THE TWINS: After completing their five-game, seven-day southern California roadtrip with a record of 1-4 (0-2 against the Dodgers and 1-2 against the Angels), the Twins began their seven-game, eight-day homestand with consecutive wins over the Royals the last two nightstoday, they will play the three-game series finale against Kansas Citythey will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Rangers for four games from Friday-Mondaythe Twins
an off-day tomorrow, then host the Rangers for four games from Friday-Mondaythe livins have gone 33-25 at home and 27-30 on the road.

GRAY > ROYAL BLUE: The Twins shut out the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 9-0, their largest margin in a shutout victory since a 12-0 win over Tampa Bay on August 14, 2021...Sonny Gray (7-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, one walk and 10 strikeouts...it marked his 12th career double-digit strikeout total and matched a season-high for the second time...the offense tied a season-high with 16 hits (also June 5 at Toronto)...Gio Urshela tied his career-high with four hits (done 3x previously) while Luis Arraez and Jose Miranda each had three hits apiece.

◆ The Iwins have recorded 23 singles in their last two games (10 Monday night and 13 last night), their first time with at least 23 singles in a two-game span since also having 23 from September 1-2, 2019.

◆ The win marked the 60th for the Twins this season...in 2021, they didn't reach 60 victories until September 6 at Cleveland (60-77).

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 13th of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 8-4 against Kansas City this season, going 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 4-2 at Target Field...these two will meet again six more times this season, a three-game series at Target Field from September 13-15 and a three-game series at Kauffman Stadium from September 20-22.

◆ They have outscored the Royals 61-40 this season...after starting the season 0-2, they have won eight of their last 10 against KC.

◆ Twins batters have hit .304 (126-for-414) with 18 doubles, three triples, eight home runs, 49 walks and 61 runs scored against the Royals this season...they have recorded double-digit hit totals in seven straight against KC.

STARTING TO ROLL: Twins starters have combined to go 5-3, 3.36 ERA (80.1 IP, 30 ER) with 23 walks, 90 strikeouts and a .225 opponent batting average in their last 16 games since July 30...below are the last five starts through the rotation:

ARRAEZ-ING UP: Luis Arraez went 3-for-5 last night, giving him five three-hit games in his last eight overall and 15 three-hit games on the season, tied with Freddie Freeman for the most in baseball...in those last eight games, he is hitting. 486 (17-for-35) with a .526 on-base percentage and a 1.183 OPS...last night, he surpassed 400 career hits (402) in his 348th career game, the fastest to reach the mark among Venezuelan-born players:

UR THE MAN: After going 4-for-5 last night, Gio Urshela is hitting .313 (26-for-83) with five doubles, one triple, four home runs, 16 RBI, a .542 slugging percentage and an .872 OPS in his last 24 games, since July 2.

YES WAY JOSE: In 64 games, since May 20, Jose Miranda is hitting .329 (71-for-216) with a .903 OPS...among all AL players since that date (minimum 100 PA), he ranks sixth in batting average, seventh in OPS, 10th in slugging (.528), and 12th in RBI (46).

Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 200 at-bats this season, he ranks second in batting average (.283) and slugging percentage (.461), third in OPS (.791) and fourth in on-base percentage (.330).

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the sixth time in their last seven games overall, going 2-3 in those previous five.
 ▼ Twins have gone 19-16 this season when facing a left-handed starter...they have an OPS of .713 vs. lefties this season, compared to a .749 OPS against righties.
 ▼ Byron Buxton has a .641 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching, the seventh-best in baseball and third-best in the AL... his nine home runs vs. lefties are tied for second-most among AL players.

THE BUCK SHOW: In 15 games since the All-Star Break, Byron Buxton is hitting .291 (16-for-55) with two doubles, five home runs, eight RBI, 11 runs scored, six walks, a .371 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a .971 OPS...today marks the ninth time in 22 games since the break that Buck has started at DH...he leads the team with 32 starts at DH entering today.

