 5－2， 2．08 ERA（ 52.0 IP， 12 ER）with 10 walks and 41 strikeouts in eight career starts against Kansas City．．． those numbers improve to 3－1，1．13 ERA（24．0 IP， 3 ER）with just three walks and 22 strikeouts in four career starts vs．Kansas City at his home ballpark
$\Phi$ Has won five－straight starts against the Royals since April 16，2016，boasting a 1．41 ERA（32．0 IP， 5 ER）with six walks and 27 strikeouts in that span．

玉 Gray has historically been successful in the month of August，producing a 2.78 ERA（262．1 IP， 81 ER），the lowest monthly ERA（including March／April and September／October）in his career．．．．his career ． 213 opponent batting average（205－for－964）in August is also the lowest of a single month in his career．
$\Phi$ His 247 career strikeouts in the month of August are his second－highest monthly total，trailing the 250 strikeouts he has recorded in July．

HOME SWEET HOME：Slated to make his 10th start at Target Field this season，producing a 2－1 record，3．50 ERA（43．2 IP， 17 ER ）in his previous nine efforts（Twins are 5－4）．．．numbers are skewed by a six－run outing on July 14 vs．Chicago－AL（L， 3.2 IP， $9 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 3 \mathrm{~K}$ ）．．．has allowed three－or－fewer earned runs in all his other home starts this season．．．if his July 14 start is excluded，his ERA at Target Field drops to 2.48 （ 40.0 IP， 11 ER）．．．in comparison is 4－2，3．15 ERA（40．0 IP， 14 ER）in eight starts on the road this year．

KEEP IT IN THE PARK：Has allowed just eight home runs through his first 17 starts of the season （83．2 IP）．．．is tied for the fourth－fewest home runs surrendered by an American League starter this season（min． 17 GS），trailing Los Angeles－AL＇s Patrick Sandoval（5 HR in 19 GS／100．0 IP），Toronto＇s Kevin Gausman（7 HR in 22 GS／122．1 IP）and Houston＇s Framber Valdez（7 HR， 22 GS／142．0 IP）．
$\Phi$ Has given up just one home run to a Kansas City hitter in his career，a solo home run by Raú Ibañez on August 1，2014．．．the home run produced the Ione run of the game，as Kansas City defeated Gray and the Oakland Athletics，1－0．
