THE TWINS: Began their seven-game, eight-day homestand with a three-game sweep over the Royals this week at Target Field...tonight, they will begin a four-game series with the Rangers through Monday evening, then travel to Houston for a short three-game series/roadtrip...the Twins have gone 34-25 at home and 27-30 on the road.
 ☞ Twins are looking to win four straight, which would mark their longest winning streak since taking six straight from May 18-24.

BULLPEN FINISHES OFF THE ROYALS: The Twins shut out the Royals on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 4-0, their 12th shutout of the season and their sixth sweep in 2022...Tyler Mahle was the starter but did not factor into the decision, exiting the game in the third inning after experiencing right shoulder fatigue...Emilio Pagan (2.0), Griffin Jax (1.2), Jhoan Duran (1.0), Michael Fulmer (1.0) and Trevor Megill (1.0) combined to pitch 6.2 scoreless innings of relief with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Jose Miranda, who drove in two and hit his 12th home run of the season.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other today for the fourth of seven scheduled meetings in 2022...they last played a three-game series at Globe Life Field from July 8-10 as the Twins won the third game.

- ☞ Since the start of last season, all 10 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while five games have been decided by one run...the Twins are 11-6 vs. the Rangers in their last 17 games (since 2019).
- ☞ Twins have scored 6.1 runs-per-game against Texas since 2019, the best in baseball against the Rangers (min. 10 games)...they have scored 5.9 runs-per-game against the Rangers dating back to 2015, also leading baseball (min. 10 games).
- ☞ Luis Arraez has reached safely in 13 of 14 career games against the Rangers, hitting .304 (17-for-56) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, four walks, a .350 on-base percentage and an .850 OPS.
- ☞ Carlos Correa has hit three home runs with nine RBI in his last seven games against Texas...his 20 career home runs vs. the Rangers are his most against any opponent.
- ☞ Gary Sanchez is hitting .328 (20-for-61) with four doubles, eight home runs, 16 RBI, a .414 on-base percentage, a .787 slugging percentage and a 1.201 OPS in 19 career games vs. the Rangers.

STARTING TO ROLL: Twins starters have combined to go 5-3, 3.27 ERA (82.2 IP, 30 ER) with 24 walks, 91 strikeouts and a .220 (67-for-305) opponent batting average in their last 17 games since July 30...below are the last six starts, just over one time through the rotation:

MIRANDA BY THE MONTH: Jose Miranda is hitting .322 (19-for-59) with two doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, a .385 on-base percentage, a .458 slugging percentage and an .842 OPS in 15 games this month...below are his monthly comparisons during his rookie season:

HANGING ZEROS: Twins pitching enters tonight having thrown 26-consecutive scoreless innings, dating back to allowing two runs in the opening inning of the Royals series on Monday...it marks their longest stretch since May 5-8, 2019 - also 26...the last time the Twins had more than 26-straight scoreless was from July 5-8, 2004, when they posted 32-straight, which is also the club record.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Tonight marks the 11th of 20 scheduled home games in August...the Twins have gone 7-3 in 10 home games this month...they enter tonight tied with Chicago-AL (7-3) and Kansas City (7-4) for most home wins in baseball this month, trailing St. Louis (11-1) and New York-NL (9-2)...in those 10 games, the Twins pitching staff has posted a 2.71 ERA (93.0 IP, 28 ER) with 26 walks, 112 strikeouts and a .222 (76-for-342) opponent batting average.
 ☞ Twins are 34-25 at home this season, fifth-most wins in the AL and tied for ninth-most in baseball.

LEFTIES LINING UP: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the seventh time in their last eight games overall (Julio Urias - 8/9 at LAD, Patrick Sandoval - 8/12 at LAA, Reid Detmers - 8/13 at LAA, Tucker Davidson - 8/14 at LAA, Kris Bubic - 8/15 vs. KC and David Lynch - 8/17 vs. KC), going 3-3 in those previous six.

- ☞ Over the six-game stretch, Twins batters have hit .242 (37-for-153) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 walks, a .306 on-base percentage, a .359 slugging percentage and a .665 OPS against left-handed pitching.
- ☞ Twins have gone 20-16 this season when facing a left-handed starter...they have an OPS of .711 vs. lefties this season, compared to a .749 OPS against righties.
- ☞ Byron Buxton has a .612 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching, the eighth-best in baseball and third-best in the AL...his 10 home runs vs. lefties are tied for second-most among AL players.

FAST STARTS: In their last eight games, the Twins have scored at least one run in the first two innings in seven games...the Twins' winning percentage in games in which they've scored the first run this season (.746, 50-17) is 522 points higher than their mark in games in which their opponent scored first (.224, 11-38)...that's the largest such differential for any major league team this season.
 ☞ The Twins have scored 76 first-inning runs this season, fourth-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (82), New York-AL (80) and St. Louis (80).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2007, Johan Santana set a club record with 17 strikeouts against the Rangers at the Metrodome, allowing two hits (both to Sammy Sosa - one single and one double) and no walks in 8.0 innings as Joe Nathan pitched the ninth inning and the Twins beat the Rangers 1-0...Michael Cuddyer provided the game's only run with a homer...Santana passed the Twins previous mark of 15, set by Bert Blyleven (1986), Joe Decker (1973) Jerry Koozman (1980) and Camilo Pascual (1961).