MINOR MATTER: Infielder Brooks Lee hit his first professional home run last night for High-A Cedar Rapids vs. Wisconsin...he is now 6-for-9 in his last two games for the Kernels...in nine professional games between Cedar Rapids and the FCL Twins, he is hitting .378 (14-for-37) with a .939 OPS...he was selected by Minnesota with the eighth overall pick in the 2022 Draft.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, Jim Thome hit the first walk-off home run in Target Field history, a two-run shot off Matt Thornton, beating the White Sox 7-6 in 10 innings...the win made the Twins 69-50 and put them 4.0 games up on second-place Chicago.

LAST TIME OUT: Mahle earned his first win in a Twins uniform in his last start on August 12 at Los Angeles-AL, leading the Twins to a 4-0 shutout victory at Angel Stadium...tossed 6.0 innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and six strikeouts...marked his third scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings this season, also doing so on May 29 vs. San Francisco (6.2 IP) and June 14 at Arizona (9.0 IP)...also marked his 10th quality start of the season, two shy of his career high of 12, set in 2021.

TWO STARTS AGO: Mahle did not factor into the decision on August 5 vs. Toronto at Target Field, his first outing with Minnesota since being acquired from Cincinnati on August 2...allowed four runs on five hits (3 home runs), with one walk and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work...marked his 11th start (out of 20 on the season) in which he worked at least 6.0 innings...yielded a career-high-tying three home runs, doing so for the fifth time in his career and first since May 2, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (with Circinati)

(with Cincinnati).
 Mahle threw 61 of his 83 pitches for strikes, good for a 70.9 strike percentage – his first time throwing at least 70 percent of his pitches for strikes in a start this season (11th time in his career)...his best single-start strike percentage is 75.7, done on September 29, 2019 (his birthday) at Pittsburgh (with Cincinnati).
 Departed with Minnesota ahead, 5-4...after Toronto tied it at 5-5 in the top of the ninth, the Twins won, 6-5, on Tim Beckham's RBI fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th.

ROYAL RUMBLE: Facing Kansas City for just the third time in his career and making his second start; is 1-0, 2.79 ERA (9.2 IP, 3 ER) with five walks, seven strikeouts and a .167 (5-for-30) opponent batting average in his prior two appearances (1 start)...last faced the Royals in a relief appearance on August 12, 2020 at Great American Ball Park with Cincinnati (3.1 IP, 2 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 6 K)...also made a start at Kauffman Stadium on June 13, 2018, earning the 7-0 win in a quality start (6.1 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 1 K).

Today marks his third start and appearance this season against the American League Central division, after a pair of starts earlier this season against Cleveland with Cincinnati, as part of the Ohio Cup rivalry series...has no record, a 4.35 ERA (10.1 IP, 5 ER), four walks, eight strikeouts and a .200 (7-for-35) opponent batting average in those two outings...is 5-2, 4.32 ERA (66.2 IP, 32 ER) with 36 walks, 77 strikeouts and a .234 (58-for-248) opponent batting average in 14 career games (13 starts) against the AL Central.

DAY AND NIGHT, NIGHT AND DAY: Mahle is making his first daytime start as a member of the Twins this afternoon...has gone 2-4, 4.29 ERA (65.0 IP, 31 ER) with 29 walks, 68 strikeouts and a .211 (50-for-237) opponent batting average in 12 day start for Cincinnati this season...earned the win in his last day start on July 24 vs. St. Louis (6.0 IP, 2 H, 3 R/ER, 2 HR, 3 BB, 5 K)...this compares to his 4-3, 4.21 ERA (51.1 IP, 24 ER) with 13 walks, 57 strikeouts and .249 (49-for-197) opponent batting average in nine cumulative night starts this season.

 ARSENAL: Here's a look at Mahle's repertoire in his first 21 starts of the season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his two fastballs, the 4-seam and split finger.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Mahle is holding opposing left-handed batters to a .195 (43-for-221) batting average this season, seventh best in the majors (min. 200 AB)...has held lefties to just 1-for-13 (.077) since joining the Twins...by contrast, righties are hitting .263 (56-for-213) against him this season.

© Owns a .194 (124-for-639) opponent batting average against left-handed hitters since the start of 2020, second best in the majors in that span (min. 500 AB), behind only Milwaukee's Pranden Wedgutff (.189).

WITH THE REDS: Went 5-7, 4.40 ERA (104.1 IP, 51 ER) with 39 walks, 114 strikeouts and a .248 (91-for-393) opponent batting average in 19 starts with the Reds this season...had an 18-day stint on the 15-day Injured List from July 6-23 with a right shoulder strain...in his last nine starts for the Reds, he went 3-2, 2.83 ERA (57.1 IP, 18 ER) with seven quality starts, 16 walks and a .212 (44-for-208) opponent batting average.

Produced four consecutive quality starts from May 29-June 14, the longest such streak of his career

his career.

his career. In his outing on May 29 vs. San Francisco, did not allow a hit until Thairo Estrada, Mahle's final batter, doubled with two outs in the seventh inning...left the game with a 2-0 lead but was the victim of a blown save when the Giants scored six runs in the eighth inning, all with two outs...the Reds lost, 6-4. In the 12-inning, 5-3 win on June 14 at Arizona, Mahle became the first pitcher in the major leagues since 1900 to not earn a win after throwing at least 9.0 scoreless innings on the road with zero walks and at least 12 strikeouts (*Elias*)...became the first Reds pitcher to throw at least 9.0 scoreless innings without earning a win since left-handed pitcher Travis Wood (9 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 8 K) did so in an 11-inning, 1-0 loss on July 10, 2010 at Philadelphia. Made the first Opening Day start of his career and earned the 6-3 win on April 7 at Atlanta (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/0 ER, 2 BB, 7 K) at Atlanta.

CAREER NOTES

Acquired by Minnesota via trade from Cincinnati on August 2, 2022 in exchange for minor league infielders Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer, and left-handed pitcher Steve Hajjar.
Named the Reds' 2022 Opening Day starter, making his first Opening Day start and his fifth-consecutive Opening Day roster.
In 2021, established single-season career highs in wins (13), starts (33), quality starts (12), innings pitched (180.0), strikeouts (201) and batters faced (759)...had 13 wins after entering the season with 13 victories in his career...ranked among the National League pitching leaders in starts (T-1st), wins (T-10th), ERA (16th), strikeouts (9th) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (7th, 10.50).
His strikeouts-per-9 innings ratio of 10.50 in 2021 was third best in Reds franchise history behind Luis Castillo (10.67 in 2019) and Sonny Gray (10.52 in 2019).
Opponents hit just .198 (34-for-172) against Mahle in 2020...went 2-2, 3.59 ERA (47.2 IP, 19 ER) with six home runs, 21 walks and 60 strikeouts over the course of the season.
Made the first relief appearance of his major league career, following 54 consecutive

Oppolentis in Isis. 1-36 (44-101-172) against maint in 2020...went 12-3, 3.9 EAR (47-18) and 60 strikeouts over the course of the season.
 Made the first relief appearance of his major league career, following 54 consecutive starts, on August 12, 2020 vs. Kansas City (3.1 IP, 2 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 6 K)... was his first professional relief appearance since 2015, when he made 26 starts and one relief outing.
 Went 2-10, 4.93 ERA (102.1 IP, 56 ER) in 19 starts in 2019 before he went on the 10-day Injured List on July 22 with a left hamstring strain...was reinstated from the IL and optioned to Triple-A Louisville on August 22 before being added to the Reds' roster on September 1...went 1-2, 5.93 ERA (27.1 IP, 18 ER) in six starting efforts after his September callup and the Reds won three of his last four starts.