- ☞ Facing Texas for the second time this season, after earning the win on July 10 at Globe Life Field (5.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K)...career 7-2, 3.45 ERA (62.2 IP, 24 ER) in 12 games (10 starts) vs. Texas.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Bundy did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 13 at Los Angeles-AL...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and one strikeout...marked his fourth scoreless start of the season and third of 5.0 innings (also, April 11 vs. Seattle and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL)...also marked his 14th start with one-or-fewer walks allowed.

☞ Bundy departed with the Twins ahead 2-0; the Angels tied the game at 3-3 in the bottom of the ninth and won, 5-3, on Taylor Ward's two-run, walk-off home run in the bottom of the 11th inning.

TWO STARTS AGO: Bundy did not factor into the decision on August 6 against the Toronto Blue Jays at Target Field...allowed two runs on five hits (1 home run), with one walk and six strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...six strikeouts matched his second-highest single-start total of the season for the fourth time (season high is 7, done twice).

☞ Bundy departed with the score tied 2-2; the Twins scored one run in the fifth, two runs in the sixth and two more in the eighth to win, 7-3.

STAYING IN THE ZONE: Bundy threw 46 of his 65 pitches for strikes in his last start on August 13, good for a 70.8 strike percentage...has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent in 11 of his 20 starts this season...owns a **69.27 strike percentage on the season, third best in the majors (min. 95.0 IP), behind Toronto's Kevin Gausman (70.10) and Los Angeles-NL's Julio Urias (69.44).**

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 21 batters in 98.1 innings, including five starts with no walks allowed and nine starts with one walk...this equates to a career-low 5.0 walk percentage and a 1.92 walks-per-9.0 innings...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (33.3%) and first-pitch strike percentage (67.7%).

☞ His 5.0 walk percentage ranks 10th in the American League (min. 95.0 IP), while his 1.92 walks-per-9.0 IP is also 12th under those same parameters.

☞ Additionally, his chase rate ranks in the 89th percentile in baseball this season and his walk percentage ranks in the 90th percentile.

BUNDY, TEXAS WRANGLER: Bundy is making his 13th career appearance and 11th start against Texas tonight (second start/appearance this season); is 7-2, 3.45 ERA (62.2 IP, 24 ER) with 17 walks, 59 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP in his prior outings...tossed 4.0 scoreless innings (1 H, 1 BB, 3 K) in his first two outings against the Rangers, both in relief; each of his last 10 outings have been starts.

☞ Earned the 6-5 win on July 10 at Globe Life Field, after allowing four runs on six hits, with two walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work.

☞ **Seven wins are his most against any single opponent in his career**, while his 3.45 ERA is his third lowest (min. 4 starts) behind his marks against Seattle (2.44 ERA, 7 GS) and Cleveland (2.96 ERA, 5 GS).

☞ Tonight also marks Bundy's fifth start/appearance this season against the American League West division...is 2-0, 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks, 10 strikeouts and a .172 (11-for-64) opponent batting average in his four prior outings against Seattle, Oakland, Texas and Los Angeles-AL.

ON TARGET: Bundy has pitched well at Target Field so far this season, going 3-1, 2.83 ERA (35.0 IP, 11 ER) with seven walks, 24 strikeouts and a .220 (29-for-132) opponent batting average in his seven home starts (Twins are 4-3)...however, just one third of his outings this season (8 of 21, including tonight) have come at home...this compares to his 3-4, 5.83 ERA (63.1 IP, 41 ER), 14 walks, 51 strikeouts and .289 (74-for-256) opponent batting average he's posted in 13 road starts.

☞ Is 1-1, 3.52 ERA (15.1 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 11 strikeouts in his last three home starts, since June 24 (Twins are 2-1).

☞ Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in five of his seven home starts this season...the two exceptions are June 9 vs. New York-AL (4 ER) and July 16 vs. Chicago-AL (3 ER).

KEEP IT MOVING: Bundy is averaging 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant...is the third-fastest worker on the Twins this season (min. 100 pitches) with the bases empty, trailing Cole Sands (14.2 seconds) and Bailey Ober (15.7 seconds)...works faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.2 seconds when there are runners on base, the fourth fastest on the Twins' current active roster and eighth-fastest worker overall for the Twins this season.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 19 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...35 of his 75 strikeouts this season (47 percent) have come on his slider, his second-most-used pitch...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER [2022 SEASON: 2-6, 4.15 ERA // CAREER: 63-87, 3.89 ERA]

Right-hander Chris Archer is scheduled to start tomorrow night against the Texas Rangers at Target Field...was saddled with the 4-2 loss in his last start on August 14 at Los Angeles-AL...allowed three runs on four hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...recorded his ninth start of the season with one-or-fewer walks allowed...also marked his third-straight losing decision; Twins are 0-6 in his last six starts and he last won on June 25 vs. Colorado...is due to face Texas for the first time this season and eighth time in his career (all starts); is 1-3, 4.64 ERA (42.2 IP, 22 ER) with 15 walks and 59 strikeouts in his prior seven outings...last faced the Rangers in 2017, as a member of the Rays; went 0-1, 3.21 ERA (14.0 IP, 5 ER) in two starts that season.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts.
